Gr 2018-19 Men's Basketball - STUDENT Ticket Policy

Georgia Tech students must meet one of the following criteria to be eligible to claim a student ticket for games at McCamish Pavilion:

- 1. Must be an enrolled full-time student
- 2. Graduate/Intern/Co-Op/Part-Time students must verify Athletic Fee payment through the Bursar's Office

All student tickets will be MOBILE!!!

Register online to reserve your free single game ticket online at <u>ramblinwreck.com/students</u>.

The single game ticket delivery method will be Mobile Delivery. You must register for each game in advance and present your mobile ticket at the door upon entry to West Entrance at McCamish Pavilion along with your valid student BuzzCard.

Arrive early! Although you reserve a ticket, entry is only guaranteed if you arrive prior to tipoff. The first ~900 students to arrive at the game with a reserved mobile ticket will be guaranteed seating in the student section. If the student section reaches capacity yet inventory remains in non-student sections, students will be given a ticket as they enter to sit in a reserved, non-student section seat. Students who did not reserve a ticket in advance will be permitted to wait in a standby line to be admitted to the game after tipoff based on seat availability.

- Students without a paid athletic fee will not be able to participate in the student ticket program.
- Student General Admission Seating Areas:
 - Section 108: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)*
 - Section 109: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)*
 - Section 110: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)*
 - Section 113: Rows 1-24 (Behind Basket)

*Must have wristband to sit in Courtside Sections. See Courtside Seat Policy below. **All other sections are reserved for regular ticketed patrons. **

- ALL students must enter through the West Entrance (On Fowler Street across from the Byers Tennis Complex).
- Doors open 1 hour before tip-off.
- "Camping Out" Overnight is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- NO Student GUEST Tickets. Student guests should look to purchase an individual game ticket (if available).

Courtside Seat Policy - The 200 courtside seats are reserved for GT Students ONLY. Students sitting courtside MUST acquire a new wristband for each game. You must show your BuzzCard to obtain a wristband. Wristbands must be attached immediately. No non-GT students (i.e. guests) may occupy courtside seats. No visiting team colors may be worn in this area. Wristbands will likely be "sold out" shortly after doors open. Please DO NOT take a courtside seat if you will not sit there the whole game.

Gr Additional Student Ticket Policies

- Note that reserving a ticket does not guarantee entrance to that game. Reserving a ticket helps accommodate the demand of overflow when available.
- All seating is general admission within the designated student sections.
- Seating availability is first come, first served.
- **NO BACKPACKS ALLOWED**; all bags will be searched upon entrance to McCamish Pavilion, no bags larger than 14"x10"x5" will be allowed into McCamish Pavilion.
- Students must enter games using their own BuzzCard and **MOBILE TICKET**. The name on the mobile ticket **MUST** match the Violators will have the card confiscated and turned over to the BuzzCard office.
- The GTAA reserves the right to sell student section tickets to the general public during games that take place over Winter break. Additionally, student section tickets may be sold if student turnout is at less than 500 students at tip-off.
