TACKLES

Number of tackles made by a player are recorded as follows at Georgia Tech: Whenever a player tackles an opponent by himself he is given credit for one tackle. Whenever two Tech players tackle an opponent at the same time, or approximately the same time, each are given credit for one tackle. If more than two players are in on a tackle at the same time, or the opponent slips and falls, etc., no credit is given to anyone at all. Men working with binoculars in the press box record the tackles as accurately as possible using the above formula.
