Matt Harpring scored 28 points, pulled down 13 rebounds and handed out assists to lead Georgia Tech to a season-opening 74-49 victory over Wofford. Jackets led by just three points, 34-31, at halftime despite shooting nearly 60 cent from the field as Wofford nailed seven three-pointers and took advantage 0 Tech turnovers. But after the intermission, Tech held the Terriers to just 18 its—the lowest second half point total for a Rambling Wreck opponent since yland Eastern Shore scored 18 in 1985—on just 29 percent shooting from floor.

Tech freshman point guard Kevin Morris turned in a strong effort in his at with 17 points, six assists, seven rebounds and three steals.

Matt Harpring notched a double-double with 21 points and 14 rebounds as Georgia Tech defeated Morgan State, 74-58, at Alexander Memorial Coliseum at McDonald's Center, giving Tech head coach Bobby Cremins his 300th victory at Tech and 400th overall. Tech's frontcourt combined for 55 of the Jackets' 74 points as Michael Maddox had 12 points and Eddie Elisma 10, while freshman Pablo Machado contributed 12 points off the bench. The Jackets shot just 39 percent from the field and committed 25 turnovers, but Tech forced 24 Morgan State miscues and outrebounded the Grizzly Bears 53-32.

A three-pointer by Matt Harpring, followed by two more treys by Michael Maddox ignited a 14-point spurt by Georgia Tech as the Yellow Jackets (4-0) rallied from 11 points down in the final four minutes for a 62-61 victory over Georgia in the Bulldogs' first visit to Alexander Memorial Coliseum since 1980.

After the Yellow Jackets led by as many as 10 points in the first half, Georgia took a 59-48 lead on a Ray Harrison steal and layup with 4:51 left. Tech began its run with a steal by Jon Babul and a hard foul on Kevin Morris by Georgia's Derrick Dukes on the ensuing fast break, inciting the crowd. Trailing 59-49, Morris hit both free throws to pull Tech within eight with four minutes to go.

Harpring nailed his trey at 3:41. Back-to-back three-pointers by Maddox followed, the second of which put Tech ahead, 60-59, with 2:27 to play. Maddox, who tied his career high with 18 points, then knocked away a pass by Georgia's Jon Nordin, leading to a pair of Harpring free throws and a three-point advantage

Georgia guard G.G. Smith hit two free throws to cut Tech's lead to one, and then after a turnover by Eddie Elisma, the Bulldogs had the ball back with just over a minute to play. A series of loose balls and a kick allowed Georgia to maintain possession, but the Bulldogs never managed a to get a shot off.

Tech stayed within striking distance the entire second half and trailed by just two points after three-pointer by Matt Harpring with 4:40 left. But the Jackets squandered the chance to tie or go ahead with a pair of untimely turnovers. Still, Tech had one last chance. The Jackets were down 53-47 when Michael Maddox's three-pointer with 43 seconds left cut the deficit in half, and after a steal by Jason Floyd, the Yellow Jackets had another chance to tie the game. But Maddox and Floyd misfired from three-point range, and a Tech turnover led to a dunk by Clemson's Harold Jamison with seven seconds left to seal the outcome.

Harpring led Tech with 21 points as he topped 1,500 for his career, and Eddie Elisma, playing his final home game, added 12 points and seven rebounds.

C.C. Harrison scored 19 points and Jeremy Hyatt added 16 points, including two crucial second-half three-pointers as eighth-seeded N.C. State downed ninth-seeded Georgia Tech, 60-46, in the first round of the ACC Tournament at the Greensboro Coliseum. Tech led 20-19 at the half, but the Wolfpack shot almost 60 percent from the field in the second half to outscore the Jackets, 41-26.

Tech took a four-point lead, 37-33, on a pair of free throws by Matt Harpring with 8:39 left in the game. Hyatt nailed a three-pointer to pull the Wolfpack within one, and after the teams traded baskets, Hyatt's baseline jumper put NC State ahead for good, 40-39, with six minutes left. A minute later, following a timeout, he added another trey for a 43-39 advantage, and from there, State outscored the Jackets, 17-7 in the final minutes. Matt Harpring led Tech with 18 points.
