

## GEORGIA TECH 95, WINTHROP 65

11-24-97 • Alexander Memorial Coliseum

Freshman center Alvin Jones shattered the school record with 11 blocked shots in his collegiate debut as Georgia Tech opened the season with a 95-65 victory over Winthrop. Jones, who broke the previous record of seven blocks, held by John Salley, Matt Geiger and Eddie Elisma and fell one shy of the ACC record, helped Tech hold the Eagles to 33 percent shooting from the field. Matt Harpring had 25 points, 12 rebounds, six assists and four steals to lead the Jackets, while Jason Floyd scored 22 points off the bench.

Matt Harpring scored 21 points and tied his career-high with 16 rebounds as Georgia Tech downed Alabama, 62-60, in the opening round of the Puerto Rico Shootout. With the score tied at 56 with five minutes to play, Dion Glover hit a layup and then Harpring followed with a three-pointer to put the Yellow Jackets ahead for good. Glover added 14 points for the Jackets, while Alvin Jones blocked six shots, helping Tech hold the Tide to less than 32 percent shooting from the field.

## GEORGIA TECH 77, ST. JOHN'S 65

11-28-97 • Eugenio Guerra Sports Complex

Led by double-doubles from Matt Harpring (19 points, 12 rebounds) and Michael Maddox (18 points, 12 rebounds), Georgia Tech defeated St. John's 77-65, in the semifinals of the Puerto Rico Shootout. With the score tied at 36 with 16 minutes to play, the Jackets went on a 19-6 spurt to build a 55-42 advantage midway through the second half. Dion Glover, who finished with 16 points, hit two three-pointers on the run, and Harpring capped it with a 79-foot buzzer-beater at the end of the third quarter. Tech maintained its lead by hitting 20 of 24 from three throw line while holding St. John's to just 32.4 shooting percent from the field.

## GEORGIA TECH 73, LOUISVILLE 69

11-29-97 • Eugenio Guerra Sports Complex

Matt Harpring had 18 points and was named the tournament's Most Valuable Player as Georgia Tech defeated 19th-ranked Louisville, 73-69, to win the Puerto Rico Shootout. Dion Glover also scored 18 points and Michael Maddox added 16 for the Jackets. Tech shot nearly 55 percent from the field in the first half but committed 12 turnovers and the score was tied a 38-38 at the intermission. The Jackets took the lead for good on a Maddox trey at 16:28 of the second half and built an eight-point lead with four minutes to play. After Louisville managed to cut it to three with less than a minute, Glover sealed the outcome with a dunk.

## NC STATE 71, GEORGIA TECH 69 (OT)

12-4-97 • Alexander Memorial Coliseum

C.C. Harrison scored 25 points, including the game-winning 14-foot jumper at the buzzer to give NC State a 71-69 overtime victory. Matt Harpring, who finished with 24 points and 14 rebounds, scored 10 points in the final four minutes of regulation, including a three-pointer with 44 seconds left that put Tech ahead 64-62, but Harrison tied the game with a pair of free throws with 30 seconds left. The Jackets, who trailed by 12 in the first half and by six in the second half, scored the first three points of the overtime but trailed 69-67 when Michael Maddox's short jumper tied the game with 1:50 to play, setting up Harrison's heroics.

Six Kentucky players scored in double figures, led by Heshimu Evans with 14 points, as the fourth-ranked Wildcats outscored Georgia Tech by 16 points in the second half to win 85-71. Tech led by 10 points late in the first half but took just a 35-34 advantage into the locker room, and then Kentucky opened the second half with a 17-4 run to lead 51-39 with 14:30 to play. Dion Glover scored 27 points and Matt Harpring added 22 for Tech, which was plagued by poor shooting (39 percent) and 22 turnovers.

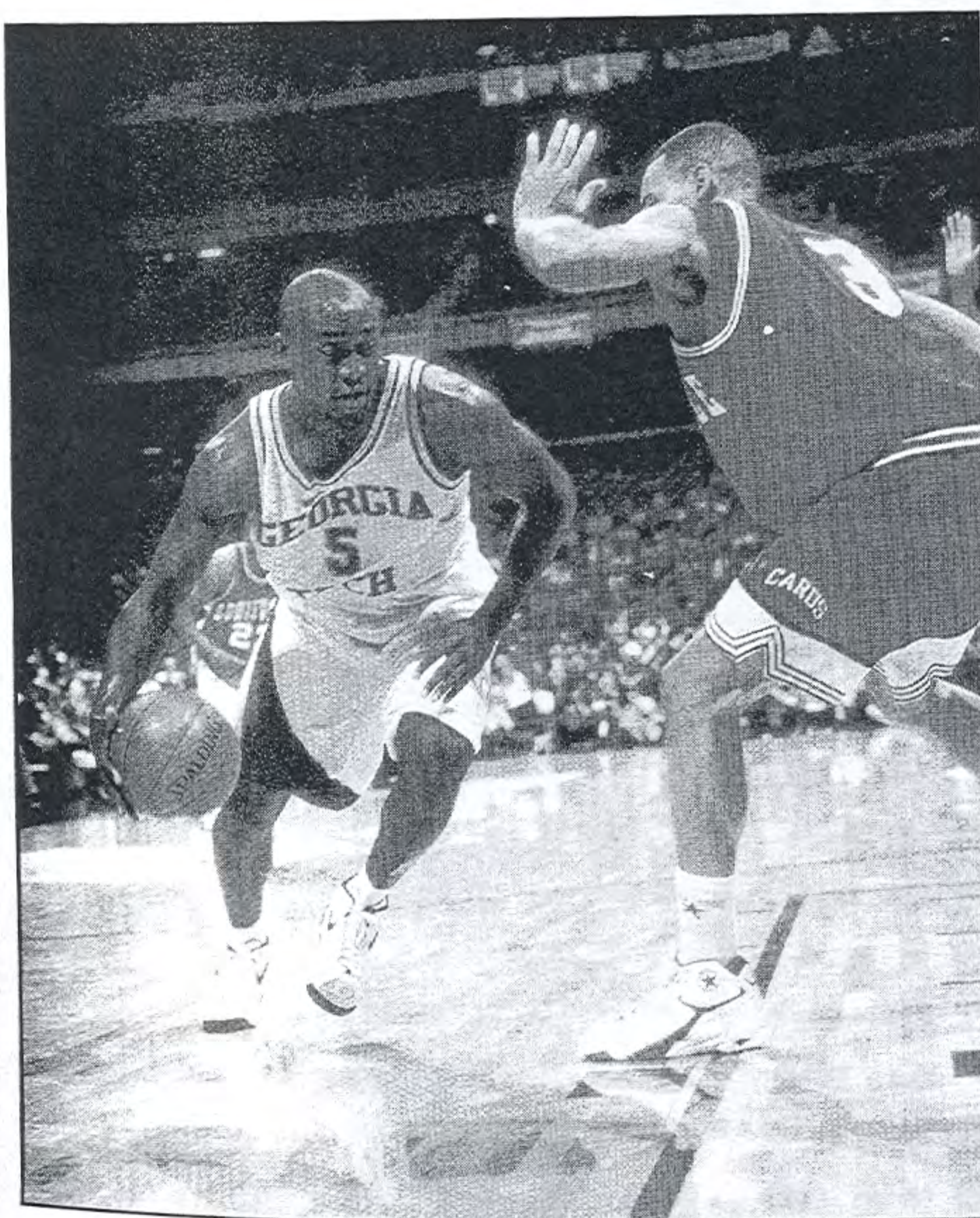
## GEORGIA TECH 94, LOUISVILLE 86

Trailing by 16 points with less than nine minutes to play, Georgia Tech went on a 20-5 run to force overtime and then hung on for an 80-79 victory over Georgetown in the second round of the NIT at Alexander Memorial Coliseum. Down 64-49, freshman T.J. Vines, who scored a career-high 12 points off the bench, began Tech's comeback with a three-pointer at 8:27 and added two more treys on the run. Matt Harpring, who finished with 20 points and 13 rebounds, completed the comeback with a three-point play with 29 seconds left that tied the score at 69. Georgetown's Shernard Long hit a three-pointer with 42 seconds left in the overtime to knot the score at 79. With Tech playing for a final shot, Vines was fouled and hit one free throw with 11 seconds left to put Tech ahead. He missed the second and Tech rebounded, but Harpring missed a pair from the line with 8.7 seconds on the clock. The Hoyas had a chance to win, but Rhese Gibson's layup attempt from the lane was off the mark.

Tech led 18-17 with five minutes left in the first half before the Hoyas finished the half with a 15-2 run to lead 32-20. The Jackets made 20 of 30 field goals (67 percent) in the second half and overtime after hitting just 7-for-25 (28 percent) in the first half.

Four Penn State players scored in double figures, led by Pete Lisicky and Greg Grays with 18 points each as Penn State defeated Georgia Tech 75-70, in the quarterfinals of the NIT. Tech's Matt Harpring scored 25 points in his final game, leaving him eight points shy of the Georgia Tech career scoring record of 2,232 points.

The game featured two of the nation's top shot blockers in Penn State's Calvin Booth, who ranked second in the nation, and Tech freshman Alvin Jones, who was third, but it was Booth who proved to be the difference for the Nittany Lions. With Tech trailing by one with less than three minutes to play, Booth blocked a shot by Dion Glover and then scored a layup on the other end. After a Tech turnover, Booth's hook shot from the baseline put Penn State ahead 69-64 with a minute to go.
