



Georgia Tech pushed second-ranked North Carolina to the limit before falling 107-100 in a double-overtime thriller. North Carolina's Shammond Williams poured in 42 points, including 8-for-11 from three-point range, and Antawn Jamison had 31 to outdo Tech's senior duo of Michael Maddox, who had a career-high 32 points, and Matt Harpring, who tied his career-highs with 30 points and 16 rebounds. Tech trailed by eight with two minutes to play in regulation, but after Ed Cota made one of two free throws, Maddox's three-pointer tied the game with 17 seconds left to force the overtime. Another Maddox trey put the Jackets ahead by four midway through the first overtime, but Williams tied the

game with two free throws with six seconds left. The Jackets had one final shot, but Jason Floyd's baseline jumper rolled out and Maddox's tip-in came just after the buzzer. Williams hit two long three-pointers and four free throws in the second extra session and the Tar Heels held on for the win. Tech outrebounded the Heels, 46-29, but UNC shot an amazing 63.8 percent for the game, including 10-for-18 from three-point range. The combined 214 points is the highest scoring game between two ACC teams since Duke beat Maryland, 114-111, in overtime on Feb. 10, 1990
