In his first game in a Georgia Tech uniform, Jason Collier had 22 points, 11 rebounds and five blocked shots as the Yellow Jackets rallied from a 15-point second-half deficit for an 84-79 overtime victory over arch-rival Georgia. Tony Akins led Tech with 24 points, including two free throws that tied the game at the end of regulation and six of Tech's 12 points in the overtime.

Ahead most of the game, Georgia built a 65-50 advantage on a Michael Chadwick basket with 10:33 left in the second half, but that was the Bulldogs' last field goal of regulation. Tech still trailed 72-65 when Collier hit a three-pointer to cut the deficit to four points with 1:40 to play. Then Akins stole the ball and fed Collier for a layup that made the score 72-70. On Tech's next possession, Akins pounced on a loose ball and was fouled, and his free throws tied the game with 34.6 seconds left. Georgia had a shot to tie, but G.G. Smith's final shot was blocked by Collier. Collier scored the first basket of the overtime to give the Jackets their first lead since 9-7. Akins added a driving layup and Darryl Barrie came off the bench to hit a crucial field goal. After Georgia the lead to one, Akins sank a pair of free throws with 20.3 seconds left, and then sealed the win with two more charity tosses. Tech hit 12 of its last 14 shots from the field, including all four in overtime.

Georgia Tech's front line of Jason Collier and Alvin Jones combined for 58 points, 27 rebounds and five blocked shots as the Yellow Jackets outlasted Florida State, 111-108, in double overtime to snap a three-game losing streak. Collier poured in a career-high 30 points, including four-of-five three-pointers, and grabbed 10 rebounds, while Jones went 10-for-12 from the field for a career-best 28 points, including 10 points in overtime, along with 17 rebounds. After FSU's Adrian Crawford sent the game into overtime with a running jumper with 4.6 seconds left, Jason Floyd rescued the Jackets with a threepointer with 32.9 seconds left in the first overtime, forcing the second session. The Seminoles, who had five players foul out, nearly forced another overtime, but Crawford's three-point attempt at the buzzer rolled off the rim. With 111 points, Tech set a school record for points in an ACC game and recorded its highest point total since the

But UNC answered quickly with six straight points from backup center Brian Bersticker, who finished with 12 points, to begin a 38-9 run over the final 12:30. The Tar Heels shot 54 percent from the field, including 18-for-27 (67 percent) in the second half, while Tech managed to hit just 30 percent and did not score a twopoint field in the second half. Collier led Tech with 17 points.

A.D. Smith scored 17 points, including the winning free throws with 1:20 left, and Alex Scales added 16 points to lead Oregon to a 67-64 victory over Georgia Tech in the first round of the NIT. After trailing 63-59, Tech took the lead on a three-pointer by Jason Floyd and then a tip in by Alvin Jones that put the Jackets ahead 64-63 with 1:38 to play. On Oregon's next possession, Smith drew a charge on Tech's Jason Collier and hit both free throws to put the Ducks ahead. Tony Akins missed a final shot for the Jackets. Jones led Tech with 27 points and 11 rebounds, while Collier had a career-best 13 boards.
