#### **LEADING OFF**

- Coming off a road series win at Charleston Southern, Georgia State plays its annual series vs.
   Atlanta neighbor Georgia Tech, Tuesday at Tech's Russ Chandler Stadium and Wednesday at the
   GSU Baseball Complex.
- To win the series at Charleston Southern, the Panthers rallied from a 4-1 deficit after six innings and a 6-4 deficit after eight. In the ninth, GSU loaded the bases on a hit by pitch and singles by Griffin Cheney and Brandon Bell. Jake Corso pulled GSU within one with a sacrifice fly, and then Elian Merejo laced a single off the pitcher that deflected into left field to bring home two runs. Freshman Ryan Watson finished the game with two scoreless innings to earn the win.
- Merejo, the junior designated hitter, went 5-for-12 with a home run, five RBI and three runs scored in the series, along with his game-winning hit.
- Freshman right-hander Joseph Brandon, who won back-to-back state titles at Loganville High School, will make his first start Tuesday at Georgia Tech.
- Georgia Tech leads the series, 66-11, but Georgia State won the last meeting with a 5-2 victory at Tech. Seniors Will Kilgore and Romero Greer drove in two runs each and seven GSU pitchers combined for 14 strikeouts, including Tyler Koch, who recorded the final five outs to earn the save.
- Last year's win at Georgia Tech is one of five victories over the Yellow Jackets under head coach Greg Frady.
- Georgia State returns 19 letterwinners, including nine seniors, and the Panthers welcome 13 newcomers with nine freshmen and four junior college transfers. GSU graduated its entire infield, including All-Sun Belt catcher Nick Gatewood, an 11th-round draft pick of the San Diego Padres, and four-year starting shortstop Justin Jones, along with Sunday starter Jordan Lee.
- Preseason All-America and Preseason Sun Belt Conference Pitcher of the Year Hunter Gaddis takes the mound for the Panthers on Friday nights. The junior right-hander has 13 career victories, including a 9-4 record and a 2.95 ERA in 2018, when he tied for the Sun Belt lead in victories while ranking second in the league in innings pitched (100.2), third in strikeouts (98) and fourth in ERA.
- Gaddis leads the Sun Belt with 15 strikeouts in his first two starts. He has taken a lead into the
  eighth inning in both games but does not have a decision yet.
- Gaddis is one of three Panthers named to the Preseason All-Sun Belt team. Senior Brandon Bell, GSU's top returning hitter and starting right fielder who also plays third base and pitches, was named as a utility player. Sophomore Ryan Glass was selected as the DH after earning second-team all-conference honors there in 2018, when he belted seven homers; he is now starting at third base.
- Freshmen reliever Ryan Watson has earned a save and a victory in his first two appearances in a Panther uniform. Against UIC, he pitched two perfect innings with three strikeouts for the save, then at Charleston Southern, he finished the game with two scoreless inning to earn the win.
- The GSU bullpen is boosted by the return of fifth-year senior reliever Rhett Harper, who missed the 2018 season after elbow surgery. The righty led the Panthers with six saves in 2017, when he was also a CoSIDA Academic All-District selection. He maintains a 4.1 GPA while majoring in accounting and finance.
- Now in his 13th season as the Georgia State head coach, Greg Frady is the Panthers' career victory leader with 358 in Atlanta as part of his 545 career wins in his 19th season.

- Preseason Sun Belt Conference Pitcher of the Year by the league head coaches and Collegiate Baseball newspaper.
- Rated the No. 105 college prospect for the 2019 MLB Draft by D1 Baseball.
- Career record of 13-8 with a 3.23 ERA.
- Twice taken a no-hitter into the eighth inning (UT Arlington in 2017; Little Rock in 2018)
- Pitched for the Cape Cod League's Chatham Anglers in the summer of 2018 (3-1 record, 2.00 ERA) and for Team USA in the summer of 2017.

### 2019 SEASON (JUNIOR)

Has taken a lead into the eighth inning in his first two starts that bullpen was unable to hold. Leads Sun Belt with 15 strikeouts.

### **2018 SEASON (SOPHOMORE)**

- 2018 All-Sun Belt (second team), All-Sun Belt Tournament and two-time Sun Belt Pitcher of the Week.
- 9-4 record, when he led the Sun Belt with nine wins and two complete games and second in the league in innings (100.2), third in strikeouts (98) and fourth in ERA (2.95).
- Tied the GSU season record with nine victories.
- His 2.95 ERA was the fifth-lowest in school history, while his 98 strikeouts rank fourth in a season but are the most for a GSU pitcher since 1997.
- Of GSU's 10 conference victories in 2018, six came in his starts, plus one that he closed.
- Finished 2018 with dominating performance vs. Little Rock in Sun Belt tourney, despite pitching on short rest. Took a no-hitter with a career-high 12 strikeouts into the eighth inning before giving up a single up the middle with two outs in the eighth.
- Combined with his relief outing on the final day of the regular season, for his last nine innings of 2018, he allowed 0 runs on one hit with 16 strikeouts
- Pitched a complete-game, three-hit shutout vs. Samford and a complete-game victory over South Alabama.
- Defeated No. 16 Coastal Carolina on the road as he allowed two runs on five hits with eight strikeouts over seven innings.

### **2017 SEASON (FRESHMAN)**

- Georgia State's top pitcher as a freshman with 4-4 record and 3.72 ERA.
- Moved into weekend rotation in week three after earning two wins out of the bullpen.
- Led the team with 67 strikeouts, against 19 walks, 75.0 innings and a .227 average against.
- Had a no-hitter through seven innings vs. UT Arlington before allowing a solo homer to lead off the eighth.
- Pitched 18 consecutive scoreless innings vs. Northern Kentucky, Army and UT Arlington.

SERIES vs. GEORGIA TECH: The two Atlanta schools have met 77 times since 1971, including every year since Georgia State reinstated its program in 1992.

- Georgia Tech leads the series 66-11, but the Panthers won the last meeting, 5-2, last season at Tech. The Jackets won the first meeting in 2018, 12-6 at GSU.
- The Panthers have earned five victories over Georgia Tech under head coach Greg Frady, including four at Russ Chandler Stadium.
- GSU's 10-1 victory in 2009 over a Tech team ranked No. 3 represents the highest-ranked team the Panthers have ever beaten.
- Georgia State's only NCAA appearance came in the 2009 Atlanta Regional at Tech's Russ Chandler Stadium.
- State and Tech are playing back-to-back games for the first time since 2000.

#### **MORE ON COACH FRADY**

Georgia State's career leader in victories with 358, surpassing Mike Hurst (293, 1993-2006) on March, 20, 2016. Also has the highest winning percentage of any coach in GSU history.

Reached 500 career victories, including 187 at North Florida C.C., vs. Northern Kentucky on March 4, 2017. Now has 545 career wins.

After taking over a program with just two winning seasons in its history, he has guided the Panthers to six 30-win campaigns in the last 11 years, highlighted by a conference title and NCAA regional berth in 2009.

His program has produced three All-Americans, four Freshman All-Americans, four preseason All-Americans, three Academic All-Americans and 46 all-conference or all-rookie honorees.

In the last six years, eight different Panthers have earned a total of 13 All-America awards.

Has coached prolific offensive teams throughout his Georgia State tenure, including clubs that:

- Led the nation in runs scored (2010);
- Ranked third in the nation in batting average and fourth in runs per game (2013);
- Ranked second in the nation in home runs per game (2014).

Served 11 years (2004-14) as manager of the German National Team and was inducted into the German Baseball and Softball Hall of Fame in 2016.

### **FUTURE HOME OF THE PANTHERS**

In 2017, Georgia State University purchased the former Turner Field property occupied by the Atlanta Braves.

The venue is now Georgia State Stadium and is the home of Panther football.

In the near future, the GSU baseball program will move into a new stadium that will be constructed adjacent to Georgia State Stadium. The baseball facility will be on the footprint of the former Atlanta Fulton-County Stadium, where Hank Aaron hit home run No. 715 and the Braves won the 1995 World Series.

The area will also include student housing as well as retail development, becoming an extension of Georgia State's rapidly growing downtown Atlanta campus.

Seven of his collegiate players and three of his German team standouts have reached the Major Leagues, including former Georgia State pitcher David Buchanan.

Seven GSU players and five signees have been selected in the Major League Baseball draft over the last five years.

Inducted into the Georgia Dugout Club Hall of Fame in 2017.

Won a Division II national title as a player at Troy State.
