### BULLDOG POLLS/INJURY UPDATE

\*Georgia moved up to a season-best No. 4 in the *D1Baseball.com* Top 25. Georgia's ranking ranges from No. 4-8 this week.

\*Junior starting LF **Tucker Bradley** is out for the season after having successful surgery March 12 to repair his right (non-throwing) shoulder. A career .303 hitter, he is expected to make a full recovery. He was injured diving for a catch versus Dayton.

\*Sophomore LHP **Ryan Webb**; Arm Soreness; OUT since March 8. Junior starting 1st Baseman **Patrick Sullivan**: Sliding attempt to catch foul ball near 1B line at South Carolina, OUT with Concussion since March 19. Starting junior RHP **Will Proctor**; Arm Soreness; OUT since March 19. Sophomore starting Catcher **Mason Meadows**: Swung at pitch, foul tip; Facial Fracture, OUT since March 24.

### TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach: **Scott Stricklin** is in his 6th season at UGA; 15th season overall.

**Rankings:** #4 *D1Baseball.com*; #6 *USA Today*; #6 *Baseball America*; #8 *Coll. Baseball*.

\*At 21-3 overall, Georgia is off to its best start since 2009 when that club was also 21-3 after 24 games. However, this year's squad is 5-1 in the SEC which is tied with Arkansas and Texas A&M for the best record in the league. The 2009 squad was 4-2 after its first two SEC series. Two of Georgia's losses this year have been 1-0.

\*Up next, Georgia plays the first of three contests against Ga. Tech (16-8). On Tuesday, the Bulldogs travel to Atlanta to face the Yellow Jackets with first pitch at 7 p.m. Game two of the series will be April 9 in Athens and the final game will be at SunTrust Park, home of the Atlanta Braves, on April 23 to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. The Bulldogs have swept Tech the past two years for a six-game winning streak in the series, the longest stretch since a six-game streak in 1985-86. Georgia's Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Scott Stricklin** played for Tech coach Danny Hall at Kent State in the early 1990s and later served on his staff as a volunteer coach (1998-99) and assistant coach (2002-04). During his Georgia tenure, Coach Stricklin is 10-4 against Tech.

\*Georgia's pitching staff ranks fifth nationally with a 2.54 ERA. Georgia's starting pitching this year is 16-2 with a 1.85 ERA. In the series win over No. 10 LSU, the starting trio of sophomore **Emerson Hancock** (5-1 0.59 ERA), sophomore **C.J. Smith** (2-0, 2.05 ERA) and junior **Tony Loyce** (4-0, 2.10 ERA) combined for 19.1 innings and allowed just two earned runs but came away 1-1.

\*Georgia junior **Tim Elliott** (3-1, 0.39 ERA) gets the start versus Tech. His lone loss came 1-0 to LIU Brooklyn on an unearned run on Feb. 26. The past two weeks, he's beaten Ga. State in midweek action. This will be Elliott's ninth career start, and he's 4-1 with a 1.50 ERA as a starter.

\*The Bulldogs posted a perfect fielding percentage in the series win over No. 10 LSU. In SEC play, Georgia has made just one error for a .995 fielding percentage.

\*The Bulldogs are batting .290 with a .406 on base percentage, a 2.54 ERA and a .982 fielding percentage (tied for 4th nationally). Georgia's top hitters are senior 2B **LJ Talley** (.398-4-16), sophomore RF **Riley King** (.348-3-26), junior CF **Tucker Maxwell** (.333-6-26) and junior 3B/Closer **Aaron Schunk** (.313-4-19, 0-0, 1.64 ERA, NCAA-leading 10 SV).

\*Georgia has moved up to a season-best No. 4 ranking in the *D1Baseball.com* Top 25 poll. It's the highest ranking for the Bulldogs since checking in at No. 1 for five weeks during the 2009 season.

\***On Deck:** The Bulldogs return to SEC action Thursday against Kentucky in Lexington. The Wildcats (14-10, 0-6 SEC) opened league play by getting swept by No. 13 LSU in Baton Rouge and then swept at home this past weekend by No. 13 Texas A&M. Game one of the UGA-UK series on Thursday will be televised on the SEC Network with the final two contests available on SEC Network+. The road team in the Georgia-Kentucky matchup has won every series since 2014.

UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH  
6TH SEASON AT UGA; 15TH OVERALL



Scott Stricklin is in his sixth season as the Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach at the University of Georgia. Since arriving at UGA, Stricklin, 47, has created an atmosphere of excitement around the program, starting with the current student-athletes, extending to former lettermen and to Georgia baseball fans around the state. He has organized numerous lettermen functions to help reunite former players and steered the \$12 million Foley Field Revival project that was completed prior to the 2015 season. He has engaged the fan base with the annual First Pitch banquets featuring Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Phil Niekro and Chipper Jones, Braves standout Jeff Francoeur and Bulldog legends and Major Leaguers Gordon Beckham and Kyle Farmer.

Georgia's recruiting classes have steadily improved under Stricklin, according to *Perfect Game USA* national rankings. In fact, the class that made its debut in 2017 was ranked No. 3 nationally. Additionally, the Bulldogs have excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.08 GPA for the fall semester of 2016 and 3.01 GPA in the fall of 2017. A total of 19 Bulldogs made the 2017 SEC Academic Honor Roll and 21 earned a spot on the honor roll in 2018.

The 2018 campaign saw Georgia return to prominence as a regular in the Top 25 rankings, earning a top eight national seed and playing host to an NCAA Regional for the first time in a decade. After being picked to finish fifth in the East, Georgia posted 39-21 record and its 18-12 SEC mark tied for the second best in the league. The Bulldogs were NCAA Athens Regional Finalists and set four school records (.979 fielding percentage, holding opponents to a .236 batting average, 532 strikeouts by the pitching staff and seven grand slams by the offense). Three Bulldogs earned All-America honors, four made the All-SEC squad, 21 made the SEC Academic Honor Roll and three were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in earned run average during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (16) and Keaton (11), and a son, Cale (14).
