- The Tigers are averaging 6.3 runs per game and hitting .253 with a .359 on-base percentage and 78 steals.
- The pitching staff has a 3.87 ERA, .234 opponents' batting average and 2.58 strikeout-to-walk ratio and Clemson is fielding .970.

POWER & SPEED SURGE

- In 2018, Clemson hit 98 homers, tied for third in the nation, but many of those players who contributed to that total departed.
- Clemson has hit 49 homers in 42 games in 2019, good for 1.2 per game. The Tigers were second in the nation in that category in 2018 (1.6).
- Clemson hit a homer in 13 consecutive games, the last two games of 2018 and the first 11 games of 2019.
- The 13-game streak tied a Tiger record. From March 21 to April 12, 1966 and March 31 to April 17, 1996 Clemson also had a 13-game streak.
- Thirteen Tigers have accounted for the 49 homers. Logan Davidson has a team-high 11 homers and Bryce Teodosio is second with eight homers.
- Clemson has also showed a penchant for stealing bases in 2019. The Tigers have 78 steals, an average of 1.9 per game.
- Twelve Tigers have accounted for the 78 steals. Sam Hall leads the team with 27 steals and Logan Davidson is second with 16 steals.

KEEPING THEM LOADED

- Tiger pitchers have performed remarkably well when the opposition has the bases loaded in 2019.
- They have held opponents to just 4-for-36 (.111) with three singles, a double, walk and no hit-by-pitches with six strikeouts.
- Opponents are 0-for-9 against Carson Spiers and 0-for-5 versus Davis Sharpe with the bases loaded.

FAMILY CONNECTIONS

- Clemson has several players who have family ties to current and former professional athletes as well as former Tigers.
- Grayson Byrd's father, Paul Byrd, was a righthander at Louisiana State and played 14 seasons (1995-02,04-09) in the major leagues.
- Logan Davidson's father, Mark Davidson, played at Clemson in 1982 and played six seasons (1986-91) in the majors with the Twins and Astros.
- Chad Fairey's uncle, Burke Fairey, played baseball at Clemson (1985-88) and his grandfather, Jim Fairey, played six MLB seasons (1968-73).
- Adam Hackenberg's brother, Christian Hackenberg, was a quarterback at Penn State from 2013-15.
- Ryne Huggins' father, Mike Huggins, played three seasons (1986,87,89) at Clemson and had a 4-3 record and four saves in 41 relief outings.
- Bo Majkowski's father, Don Majkowski, played football at Virginia, then played 10 years (1987-96) in the NFL, totaling 12,700 passing yards.
- James Parker's father, Tim Parker, was a pitcher at Clemson in 1987,88,90 and was a third-round draft pick by the Chicago Cubs.
- Carson Spiers' cousin, Will Spiers, was a sophomore starting punter on Clemson's 2018 national title team.
- Carson Spiers' father, Michael Spiers, hit .301 with 16 homers, 110 RBIs and 32 steals in 184 games over four seasons (1988-91) at Clemson.
- Carson Spiers' uncle, Bill Spiers, played three seasons (1985-87) at Clemson and played 13 seasons (1989-01) in the major leagues.
- Carson Spiers' grandfather, Bud Spiers, hit .254 with seven homers and 44 RBIs at Clemson (1956-58).

ASKEW ANSWERING THE CALL

- When Clemson was in need of help in the weekend rotation in early March, freshman lefthander Keyshawn Askew stepped up.
- He was a midweek starter in the first few weeks, then he made his weekend starting debut against No. 3 North Carolina on March 10.

 He is 2-1 with a 4.42 ERA, .262 opponents' batting average and 33 strikeouts in 38.2 innings pitched over 10 appearances (nine starts).

BYRD PROVIDING SENIOR LEADERSHIP

- Senior Grayson Byrd has been a steadying influence as a leader and due to his ability to play both corner infield spots and in the outfield.
- He has started 21 games at third base, 11 at first base and 10 of the last 12 in left field.
- He is hitting .295 with five homers, two triples, 10 doubles, 32 RBIs, 30 runs and a .385 on-base percentage in 42 games in 2019.
- He is hitting .313 with three homers, a triple, five doubles, 17 RBIs, 15 runs and a .411 on-base percentage in 21 ACC regular-season games.
- He was named ACC Player-of-the-Week on April 1 for his performances in four road games from March 26-31.
- He was 9-for-15 (.600) with two doubles, two triples, a homer, seven RBIs, 10 runs and a .714 on-base percentage in the four games.
- In his three seasons as a Tiger, he is hitting .276 with 15 homers, 78 RBIs, 75 runs and nine steals in 147 games (135 starts).
- He is the son of former MLB pitcher Paul Byrd.

CLARK CARVING UP THE COMPETITION

- Sophomore lefthander Mat Clark was a reliever as a freshman in 2018 and during the first few weeks of the 2019 season.
- He has since moved into the weekend rotation as the Saturday starter.
- He has utilized his control and change of speed to be effective on the mound.
- He was one of 69 pitchers named to the National Pitcher-of-the-Year Award Watch List in April.
- He is 7-1 with a 2.84 ERA, .196 opponents' batting average and 35 strikeouts in 44.1 innings pitched over nine appearances (six starts).
- He has allowed just 11 walks.
- He is 5-1 with a 3.06 ERA, .198 opponents' batting average and 22 strikeouts in 35.1 innings pitched in six ACC regular-season starts.
- He made his second career start against No. 3 North Carolina in the second game of a doubleheader on March 9 and earned the win.
- He pitched 7.0 scoreless innings of three-hit ball with seven strikeouts against no walks to earn the win against Notre Dame on March 16.
- He allowed just one run on four hits in 7.1 innings pitched to earn the win against No. 8 Louisville on April 6.
- In his career, he is 11-1 with a 2.47 ERA and .203 opponents' batting average in 65.2 innings pitched over 28 appearances (seven starts).
- He has 58 strikeouts against only 15 walks in his career, good for a 3.87 strikeout-to-walk ratio.

DAVIDSON DOING IT ALL

- Junior shortstop Logan Davidson has shown the ability to impact the game in a variety of ways.
- He was one of 40 players named to the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List in April.
- He was one of 69 shortstops named to the Brooks Wallace Award Watch List in April
- He was voted as a co-captain (alongside Carson Spiers) by his teammates prior to the 2019 season.
- He is hitting .280 with 11 doubles, a triple, 11 homers, 38 RBIs, 36 runs, a .401 on-base percentage and 16 steals in 42 games.
- He is 10-for-27 (.370) with three homers, four doubles, nine walks and a .564 on-base percentage after the seventh inning.

- He has committed only seven errors in 204 chances at shortstop, good for a .966 fielding percentage.
- He had a 14-game hitting streak in March and is riding a current 39-game on-base streak.
- He hit a walkoff two-run homer on a 2-2 pitch with two outs in Clemson's 5-4 win over No. 3 North Carolina to complete a sweep on March 10.
- In his career, he is hitting .287 with 38 doubles, a triple, 38 homers, 125 RBIs, a .399 on-base percentage and 36 steals in 168 games.
- He has hit 19 career homers as a lefthanded batter and 19 career homers as a righthanded batter.
- He is the 10th Tiger in history to hit double-digit homers in three different seasons.
- He is the first Tiger in history to total double-digit homers and double-digit steals in three different seasons.
- He has started every Clemson game of his career at shortstop and has a .949 career fielding percentage.
- He was named Clemson's top male ACC Scholar-Athlete (for all sports) in 2019 thanks in large part to his 3.98 cumulative GPA.
- His father, Mark, a former Tiger and MLB player, was a student assistant coach on the 2018 team.

HALL STARTING THINGS OFF

- Sophomore infielder and outfielder Sam Hall has been in the leadoff spot in 2019, and he has also started at five different positions.
- He is hitting .273 with 11 doubles, seven homers, 27 RBIs, 45 runs, a .383 on-base percentage and 27 steals in 42 games in 2019.
- His 27 steals are the most by a Tiger since 1999, when Henrí Stanley also had 27 steals.
- He has made 14 starts at second base, 13 in left field, seven at third base, six in center field and two in right field in 2019.
- He is the only Tiger to start every game in the same lineup spot (1).
- He received the Bob Bradley Award as Clemson's MVP of the South Carolina series from March 1-3.
- He was 5-for-10 with a homer, double, three RBIs, four runs, a .571 on-base percentage and three steals in the series against the Gamecocks.
- In Clemson's sweep of No. 3 North Carolina from March 9,10, he started one game apiece in left field, center field and right field.
- He was 6-for-15 (.400) with three homers, six RBIs, five runs and four steals in the three-game series against Duke from April 19-21.
- In his career, he is hitting .263 with 15 doubles, nine homers, 34 RBIs, 63 runs and 35 steals in 67 games (63 starts)

BRYAR HAWKINS PATCHING THE TIGERS

- Freshman infielder Bryar Hawkins has emerged as an everyday player at first base and designated hitter.
- He is hitting .282 with five doubles, a triple, four homers, 17 RBIs, 23 runs and a .364 on-base percentage in 34 games (31 starts).
- He is hitting .321 with three homers, four doubles, nine RBIs, 19 runs and a .396 on-base percentage in 21 ACC regular-season games.
- He is riding a current 10-game hitting streak.
- He hit a three-run homer in his first career plate appearance against Virginia Military in the second game of a doubleheader on Feb. 23.
- He had five straight two-hit games between March 24-31.

HENNESSY FINDING HIS GROOVE

 Junior lefthander Jacob Hennessy was Clemson's Friday starter on the mound in 2018, but has been a reliever most of 2019.

- He made his first start of the 2019 season against Furman on April 10 and made his first ACC start against Duke on April 21.
- He is 3-0 with a 3.95 ERA, .233 opponents' batting average and 19 strikeouts in 27.1 innings pitched over 10 appearances (three starts).
- He allowed just two hits, no runs and no walks with three strikeouts in 6.1 innings pitched to earn the win against Furman on April 10.
- He allowed only two hits, no runs and one walk with four strikeouts in 5.0 innings pitched at No. 4 Georgia on April 16.
- In his career, he is 9-4 with three saves, a 3.90 ERA and 110 strikeouts in 129.1 innings pitched over 50 appearances (17 starts).
- He has allowed just 33 walks and 128 hits in his career, good for a .257 opponents' batting average.

JONES STANDING TALL

- Sophomore righthander Holt Jones is one of the tallest Tigers in history at 6'8".
- The native of Santa Monica, Calif. pitched sparingly as a freshman in 2018, but he has become one of the team's top relievers in 2019.
- He is 2-0 with three saves, a 2.86 ERA, .162 opponents' batting average and 39 strikeouts in 34.2 innings pitched over 16 relief outings.
- He is holding opponents to 8-for-61 (.131) with runners on base, 5-for-43 (.116) with RISP and 4-for-40 (.100) with two outs.
- He pitched 4.0 scoreless innings of one-hit ball with three strikeouts to record the save against South Carolina on March 2.
- In two relief appearances against No. 8 Louisville on April 5,7, he pitched 5.0 hitless and scoreless innings with five strikeouts
- He pitched 3.2 hitless and scoreless innings in relief in extra innings with five strikeouts at No. 4 Georgia on April 16.
- In his career, he is 4-0 with three saves, a 3.35 ERA and 57 strikeouts in 51.0 innings pitched over 24 appearances (three starts)
- He has allowed just 35 hits in his career, good for a .194 opponents' batting average.

MAJKOWSKI KNOWS GETTING ON BASE

- Sophomore outfielder has burst onto the scene to not only become an everyday starter in the outfield, but one of the team's top hitters.

- Freshman utility player Davis Sharpe has made an immediate impact, both on the mound and at the plate.
- He was one of 69 pitchers named to the National Pitcher-of-the-Year Award Watch List in April.
- He was one of 25 players named to the John Olerud Two-Way Player-of-the-Year Award Watch List in April.

- Duggar was a two-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2013-15 and made his MLB debut with the San Francisco Giants on July 8, 2018.
- Freeman, who hit .330 in 189 games as a Tiger, made his major league debut with the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 27, 2016.
- Leone, who had a 16-8 career record at Clemson, made his major league debut with the Seattle Mariners in 2014
- Miller, the 2011 ACC Player-of-the-Year, hit .339 with 36 doubles, eight triples, 16 homers, 135 RBIs and 46 steals in 191 games as a Tiger.
- Sipp batted .280 and had a 2-2 pitching record for the Tigers in 2004.
- Wilkerson was a three-time All-ACC player as a Tiger from 2011-14 and made his MLB debut with the Baltimore Orioles on June 20, 2018.
- Every Tiger team from 1974 to 2015 has had at least one future major leaguer on its roster.
