#### **BULLDOGS IN THE POLLS THIS WEEK**

\*In the D1Baseball.com Top 25, Georgia is ranked No. 4. This week the Bulldogs are ranked between No. 3-5 with an RPI of No. 4.

#### **BEST RECORD SINCE...**

\*At 33-8, Georgia has posted its best record after 41 games since the 1990 national championship team was 34-7 at this point in the season and they would go on to finish 52-19. After 42 games, they were 35-7 and got to 37-7 before dropping another game.

The 2009 club was 32-9 after 41 games and 33-9 after 42 games. This season, Georgia is taking aim at its first SEC title since 2008. The Bulldogs hold a one game lead over Vanderbilt and Arkansas as they are each 12-6 with 12 games left to play. Georgia won the Vanderbilt series 2-1 in Athens while it does not face Arkansas.

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach: **Scott Stricklin** is in his 6th season at UGA; 15th season overall. **Rankings:** #4 D1Baseball.com; #3 Baseball America; #4 Collegiate Baseball; #5 *USA Today*/ESPN;

\*Fourth-ranked Georgia (33-8) plays the rubber game of its series with No. 11 Ga. Tech (27-13) Tuesday at SunTrust Park in Atlanta for Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA). Both teams won on their campus earlier this year (Georgia 12-2 on April 9; Tech 11-2 on March 26). The Bulldogs have won seven of the past eight games against Tech and are 11-5 under Ike Cousins head coach Scott Stricklin. First pitch will be at 7 p.m. and be available via ACC Network Extra and the Georgia Bulldog Sports Network.

Georgia holds an 11-5 edge in the neutral site meetings to benefit CHOA including 2-0 at SunTrust Park, winning 8-7 in 2017 in front of 23,737 and 3-1 in 2018 in front of 17,741. On Friday, Georgia returns to SEC action at ninth-ranked Miss. State (32-9, 10-8 SEC). Georgia is 13-2 against ranked teams this season. The Bulldogs lead the nation in wins.

\*Georgia is winning with pitching, defense and timely hitting. The Bulldogs own an NCAA-leading 2.57 ERA and a .982 fielding percentage (3rd nationally), and those are on pace to be school records. Georgia's record for lowest ERA in a season is 2.97 by the 1958 club and the next best is 3.26 by the 1967 squad. Last year, the Bulldogs set the fielding mark at .979. Georgia is batting .266 with a .376 on base percentage. Opponents are batting only .182 against the Bulldogs. Also, Georgia leads the nation in Fewest Hits Allowed Per Nine Innings (5.70) and WHIP (1.04). MSU leads the SEC in batting at .316.

\*Georgia's SEC rotation features sophomore RHP **Emerson Hancock** (7-2, SEC-best 1.04 ERA) who is on the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List, sophomore LHP **C.J. Smith** (3-2, 3.05 ERA) and junior RHP **Tony Locey** (7-0, 2.04 ERA). The midweek starter has been junior RHP **Tim Elliott** (5-1, 1.52 ERA). Locey has held opponents to a .134 batting average while Hancock is at .143 and Elliott's at .153, and that ranks 1-2-3 in the SEC. Elliott will start versus Tech for the third time this season. He is 1-0 with a 2.38 ERA against the Yellow Jackets this year. In 11.1 IP he has allowed 4R, 3ER, 7H, 5BB and 13 K.

\*Junior starting third baseman/closer **Aaron Schunk** (.340-6-29) has 11 saves to go with a 1-1 mark and 2.14 ERA while junior RHP **Zac Kristofak** is 3-0 with a 3.86 ERA and five saves. In SEC action, Hancock is 3-2 with a 1.40 ERA, Locey is 4-0 with a 1.78 ERA and Smith is 1-2, 4.45 ERA.

\*Senior 2B LJ Talley continues to lead the team in batting at .349-6-30. Junior CF Tucker Maxwell leads the club with eight home runs and ranks among the SEC leaders in stolen bases with a team best 19 out of 21 attempts. Georgia's RBI leader with 34 is sophomore OF Riley King (.304-5-34). In SEC action, Schunk is batting a team-high .361 along with a 1-1 mark, 3.60 ERA and four saves. Graduate designated hitter John Cable is batting 259 with three home runs and 16 RBI.

## **#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN**

#### UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 6TH SEASON AT UGA; 15TH OVERALL

Scott Stricklin is in his sixth season as the Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach at the University of Georgia. Since arriving at UGA, Stricklin, 47, has created an atmosphere of excitement around the program, starting with the current student-athletes, extending to former lettermen and to Georgia baseball fans around the state. He has organized numerous lettermen func-



tions to help reunite former players and steered the \$12 million Foley Field Revival project that was completed prior to the 2015 season. He has engaged the fan base with the annual First Pitch banquets featuring Hall of Famers John Smoltz, Phil Niekro and Chipper Jones, Braves standout Jeff Francoeur and Bulldog legends and Major Leaguers Gordon Beckham and Kyle Farmer.

Georgia's recruiting classes have steadily improved under Stricklin, according to *Perfect Game USA* national rankings. In fact, the class that made its debut in 2017 was ranked No. 3 nationally. Additionally, the Bulldogs have excelled in the classroom, posting a 3.08 GPA for the fall semester of 2016 and 3.01 GPA in the fall of 2017. A total of 19 Bulldogs made the 2017 SEC Academic Honor Roll and 21 earned a spot on the honor roll in 2018.

The 2018 campaign saw Georgia return to prominence as a regular in the Top 25 rankings, earning a top eight national seed and playing host to an NCAA Regional for the first time in a decade. After being picked to finish fifth in the East, Georgia posted 39-21 record and its 18-12 SEC mark tied for the second best in the league. The Bulldogs were NCAA Athens Regional Finalists and set four school records (.979 fielding percentage, holding opponents to a .236 batting average, 532 strikeouts by the pitching staff and seven grand slams by the offense). Three Bulldogs earned All-America honors, four made the All-SEC squad, 21 made the SEC Academic Honor Roll and three were selected in the 2018 MLB Draft.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in earned run average during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons of professional baseball and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (16) and Keaton (11), and a son, Cale (14).
