If THEY win the remaining two matches of the season, Tech's Golf Team will have the distinction of being undefeated during the past two years, during which time they have played the outstanding Southern colleges. The team is composed of Frank Ridley, George Harris, Charlie Yates, and Berrien Moore, with John Ridley and Bruce Morgan as alternates.


This year the players have all been playing very excellent golf, as is evidenced by the fact that the team's average per round is 74 over some of the most difficult courses in the South, including the Augusta National Course, where Tech took the measure of Georgia, captained by Billy McWilliams, by a score of 16 to 2.

Two members of the Golf Team—Yates and Moore—qualified in the National Intercollegiate Championship last summer, with Yates reaching the semi-finals. Yates was Georgia State Champion in 1931 and 1932, and for the past two years had reached the second round of match play in the National Amateur, while this spring he was low Amateur in the Masters' Invitation Tournament at Augusta with a score of 297.

Frank Ridley and George Harris, who shot consistently in the low seventies throughout all the matches, have long been prominent in State golf circles, qualifying and making fine showings in the many tournaments of this section. Berrien Moore is also very well known, being a former holder of the Atlanta City Championship, as well as being present holder of the Tait Mountain Estates Championship.
