GOLF

The prospects for the 1937 golf team point towards an even better season than last year. The team is composed of Tommy Barnes (No. 1), Stanley Holditch (No. 2), Bill Eager (No. 3), and Willingham Smith (No. 4). Barnes is Atlantic City champion, and played in the National Amateur Tournament held at Garden City, N. Y., last summer. Holditch is a former winner of the Radium Springs and Columbus, Georgia, Invitation Tournaments. Eager won the Columbus Invitation Tournament last year, and went to the finals in the Southern Intercollegiate Match at Athens, Georgia. Smith is the team's only new member, but his past scores prove that he will uphold the records established by his team-mates.

Under the leadership of Captain Tommy Barnes, the team will engage in eleven matches with the leading colleges of the South. It is also entered in the Southern Intercollegiate Tournament to be held April 22-24 at Athens, Georgia. In addition, the team members expect to enter the National Intercollegiate Tournament at Oakmont Country Club, Pittsburgh, Pa., in July.
