HEAD GOLF COACH TOMMY PLAXICO

Likeable Tommy Plaxico, a former Georgia Tech star of the cinders, has been the Yellow Jackets' golf coach since Jan-



uary of 1956. His 17 Tech teams have won 116 dual matches while losing 127 and being tied 8 times. Plaxico does a good job of instilling his golfers with the same desire to win that he himself demonstrated as an outstanding Tech trackman of the early 1940's.

Coach Plaxico was a regular on the Tech Track team for three years and was captain of the 1941 squad. After a four-year interlude spent as a Navy fighter pilot in World War II, Plaxico returned to the campus to receive his degree in Industrial Management in 1946. He immediately

agement in 1946. He immediately joined the Tech racuity as a member of the Physical Training staff, a capacity in which he still serves. Tommy also served as assistant track coach for five years and has been in charge of Georgia Tech's fine intramural program since 1952.

Coach Plaxico was born in York, S.C., on May 17, 1919.

He attended Tech High of Atlanta and entered Georgia Tech the fall of 1937. He was married on Sept. 11, 1953 to Frances Perry, of Tifton, Ga. The Plaxicos have four children: daughters Bonnie and Anita, sons Perry and Blake. Coach Plaxico's hobbies are golf and tennis.
