

Men's Basketball Parking

Priority Assignment Process and Lot Availability

Overview

Georgia Tech Athletics assigns men's basketball parking passes through a combination of Alexander-Tharpe Fund giving status, season ticket status and A-T priority points. The allocation system outlined below is designed to equitably distribute parking passes in the best locations to the donors and season ticket holders.

General Rules

- The assignment process is broken down into four categories, with each category ranked by priority point total.
- Season parking passes may only be requested with an accompanying season ticket purchase.
- Currently the McCamish Lot (E65) is <u>ONLY</u> available to Season Ticket Holders who purchase Courtside seats or are A-T Fund Society Members—by priority point order
- No more than two (2) McCamish parking passes allowed per account
- The total quantity of passes that are eligible for priority allocation is limited to 1 pass for every 3rd season ticket. Additional passes purchased outside of this ratio will be assigned at the end of the process.
- All parking pass assignments and relocations are subject to yearly renewal and request deadlines

1st Assignment Group: Golden Jackets

- Golden Jackets with season tickets will have one parking pass issued in McCamish (E65) lot
 - If a Golden Jacket has 3 or more (3+) tickets they may purchase a second parking pass but this pass is NOT guaranteed to be in the McCamish lot

2nd Assignment Group: Courtside Season Ticket Holders

- Season Ticket Members with at least one (1) Courtside seat will receive one (1) complimentary parking pass in McCamish Lot
- One (1) McCamish pass is allotted per three (3) season tickets
- If requested, Courtside Season Ticket Holders who purchase four or more (4+) tickets may receive a second complimentary pass in the McCamish Lot
- Courtside Season Ticket Holders who are also Life Members, are not eligible for a 3rd complimentary pass unless they have six or more (6+) season tickets. The 3rd pass would be a designated to a lot other than the McCamish

3rd Assignment Group: Giving Society Members

- After all Courtside orders are filled, any members of the A-T Fund Giving Societies (Jack Thompson and Homer Rice Societies) with season tickets are assigned 1 complimentary pass in priority point order based on their stated preference.
 - If a Giving Society member may purchase an additional parking pass for each third season ticket held, but these passes are assigned at this time with all other paid passes. Additional passes purchased outside of this ratio will be assigned at the end of the process.

4th Assignment Group: All remaining Paid Passes

• After all Giving Society complimentary passes are filled, any remaining paid passes are assigned in priority point order based on the stated preference.

Assignment Group and Point Requirements

Below is the minimum required level and point total for each men's basketball parking lot after end of the 2019-20 season. These minimums are provided for informational purposes and do not guarantee an assignment in any specific lot.

E65 – McCamish	Group 3 w/ 3,500
E63 – East O'Keefe	Group 3 w/ 2,000
FS – Fowler Street ADA	0
ER66 – Family Housing	Group 4 w/ 350
LP – Lower Peters	Group 4 with 0 points
