2020 Georgia Tech Football Student Ticket Policy

Georgia Tech students must meet one of the following criteria to be eligible to request a student ticket for games at Bobby Dodd Stadium:

- 1. Must be an enrolled full-time student
- 2. Graduate/Intern/Co-Op/Part-Time students must verify Athletic Fee payment through the Bursar's Office

The list of eligible students is provided to the GTAA by GT Registrar. Students who are deemed eligible may request student tickets, however, if the Athletic Fee is not paid, tickets will be removed from their account.

Eligible students have the option to enter into a lottery for student tickets at Bobby Dodd Stadium:

STUDENT TICKET DISTRIBUTION

General Information

- All student tickets for the 2020 season will be complimentary. No season tickets will be sold.
- Each eligible student will be given the opportunity to enter into a student ticket lottery the Monday of each game week.
- Lottery entries will not carry over from game to game. Students must submit a new lottery entry each game week.
- Lottery winners will receive one (1) student ticket for their own use and one (1) student ticket to transfer to another GT student of their choosing.
- Game tickets will be distributed the week of the game after a randomized lottery has taken place.
- Approximately 800 student tickets will be available each week, with approximately 400 lottery winners.
- The ticket lottery process allows a completely random selection of students to gain admission into Bobby Dodd Stadium for each home game. GTAA switched to a lottery process for the 2020 football season in order to accommodate the most students while maintaining social distancing guidelines within Bobby Dodd Stadium.
- 2020-2021 Yellow Jacket Club (YJC) members will receive an extra entry to each lottery (i.e. if a YJC member enters a lottery that student will receive two (2) entries instead of one (1)). YJC members must still enter into the lottery to request tickets. Students can join the YJC by purchasing a \$15 membership at <u>www.ramblinwreck.com/students</u>. In order to receive the extra entry, memberships must be purchased prior to entering into the lottery.
- All student seating will be general admission and in the North Stands: Sections 112-120.
- Seats will be in clusters of 2 and denoted by stinger seats throughout sections 112-120. The lottery winner and their guest will sit in a seat cluster of 2 upon arrival to the student section. Lottery winners who elect to attend the game alone will sit in a seat cluster of 2 and claim both seats to maintain social distancing.

Gameday Entrance Procedures

- The single game ticket delivery method for the 2020 season will be Mobile Delivery. If you win the lottery, you will receive an Apple Wallet or Google Pay version of your single game ticket. You must present your mobile ticket at the gate upon entry to the stadium along with your valid student BuzzCard.
- All students and fans are **required to wear an approved personal face covering at all times** while within the Bobby Dodd Stadium perimeter (stadium perimeter includes security queues at all stadium entrances, as well as gueues at ticket and will call windows). View all 2020 Fan Safety Protocols.
- Enter @ Gate 7

Lottery Protocols

- Enter into the lottery for free single game tickets online at <u>www.ramblinwreck.com/students</u>.
- Once you are logged in, be sure to select the game you wish to attend. The preloaded default quantity of "2" will be in the request quantity box, click "Add to Cart" and complete the checkout process.
- Once your entry is submitted, you will receive an email confirming your entry into the lottery.
- When the window for lottery entries has closed, the GT Ticket Office will run the lottery and winners will be selected.
- All students who entered the lottery, those who were selected for game tickets and those who were not, will receive an email on the Wednesday prior to the game. Be sure to check your SPAM folder.

- Students selected in the lottery will receive two tickets for the game. Students who were not selected will not receive a game ticket.
- Students who receive two tickets to the game may either:
 - Transfer the second ticket to a Georgia Tech student they trust that will share a cluster of two seats with them at the game
 - Choose not to transfer the guest ticket to another GT Student and sit in a cluster of two seats to maintain social distancing.
 - Transfer both tickets back to the ticket office to distribute to other students.
- Students who did not receive a game ticket will have the opportunity to enter into a wait list. The wait list will be used to distribute any tickets that were turned back into the ticket office.

STUDENT BEHAVIOR POLICY

- Misconduct at GT football games will be subject to review by the Office of Student Integrity and will result in forfeiture of student ticket for the next home game.
- Misconduct includes but is not limited to:
 - Using another student's ID to enter the game.
 - Violent or aggressive behavior.
 - Excessive public drunkenness.
 - Failure to adhere to new stadium policies.

RESALE POLICY

- Georgia Tech students are prohibited from reselling football student tickets for profit. Students found to be in violation of this policy will be penalized. Penalties include the cancellation of single game tickets, cancellation of tickets already purchased or claimed, and the loss of student ticket privileges. Students can transfer tickets to other Georgia Tech Students free of charge by logging in to their student account at www.ramblinwreck.com/students.
- Abuse of transfers could lead to the cancellation of the current policy and the reduction of the student section capacity. Student ticket holders are expected to transfer tickets to students they intend on sitting with in their seat cluster. This ensures that we have enough seat clusters for the students who received tickets. Abuse of transfers will not be tolerated.

2021 BLOCK SEATING INFORMATION

- Group seating will NOT be available to students during the 2020 football season.
- 2021 group seating assignments will be made by the SGA based on overall group attendance from 2019 (tracked via ticket scans).
- To create a new group for the 2021 football season, please contact the SGA. A group must consist of 15 or more individuals.
- New Groups for 2021 will be moved to the bottom of the priority list for this season when determining Group seating assignments, but their 2021 attendance will be considered in the 2022 assignment.
- Attendance at 2019 games by block participants will be tracked and used as a priority measure for 2021 block locations.

OTHER GENERAL INFORMATION

- Student guest tickets are not available for the 2020 season.
- Student away game tickets are not available for the 2020 season.
- Students may transfer their ticket to another student.
- If you receive tickets and are unable to attend the game, please be sure to transfer your tickets to either a student who can attend the game or the ticket office.
