

2020-21 Men's and Women's Basketball – Student Ticket Policy

Students who wish to attend men's and/or women's basketball games will be asked to complete a one-time online registration by visiting www.ramblinwreck.com/students. Registration is open now.

To best manage the limited student seating and provide an equitable opportunity for students to attend, games will be pre-designated with a "White" or "Gold" game designation. Students that register will receive important updates throughout the season, including updates on "White/Gold" game designations. Completion of the one-time registration also ensures digital ticket delivery for "White" games. The game designations will be set prior to the start of the season and are subject to change at the discretion of the GTAA. Such changes will be communicated to the student body in a timely manner.

White Games

Digital tickets for "White" games will be emailed approximately four (4) hours prior to the game to all students who have completed the one-time registration to receive basketball tickets. Students will simply click a link within the email that will prompt them to add the ticket to their Apple or GPay Wallet. All students with a ticket saved in their phone's digital wallet are eligible for, but not guaranteed, entry. Admission to "White" games will be granted on a first-come, first-served basis.

Gold Games

Games designated as "Gold" games are anticipated to be high demand games. For these games, tickets will be distributed via a student ticket lottery system.

Students interested in attending "Gold" games will be required to enter a student ticket lottery five (5) days prior to the game. Lottery selections will be weighted based on combined 2020-21 attendance records from previous men's and women's "White" games. For example, a student who has attended five women's games and five men's games will receive 10 entries. Members of the student Yellow Jacket Club will receive double entries to the lottery. Students who win the lottery are guaranteed admission to the game, and only students who win tickets via the lottery will be admitted to games. Lottery winners will be emailed a pair of tickets one (1) day prior to the game, one (1) for the winner and one (1) for another Georgia Tech student of their choice. The lottery winner will be delivered both tickets and can then transfer the ticket to the other Georgia Tech student with the expectation that the winner and the transfer recipient arrive together and sit together at the game. Or, a student may wish to attend the game alone, letting the second ticket go unused. Students should only transfer their second ticket if they intend to sit with the transfer recipient. This will ensure enough socially distanced seats are available for students who attend the game.

Game Entry and Seating

A digital ticket AND valid Georgia Tech Buzz Card are required for entry. This will be strictly enforced. The name on the Buzz Card must match the name on the digital ticket. All students must enter via the North Entrance (the entrance facing 10th Street). Digital tickets must be saved in the student's Apple or G Pay Wallet prior to arriving at the game. The digital tickets utilize NFC technology allowing students to simply tap their phone on a self-service pedestal scanner to gain entry to McCamish Pavilion.

General admission seating inside the venue will be grouped in pairs with six feet of distance between each pair. Students who arrive together will sit together in one of the socially distanced seating pairs. A student who attends the game alone will claim a pair of seats for them self.

General Policies

Georgia Tech students must meet one of the following criteria to be eligible to claim/receive a student ticket for games at McCamish Pavilion:

- Must be an enrolled full-time student
- Graduate/Intern/Co-Op/Part-Time students must verify Athletic Fee payment through the Bursar's Office

The list of eligible students is provided to the GTAA by GT Registrar.

Behavior Policy

All students and fans are required to wear an approved personal face covering at all times while within McCamish Pavilion as well as in the que lines outside the venue.

- Misconduct at GT basketball games will be subject to review by the Office of Student Integrity and will result in forfeiture of student ticket for the next home game.
- Misconduct includes but is not limited to:
 - Using another student's ID to enter the game.
 - Violent or aggressive behavior.
 - Excessive public drunkenness.
 - Failure to adhere to new stadium policies.

Ticket Resale / Transfer Policy

- Georgia Tech students are prohibited from reselling student tickets for profit. Students found to be in violation of this policy will be penalized. Penalties include the cancellation of single game tickets, cancellation of tickets already purchased or claimed, and the loss of student ticket privileges. Students can transfer tickets to other Georgia Tech Students free of charge by logging in to their student account at www.ramblinwreck.com/students.
- Abuse of transfers could lead to the cancellation of the current policy and the reduction of the student section capacity. Student ticket holders are expected to transfer tickets to students they intend on sitting with in their seat cluster. This ensures that we have enough seat clusters for the students who received tickets. Abuse of transfers will not be tolerated.
