## STORYLINES

- Georgia hits the road for the second-straight game to begin the 2020-21 season. Following their 83-64 victory at Mercer this past Wednesday, the Lady Bulldogs now make the short drive to Atlanta to take on Georgia Tech Sunday at 2 p.m.
- Sunday's contest will air on the ACC Network. Jeff Dantzler -- the Voice of the Lady Bulldogs -- will call the action for the Georgia Bulldogs Sports Network. Fans in Athens can listen to the game on WXKT 103.7 FM.
- For the first time since the 2002-03 campaign, Georgia is opening a season with threestraight road games. The 2002-03 Lady Bulldogs went 2-1 to open the season and finished the year in the NCAA Sweet 16.
- Georgia owns a 35-7 lead in the all-time series against Georgia Tech and is 12-5 against the Yellow Jackets in Atlanta. The two teams have split the last four contests at McCamish Pavilion.
- Lady Bulldog senior guard Gabby Connally needs just two points to reach 1,000 in her career. She would be the 40th player in Georgia history to reach that milestone.
- Joni Taylor is one win away from reaching the 100-victory mark of her head coaching career. Taylor -- now in her sixth season -- has averaged 19 wins per year as a head coach.
- The Lady Bulldogs need just two victories to reach the 1,000 win mark in program history. Georgia is trying to become one of two SEC schools (Tennessee) and one of 16 nationwide to accomplish that feat. Georgia is still one of only three programs -- along with Tennessee and Wisconsin-Green-Bay -- to never have a losing season.
- This year's Georgia team returns four senior starters. Each of the Lady Bulldogs' seniors earned their degrees from UGA this past May and all are currently pursuing master's degrees. Overall, the Lady Bulldogs returned 90 percent of their scoring and 88 percent of their rebounding.
- Georgia used a balanced offensive effort to defeat Mercer. Every available player saw the floor for the Lady Bulldogs, with three scoring in double figures. Sophomore Javyn Nicholson led the attack, finishing with a team-high 15 points and seven boards.
- Senior center Jenna Staiti was one of the most improved players in the SEC a season ago. She scored in double figures in nine-straight games, averaging 19.4 points and 9.4 boards per contest over that span. She scored eight points in just seven minutes against Mercer, sitting for three quarters due to back spasms.

## BEST SHOOTING EFFORT SINCE 2009

Georgia's offense got off to a good start against Mercer Wednesday night. The Lady Bulldogs finished the game hitting 32 -of- 53 shots ( 60.4 percent), marking the team's best single-game shooting percentage since March 5, 2009 against Kentucky ( 63.4 percent) -- a span of 11 seasons.

The Lady Bulldogs knocked in 8-of-10 (80 percent) field goals in the fourth quarter against the Bears. Eight of the 11 Lady Bulldogs who played hit 50 percent or better from the field.

## POST PLAYERS SHINE

The Lady Bulldogs used a strong performance in the paint against Mercer. Georgia had a steady and deep rotation of post players, using that depth to outscore Mercer 52-24 in the paint.

Javyn Nicholson and Malury Bates combined to make 8 -of- 11 shots and totaled 28 points and 11 boards to lead Georgia's post players. Jordan Isaacs also had a solid performance with eight points and four rebounds in her first career start.

## NICHOLSON LEADS IN OPENER

Sophomore forward Javyn Nicholson had one of the best games of her career Wednesday night. She led Georgia in scoring with 15 points, with the bulk of of those coming in the fourth quarter. The former fivestar prospect hit 3-of-4 shots and finished with nine points in the final 10 minutes of action. It marks the first time she has scored in double figures since last December.

## GEORGIA RETURNS EXPERIENCED TEAM

The last time Georgia had this much experience on its roster was back during the 2017-18 season when the team went 26-7 on its way to a second-place finish in the SEC standings. In 2018-19, Georgia had the youngest team in the SEC, while last year it had to replace its top two scorers.

The Lady Bulldogs now return over 90 percent of their scoring and 88 percent of their rebounding, including four starters and 10 total letterwinners.

A CLOSER LOOK AT STAITI'S LAST NINE GAMES OF LAST SEASON

## STAITI STEADY AT THE STRIPE

What might have gone unnoticed last season was Jenna Staiti's performance at the free-throw line.

Staiti finished the year hitting 89 percent from the stripe -- good for the second-best single season average in Georgia history.

## CONNALLY, STAITI APPROACHING CAREER TOP-10

Georgia seniors Gabby Connally and Jenna Staiti are approaching the top-10 of a few Lady Bulldog career categories.

## The Last Meeting Recap (from Nov. 17, 2019)

ATHENS, Ga. - The Georgia Lady Bulldog basketball team fell to Georgia Tech 73-40 at Stegeman Coliseum Sunday.

Georgia Tech shot 57 percent from the 3-point line, with sophomore Jasmine Carson and senior Francesca Pan draining four each.

Georgia kept the Yellow Jackets scoreless from the field through the first eight minutes of play, only allowing three field goals overall in the opening quarter. Redshirt-junior Jenna Staiti notched the first score of the night, making her first 3-pointer of the season.

A shot from Connally gave Georgia a double-digit lead with a 13-1 advantage. Although the Yellow Jackets ended the frame on a 7-0 run, the Lady Bulldogs maintained the 13-8 lead at the conclusion of the period.

Georgia trailed for the first time early in the second quarter after two straight three's from Georgia Tech's Carson. The Lady Bulldogs quickly regained their advantage after a layup from junior Maya Caldwell, giving Georgia the 17-16 edge.

After trading baskets, the score was knotted 22-22 halfway through the period. The Yellow Jackets garnered their largest lead of the half, 29-24, after forcing a 4-0 run with a minute left. A layup from redshirt-sophomore Malury Bates brought the Lady Bulldogs within three as the clock expired, 29-26.

The Yellow Jackets opened the second half on an 8-0 streak to extend their lead to double digits for the first time. Connally made the Lady Bulldogs' sole jumper of the period to bring the deficit down to single digits, but Georgia Tech's hot hand and 16 rebounds capped the third quarter 50-32.

Georgia Tech continued its hot streak in the fourth quarter with five 3 -pointers, shooting 71 percent from three and 66 from the field to defeat Georgia, 73-40.

With 118 blocks in three seasons, Staiti needs four more to move into the top-10 at UGA for career blocked shots.
