#### A WIN ON THURSDAY WOULD

- Be the 953rd win in program history (952-471)
- Be head coach Wes Moore's 735th career win (734-231)
- Be Moore's 177th win at NC State (176-62)
- Be Moore's 81st ACC win at NC State (80-37)
- Be the Pack's third-straight 9-0 start to a season

#### NOTING THE WOLFPACK (8-0, 3-0)

- Ranked season-high No. 3 nationally in the Associated Press Top 25 after moving up a spot in Monday's poll
- One of two remaining unbeaten teams in the conference and currently riding the ACC's longest winning streak of 13 games that started last season on Feb. 27, 2020
- Streak includes eight-straight victories over ACC opponents
- Currently ranked first in the conference standings with its 3-0 league record, with Georgia Tech one game back at 2-0 in league play
- No. 8 nationally and first in the conference in defensive rebounds per game (33.6)
- No. 18 in scoring margin (+25.8)
- No. 18 in field-goal percentage defense (.328)
- No. 18 in rebound margin (+12.9)
- No. 24 in field-goal percentage (.480)
- Also leads league in assist-to-turnover ratio (25th nationally 1.30), assists per game (27th nationally - 17.9) and scoring defense (56.9)
- Three members of the squad with scoring averages in double digits
- Elissa Cunane (15.9), Kayla Jones (13.4) and Jakia Brown-Turner (13.1)

- All five regular starters averaging better than 43 percent from the floor and one of two teams in the conference with a pair of players shooting better than 50 percent on the season (five field goals made per game minimum)
- Cunane (.550) and Jones (.569) both ranked in the top seven in the league in field-goal percentage
- Held four opponents to under 28 percent shooting and six of eight opponents to under 40 percent
- Averaging 40.3 points in the paint. Outscored its opponents in the category in every game this season for an average advantage of 17 points per game. Also deadly from distance with an average of 8 made three pointers per contest
- Shooting 37.9 percent as a team from distance and put together three-point shooting percentages of 40 percent or better in four
- Assisted on 143 of its 248 made field goals this season for a .578 team assist rate

#### LAST TIME OUT

- NC State is coming off of a 31-point win over Miami, which stands as one of its biggest victories over an ACC opponent in the Wes Moore era. In the 78-47 victory, the Wolfpack led by at least 20 points from the end of the first quarter on and opened up a lead of as large as 41 noints.
- Four Wolfpack players scored in double figures Elissa Cunane (18 points, 7-of-11 shooting, 3-of-5 three-point shooting), Kai Crutchfield (14 points, three assists, zero turnovers), Kayla Jones (10 points) and

### LAST MEETING - NC State vs. Georgia Tech



GREENSBORO, N.C. – The 10th-ranked NC State women's basketball team (26-4) climbed out of a double-digit first-half deficit to beat Georgia Tech (20-11) by a 57-48 score in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals on Friday evening.

In its 2020 ACC Tournament debut, NC State trailed by 14 points (21-7) at the 8:31 mark of the second quarter, but the Wolfpack outscored the Yellow Jackets 16-2 over the final seven minutes of the first half to knot the score at 23 at the halftime break.

The Wolfpack led by as many as eight points (33-25) in the third quarter. Georgia Tech managed to tie the score once (42-42) with 5:49 left in the fourth, but NC State made the switch to its zone defense to stifle the Yellow Jacket offense. Georgia Tech once again hit a scoreless spell that spanned nearly three minutes late in the final quarter, and NC State went on an 8-2 run to give itself a cushion before ultimately winning by nine points.

Senior Aislinn Konig and sophomore Elissa Cunane tied for the team and game-high in scoring with 16 points each. They were the only members of the Pack to tally double figures, but a total of eight players found the scoring column on the night. Kayla Jones contributed on the defensive side of the ball with 10 rebounds, and Kai Crutchfield led the team with four assists.

#### Jakia Brown-Turner (10 points)

- Miami entered the contest ranked best in the league in threepoint field-goal defense (.221), but the Pack shot 40 percent for the game from long range. That included a 7-of-10 three-point clip in the first quarter alone.
- NC State limited the Canes to just two baskets and five points total in the second quarter. It held Miami to 27.4 percent (17-of-62) shooting and easily cleaned up on the glass with more rebounds (48) than the Hurricanes had points.

#### **FAMILIAR HEIGHTS**

The Wolfpack jumped up one spot to check in at No. 3 in Monday's edition of the Associated Press Top-25 Poll. It marks the 40th week in program history that NC State has been featured in the top five.

NC State opened the year with its best AP preseason ranking (No. 8) since 1990-91, and its current ranking marks its best since Jan. 10, 2000 when it was listed third to cap off six-straight weeks spent in the national top five. The Wolfpack has now spent the last four weeks in the AP Top 5, which marks the longest such streak since that 1999-2000 campaign.

The Pack has already established itself as a mainstay in the Top 25. The program has spent 399 total weeks ranked in the AP Poll in its history and has been ranked every week since Feb. 5, 2018. In 2019-20, the Pack spent the entire year in the AP Top 15 and was featured inside the Top 10 for the last 15 weeks of the campaign.

# **SCOUTING THE YELLOW JACKETS (4-1, 2-0 ACC)**

- Picked to finish fifth in the ACC this season by the league's head coaches and ninth by the Blue Ribbon Panel
- $\bullet$  Currently ranked second in the league behind the Pack
- Ranked in the top three in the ACC in both three-point field-goal defense (2nd .247) and scoring defense (3rd 59.8)
- Lorela Cubaj averages a double-double with team-leading averages of 15.6 points and 12.6 rebounds. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (14.6) and Loyal McQueen 11.6) also averaging double figures
- Set to play its first game since Sunday, Dec. 13 after having contests canceled due to positive COVID tests within the program
   Enters the contest on a three-game winning streak, most recently defeating Notre Dame on the road by an 82-67 final score

#### SERIES HISTORY (NC State leads 48-24)

- Thursday marks the 73rd meeting between the Wolfpack and the Yellow Jackets. The teams have faced each other at least once a season since they first met on Jan. 12, 1980.
- NC State owns a 21-13 record in road games at Georgia Tech. The Pack has won five in a row in Atlanta, with its last road loss to the Yellow Jackets coming in overtime on Feb. 2, 2012.
- The squads faced off twice last season. In the regular season, Georgia Tech snapped what was a six-game winning streak in the series for the Pack as it took the narrow 65-61 victory inside Reynolds Coliseum. NC State returned the favor in the postseason with a 57-48 win in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals, which earned the team a spot in the semifinals for the third-straight year.

#### **CLUTCH KJ**

The versatility and reliability of **Kayla Jones** continues to shine bright in her senior season. She is currently one of two players in the ACC (Maddy Westbeld, Notre Dame) to average at least 13 points, seven rebounds and 2.5+ assists per game.

After tallying just five points in the Pack's season opener, Jones has scored in double figures in each of the seven games since. In that stretch, she is shooting 39-of-69 (.565) for 14.6 points per game, and she has stuffed the stat sheet with four games with 7+ rebounds and five games with 3+ assists.

Her best scoring output this season came on the road at Boston College where she posted a career-high 25 points, nine more than her previous career high of 17 points. That outing marked the first 25+ point performance for a member of the Pack since Elissa Cunane posted 27 points at Duke on Feb. 2, 2020.

#### **EXCEEDING EXPECTATIONS**

NC State has met ACC coaches' preseason expectations in all seven completed seasons under Coach Moore and has exceeded expectations in five of those years.

In head coach Wes Moore's eight seasons in Raleigh, the Wolfpack has posted an impressive 80-37 (.694) record in league games that includes a 42-17 (.712) mark in Raleigh.

#### **MAKING IT RAINA**

Raina Perez came to NC State after averaging nearly 20 points per game at Cal State Fullerton last season, and she has shown her ability to be both a prolific scorer and a consistent play facilitator.

She is the best in the league and among the best in the nation as a ball handler. Perez owns the nation's eighth-ranked assist-to-turn-over ratio (5.8) with 35 assists and just six turnovers. The Goodyear, Ariz., native has four games this season with zero turnovers.

Despite her small size, Perez has a knack for making plays inside the perimeter. She is 8-of-22 (.364) from three-point range this season and 19-of-33 (.576) from two.

#### **#BIGSMILE ROLLING IN ACC PLAY**

During her sophomore campaign, center **Elissa Cunane** was the only player in the ACC to finish the regular season averaging a double-double. The junior continues to roll through conference play in her third year of league action.

In the Pack's three conference games, Cunane is averaging:

- 19.3 points per game (sixth in the ACC), with one 20+ point game against Boston College
- 10.7 rebounds per game (second in the ACC), with her 15 rebounds against Boston College marking the most by any ACC player in a conference game this season
- 58.8 percent shooting (fifth in the ACC)
- 1.7 blocks per game (eighth in the ACC)

#### **TAKING CARE OF ROAD BUSINESS**

Through seven completed seasons under head coach Wes Moore, the Wolfpack has earned 52 true road wins (averaging 7.1 per completed season) since the start of the 2013-14 season. In the prior eight seasons from 2005-06 to 2012-13, the Wolfpack earned 32 true road wins (4.0 per season).

#### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE CLUB**

Four Wolfpack players have posted double-doubles this season-Elissa Cunane (3), Kayla Jones (2), Jakia Brown-Turner (1) and Jada Boyd (1). That number ranks second in the league behind North Carolina with six different players posting double-doubles.

Jones came within striking distance of a rare triple-double against Wake Forest on Dec. 17 with 12 points, 11 rebounds and seven assists. Only one Wolfpack player in the program's history (Tynesha Lewis) has posted a triple-double. She posted two within a month of each other during the 2001 season.

#### **DISHING IT OUT**

Two Wolfpack starters are averaging 3+ assists per game - Raina Perez (35, 4.4 average) and Jakia Brown-Turner (28, 3.5 average). Both of those players also take great care of the ball with the conference's top two assist-to-turnover ratios.

As a team, NC State has dished out 20 or more assists in four games, which includes a season-high 28 assists in the Pack's win over Coastal Carolina. That number marks the most in a single game for NC State in the Wes Moore era (previous high was 27 against Elon in 2013, Moore's first season with the Wolfpack). It is also the most for the Pack in a single game since at least the 2000-01 campaign.

#### WE WIN

In what was one of the most highly-anticipated matchups of non-conference collegiate women's basketball, NC State came away with the 54-46 victory over No. 1 South Carolina on the road on Dec. 3. The victory marked the Wolfpack's first over a top-ranked team since March 3, 2007 when it defeated No. 1 Duke in the ACC Tournament. It was also just the third win over a top-ranked team in a total of 20 tries in program history.

#### **PACK EFFORT**

During its five non-conference games, NC State had six players score in double figures twice - against NC Central on Nov. 29 and again versus Coastal Carolina on Dec. 6. The Wolfpack also accomplished this feat twice during the 2019-20 campaign - at Saint Mary's and at Boston College. Prior to last year, the last time the Wolfpack had more than five players score 10+ points was when it had eight in double figures against Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012.

#### **COMEBACK PACK**

The Pack overcame a 16-point deficit that it faced with 6:15 remaining in the game to defeat Boston College on Dec. 13. The victory marked the largest fourth-quarter comeback for the Pack since NCAA women's basketball switched from halves to quarters at the start of the 2015-16 campaign. It was also the second-largest second-half comeback in the Wes Moore era, as NC State previously overcame a 20-point second-half deficit to Miami in February 2015.

# STRENGTH IN THE PACK

Since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum was completed in August 2016, NC State has put together a 66-9 mark when playing on Kay Yow Court. That record includes 40 consecutive victories over non-conference opponents and 26 out of 35 possible league wins. The Pack's non-conference streak dates back to the old Reynolds Coliseum days and excludes the 2015-16 season that was played at Broughton High School during renovations. NC State's last non-conference defeat on Kay Yow Court coming at the hands of Minnesota on Dec. 3, 2014.

#### RANKED WINS UNDER MOORE

Under the leadership of head coach Wes Moore, NC State has defeated a total of 21 nationally-ranked opponents. The Wolfpack has hosted a total of 11 opponents ranked in the AP Top 25 since the renovation of Reynolds Coliseum (start of the 2016-17 season), and NC State has won seven of those 11 home games.

#### STATEMENT SHOOTING NIGHT

On Nov. 29, NC State picked up a 108-70 victory over NC Central during which the team posted its highest field-goal percentage since Nov. 23, 1990. The team shot 41-of-60 from the floor for its second-highest shooting percentage in 46 completed seasons of Wolfpack women's basketball.

The team's performance was its first time exceeding 100 points in a single game in the Wes Moore era. The last time NC State had done so was with 102 points in a win over Longwood on Nov. 15, 2012. The Pack's 108 points also marked the most in a contest since the 1996-97 campaign.

#### 1K CUNANE

With a backdoor layup off of an assist from **Raina Perez**, center **Elissa Cunane** reached the 1,000 career point milestone in the first game of her junior campaign. After the 2019-20 season was cut short due to the COVID-19 pandemic, Cunane needed just 12 points to reach 1,000 and hit that exact number in the first half of the Wolfpack's win over North Florida.

Cunane became the ninth active ACC player, the only active junior in the conference and the 35th player in program history to reach the milestone. It took the Summerfield, N.C., native just 67 career games and 43 career starts.

#### THEN AND NOW

After the 2018-19 Wolfpack team was plagued by injuries, multiple players were called upon to step up to the plate, including then-sophomores **Kayla Jones** and **Kai Crutchfield**. The season prepared both of them for even better junior campaigns during which each player saw her statistical output increase drastically.

#### **2019-20 ACC REWIND**

NC State capped off one of the best seasons in its 46-year history by winning the 2020 ACC Tournament on March 8. The title was the first for NC State in 29 years (since 1991) and the fifth in program history. The Wolfpack ended the championship game against Florida State with a 13-3 run to take home the

- NC State led the conference in three-point field-goal percentage (.364), rebound margin (+6.3), defensive rebounds per game (28.7) and three pointers per game (8.2)
- Elissa Cunane was second in the conference in double-doubles (8), first in rebounding (9.6) and sixth in scoring (16.7) in league action
- Then-freshman Jakia Brown-Turner scored in double figures in 11 of 18 ACC games and averaged double figures (10.1 points per game) in league play

#### 2019-20 OVERALL REWIND

- Reached 25+ wins for the third season in a row with its 28-4 overall record
- Compiled the best 23-game record in program history as it opened the year 22-1, surpassing 21-2 marks set in both 1977-78 and 2018-19

#### **SENIOR CLASS**

The four-year members of NC State's senior class - **Kai Crutchfield** and **Kayla Jones** - will look to continue making their mark on the Pack. Since they arrived at the start of the 2017-18 campaign, Crutchfield and Jones have helped the Wolfpack go 90-19 (.826) overall, 52-7 (.881) at home and 40-13 (.755) in conference play in three seasons.

The class needs 15 victories to tie for the most by a four-year group in program history (105).

# SOPHOMORE SENSATION

Center **Elissa Cunane**'s breakout sophomore campaign was highlighted by All-America Third Team honors from the Associated Press and USBWA and Honorable Mention All-America honors from the WBCA. Cunane's status as an AP All-America honoree made her the first player in program history to earn a spot on one of the three teams after six honorable mention recognitions in program history.

Cunane is one of five returning All-ACC selections from last season, joining Louisville's Dana Evans, Syracuse's Kiara Lewis, Virginia Tech's Aisha Sheppard and Wake Forest's Ivana Raca. Cunane received three ACC Preseason Player of the Year votes from the league's head coaches and 11 from the Blue Ribbon Panel.

### **WEST RETURNS**

Over the offseason, Wes Moore rounded out and bolstered his staff with the announcement of **Nikki West**'s return to the Wolfpack

bench. West previously spent five seasons (2013-14 through 2017-18) on the NC State staff and rejoined the Pack after spending the 2019-20 campaign as an assistant coach for the Charlotte 49ers.

In her previous five seasons with the Wolfpack, West helped Moore and the Pack post a 112-52 (.683) overall record and a 51-29 (.638) mark in ACC games. She helped lead NC State to postseason invitations each year, including a Sweet 16 berth in 2018, in addition to four 20+ win campaigns, two top-four ACC finishes and three top-25 national finishes.

#### THREEEEEEEEEE

At the end of last season, NC State set the NCAA Division I women's college basketball record for most consecutive made three pointers by a team. The Wolfpack started its March 1, 2020 game at Virginia shooting a perfect 13-of-13 from downtown before missing its first three of the game early in the third quarter. Additionally impressive, seven different members of the NC State roster contributed to the streak.

The 13 consecutive threes surpassed the previous record of 11, which was set by both Bowling Green (Feb. 6, 2016) and TCU (March 3, 1996).

#### **POSTSEASON PROGRESS**

During the 2019 postseason, NC State participated in NCAA Tournament games in Raleigh for the second consecutive year. The Wolfpack is 16-2 in NCAA Tournament games played in Raleigh and has not lost a home game in the tournament since 1983.

NC State made its fourth NCAA Tournament appearance during head coach Wes Moore's sixth season in Raleigh. This marked the first time that the Wolfpack has made three consecutive NCAA Tournaments since the program did so in 2005, 2006, and 2007. With its first-round victory over Maine on March 23, 2019, NC State has won at least one game in three straight tournaments played for the first time since the program did so in 1989, 1990, and 1991.

The Wolfpack concluded the 2018-19 season in the Sweet 16 of the NCAA Tournament, making its second consecutive appearance in this round for the first time since 1990 and 1991.
