## BENCH SUPPORT

Georgia Tech's bench has given a helping hand in every contest this season, contributing double-figures each time. Tech saw its greatest bench contribution in its last outing, collecting 27 points between Kierra Fletcher, Nerea Hermosa and Avyonce Carter. Through six games, Georgia Tech's bench has averaged 16.5 points per game.

Coming off the bench, Nerea Hermosa finished with 10 points, six rebounds, two blocks, one steal and an assist against the Wolfpack in 28 minutes on the floor. In games coming off the bench, Hermosa is shooting 70.0 percent from the field and contributing 6.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game.

## WEEKLY AWARD SWEEP

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Loyal McQueen swept the ACC weekly awards the week of Dec. 14, winning Player and Freshman of the Week, respectively. Lahtinen became the first Yellow Jacket since 2017 to earn player of the week accolades. She earned the honor after posting then-career highs in scoring (27), field goals made (11), 3-point field goals made (5), assists (8) and steals (8) during the two-game week. Lahtinen led the Jackets offensively in both games.

McQueen picked up freshman of the week honors after she averaged 12.0 points per game and shot 56.3 percent from the field. In the win over Boston College, McQueen recorded a pair of career bests with 13 points and five assists.

The respective awards marked the first for both Lahtinen and McQueen.

## FROM DOWNTOWN

Georgia Tech has opened ACC play shooting 40.8 percent (29-71) from three-point range, hitting 10 three-pointers in back-toback games against Boston College and at Notre Dame, before connecting on nine against NC State. In each game, four or more different Jackets connected on a bucket from long distance.

The last time Tech hit 10-plus three-pointers in consecutive games dates back to the 2016-17 season when the Jackets had a streak of three games with 10 or more 3-pointers. Tech capped the streak hitting 14 3-pointers against Appalachian State $(12 / 11 / 16)$ to set the single-game record for three-pointers made.

## DOMINATING CUBAJ

Senior Lorela Cubaj has been a strong presence early on this season, recording three double-doubles in six games to average a double-double on the season ( $15.5 \mathrm{pts}, 11.0$ rebs). She has led the Jackets on the glass in five contests, pulling down dou-ble-figure rebounds in four outings. Against Tulane, Cubaj secured a career-high 16 rebounds to mark the first 15-plus rebounding performance by a Yellow Jacket since the 2018-19 season.

In the ACC, Cubaj is third in rebounding, sixth in blocks, seventh in steals and 12th in scoring.

Nationally, - as of Dec. 31 - Cubaj is 9th in defensive rebounds per game, 12th in rebounds per game, 41st in blocked shots per game and 50th in rebounds.

## POINTING TO LAHTINEN

After dishing out a career best eight assists at Notre Dame, Lotta-Maj Lahtinen increased her team-leading total assists to 24 on the season (4.0 apg). The juinior is tied for fifth in the ACC

in assists and has led the Jackets in assists in three games this season.

She became the first Yellow Jacket since 2012 to record eight assists in a single game - Dawn Maye recorded five games during the 2012-13 season with eight-plus assists.

Lahtinen currently leads the ACC in steals, averaging 3.5 per game, and is 15th in the nation in steals per game.

## UNSTOPPABLE LAHTINEN

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen continued her dominating presence on the hardwood against No. 3 NC State on Dec. 31, scoring a career-high 30 points against the Wolfpack. Behind hitting a career-high seven free throws, Lahtinen finished the game with 10 field goals, three 3-pointers, three steals and an assist. She also led the Jackets on the glass, securing 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and third of her career.

She opened ACC play against Boston College with an impressive performance on Dec. 9. The junior dropped a then-career-high 27 points to lead all scorers in the win. Lahtinen reached 27 points, shooting 11-of-16 from the field, including a 5 -for-8 performance from three-point range. The 11 field goals and five three-pointers each marked personal-bests. Additionally, Lahtinen recorded a career-high eight steals in the win. The 20-plus point outing marked the first of her collegiate career.

The eight steals marked the most by a Yellow Jacket in a single game since Dawnn Maye recorded 10 steals against Marquette on Nov. 18, 2012. It is also the most steals recorded in the ACC this year in a game.

## MCQUEEN JUMPS RIGHT IN

Tech freshman guard Loyal McQueen has quickly filled a starting role with the Yellow Jackets, earning the start in five games thus far. The freshman has also contributed double-figure scoring numbers in every outing, and currently is third on the team in scoring, averaging 11.6 points per game. The Florence, S.C., native is averaging 31.5 minutes per game.

## DOUBLE-DOUBLES ANYONE?

In Tech's first six games of the 2020-21 season, two different Yellow Jackets recorded double-doubles: Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (2) and Lorela Cubaj (3). Lahtinen helped lead the Jackets to a victory over Georgia State (Nov. 25) with her second career double-double (14 pts, 10 rebs) and then posted her second against NC State (Dec. 31) with 30 points and 11 rebounds.

Teammate Cubaj posted her 10th, 11th and 12th career double-doubles against Georgia (20 pts, 13 rebs), Tulane (18 pts, 16 rebs) and Notre Dame (16 pts, 13 rebs). Cubaj is one of four players in the ACC to have recorded three or more double-doubles this season so far. Elizabeth Kitley of Virginia Tech leads the league with six double-doubles - Cubaj is tied for second with three.

## MORE ACC ALL AROUND

With the women's basketball schedule adjustments due to Covid-19, the ACC women's basketball schedule was extended to 20 games for the 2020-21 season. Due to the extended conference schedule, the Yellow Jackets visit Notre Dame twice and will play a home-and-home with Boston College. In addition, Tech will have home-and-home series against Clemson, Florida State, Miami and Wake Forest.

## CONTINUING MOMENTUM

Under second-year head coach Nell Fortner, the Yellow Jackets look to carry momentum from an impressive 2019-20

Tech finished last season with a $20-$ 11 overall record, finished seventh in the ACC behind a 10-8 league record and reached the ACC Tournament quarterfinals before the season was suspended due to Covid-19. Fortner was tabbed the 2020 Whack Hyder Georgia Women's College Coach of the Year following the conclusion of the 2019-20 season. Francesca Pan led the Yellow Jackets offensively last season, averaging 13.4 points per game. She earned All-ACC honors, ACC All-Tournament Team accolades and All-ACC
Academic Team recognition to close out her collegiate career.
At the collegiate level, Fortner enters her 11th season as a head coach having led the helm at Purdue (one season), Auburn (eight seasons) and Georgia Tech (one season). In her collegiate head coaching career, Fortner has compiled a 186-130 (.587) record.

## WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returns seven letterwinners from last season's squad and welcomes six newcomers. The Jackets return 59.4 percent of its scoring from last season and 60.7 percent of its rebounding.

## HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

## 2nd Season • Texas ‘82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 329-200 (.621) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue - 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn - 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 10 seasons of experience as a head coach - one at Purdue (199697), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and one at Georgia Tech (2019-20) - and has compiled a 186-130 (.587) overall record in the college ranks.
