STORYLINES

• Georgia Tech returns to the comforts of home for a two-game homestand - its only two scheduled home games in the month of January. The Hokies visit to open the swing on Sunday with a tip slated for 2 p.m. on the ACC Network. Sam Ravech and Monica McNutt will call the broadcast. Fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call live from Atlanta.

• The Yellow Jackets got back to winning ways on Thursday, capturing their third ACC win with a 67-55 victory over Clemson in Littlejohn Coliseum. Tech won its fourth-straight over the Tigers with the victory and looks to move to 4-2 in league play Sunday afternoon against Virginia Tech.

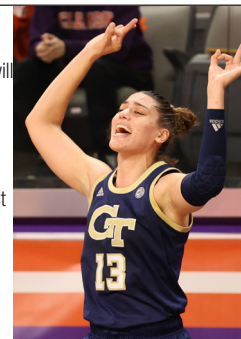
• Lorela Cubaj continues to be a strong presence on the glass and recorded her fifth game this season with double-figure rebounds at Clemson in style. The senior forward from Terni, Italy led all players with a game- and career-high 20 rebounds in Littlejohn Coliseum. The 20-rebound performance marks the first from a Yellow Jacket since Kisha Ford secured 21 rebounds on Nov. 26, 1996.

• Georgia Tech has won the rebounding battle in five contests this season. The Jackets hold the rebounding edge against its opponents on the season and are led on the glass by senior Lorela Cubaj, who boasts an 11.8 rebounds per game average.

• The Jackets have been productive from three-point range in ACC play this season, shooting 37.4 percent to rank third in the ACC in conference games only. In each conference game, four or more Jackets have connected from long distance with four most recently hitting a 3-pointer at Clemson. Sarah Bates leads the Jackets with 19 3-pointers overall this season, while Lotta-Maj Lahtinen paces Tech in conference games with 16 triples.

• Senior forward Lorela Cubaj currently leads the ACC in rebounding, pacing Tech on the glass with an 11.8 rebounds per game average. Cubaj ranks 7th in the nation in rebounds per game as of Jan. 7. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen currently leads the conference in steals, averaging 3.1 per game and ranks 20th nationally.

• Georgia Tech leads the all-time series against Virginia Tech, 11-7, despite dropping the lone meeting between the teams last season in overtime. The Hokies have won two of the past three contests after the Jackets took four-straight. Tech has defended its home court against the Hokies, leading the series, 5-2, and has won the last three meetings in Atlanta. Virginia Tech last won in Atlanta in 2013.

CUBAJ ON THE BOARDS

Lorela Cubaj put together an impressive performance on the boards at Clemson (1/7) - securing a career-high 20 rebounds in the win. For the game, Tech pulled down 38 rebounds, led by Cubaj's 20. Cubaj is the first and only player in the ACC to own a 20-rebound performance this season.

Nationally, through Jan. 7 games, Cubaj becomes the 15th player to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. Four players hold the national individual game high record in rebounds this season with 23 in a game.

Cubaj becomes the sixth Yellow Jacket in program history to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. The last Tech player to reach the feat was Kisha Ford who secured 21 rebounds on Nov. 26, 1996.

FLETCHER'S RETURN

Senior guard Kierra Fletcher made her first appearance this season against No. 3/3 NC State (Dec. 31) after being sidelined due to injury in the beginning of the season. Fletcher has taken the floor in three contests and made immediate impact for the Jackets. The Warren, Mich., native has averaged 25.8 minutes, 14.0 points and 4.3 rebounds per game in the three outings. Fletcher led all scorers in Tech's second visit to Notre Dame (Jan. 3), scoring 19 points, while finishing with seven rebounds, four assists, three blocks and two steals in 31 minutes.

BENCH SUPPORT

Georgia Tech's bench has given a helping hand in every contest this season, contributing double-figures each time. Tech saw its greatest bench contribution at Notre Dame (1/3), collecting 35 points between Kierra Fletcher and Nerea Hermosa. Through eight games, Georgia Tech's bench has averaged 18.8 points per game.

Coming off the bench, Nerea Hermosa finished with 12 points, eight rebounds, an assist and a steal at Notre Dame. Hermosa was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line to help contribute to her highest offensive output of the season. In games coming off the bench, Hermosa is shooting 52.2 percent from the field and contributing 6.6 points and 4.4 rebounds per game.

WEEKLY AWARD SWEEP

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Loyal McQueen swept the ACC weekly awards the week of Dec. 14, winning Player and Freshman of the Week, respectively. Lahtinen became the first Yellow Jacket since 2017 to earn player of the week accolades. She earned the honor after posting then-career highs in scoring (27), field goals made (11), 3-point field goals made (5), assists (8) and steals (8) during the two-game week. Lahtinen led the Jackets offensively in both games.

McQueen picked up freshman of the week honors after she averaged 12.0 points per game and shot 56.3 percent from the field. In the win over Boston College, McQueen recorded a pair of career bests with 13 points and five assists.

The respective awards marked the first for both Lahtinen and McQueen.

FROM DOWNTOWN

Georgia Tech opened ACC play shooting 40.8 percent (29-71) from three-point range through the first three ACC games (BC, ND, NCSU), hitting 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games against Boston College and at Notre Dame, before connecting on nine against NC State. In each game, four or more different Jackets connected on a bucket from long distance.

The last time Tech hit 10-plus three-pointers in consecutive games dates back to the 2016-17 season when the Jackets had a streak of three games with 10 or more 3-pointers. Tech capped the streak hitting 14 3-pointers against Appalachian State (12/11/16) to set the single-game record for three-pointers made.

LAST WIN VS. RANKED OPPONENT

Tech picked up its fourth win over a ranked opponent in the 2019-20 season, sweeping No. 17/18 Florida State on Feb. 23, 2020. Francesca Pan dropped 23 points in her final regular season home game on The Flats.

The Jackets have seen significant production from three-point range this season:

- 5 vs. Georgia State (11/25/20)
- 4 vs. Georgia (11/29/20)
- 5 vs. Tulane (12/3/20)
- 10 vs. Boston College (12/9/20)
- 10 at Notre Dame (12/13/20)

DOMINATING CUBAJ

Senior Lorela Cubaj has been a strong presence early on this season, recording four double-doubles to average a double-double on the season (14.1 pts, 11.8 rebs). She has led the Jackets on the glass in seven contests, pulling down double-figure rebounds in five outings. At Clemson, Cubaj became the first Yellow Jacket since 1996 to secure 20 or more rebounds, pulling down a career-high 20 against the Tigers to lead the Jackets.

In the ACC, Cubaj is first in rebounding, sixth in steals, fourth in blocks and tied for 16th in scoring.

Nationally, - as of Jan. 7 - Cubaj is 6th in defensive rebounds per game, 7th in rebounds per game and 15th in rebounds.

POINTING TO LAHTINEN

After dishing out a career best eight assists at Notre Dame, Lotta-Maj Lahtinen owns a team-leading 31 total assists on the season (3.8 avg). The junior is ninth in the ACC in assists and has led the Jackets in assists in five games this season.

She became the first Yellow Jacket since 2012 to record eight assists in a single game - Dawn Maye recorded five games during the 2012-13 season with eight-plus assists.

Lahtinen currently leads the ACC in steals, averaging 3.1 per game, and is 21st in the nation in steals per game.

APPROACHING A MILESTONE

The team's leading returning scorer from last season, senior Kierra Fletcher is quickly approaching the 1,000-career point plateau, currently sitting with 856 career points. The Warren, Mich., native needs to score 144 points to become the 32nd member of the Georgia Tech women's basketball 1,000-career point club.

UNSTOPPABLE LAHTINEN

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen continued her dominating presence on the hardwood against No. 3 NC State on Dec. 31, scoring a career-high 30 points against the Wolfpack. Behind hitting a career-high seven free throws, Lahtinen finished the game with 10 field goals, three 3-pointers, three steals and an assist. She also led the Jackets on the glass, securing 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and third of her career.

She opened ACC play against Boston College with an impressive performance on Dec. 9. The junior dropped a then-career-high 27 points to lead all scorers in the win. Lahtinen reached 27 points, shooting 11-of-16 from the field, including a 5-for-8 performance from three-point range. The 11 field goals and five three-pointers each marked personal-bests. Additionally, Lahtinen recorded a career-high eight steals in the win. The 20-plus point outing marked the first of her collegiate career.

The eight steals marked the most by a Yellow Jacket in a single game since Dawn Maye recorded 10 steals against Marquette on Nov. 18, 2012. It is also the most steals recorded in the ACC this year in a game.

Tech freshman guard Loyal McQueen has quickly filled a starting role with the Yellow Jackets, earning the start in six games thus far. The freshman has also contributed double-figure scoring numbers in five outings, and currently is fourth on the team in scoring, averaging 9.7 points per game. The Florence, S.C., native is averaging 27.2 minutes per game.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES ANYONE?

In Tech's first eight games of the 2020-21 season, two different Yellow Jackets recorded double-doubles: Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (2) and Lorela Cubaj (4). Lahtinen helped lead the Jackets to a victory over Georgia State (Nov. 25) with her second career double-double (14 pts, 10 rebs) and then posted her second against NC State (Dec. 31) with 30 points and 11 rebounds.

Teammate Cubaj posted her 10th, 11th, 12th and 13th career double-doubles against Georgia (20 pts, 13 rebs), Tulane (18 pts, 16 rebs), Notre Dame (16 pts, 13 rebs) and at Clemson (14 pts, 20 rebs). Cubaj is one of four players in the ACC to have recorded three or more double-doubles this

season so far. Elizabeth Kitley of Virginia Tech leads the league with six double-doubles - Cubaj is second with four.

MORE ACC ALL AROUND

With the women's basketball schedule adjustments due to Covid-19, the ACC women's basketball schedule was extended to 20 games for the 2020-21 season. Due to the extended conference schedule, the Yellow Jackets visit Notre Dame twice and will play a home-and-home with Boston College. In addition, Tech will have home-and-home series against Clemson, Florida State, Miami and Wake Forest.

CONTINUING MOMENTUM

Under second-year head coach Nell Fortner, the Yellow Jackets look to carry momentum from an impressive 2019-20 campaign into 2020-21. Tech finished last season with a 20-11 overall record, finished seventh in the ACC behind a 10-8 league record and reached the ACC Tournament quarterfinals before the season was suspended due to Covid-19. Fortner was tabbed the 2020 Whack Hyder Georgia Women's College Coach of the Year following the conclusion of the 2019-20 season. Francesca Pan led the Yellow Jackets offensively last season, averaging 13.4 points per game. She earned All-ACC honors, ACC All-Tournament Team accolades and All-ACC Academic Team recognition to close out her collegiate career.

At the collegiate level, Fortner enters her 11th season as a head coach having led the helm at Purdue (one season), Auburn (eight seasons) and Georgia Tech (one season). In her collegiate head coaching career, Fortner has compiled a 187-131 (.587) record.

WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returns seven letterwinners from last season's squad and welcomes six newcomers. The Jackets return 59.4 percent of its scoring from last season and 60.7 percent of its rebounding.

Tech will look for leadership from its two seniors this season: Lorela Cubaj and Kierra Fletcher. Cubaj, the team's leading rebounder in 2019-20, averaged a 7.7 rebounds per game. Fletcher enters the 2020-21 season as the team's leading returning scorer having averaged 10.2 points per game. With 814 career points, Fletcher needs to score 186 points her senior season to surpass the 1,000-career point mark.

WHAT'S NEW?

Even though Tech returns the core of its roster from last season, the Jackets welcomed six newcomers to the squad. Tech's recruiting class was ranked No. 12 by ESPNW HoopGurlz.

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 330-201 (.621) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 10 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and one at Georgia Tech (2019-20) – and has compiled a 187-131 (.587) overall record in the college ranks.
