Amanda Butler is entering her third season at the helm of the Clemson women's basketball program in 2020-21. Butler has 20+ years of coaching experience, including 14 seasons as a Division I head coach and proved that she was the right person to lead Clemson women's basketball after her first season, where she completely changed the perception of the Tiger program.

With an overall head coaching record of 258-195, Butler is no stranger to success, having led her teams to 11 postseason berths in 14 years. Five of those 11 postseason appearances came in the NCAA Tournament, advancing to the Second Round in four out of five years.

In 14 years at the Division I level, Butler has coached her teams to eight 20-win seasons, including a 20-win campaign in her first year at Clemson, marking the first time that the Tigers reached 20 wins since 2001.

Despite a tough win/loss record in 2019-20, the Tigers broke two major streaks during the year. On December 29, Butler's Tigers became the first ACC team to defeat Notre Dame on their home floor since the Irish joined the ACC, snapping a 58-game home winning streak. Kendall Spray tied the school single-game record

with 8 three-pointers and Clemson earned its first-ever win over the Fighting Irish.

In January, the Tigers pulled off arguably the upset of the year, dominating Duke from start to finish and snapping a 23-game losing streak over the Blue Devils. Of Butler's first full recruiting class, Amari Robinson was named to the ACC All-Freshman Team and three new Tigers (freshmen Amari Robinson and Hannah Hank, transfer Kendall Spray) were named to the ACC All-Academic Team.

In her first year at Clemson, the Tigers climbed to historical heights, highlighted

by their first NCAA Tournament appearance since 2002. Clemson finished the season at 20-13, the most wins in a season since 2001.

Bringing in just two players of her own for that first season, Butler faced the task of coaching a team that was picked to finish last in the ACC by the Blue Ribbon Panel. Undaunted by the task ahead, the Tennessee native pulled together a gritty, hard-working group of women, uniting them through the tenants of trust, loyalty and commitment.

The TLC factor paid off as three Tigers were honored with ACC awards: Kobi Thornton – ACC All-Second Team, Danielle Edwards – ACC All-Defensive Team, and Simone Westbrook – ACC All-Defensive Team. Senior Aliyah Collier also became the first Tiger to earn a spot on the ACC All-Tournament Team since 2002.

As the season progressed, the wins began to accumulate, including a few signature wins over rv/23 Miami and 21/19 Florida State. The Tigers tore through ACC play to finish the conference slate at 9-7 and in seventh place in the ACC. After winning just one ACC game the year before, Clemson's nine wins under Butler marked the largest turnaround by a first-year ACC head coach in conference history. Her success in her first year in the ACC earned Butler ACC Coach of the Year on March 6, two years to the day of her firing at Florida. It was also her birthday.

Prior to Clemson, Butler spent 10 seasons at the head of the Florida Gators women's basketball program, posting a 190-137 record in that span with eight postseason berths. She averaged 19.0 wins per season in her 10 years at Florida and was responsible for six of the program's 15 total 20-win seasons.

Butler's mentorship led to 10 All-SEC selections and eight All-SEC Freshman Team honorees during her 10 years at Florida. Following the spectacular 2008-09 season, Sha Brooks received WBCA and AP All-America Honorable Mention status. As a coach, Butler was a United States Marine Corps/WBCA NCAA Division I National Coach of the Year finalist in 2016.

Butler began her head coaching career at Charlotte, where the 49ers posted a 40-22 record in two seasons. She led the 49ers to two WNIT berths and the team's first-ever share of the Atlantic 10 Conference regular-season championship. In her debut season, Butler's team posted a 21-9 mark and a WNIT appearance, earning her Atlantic 10 Coach of the Year honors.



After graduating from Florida in 1994, Butler transitioned into an assistant coach role with the team under then-Florida coach Carol Ross. In two seasons as an assistant coach, Butler mentored the team to two NCAA Tournament berths, including an Elite Eight appearance.

She spent the next phase of her coaching career as an assistant coach at Austin Peay State University before joining the Charlotte women's basketball staff as an assistant coach. Butler earned a promotion to associate head coach following the 2002-03 season and continued her success in recruiting, bringing to Charlotte four All-Atlantic 10 selections, four Conference USA All-Freshman team members and one All-Conference USA honoree. The following season, Butler received the nod as head coach of the 49ers.

A native of Mt. Juliet, Tenn., Butler enjoyed a stellar prep career at Mt. Juliet High School, where she tallied over 1,400 points. Butler went on to a standout playing career at the University of Florida. During her junior and senior seasons, she led the Gators to the first two NCAA Tournament appearances in program history.

A three-time member of the SEC Academic Honor Roll, she was voted a finalist on the CoSIDA Academic All-America District Team. Butler completed her Gator career ranked second on the program's all-time assists list with 401. During her tenure with the Gators, Butler helped the team to

73 victories and 21 SEC wins, in addition to serving as captain during her senior season.

Butler earned a bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science from the University of Florida ('95) and a master's in 1997.

## SCOUTING THE YELLOW JACKETS

- Georgia Tech is coming off a 76-63 win over Syracuse on Tuesday night in Atlanta. The Yellow Jackets own a six-game ACC winning streak, longest of the season.
- Lotta-Maj Lahtinen leads the team in scoring and minutes played, with 15.3 points and 35.2 minutes per game. Kierra Fletcher and Lorela Cubaj each average double-digit scoring, while Cubaj also averages 11.8 rebounds per game.

## WIP

- Delicia Washington, nicknamed Work In Progress (WIP) by Coach Butler, joins the Tiger squad after taking a redshirt season due to NCAA transfer rules.
- She was the SEC Freshman of the Year in 2016-17 playing for Amanda Butler in her final year as the Head Coach at the University of Florida.
- Washington dropped 27 points against Charlotte and scored her 1,000th career point against Mercer. She turned in her second 20-point game as a Tiger at Miami, leading Clemson with 22 points.
- Washington tied a career high with 33 points in a double OT loss against FSU in Tallahassee and in a win over #23 Syracuse, Washington turned in her second double-double of the season, tallying 17 points and pulling down 11 boards.

## THREEEEEEE

- Senior guard Kendall Spray sits second on the NCAA's active career 3-point list (338), just behind Katie Benzan from Maryland (340). She's also fourth on the NCAA's active career 3-point FG per game list (3.07)
- Spray went 7-12 from 3 in the win over #23 Syracuse, turning in a season-high 24 points.
- Spray hit her 300th career 3-pointer against Presbyterian, turning in a six-three performance.
- Spray set the Clemson single-season three-point record last season with 80 and tied the school's single-game three-point record with 8 at Notre Dame.
- As the 2016-17 OVC Freshman of the Year at UT Martin, Spray shot 38.4 percent from beyond the arc and broke UT Martin's freshman three-point record with 89 while ranking sixth on the program's single-season list. She ranked 27th nationally in three-point field goals made per game (2.87) and 30th nationally in three-pointers made (89).
- As a sophomore in 2017-18, Spray ranked 9th nationally in three-point field goals made per game (3.68) and 7th in three-point field goals made (125). She set the school single-season record for three-pointers made and sits fourth on UT Martin's career three-point list, despite only playing two seasons with the Hawks.





**FRESHMAN?**

- Gabby Elliott may be listed as a freshman, but she doesn't play like one. The guard from Detroit, Mich., was named the ACC Freshman of the Week on Dec. 21 after averaging 18 points in two ACC wins.
- Elliott has scored in double-figures in 12 games on the year.
- In 10 ACC games, Elliott is averaging a team-high 15.6 points.

**BLACK HISTORY**

- Clemson's pregame shooting shirts contain the names of four important pieces of the university's history
- **HARVEY GANTT** - Clemson University's first black student.
- **LUCINDA BRAWLEY** - Clemson University's first black female student, who is now the wife of Harvey Gantt
- **COOKIE BLAKNEY** - Clemson University's first black female women's basketball player.
- **BARBARA KENNEDY-DIXON** - The ACC's all-time scoring leader and Clemson's first black Senior Women's Administrator

**READY FOR WHATEVER**

- Clemson has had three games postponed, two canceled and two rescheduled due to COVID-19.
- In December, the first Clemson/FSU meeting of the year was moved from Dec. 31 in Tallahassee to Dec. 17 in Clemson. The second meeting of the year, Jan. 17, was postponed until January 26, then moved to January 21.
- The Tigers were originally scheduled to play a second game at Pittsburgh on January 10, but due to COVID-19 protocols for the Panthers, Clemson's February 21 game at Louisville was moved up to January 10.
- The Tigers were originally scheduled to play Boston College on January 21, but due to a COVID-19 pause for the Eagles, the game was postponed and replaced with the aforementioned game at Florida State.
- The January 10 game at Pittsburgh has been moved to Tuesday, January 26 in Clemson.
- Clemson was originally scheduled to play Duke on Jan. 14 and Virginia on Jan. 28, but those games have been canceled after both schools opted out of the remainder of the season.

**TOP-25 WINS**

- Clemson's win over #23 Syracuse last Sunday marked the program's 74th win all-time over an AP Top-25 team.
- It was the first time the Tigers had beaten a top-25 team since downing #RV/23 Miami and #22/18 Florida State in back-to-back games in the 2018-19 season (Amanda Butler's first year)

**AUSSIE AUSSIE AUSSIE**

- In two overtime games in January, Hannah Hank averaged 13.0 points and 7.5 rebounds per game.
- Against FSU, Hank played 27 minutes and amassed 11 points and seven rebounds.
- In Sunday's win over Syracuse, Hank made her first start of the season and turned in a career-high-tying 15 points and 8 rebounds, adding 2 assists.

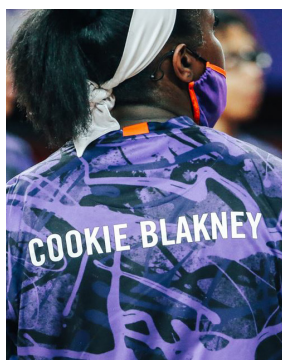

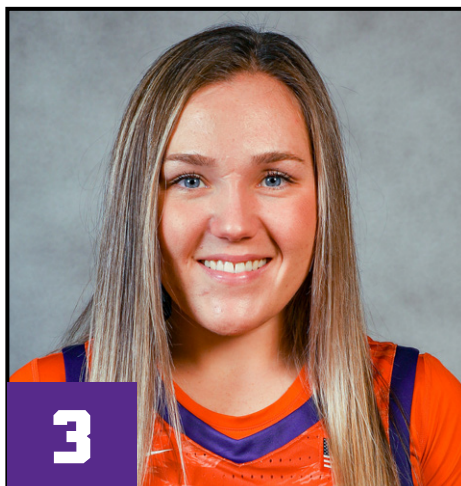
