THE SERIES

- Sunday's meeting will be the 10th meeting of all-time between the two teams with the Yellow Jackets holding a 6-3 edge in the series.
- The series is tied 2-2 in games played in Atlanta.
- Georgia Tech has won three straight in the series including a win over Pitt in the ACC Tournament last year.

A WIN WOULD...

- Be the Panthers' fourth win against Georgia Tech all-time.
- Give Pitt four ACC wins, tied for the second most in a season in program history.
- Be Pitt's 29th ACC victory in program history.

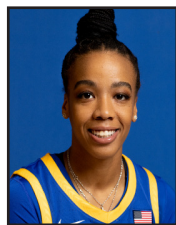
STORYLINES

- Junior guard **Jayla Everett** has led the Panthers offensively all season long and currently ranks 13th in the ACC in scoring (14.5 ppg). She also ranks 5th in the ACC in three-pointers made/game (2.8) while connecting on a team-high 46 triples.
- A bright spot for the Panthers so far this season has been their rebounding. The Panthers currently rank 10th among Power 5 programs in total rebounds/game (41.5 rpg). Pitt also ranks 15th in the NCAA and 4th among Power 5 teams (South Carolina, Baylor, UCLA) in offensive rebounds/game (16.1 orgp).

THE OPENING TIP

- Pitt will close out their regular season on the road Sunday as they take on Georgia Tech at 2pm on ACC Network.
- The Pitt offense has posted two ACC games with 80+ points scored, tied for the most in a season in program history. The Panthers are averaging 64.8 ppg in ACC play, their highest points/game total through 14 ACC games in program history.
- Freshman **Sandrine Clesca** earned her first career start at point on Thursday at #2 NC State and she produced the best game of her career as she netted a team-high 12 points, three rebounds and two steals in a career-high 33 minutes.

BY THE NUMBERS

64.8

In ACC games this season, the Panthers are averaging 64.8 points/game. It marks the highest points/game total for the Panthers through their first 14 conference games since joining the league in 2013-14.

881

Junior guard **Jayla Everett** has accumulated 881 points across her career including 246 this season as a Panther. She currently leads the team in career points and three-pointers made (135).

16.1

As a team, the Panthers have become strong on the offensive glass as they are grabbing an average of 16.1 offensive rebounds/game. They lead the ACC and rank 8th in the NCAA in offensive rebounds/game so far this season.

TEAM NOTES

LAST TIME OUT - AT #2 NC STATE

- » The Pitt offense struggled as they missed the services of starting point guard **Dayshanette Harris** and shooting guard **Gabbie Green**. Without the two starters, the Panthers were overmatched against #2 NC State as they fell 83-53 on the road.
- » Freshman point guard **Sandrine Clesca** was a bright spot for Pitt as she earned her first career start and produced 12 points, three rebounds, two steals, an assist and a block in 33 minutes of work.
- » **Emy Hayford** made her second straight start and posted seven points, four rebounds and two assists while **Jayla Everett** netted seven points, three rebounds and two blocks in the loss.
- » As a team, the Panthers shot 39.6% from the floor while the Wolfpack connected on 45.9% of their attempts.

THE DAY AND JAY SHOW

- » Heading into the 2020-21 campaign, the Panthers knew they would be relying on their talented guards to produce at a high level and they haven't disappointed.
- » In the loss at #2 NC State, **Dayshanette Harris** was sidelined with an injury while **Jayla Everett** netted seven points, three rebounds and two blocks. The two players have scored in double figures in the same game eight times this season.
- » The starting backcourt for Pitt is the fourth highest scoring guard duo overall in the ACC (26.9 ppg) as well as being the fourth highest scoring guard duo in conference games (min. 14 GP) netting 25.8 ppg combined through 14 conference games.
- » Everett or Harris have led the Panthers in scoring in 14 of 17 games this season, Everett nine times and Harris five times. Harris has scored in double digits in 11 of 15 games and in 19 of her last 23 games dating back to last year while Everett has 10+ points in 13 of the 17 games as a Panther.

HITTING THE OFFENSIVE GLASS

- » The Panthers have done a great job over the last two seasons of attacking the offensive glass.
- » Last time out, Pitt was held to a season-low nine offensive rebounds in the road loss to #2 NC State.
- » The Panthers have grabbed 15+ offensive rebounds in nine of their last 10 games, marking the first time Pitt has done so since the 2005-06 season.

- » Pitt has three games with 20+ offensive rebounds this season, all three of which came in the last seven games.
- » The Panthers have upped their production on the offensive glass this season as they lead the ACC overall (16.1 orpg) and in ACC games (16.4 orpg).
- » The Panthers currently rank 15th in the NCAA in offensive rebounds/game (16.1 orpg) and fourth overall among Power 5 programs (South Carolina, Baylor, UCLA).
- » Since White took over the program in 2018-19, the Panthers are +6.8 offensive rebounds/game as they grabbed just 9.3 offensive boards/game during the 2017-18 season.
- » Pitt has a pair of forwards who rank inside the top-7 in the ACC in offensive rebounds/game in conference games. **Cynthia Ezeja** ranks fifth (3.0 orpg) and **Rita Igbokwe** ranks seventh (2.8 orpg).

PANTHERS RACKING UP THE POINTS

- » The Panthers have scored 70+ points in eight of their 17 games this season, marking the most 70+ point games in a season since 2015-16 (eight).
- » Pitt has scored 70+ points in five ACC games so far this season, the most in conference play since joining the league in 2013-14.
- » Pitt is averaging 64.8 ppg through the first 14 ACC games, the highest ppg through 14 ACC games in program history.
- » For just the second time in program history, the Panthers have two games with 80+ points scored (Clemson, BC) in a season. The Panthers are 6-0 when they score at least 80 points in ACC play.
- » The offense has also put together four of the best scoring quarters since the NCAA switched to the four quarter format in 2015-16. Pitt has played 676 full quarters since 2015-16 and they have four of their top-5 scoring quarters this season in their last 13 games.

ABOUT GEORGIA TECH

- The Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets enter Sunday's game with a 13-7 overall record and a 11-6 ACC mark. The Yellow Jackets have lost two straight including a 84-59 loss at North Carolina on Thursday.
- Georgia Tech is being led offensively by Lotta-Maj Lahtinen who is averaging 14.3 points, 4.7 rebounds, 3.6 assists and 1.9 steals while connecting on 36.6% of her three-point attempts.
- Senior Lorela Cubaj is averaging a double-double for the Yellow Jackets as she is scoring 12.2 points/game while grabbing an ACC-high 11.3 rebounds/game.
- As a team, the Yellow Jackets are averaging 66.4 points/game while allowing 61.7 points/game. They are shooting 42.1% from the floor and 32.2% from behind the arc while holding opponents to 40.4% from the floor and 33.7% from deep.

HEY DAY DAY

- » Sophomore **Dayshanette Harris** missed her second straight game on Thursday due to a knee injury. The sophomore is day-to-day.
- » Harris has led the Panthers in scoring five times this year and 18 times in her career. She has also scored in double figures in 11 of 15 games this season and in 19 of her last 23 games dating back to last season.
- » She is the first Panther since Yacine Diop in 2017-18 to score 10+ points in six straight games to start the season.
- » Harris is enjoying a career year so far as she is averaging 26.9 minutes, 12.4 points, 4.7 assists, 4.3 rebounds and 1.3 steals. Her 4.7 apg ranks third in the ACC.
- » In ACC games, Harris is averaging 12.6 ppg to go along with 4.6 apg. The sophomore also ranks fourth in the ACC in free throw percentage (36-for-42, 85.7%). She has made 15 of her last 16 free throws dating back to the Virginia Tech game.
- » She has shot at least 50% from the floor five times this year after doing so just twice during her freshman season.
- » Harris has recorded at least five assists in eight games this season after only posting four such games a season ago.

EVERETT EXCELLING IN NEW HOME

- » After earning immediate eligibility following her transfer from New Mexico, **Jayla Everett** has made a huge impact for the Panthers through 17 games.
- » The St. Louis, MO product is enjoying a great start to her Pitt career as she is averaging 31.4 mpg, 14.5 ppg, 2.2 rpg and 2.9 apg while shooting 35.4% from behind the arc through 17 games.
- » Everett is currently 13th in the ACC in scoring (14.5 ppg), 13th in three-point field goal percentage (35.4%) and fifth in three-pointers made/game (2.7).
- » Last time out against #2 NC State, Everett was held to seven points, three rebounds and two blocks while shooting just 2-for-15 from the floor in the loss.
- » Everett currently ranks 32nd in the NCAA in three-pointers made/game (2.8) while becoming the first Panther in program to net at least two triples in each of the first eight games of the season.
- » Through her first eight games as a Panther she connected on 29 three-pointers which were the most makes through the first eight games of a season by a Pitt player in program history.

TEAM NOTES...

- » The junior has recorded 14 blocked shots this year and she is the only player under 6 feet tall in the top-25 in the ACC in blocks (20th).
- » For her career, Everett has 45 games scoring in double figures including 12 games with 20+ points scored.
- » She has made three or more three-pointers in 10 games this season and in 22 games over her career.

WHAT CAN BROWN DO FOR YOU

- » Sophomore forward **Amber Brown** has started all 48 career games for the Panthers and does a little bit of everything to help Pitt succeed.
- » Last time out against #2 NC State, Brown finished with seven points and three rebounds in 21 minutes of work.
- » Earlier this season, Brown became the second fastest player to 300 career rebounds (Brenna Wise - 40 games) since Pitt joined the ACC in 2013-14.
- » On the season, Brown is averaging 7.1 points, 6.1 rebounds and 1.5 assists while shooting a career-best 45.5% from the floor.
- » She has 22 career double digit scoring games and 11 career games with 10 or more rebounds.
- » Brown has posted 20+ minutes played in 46 of 48 career games while leading the Panthers in rebounding a team-best 20 times over her career.
- » Through her first 48 career games, Brown has played 1,418 minutes, the most by a Pitt player in their first 48 career games since Pitt joined the ACC in 2013-14.

BENCH PROVIDING PRODUCTION

- » The Pitt bench continued to produce on Thursday night as four of their five bench players scored.
- » **Liatu King** led the way with eight points, three rebounds and a steal

while **Destiny Strother** finished with six points on 2-for-5 from deep in the loss.

- » Pitt has five games with 25+ bench points this season after doing so just four times combined in Coach White's first two seasons at the helm.
- » So far this season, the Pitt bench is averaging 21.9 points/game. It is an increase of +7.9 ppg from a season ago (14.0 ppg) off the bench.
- » The Pitt bench posted a season-high 39 points in the win over Clemson, the most in a game by the Pitt bench since scoring 47 against New Orleans on Nov. 9, 2018.
- » **Liatu King** and **Destiny Strother** each scored 15 points in the win over Clemson. It marked the first time Pitt had two players score 15+ points since Feb. 2, 2017.
- » **Destiny Strother** has connected on 29 three-pointers this season, the most in the ACC by a player without a start this season.

MUCH IMPROVED REBOUNDING

- » One of the biggest points of emphasis for the Panthers since Lance White became head coach was rebounding the ball.
- » The Panthers have taken that to heart as they are averaging 6.0 rpg more this season (41.5 rpg) than the season before White took over the program (2017-18 - 35.5 rpg).
- » Pitt ranks 10th among Power 5 conference teams in rebounds/game (41.5 rpg) and 4th in offensive rebounds/game (16.1 orpg).
- » Pitt has 10 games this season with 40+ rebounds including in five of their last six ACC games.
- » So far this season, the Panthers have won the rebounding battle nine times. Since White took over the program, Pitt is 16-16 when winning the battle on the boards and just 5-42 when losing it.

2019-20 HIGHLIGHTS

- » The Panthers had a strong close to their 2019-20 campaign as they collected just the second ACC Tournament win in program history as they downed Notre Dame, 67-65, in the first round behind a **Dayshanette Harris** game-winning runner in the lane.
- » One of the brightest spots for the Panthers a season ago was the play of coach White's first recruiting class, **Dayshanette Harris, Amber Brown, Rita Igboekwe** and **Emy Hayford**.
- » The freshman quartet etched their names in the Pitt record book as they became the highest scoring freshman class in program history (948 points combined). The 948 points combined also ranked third amongst Power 5 conference freshman classes in scoring, trailing only USC (1,308 points) and South Carolina (1,047; #1 recruiting class in the NCAA).
- » Pitt was one of two Power 5 conference teams a season ago to have four freshman average at least 19.5 minutes/game (Cal).
- » Guard **Dayshanette Harris** burst onto the scene for the Panthers down the stretch and she finished the year as the only freshman from a Power 5 conference school to lead her team in scoring, assists and steals. Harris was the lone Power 5 conference freshman to average at least 12.5 ppg, 4.5 rpg and 1.8 spg a season ago.
- » Harris earned a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team following her strong first season as a Panther. She is just the second Pitt player in program history (Brenna Wise, 2016) to earn a spot on the All-ACC Freshman Team.
- » The dynamic freshman rebounding duo of **Amber Brown** (7.7 rpg - led all ACC freshman) and **Rita Igboekwe** (6.8 rpg) were the third best rebounding freshman duo in the NCAA (14.5 rpg combined). Brown and Igboekwe were one of only two freshman duos in the NCAA (Oregon State) to average at least 6.8 rpg each.
- » Brown earned ACC Freshman of the Week honors twice during her first season as she is just the second Panther in program history to earn that recognition twice in a season (Jasmine Whitney 2016-17).
- » Brown was also the only Power 5 conference freshman to lead her team in minutes played (31.9 mpg) while averaging at least 9.1 ppg and 7.7 rpg.
- » Igboekwe burst onto the scene for the Panthers as a presence down low during her first season. The athletically-gifted Igboekwe set a Pitt freshman record for blocks in a season with 60, breaking the previous record that stood for 43 years.
- » Igboekwe was one of six Power 5 conference freshman a season ago to shoot at least 46.2% from the floor while averaging 6.8 rpg and notch at least 60 blocked shots.
- » Igboekwe had a monster game against Ohio during her freshman season in which she grabbed 18 rebounds which were the most rebounds in a game by a Pitt player since 2010 and the most by a Panther freshman since 2005 when Mercedes Walker snagged 19 boards.
- » Junior sharpshooter **Gabbie Green** exploded onto the scene for Pitt a season ago after transferring in from South Plains College in Texas. Green finished off her first season connecting on 60 three-pointers, the most triples by a junior in program history. The 60 trey's are also the fourth most in a single season in program history.
- » At the conclusion of the season, Pitt placed two student-athletes (**Aysia Bugg** and **Dayshanette Harris**) on the All-ACC Academic Team. It marked the second straight season with two representatives and the ninth and tenth in program history.

LAST MEETING WITH GEORGIA TECH

GREENSBORO, N.C. – The ACC Tournament run by the Pitt women's basketball team came to an end on Thursday night inside the Greensboro Coliseum as the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets handed the Panthers a 66-56 defeat in the second round of the tournament. Freshman Phenom Dayshanette Harris netted a team-high 21 points as she finished off her first season with three straight 20+ point scoring games.

"I was really pleased with our effort for a long period of time today," said second-year head coach Lance White. "These kids when we were recruiting them we told them this year they're going to have to make all the mistakes underneath the bright lights. For our four freshmen, junior college player, they have come in and done everything I've asked. I'm excited that, again, they've laid the foundation of what we're going to be in the future. I'm most excited that these freshmen will become sophomores, and they quickly become juniors by the amount of minutes and the games that they've had to play."

The two sides exchanged buckets early on as Amber Brown grabbed an offensive rebound and finished off a layup for the first points of the game for Pitt. After Georgia Tech made a layup to take the 8-6 lead, Brown fed Rita Igboke for a fast break layup to tie things up. Cara Judkins and Ismini Prapa scored back-to-back buckets to give Pitt the 16-15 lead late but the Yellow Jackets netted the final points of the first to take the 17-16 lead through 10 minutes.

The Panthers opened up the second quarter strong defensively as they didn't allow a bucket for three minutes as they took the 20-17 behind a jumper from Dayshanette Harris and a Jahsyni Knight layup. The Yellow Jackets responded with a run of their own to take a 27-24 lead before Brown fought throw traffic for a layup. Georgia Tech scored the final four points of the quarter to take the 31-26 lead at halftime.

Harris scored the first two buckets of the third for Pitt as the Yellow Jackets surged out to a 38-30 lead just over two minutes into the quarter. After a quick timeout, Gabbie Green made three free throws and then knocked down a deep triple to send the game to the media timeout with the Panthers trailing by six, 42-36. The Panthers pushed hard to close out the third as they went on an 8-0 run behind a Harris and one layup, a Green triple and a Prapa runner in the lane but Georgia Tech banked in a shot at the buzzer to take the 48-45 lead into the fourth.

Georgia Tech opened up the fourth quarter on a 10-2 run to push their lead out to 11, 58-47, just over three minutes into the final frame. The Panthers never quit on the game as they scored seven points across the final two minutes as their season came to an end by the score of 68-58 in favor of the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets.

Harris had another monster game on the biggest stage as she netted 21 points, five rebounds, three assists and two steals on 9-for-20 shooting. She led the Panthers with six 20+ point games on the season. Brown posted 12 points and seven rebounds while Prapa scored seven points and a career-high six rebounds off the Pitt bench.

Green netted nine points while going 2-for-5 from behind the arc. With her two three-pointers, Green finished the season with 60 triples, setting a new program record for three-pointers made by a junior and tied for fourth most in a season overall. Igboke posted another multi-block effort as she finished off her impressive freshman campaign with 60 blocks, the freshman record and eighth most in a single season in program history.

As a team, the Yellow Jackets held the 36-30 edge in rebounds including a 19-9 edge in offensive rebounds. Georgia Tech scored 14 second chance points to the Panthers' eight while the Yellow Jackets also outscored Pitt 20-7 in points off turnovers.

LANCE WHITE

HEAD COACH | 3RD SEASON | TEXAS TECH '96

Lance White enters his third season at the helm of the Panthers in 2020-21 after being named as the ninth head coach in Pitt women's basketball history on April 19, 2018.

In White's second season in charge, the Panthers showed growth in every part of the program and it was capped with an ACC Tournament victory over the defending ACC Champions, Notre Dame. The win over the Irish marked just the Panthers second ACC Tournament win in program history as freshman sensation Dayshonette Harris knocked down the game-winning jumper with just 2.7 seconds left in the game. With the win, Pitt handed Notre Dame just their second loss in ACC Tournament history.

The foundation for the Pitt program was laid in season two as White's "First Class" of seven student-athletes made huge impacts that will shape the program for years to come. The Pitt freshman class of Harris, Amber Brown, Emy Hayford and Rita Igbokwe was not only the best freshman class in the ACC but they were one of the best in the NCAA. The quartet averaged 31.0 points/game combined, the most ever by a Pitt freshman class.

The youthful Panthers roster during the 2019-20 campaign was able to get loads of experience that will help down the road as Pitt was the only team in the ACC to start five newcomers, doing so in the final seven games of the season.

White signed his highest ranking recruiting class for the 2020-21 campaign as he will have five newcomers to the lineup, three freshman and two transfer student-athletes. The three freshman joining the program are Tracey Hueston, the 73rd ranked recruit in the 2020 class, Liatu King and Taisha Exanor. Hueston is the highest rated recruit for the Panthers since joining the ACC while King and Exanor are both three-star prospects with winning pedigrees.

Also joining the 2020 class will be New Mexico transfer Jayla Everett who earned the Mountain West Freshman of the Year accolades in 2018-19 after coming out of Kirkwood High School ranked as the 94th best player in the 2018 class. Sophomore Destiny Strother also transferred to Pitt after one year at Marquette, helping the Eagles to a 24-8 record while coming off the bench.

Off the court, the 2019-20 Panthers posted their best semester in the classroom since joining the ACC as they posted a team cumulative GPA of 3.481. Pitt also saw two student-athletes, Aysia Bugg and Harris, earn ACC All-Academic Team honors for the second straight season.

White notched his first career head coaching victory in the Panthers second game of the season on Nov. 9, 2018 as he led Pitt to the dominant 90-38 victory over New Orleans, their seventh largest defeat in program history and their largest in over a decade.

White collected his first ACC victory on Feb. 14, 2019 when the Panthers knocked off the North Carolina Tar Heels inside the Petersen Events Center, 91-78. The 91 points scored for the Panthers were their most scored in a game since 2014 and their most ever in an ACC contest. Another historic win for the Panthers during White's first season was the road victory over Duquesne in the City Game as they downed the Dukes by the score of 66-58.

With White at the helm, Pitt upped its offensive efficiency as they had four players average over 9.5 points/game including leading scorer Danielle Garven who finished off her impressive senior campaign averaging a career-high 11.8 points and 4.3 rebounds. Fellow senior Cassidy Walsh also had a great season under White's watchful eye as she quadrupled her scoring production from her junior season, averaging a career-high 9.7 points/game for the Panthers. Pitt also posted the fourth best season in school history from behind the arc as they connected on 32.7% from behind the arc while also bumping up their rebounding average to 35.5 rebounds/game.

Off the court, White had a pair of student-athletes, Jasmine Whitney and Cassidy Walsh, named to the All-ACC Academic Team, the most for Pitt since 2015 when they placed three on the team.

White came to Pitt after spending 15 years at Florida State, where he helped the Seminoles to a 350-145 (.707) record, including 12 seasons of 20+ wins.

During his final season at Florida State (2017-18), the Seminoles posted 25 or more wins for the fourth consecutive season, finishing with a 26-7 overall record and averaged the second-most points in a season in program history with 81.0 points per game. It was just the second time FSU averaged 80 or more points per game in a season. The team ranked in the Top 20 nationally in field goal percentage (20th), offensive rebounds per game (16th), rebound margin (sixth), rebounds per game (11th), scoring margin (10th) and scoring offense (13th). The Seminoles led the ACC in rebounding offense (42.8), rebounding margin (+10.0) and offensive rebounding percentage (41.4 percent).

During his time at FSU, 10 players were selected in the WNBA Draft, eight earned ACC All-Defensive team honors and 37 earned all-conference awards. He helped the Seminoles reach the NCAA Tournament in 13 of the past 14 years, while the team won at least one NCAA Tournament game in each of its past 15 appearances.

For his standout coaching efforts during the 2016-17 season, White was named the Women's Basketball Coaches Association (WBCA) National Assistant Coach of the Year.

White helped FSU reach new levels of success and brought an infectious energy to the program. He directed the Seminole defense and offense during his tenure in addition to being one of the country's top recruiters.

Florida State captured back-to-back regular season ACC co-titles in 2010 and 2011, and advanced to the 2010 NCAA Tournament Elite Eight. After serving as assistant coach for the first nine seasons in Tallahassee, White was promoted to associate head coach in advance of the 2012-13 campaign.

Prior to FSU, White spent 11 seasons at Texas Tech, including five years as an assistant coach with the Lady Raiders' top-10 program under legendary head coach Marsha Sharp. With White on staff, Texas Tech won three Big 12 championships and advanced to seven consecutive NCAA Tournaments, including five Sweet 16 and two Elite Eight appearances. He was a student assistant on Tech's 1993 national championship team and a graduate assistant coach for two seasons before being elevated to a full-time coach in 1998.

While in Lubbock, White worked with some of the best players the game has ever seen, including National Player of the Year and three-time WNBA MVP Sheryl Swoopes as well as Plenette Pierson, who was named 2007 WNBA Sixth Woman of the Year.

A 1996 graduate of Texas Tech, White earned his bachelor's degree in exercise and sports science. He went on to receive a master's degree in sports administration in August 1998. He attended Lubbock Christian University for three semesters before transferring to Texas Tech in January 1993.
