STORYLINES

• Earning the highest seed in program history, No. 3 Georgia Tech earned a double bye into the 2021 ACC Tournament and will open action on Friday in the quarterfinals. The Yellow Jackets will face the winner of No. 6 Notre Dame-No. 11 Clemson at 8:30 p.m. on RSN. Fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call live from Atlanta.

• Tech is making its second straight appearance in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals after picking up a second round win last season over Pitt to advance. The Yellow Jackets last advanced to the semifinals in 2012 after defeating North Carolina in the quarterfinals. Tech is 6-25 when competing in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals.

• Georgia Tech is currently leading the ACC in scoring defense, holding its opponents to 61.62 points per game. Last season, Tech held its opponents to a league-low 52.5 points and ranked 5th in the nation in scoring defense.

• Lotta-Maj Lahtinen has been a consistent offensive performer for the Jackets this season, scoring in double-figures in 14 games, including posting a streak of nine consecutive games in double figures. She led the Jackets with a team-high 22 points in the regular season finale against Pitt on Feb. 28. Lahtinen has contributed double-figure scoring numbers in 13 ACC games and currently ranks 12th in the ACC in scoring, averaging 14.62 points per game.

• Lorela Cubaj continues to be a strong presence on the glass and owns 13 games this season with double-figure rebounds. The senior forward from Terni, Italy posted her 10th double-double of the season at Florida State. She continues to pace Tech on the glass, leading the Jackets with an 11.52 rebounds per game average, and averages a double-double on the season behind 12.5 points per game. Cubaj is one of two players in the ACC averaging a double-double.

• Georgia Tech has won the rebounding battle in 12 contests this season, and holds the rebounding edge against its opponents on the season. Tech has only tied one opponent on the glass, Clemson with 32 boards each.

• Senior forward Lorela Cubaj is the ACC's active leading rebounder, pacing Tech on the glass with an 11.52 rebounds per game average. Cubaj ranks 14th in the nation in rebounds per game as of March 3. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen is currently second the conference in steals, averaging 1.86 per game.

• Georgia Tech earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament after finishing outright in third place in the ACC standings. Tech's highest seeding previously was No. 4 on three occasions (1993, 2010, 2012). In the 2021 preseason polls, the Yellow Jackets were picked to finish fifth by head coaches and ninth by the Blue Ribbon Panel.

JACKETS HAUL IN ACCOLADES

Before the Yellow Jackets opened the ACC Tournament, they hauled in a few ACC honors. Marking program firsts, the Jackets collected a trio of prestigious first-time honors (indicated below):

-Nell Fortner - ACC Coach of the Year (Blue Ribbon Panel)

-Lorela Cubaj - ACC Co-Defensive Player of the Year

-Lotta-Maj Lahtinen - ACC Most Improved Player

Additionally, Cubaj earned All-ACC First Team accolades by both the Blue Ribbon Panel and head coaches. The senior forward from Terni, Italy also placed on the All-Defensive Team.

Teammate Lahtinen also picked up all-conference honors, being named All-ACC First Team by the Blue Ribbon Panel and All-ACC Second Team by the head coaches.

With Cubaj and Lahtinen both earning All-ACC accolades, it marked the first time since 2014 two Yellow Jackets garnered All-ACC honors in the same season. Cubaj became the first Jacket since 2016 to earn first-team recognition, and just the seventh player in Tech history to earn a spot on the All-Defensive Team (first since 2014).

#BIGTIME

Head coach Nell Fortner picked up some special hardware, being named the 2021 ACC Coach of the Year by the Blue Ribbon Panel. With that accolade, Fortner has now earned coach of the year honors in the Atlantic Coast Conference, Big Ten Conference (1997 at Purdue) and Southeastern Conference (2009 at Auburn).

While also at Purdue, Fortner was named the 1997 *Basketball Times* National Coach of the Year. In 2000 while with USA Basketball, she earned USA Basketball Coach of the Year.

DOMINATING THE ACC

With Tech's win against Pitt (2/28), Georgia Tech recorded its 12th Atlantic Coast Conference win of the season, thereby tying the program record for most ACC wins in a season. The Yellow Jackets went 12-4 in 2011-12 for the best ACC season to date.

HELPING ON THE INSIDE

Senior Lorela Cubaj is a dominating presence for the Jackets defensively. She also is great at lending a hand to her teammates as the Terni, Italy, native is averaging 2.95 assists per game to rank second on the team, having dished out 62 assists this season.

In the ACC, Cubaj is tied in assists per game among true post players and she is only one of three posts players averaging 2.0-plus assists per game.

A YEAR'S DIFFERENCE

While she's been a two-year starter for the Yellow Jackets, junior Lotta-Maj Lahtinen has seen drastic improvement in her consistency this season. As a sophomore, she started 30 games for Tech and averaged 9.1 points. Through Tech's 21 games in 2020-21, Lahtinen has started all 21 games and is the team's leading scorer, averaging 14.6 points per game - a 5.5 ppg increase from last season. A gritty player on the floor, Lahtinen also leads the Jackets in steals (39) and assists (73).

Lahtinen has scored in double-figures in 14 games this season after recording a total of 14 last season. Additionally, she has 11 games of scoring 15-plus points, including four 20-plus point outings, as a junior, compared to five last season. Lahtinen went on a scoring tear this season, posting nine straight double-figure outings from Dec. 9 - Feb. 28.

She has seen significant improvement in her three-point

performance, shooting 36.7 percent (40-109) this season compared to 28.7 percent last season.

Currently, Lahtinen is 12th in the ACC in scoring, 12th in assists (3.48 apg), 2nd in steals (1.86 spg) and 5th in minutes played (35.68 mpg).

For her improved performance this season, Lahtinen was tabbed the ACC Most Improved Player by the league's head coaches. In just the third year of the award, Lahtinen is the first Yellow Jacket to receive the honor.

#NELLYEAH

In just her second year as head coach of the Yellow Jackets, head coach Nell Fortner has guided Tech to a pair of double-digit ACC win seasons - marking the first time in program history the Jackets have posted back-to-back double-digit win ACC campaigns. Last season, the Jackets finished 10-8 in the conference, earning a seventh-place finish in the league. In year two (2020-21), Tech hit the 10-win ACC mark for just the third time in program history, defeating Miami on Feb. 16.

Tech recorded its most ACC wins in a season back in 2011-12, going 12-4 in the league. That season, Tech finished 26-9 overall and reached the NCAA Sweet 16.

Tech finished third in the ACC standings, behind Louisville (1st) and NC State (2nd) - marking the highest outright finish in program history. Tech's highest ranked finish in the league also took place in 2011-12, when the Jackets finished tied for third with a 12-4 league record.

LOVE TO SEE IT

In Tech's win over Miami (2/16), freshman Eyllia Love led the Jackets on the boards for the first time this season, pulling down a personal-best nine rebounds. She bested her previous high of eight rebounds set twice earlier this season. Love nearly missed a double-double against the Hurricanes, finishing with six points.

THE STRETCH

For the second time this season, Georgia Tech played three games in a six-day period from Feb. 16-21. The Jackets hosted Miami on Tuesday, before traveling to Florida State (Thursday) and Boston College (Sunday).

Four weeks ago, Tech did the same thing to kick off the month of February. The Jackets welcomed three teams to McCamish Pavilion in six days, defeating Syracuse (Tuesday - Feb. 2), Clemson Thursday- Feb. 4) and falling to Wake Forest (Sunday- Feb. 7). During both stretches, Tech went 2-1 in the week, dropping the final decision of the week.

In the final two weeks of the regular season, Tech played three of four games on the road.

COMEBACK WIN

In Tech's game against Clemson (2/4), the Jackets trailed by nine points with less than three minutes remaining in the game. The Jackets posted an 11-0 run and forced six turnovers in Clemson's final eight possessions to fuel the closing spurt. Loyal McQueen scored twice in the run with a pair of fast break layups, including the game-tying bucket with 1:20 left, and hit a corner three during the run. Kierra Fletcher scored the other two buckets, including the go-ahead layup with 33 seconds remaining. Freshman Anaya Boyd made the key play after that. After missing two free throws, Boyd stood in and took a charge with five seconds left to return possession to the Jackets.

McQueen's 17 points marked a season-best, while Lorela

Cubaj recorded her eighth double-double in the win. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen got back to her double-figure ways, tying the team-best 17 points. Tech outscored Clemson in the paint, 40-24, and tied the Tigers on the glass, 32-32. Boyd, who played a crucial part in the game, finished with five points, two rebounds and two steals in 11 minutes.

IN THE RECORD BOOK

With her nine rebounds against Syracuse (2/2), senior Lorela Cubaj broke into the program's top-10 leaderboard in career rebounds. To date, Cubaj owns 851 career rebounds to rank fifth all-time in program history. Bonnie Tate holds the record with 1,039 career rebounds from 1977-79.

Additionally, Cubaj entered the season sitting seventh all-time in career blocks in the record book. Owing 29 blocks this season, Cubaj is now sixth all-time in career blocks with 123.

Classmate Kierra Fletcher became the 32nd player in program history to hit the 1,000-career point mark, doing so against Pitt (2/28) on her Senior Day.

LOVE OFF THE BENCH

In Tech's win over Syracuse (2/2), freshman Eyllia Love contributed a season-high 14 points to go along with five rebounds, one assist and one steal. She finished 4-of-8 from the field and 6-for-7 from the free throw line to mark a personal-best.

In games coming off the bench, Love averages 5.5 points and 3.8 rebounds in 19 games. Love has started a pair of contests against NC State and Notre Dame.

RECAPPING JANUARY

The Yellow Jackets posted a strong month of January, going 5-1 against ACC foes with its only loss to open the month at Notre Dame on Jan. 3. Tech went 3-1 on the road and defeated its opponents by an average margin of 10.5 points. The Jackets won the rebounding battle five times - with the only exception at Clemson (Jan. 7). Three Yellow Jackets averaged double-figure scoring in the month paced by Lotta-Maj Lahtinen with 15.0 ppg - Kierra Fletcher added 13.7 ppg. Lorela Cubaj contributed 10.0 points and 13.2 rebounds per game. Tech held its opponents to 56.0 points per game to lead the league in scoring defense on the month. The Jackets were third in the ACC in rebounding offense (41.0) and first in rebounding defense (31.5).

ON A ROLL

Entering the Wake Forest game on Feb. 7, Georgia Tech had won the previous seven ACC games dating back to Tech's game at Clemson on Jan. 7. It marked the longest regular season ACC win streak in program history.

Tech last won seven consecutive ACC games in the 2011-12 season when the Jackets reached the NCAA Sweet 16. Tech posted the win streak of seven ACC wins from 2/12-3/4, extending into two games of the ACC Tournament.

HERMOSA ON THE INSIDE

At Wake Forest, sophomore Nerea Hermosa was dominant on the inside, scoring Tech's first six points of the game and finishing with 16 to tie her career-high. She posted 10 points in the opening half, helping Tech hold a 10-point halftime lead.

Combined with Lorela Cubaj, the pair finished with 27 points and 18 rebounds. On the season, they are averaging a combined 20.9 points and 16.7 rebounds per game.

SCORING STREAK

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen had a streak of nine consecutive games scoring in double-figures snapped against Syracuse. The junior had scored in double-figures in nine consecutive contests dating back to Tech's ACC opener against Boston College (Dec. 9). In conference play, Lahtinen is averaging 15.6 points per game to rank 10th in scoring in the league in conference games only. Lahtinen has scored in double-figures in all but seven games this season, and has led the Jackets in scoring in 11 games thus far.

TAKING A BREAK

Covid-19 has caused several teams extended breaks during the season, and Tech is no exception. The Yellow Jackets just came off a 10-day break before playing at Wake Forest due to opponents remaining in Covid-19 protocol, having played on Jan. 10 against Virginia Tech before traveling to Wake Forest on Jan. 21. The Jackets took a 10-day break in the 2018-19 season, playing Dec. 5 and not again until Dec. 16 due to final exams.

During the 2010-11 season, the Jackets took a 16-day break from competition, playing Dec. 5 and Dec. 21. Tech finished 24-11 overall and 9-5 in ACC play, and reached the second round of the NCAA Tournament that season.

Tech took a longer break during the 1997-98 season, playing Dec. 6 and not again until Dec. 29, marking a 22-day break from competition.

CUBAJ ON THE BOARDS

Lorela Cubaj put together an impressive performance on the boards at Clemson (1/7) - securing a career-high 20 rebounds in the win. For the game, Tech pulled down 38 rebounds, led by Cubaj's 20. Cubaj was the first player in the ACC to record a 20-rebound performance this season. Only Cubaj and Elizabeth Kitley (Virginia Tech) have secured 20 or more rebounds in a game so far.

Nationally, through March 3 games, Cubaj is one of only 33 players to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. Amari Young from Old Dominion and Esmerly Martinez of West Virginia own the nation's highest rebounding total in a game this season with 24 rebounds.

Cubaj becomes the sixth Yellow Jacket in program history to record a game with 20 or more rebounds. The last Tech player to reach the feat was Kisha Ford who secured 21 rebounds on Nov. 26, 1996.

FLETCHER'S RETURN

Senior guard Kierra Fletcher made her first appearance this season against No. 3/3 NC State (Dec. 31) after being sidelined due to injury in the beginning of the season. Fletcher has taken the floor in 16 contests and made immediate impact for the Jackets. The Warren, Mich., native has averaged 34.0 minutes, 12.6 points and 5.1 rebounds per game in the 16 outings. Fletcher led all scorers in Tech's second visit to Notre Dame (Jan. 3), scoring 19 points, while finishing with seven rebounds, four assists, three blocks and two steals in 31 minutes. She matched her season-high of 19 points at Louisville (2/11), going a perfect 8-for-8 from the free throw line. She also pulled down eight rebounds, nearly missing a double-double, and dished out three assists.

BENCH SUPPORT

Georgia Tech's bench has given a helping hand in every contest this season, contributing double-figures in almost every game. Tech saw its greatest bench contribution at Notre Dame (1/3), collecting 35 points between Kierra Fletcher and Nerea Hermosa. Through 21 games, Georgia Tech's bench has averaged 12.62 points per game.

Coming off the bench, Nerea Hermosa finished with 12 points, eight rebounds, an assist and a steal at Notre Dame. Hermosa was a perfect 4-for-4 from the free throw line to help contribute to her highest offensive output of the season. In games coming off the bench, Hermosa is shooting 52.2 percent from the field and contributing 6.6 points and 4.4 rebounds per game.

WEEKLY AWARD SWEEP

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Loyal McQueen swept the ACC weekly awards the week of Dec. 14, winning Player and Freshman of the Week, respectively. Lahtinen became the first Yellow Jacket since 2017 to earn player of the week accolades. She earned the honor after posting then-career highs in scoring (27), field goals made (11), 3-point field goals made (5), assists (8) and steals (8) during the two-game week. Lahtinen led the Jackets offensively in both games.

McQueen picked up freshman of the week honors after she averaged 12.0 points per game and shot 56.3 percent from the field. In the win over Boston College, McQueen recorded a pair of career bests with 13 points and five assists.

The respective awards marked the first for both Lahtinen and McQueen.

FROM DOWNTOWN

Georgia Tech opened ACC play shooting 40.8 percent (29-71) from three-point range through the first three ACC games (BC, ND, NCSU), hitting 10 three-pointers in back-to-back games against Boston College and at Notre Dame, before connecting on nine against NC State. In each game, four or more different Jackets connected on a bucket from long distance.

The last time Tech hit 10-plus three-pointers in consecutive games dates back to the 2016-17 season when the Jackets had a streak of three games with 10 or more 3-pointers. Tech capped the streak hitting 14 3-pointers against Appalachian State (12/11/16) to set the single-game record for three-pointers made.

The Jackets have seen significant production from three-point range this season:

- 5 vs. Georgia State (11/25/20)
- 4 vs. Georgia (11/29/20)
- 5 vs. Tulane (12/3/20)
- 10 vs. Boston College (12/9/20)
- 10 at Notre Dame (12/13/20)
- 9 vs. NC State (12/31/20)

DOMINATING CUBAJ

Senior Lorela Cubaj has been a strong presence early on this season, recording 10 double-doubles to average a double-double on the season (12.2 pts, 11.3 rebs). She has led the Jackets on the glass in 18 contests, pulling down double-figure rebounds in 13 outings. At Clemson, Cubaj became the first Yellow Jacket since 1996 to secure 20 or more rebounds, pulling down a career-high 20 against the Tigers to lead the Jackets.

In the ACC, Cubaj is first in rebounding, 9th in steals and 8th in blocks.

Nationally, - as of March 3 - Cubaj is 10th in defensive rebounds per game, 9th in rebounds and 14th in rebounds per game.

POINTING TO LAHTINEN

After dishing out a career best 10 assists against Miami, Lotta-Maj Lahtinen owns a team-leading 73 total assists on the season (3.5 app). The junior is tied for 12th in the ACC in assists and has led the Jackets in assists in six games this season. She is the first Yellow Jacket to record 10-plus assists in a single game since Aaliyah Whiteside recorded 11 against Prairie View A&M on Dec. 15, 2015.

At Notre Dame, Lahtinen recorded eight assists to become the first Yellow Jacket since 2016 to record eight assists in a single game - Imani Tilford dished out eight against Mercer on Dec. 7, 2016. Dawn Maye recorded five games during the 2012-13 season with eight-plus assists. Since Lahtinen's performance, senior Kierra Fletcher has also recorded an outing with eight assists, posting the career-high at Miami. The last time two different Yellow Jackets recorded eight-plus assists in a season dates back to the 2011-12 season when Dawn Maye (10 vs. Old Dominion - Nov. 13, 2011) and Metra Walthour (8 vs. Nebraska - Nov. 30, 2011) each recorded eight or more in a single game.

Lahtinen currently is second in the ACC in steals, averaging 1.86 per game. Boston College's Marnelle Garraud leads the league, averaging 2.12 steals per game.

HITTING A MILESTONE

The team's leading returning scorer from last season, senior Kierra Fletcher hit the 1,000-career point mark on Feb. 28 against Pitt on her Senior Day. The Warren, Mich., native became the 32nd member of the Georgia Tech women's basketball 1,000-career point club.

UNSTOPPABLE LAHTINEN

Lotta-Maj Lahtinen continued her dominating presence on the hardwood against No. 3 NC State on Dec. 31, scoring a career-high 30 points against the Wolfpack. Behind hitting a career-high seven free throws, Lahtinen finished the game with 10 field goals, three 3-pointers, three steals and an assist. She also led the Jackets on the glass, securing 11 rebounds for her second double-double of the season and third of her career.

She opened ACC play against Boston College with an impressive performance on Dec. 9. The junior dropped a then-career-high 27 points to lead all scorers in the win. Lahtinen reached 27 points, shooting 11-of-16 from the field, including a 5-for-8 performance from three-point range. The 11 field goals and five three-pointers each marked personal-bests. Additionally, Lahtinen recorded a career-high eight steals in the win. The 20-plus point outing marked the first of her collegiate career.

The eight steals marked the most by a Yellow Jacket in a single game since Imani Tilford dished out eight against Mercer on Dec. 7, 2016. Lahtinen currently ranks 25th in scoring in the ACC.

MCQUEEN JUMPS RIGHT IN

Tech freshman guard Loyal McQueen has quickly filled a starting role with the Yellow Jackets, earning the start in 16 games thus far. The freshman has also contributed double-figure scoring numbers in nine outings, and currently is fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 9.1 points per game. The Florence, S.C., native is averaging 29.5 minutes per game.

Several freshmen in the ACC have made immediate impact in their collegiate debuts. McQueen is one of 11 freshmen that have started over 50% of their teams games this season.

DOUBLE-DOUBLES ANYONE?

In Tech's 2020-21 season, three different Yellow Jackets recorded double-doubles: Nerea Hermosa (1), Lotta-Maj Lahtinen (2) and Lorela Cubaj (10). Hermosa recorded her first collegiate double-double at Boston College (Feb. 21), posting 14 points and 10 rebounds. Lahtinen helped lead the Jackets to a victory over Georgia State (Nov. 25) with her second career double-double (14 pts, 10 rebs) and then posted her second double-double of the season against NC State (Dec. 31) with 30 points and 11 rebounds.

Teammate Cubaj posted her 10th, 11th, 12th, 13th, 14th, 15th, 16th, 17th, 18th and 19th career double-doubles against Georgia (20 pts, 13 rebs), Tulane (18 pts, 16 rebs), Notre Dame (16 pts, 13 rebs), at Clemson (14 pts, 20 rebs), against Virginia Tech (10 pts, 13 rebs), at Wake Forest (11 pts, 15 rebs), at Miami (14 pts, 14 rebs), Clemson (12 pts, 12 rebs), Wake Forest (11 pts, 14 rebs) and at Florida State (14 pts, 10 rebs). Cubaj recorded three consecutive double-doubles from Clemson-Wake Forest. The last Yellow Jacket to record double-doubles in three consecutive games dates back to Elo Edeferioka to close out the 2016-17 season. The last time a Jacket recorded nine or more double-doubles in a season was Roddreka Rogers in 2014-14 when she posted 12.

Cubaj is one of five players in the ACC to have recorded five or more double-doubles this season so far. Elizabeth Kitley of Virginia Tech leads the league with 12 double-doubles - Cubaj is second with 10.

MORE ACC ALL AROUND

With the women's basketball schedule adjustments due to Covid-19, the ACC women's basketball schedule was extended to 20 games for the 2020-21 season. Due to the extended conference schedule, the Yellow Jackets visit Notre Dame twice and will play a home-and-home with Boston College. In addition, Tech will have home-and-home series against Clemson, Florida State, Miami and Wake Forest.

CONTINUING MOMENTUM

Under second-year head coach Nell Fortner, the Yellow Jackets look to carry momentum from an impressive 2019-20 campaign into 2020-21. Tech finished last season with a 20-11 overall record, finished seventh in the ACC behind a 10-8 league record and reached the ACC Tournament quarterfinals before the season was suspended due to Covid-19. Fortner was tabbed the 2020 Whack Hyder Georgia Women's College Coach of the Year following the conclusion of the 2019-20 season. Francesca Pan led the Yellow Jackets offensively last season, averaging 13.4 points per game. She earned All-ACC honors, ACC All-Tournament Team accolades and All-ACC Academic Team recognition to close out her collegiate career.

At the collegiate level, Fortner enters her 11th season as a head coach having led the helm at Purdue (one season), Auburn (eight seasons) and Georgia Tech (one season). In her collegiate head coaching career, Fortner has compiled a 196-135 (.587) record.

WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returns seven letterwinners from last season's squad and welcomes six newcomers. The Jackets return 59.4 percent of its scoring from last season and 60.7 percent of its rebounding.

Tech will look for leadership from its two seniors this season: Lorela Cubaj and Kierra Fletcher. Cubaj, the team's leading rebounder in 2019-20, averaged a 7.7 rebounds per game. Fletcher enters the 2020-21 season as the team's leading returning scorer having averaged 10.2 points per game. With 814 career points, Fletcher needs to score 186 points her senior season to surpass the 1,000-career point mark.

WHAT'S NEW?

Even though Tech returns the core of its roster from last season, the Jackets welcomed six newcomers to the squad. Georgia Tech became the lowest seeded team in ACC Tournament history to qualify for the championship game in 1992 when the seventh-seeded Jackets scored a pair of one-point victories over nationally-ranked Maryland and Clemson to reach the final. Tech topped the second-seeded and fourth-ranked Terrapins, 68-67, in the first round and edged the third-seeded and 18th-ranked Tigers, 74-73, in the semifinals. In the championship game, Tech battled top-seeded and top-ranked Virginia tough, before falling by a one-point margin, 70-69.



HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

2nd Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 339-205 (.621) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 10 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and one at Georgia Tech (2019-20) – and has compiled a 196-135 (.587) overall record in the college ranks.


