STORYLINES

• Georgia Tech makes its first ACC Tournament semifinal appearance since 2012 on Saturday, facing No. 3/4 NC State at 2:30 p.m. The game will be broadcast on the ACC Network from the Greensboro Coliseum. Fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call live from Atlanta.

• Tech is making its seventh appearance in the ACC Tournament semifinals on Saturday. The Yellow Jackets last advanced to the semis in 2012 where they also faced NC State. Tech defeated NC State in 2012, 81-67, to secure a spot in the championship game. Last season, Tech faced NC State in the quarterfinals, falling to the Wolfpack, 57-48. The two ACC foes have met six times in the ACC Tournament, with NCSU leading, 4-2.

• Georgia Tech claimed its spot in the semifinals, defeating Clemson 60-57 in quarterfinal action Friday night. The Jackets shot 46.3 percent led by three in double-figures to hold off a fiery Tiger squad. Kierra Fletcher led Tech with 21 points, followed by Lorela Cubaj with a double-double of 18 rebounds and 12 points.

• Loyal McQueen exploded in the first half against Clemson, dropping in four three-pointers to match her career-high beyond the arc and finish with 12 points. McQueen and Kierra Fletcher played the full 40 minutes as Fletcher tied her season-high in scoring with 21 on the night.

• Lorela Cubaj continues to be a strong presence on the glass and owns 14 games this season with double-figure rebounds. The senior forward from Terni, Italy posted her 11th double-double of the season in the ACC Tournament quarterfinals, dropping 18 rebounds and 12 points. She continues to pace Tech on the glass, leading the Jackets with an 11.8 rebounds per game average, and averages a double-double on the season behind 11.7 points per game. Cubaj is one of two players in the ACC averaging a double-double.

• Georgia Tech has won the rebounding battle in 13 contests this season, and holds the rebounding edge against its opponents on the season. Tech has only tied one opponent on the glass, Clemson with 32 boards each.

• Senior forward Lorela Cubaj is the ACC's active leading rebounder, pacing Tech on the glass with an 11.7 rebounds per game average. Cubaj ranks 14th in the nation in rebounds per game as of March 3. Lotta-Maj Lahtinen is currently second the conference in steals, averaging 1.86 per game.

• Georgia Tech earned the No. 3 seed in the ACC Tournament after finishing outright in third place in the ACC standings. Tech's highest seeding previously was No. 4 on three occasions (1993, 2010, 2012). In the 2021 preseason polls, the Yellow Jackets were picked to finish fifth by head coaches and ninth by the Blue Ribbon Panel.

ACC Tournament Fact

Georgia Tech became the lowest seeded team in ACC Tournament history to qualify for the championship game in 1992 when the seventh-seeded Jackets scored a pair of one-point victories over nationally-ranked Maryland and Clemson to reach the final. Tech topped the second-seeded and fourth-ranked Terrapins, 68-67, in the first round and edged the third-seeded and 18th-ranked Tigers, 74-73, in the semifinals. In the championship game, Tech battled top-seeded and top-ranked Virginia tough, before falling by a one-point margin, 70-69.
