LEADING OFF

> After another dramatic Sunday comeback win, Georgia State faces a pair of midweek games, hosting No. 20 Georgia Tech Tuesday and then traveling to Mercer Wednesday. Both games begin at 6 p.m. and will air on ESPN+.

> The Georgia Tech game will be the Panthers' 16th game against a nationally-ranked foe, and 20th against teams from Power 5 Conferences. GSU has won four of the those games, including the Panthers' 10-1 victory at Georgia Tech on March 3.

> Georgia State won its Sun Belt Conference series against Troy with another improbable Sunday comeback. Trailing 15-10, the Panthers tied the game with five runs in the eighth inning, capped by Kalen Puckett's pinch hit, two-run double, and then Kyle Riesselmann hit a two-run, walk-off homer in the 10th inning for the 17-15, series-clinching victory. Chandler Dawson finished the game with two scoreless innings to earn the win.

> The Panthers also rallied in Saturday's 7-5 win over Troy. GSU scored four runs in the seventh, including Elian Merejo's go-ahead, three-run home run.

> Last Sunday at Appalachian State, GSU trailed 12-6 before scoring nine runs in the ninth inning, capped by Josh Smith's go-ahead grand slam, and won 15-13. Ryan Glass started the scoring with an RBI-single, and then Cameron Jones' three-run homer, the first of his career, made it 12-10. After Dalton Pearson's RBI-single brought GSU within one, the Panthers were down to their last strike when Griffin Cheney was hit by a pitch to load the bases. Then Smith hit the 1-2 pitch over the center field fence.

> In between at No. 20 Georgia, the Panthers almost pulled off another comeback. GSU scored five runs in the ninth, including RBI-singles by Dalton Pearson and Will Mize and a three-run homer by Will Goldberg, but the rally came up just short in the 10-7 loss.

> Sundays are for Slams: Josh Smith has hit grand slams each of the last two Sundays. First he hit the go-ahead grand slam in the Panthers' nine-run, ninth-inning rally at Appalachian State, and then he hit another slam in the 17-15 win over Troy. His slam at App State earned him Sun Belt Conference Player of the Week honors (April 17). He is the first Panther with two grand slams in a season since Ryan Blanton in 2017.

> Second baseman Griffin Cheney has started Georgia State's last 107 games at 2B, SS or 3B. In those 107 games, he has failed to reach base only 12 times. Cheney led the Panthers to back-to-back wins over Troy by going 6-for-9 with three RBI and six runs scored in those two contests.

> Friday starter Cameron Jones is a two-way player who also sees time at first base and is hitting .364 in limited action. He hit a three-run homer in the nine-run ninth inning at App State, and then followed with three hits Tuesday at Georgia. He added four hits in the back-to-back wins over Troy.

> Georgia State won its Sun Belt series against rival Georgia Southern (April 1-3). After a tough loss in Game 1, the Panthers bounced back with a 7-6, 10-inning victory on Blaine Marchman's walk-off single. In Game 3, Georgia State scored two runs in the seventh inning, including Will Mize's go-ahead, RBI-double, to clinch the series with a 3-2 victory.

> Dawson Sweatt, who will make his first start against Georgia Tech, earned back-to-back wins over Georgia Southern. In Friday's walk-off win, Sweatt pitched a scoreless 10th inning to allow the

Panthers to win it in the bottom half. Then in the deciding Game 3, Sweatt entered the contest with Georgia State down by one, runners at second and third and two outs and immediately induced an inning-ending groundout. He finished the game, allowing no runs and one hit in 3.1 innings, to seal the win after the Panthers took the lead in the seventh.

> Georgia State played its first 14 games against ranked foes, including four victories: No. 14 West Virginia twice, 7-6 (10) and 20-4 (home) No. 2 Vanderbilt, 4-2 (away)

No. 2 Vanderbilt, 4-2 (away) No. 10 Georgia Tech, 10-1 (away)

> Georgia State opened Sun Belt Conference play with a 4-3 win at ULM as freshman right fielder Dalton Pearson led the Panthers. GSU trailed 2-1 after five innings, but Pearson's two-run single in the sixth put the Panthers up 4-2. Then in the bottom of the sixth, after ULM pulled within 4-3, he threw out the potential tying run at the plate.

> In the win over ULM, starting pitcher Ryan Watson allowed no earned runs in six innings to earn his 10th career victory, the most of any active GSU pitcher. He struck out seven and walked none.

> The Panthers earned a Friday night, 4-2 victory at No. 2 Vanderbilt (Feb. 26), the highest-ranked team GSU has ever beaten. Previously, the highest ranked team GSU had ever defeated was No. 3 Georgia Tech in 2010, 10-1.

> In the win over Vandy, starting pitcher Ryan Watson threw five strong innings (1 run, 4 hits, 7 strikeouts) and Elian Merejo provided key insurance runs with a two-run homer in the top of the ninth inning. Vandy put the tying runs on base in the bottom of the ninth, but Chad Treadway recorded the final two outs for the save.

> Georgia State opened the season with a fourgame series split against No. 14 West Virginia. After falling 5-3 in 10 innings on Opening Day, Georgia State swept the Saturday doubleheader with a 7-6 walk-off win on Elian Merejo's two-out single in the 10th, and then a 20-4 victory in the nightcap. GSU then held WVU to just three hits in the series finale, but the Mountaineers managed a 3-2 victory.

- > The Panthers' 20-4 win in Game 3 of the WVU series represents the most runs GSU has ever scored against a ranked foe. Georgia State jumped on the Mountaineers with an 11-run first inning and never looked back.
- > Second-year head coach Brad Stromdahl took over the Georgia State program in 2020 after seven seasons as the head coach at Georgia Gwinnett, where he started the program from scratch in 2013 and compiled a record of 328-104. He led the Grizzlies to the Avista-NAIA World Series three times, including his last two years (2018-19). Before going to Georgia Gwinnett in November 2011, Stromdahl spent five seasons (2007-11) as an assistant coach at Georgia State.

SERIES vs. GEORGIA TECH:

> Georgia State knocked off then No. 10 Georgia Tech 10-1 on March 3 at Tech. Freshman right-hander Mason Patel pitched six scoreless innings and allowed just four hits while striking out eight, the most strikeouts for a GSU freshman since 2013. Backing the strong pitching effort in were Will Mize (2-for-4, 2-run HR, 2B, 3 RBI) and Kyle Riesselmann (2-run HR, 3 RBI) as the Panthers jumped in front with four runs in the first inning and never looked back.

>The two Atlanta schools have met 80 times since 1971, including every year since Georgia State reinstated its program in 1992 through 2019. They did not meet in the abbreviated 2020 season. Georgia Tech leads the series 68-12.

- > GSU's 10-1 victory in 2009 over a Tech team ranked No. 3 was the highest-ranked team the Panthers had ever beaten until this year's 4-2 victory at No. 2 Vanderbilt.
- > Brad Stromdahl is 1-0 against Tech as a head coach, and during his tenure as a GSU assistant coach, he helped the Panthers to three wins over the Jackets (2007, 2009 and 2011), all on the road and all over ranked Tech teams.

The GSU softball (Alabama) and men's soccer (Wake Forest) programs have also defeated a No. 2-ranked team.

SERIES VS. MERCER

- > Georgia State and Mercer are meeting for the third of four scheduled games this season. Mercer won 5-3 in Atlanta (March 23) and 5-1 in Macon (April 6). The final meeting is May 11 at Georgia State.
- > Mercer leads the series 71-51, but the teams have split the last 14 meetings.
- > Mercer is Georgia State's most frequent opponent as the two schools have played 122 times since 1967. Every year that GSU has fielded a baseball team, it has played Mercer at least once.

HEROICS FOR ELIAN MEREJO

- > Georgia State was thrilled to have Elian Merejo back for an extra season, and he has delivered some huge moments for the Panthers this season.
- > He began his 2021 season with a walk-off, delivering a two-out, RBI-single in the 10th inning to lift the Panthers to a 7-6 win over No. 14 West Virginia.
- > With GSU holding a 2-1 lead at No. 2 Vanderbilt, Merejo smashed a two-run homer in the top of the ninth inning to extend the lead to 4-1. Those proved to be crucial insurance runs as Vandy scored one in the bottom and put the tying runs on base, but Georgia State held for the highest ranked win in program history.

- > Merejo had four hits and four RBI in back-toback victories over Georgia Southern to help Georgia State win the rivalry series.
- > He led the Panthers to a 7-5 win over Troy with four RBI, including the go-ahead, three-run homer in the seventh inning.
- > Merejo is a Preseason Third-Team All-America by the National Collegiate Baseball Writers Association (NCBWA) and a first-team Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference selection.
- > In 2020, Merejo led the team with a .407 batting average, five homers and six doubles, along with 13 RBI. He ranked in the Top 5 in the Sun Belt in average (3rd), homers (4th), slugging (.763/2nd), on-base percentage (.527/T-2nd) and walks (15/T-2nd) and was named the Sun Belt's "Breakout Player" by D1 Baseball.
- **NATION'S TOUGHEST SCHEDULE?** Georgia State has faced what is certainly the most challenging schedule in program history and what could be the toughest non-conference slate in the nation.
- > GSU is facing eight different teams that were ranked in at least one Preseason Top 25 for a total of 20 games, including 11 road tests, highlighted by trips to consensus preseason No. 1 Florida and 2019 national champion Vanderbilt.
- > The Panthers are playing 20 games against opponents from Power 5 conferences, 14 on the road. GSU faces SEC foes Florida, Vanderbilt,

Georgia, Tennessee and Kentucky, ACC programs Georgia Tech and Clemson and West Virginia of the Big 12.

> GSU opened the season with 18 straight nonconference games against Big 12, SEC and ACC foes, including 13 straight road tests.

HEAD COACH BRAD STROMDAHL

Record at GSU: 19-34 (2nd Year) Career Record: 347-138 (9th Year)

rad Stromdahl, a former Georgia State assistant coach who built an NAIA powerhouse at Georgia Gwinnett College, was introduced as the 10th head baseball coach in GSU history on June 26, 2019.

Although his first season at the helm of the Panther program was cut short in 2020, Stromdahl and his staff immediately made an impact on the field and on the recruiting trail, laying the foundation for future success.

The Stromdahl Era got off to a impressive start as his Panthers earned a walk-off victory over 2019 NCAA Regional participant Cincinnati on Opening Day 2020 and followed with victories over St. John's and St. Peter's. After the 3-0 start, GSU received votes in the national polls.

The Panthers went on to compile a 9-7 record in the shortened season. Senior outfielder Elian Merejo was selected as the breakout player in the Sun Belt Conference after hitting .407 with five homers and 13 RBI in 16 games. Shortstop Will Mize and right-handed pitcher Chad Treadway were named to Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-American team.

In eight seasons as a head coach, Stromdahl has produced eight winning seasons and won 75 percent of his games with a career mark of 337-111. Not counting the abbreviated 2020 season, he has averaged 47 wins per year.

After starting the Georgia Gwinnett program from scratch in 2013, Stromdahl compiled a 328-104 record in seven seasons as head coach at the Lawrenceville, Ga., school. He earned his first head coaching position after five seasons (2007-11) as an assistant coach at Georgia State, serving as recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor during the Panthers' most successful run.

Stromdahl's Grizzlies posted four 50-win seasons, reached the Avista-NAIA Baseball World Series three times, claimed the No. 1 ranking in the NAIA coaches' poll, captured four Association of Independent Institutions (A.I.I.) titles and boasted an NAIA Player of the Year. Nine Grizzlies have been drafted by Major League Baseball organizations in the last six years.

Stromdahl earned A.I.I. Coach of the Year honors in five of his seven seasons at GGC: 2019, 2018, 2016, 2015 and 2014.

Stromdahl and the Grizzlies made back-to-back trips to the Avista-NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho, in his last two seasons, reaching the semifinals in both 2018 and 2019. The Grizzlies finished the 2019 season ranked No. 4 in the NAIA with a 48-13 record. Three players garnered NAIA All-America accolades, and two Grizzlies were selected in the 2019 Major League Baseball draft with Cam Coursey going in the 13th round to the Arizona Diamondbacks and Matthew Swain in the

23rd round to the Minnesota Twins.

In 2018 Stromdahl led GGC to a 50-12 record season and a berth in Avista-NAIA World Series. His 2016 squad won a school-record 57 games and climbed to No. 1 in the NAIA for the second straight year after opening the season with 25 straight wins, after his 2015 team, featuring NAIA Player of the Year Ty Abbott, earned the program's first No. 1 ranking. That team finished 50-14 with an offense that was No 1 in the nation in stolen bases and No. 2 in runs scored and a pitching staff that led the NAIA in strikeouts.

Stromdahl guided Georgia Gwinnett to its first Avista-NAIA World Series in 2014, the program's second year of existence and first year of postseason eligibility and less than 10 years after the school opened its doors. The Grizzlies posted a 53-13 record with two wins over eventual NAIA champion Cumberland (Tenn.) while leading the nation in triples and ranking second in 11 statistical categories, including runs scored (589), hits (723) and stolen bases (201). The squad reached No. 4 in the national poll before ending the year at No. 7, and Stromdahl was named Coach of the Year by the A.I.I, ABCA NAIA East Region and the Georgia Dugout Club. Eight players earned all-conference honors with Tyler Carpenter named honorable mention All-America.

Carpenter was also one of three Grizzlies to be selected in the 2014 MLB First-Year Player Draft, going in the 25th round to the Los Angeles Angels. He was joined by 23rd-round picks John Fidanza (Arizona) and Zeke McGranahan (Baltimore).

Stromdahl was tabbed as Georgia Gwinnett's first head coach in the fall of 2011, and when the Grizzlies played their inaugural season in 2013, he directed a 30-win campaign,

including two wins over ranked opponents.

During his five-year tenure as an assistant at Georgia State (2007-11), Stromdahl helped the Panthers average more than 35 victories over his final four seasons, highlighted by the 2009 Colonial Athletic Association title and NCAA Atlanta Regional berth--both firsts for the program--and a GSU-record 39 wins.

He served as the hitting instructor for the most prolific offensive teams in GSU annals as the Panthers hit .300 or better in each of his five seasons, led by the 2010 squad that shattered nearly every offensive school record with a

.356 batting average, a Division I-leading 10.5 runs per game and 82 home runs.

Before coming to Georgia State, Stromdahl spent three seasons at Central Michigan (2004-06), where his primary responsibilities were hitting instruction, working with infielders and assisting with recruiting. CMU made three straight appearances in the Mid-American Conference Tournament, including the MAC regular-season title in 2004 and a 42-18 record in 2005.

He spent one season at Marshall (2003) and four seasons at Division II Southwest Minnesota State (1999-02), his alma mater, while also coaching summer baseball in the Coastal Plains League (2004) and the Northwoods League (2006).

Stromdahl played collegiately for two seasons at Bethany Lutheran College in Mankato, Minn., and two seasons at Southwest Minnesota State before pursuing professional baseball. He received his bachelor's degree in business administration from SMSU in 2002 and then earned a master's in sports administration from Central Michigan.

Stromdahl, 42, grew up in Napa, Calit, before finishing high school in Minocqua, Wis. He is married to the former Tessa Rieger, and the couple has two sons, Leo William, born in 2011, and Hugo Walter, born in 2014.
