- ♦ Nationally-ranked Georgia (26-13, 9-9 SEC) plays host to Ga. Tech (19-16, 15-12 ACC) Tuesday at Foley Field at 7:02 pm ET on the SEC Network. Then on Thursday, Georgia returns to SEC action when Auburn (17-20, 3-15 SEC) visits for a three-game series.
- ♦ Freshman RHP Hank Bearden (3-0, 1.06 ERA) will start against Tech while the Yellow Jackets counter with freshman LHP Dalton Smith (1-0, 5.91 ERA). This will be Bearden's third start and 11th overall appearances. In 17 innings, he has 18 strikeouts and six walks. His wins have come over Evansville, North Florida and Georgia State. He started last Tuesday against Clemson as part of a staff night and did not factor in the decision, providing two scoreless innings with three strikeouts.
- ◆ The Bulldogs have won three consecutive SEC series including two on the road (@ #1 Vanderbilt @ Missouri) to even their league mark at 9-9. Against Kentucky and Missouri, Georgia dropped the opener and came back to win the series. Georgia is 8-3 in its last 11 games, and the turnaround began with the road series win over the top-ranked Commodores, outscoring them 25-8. Last week, Georgia went 3-1, starting with a home win over Clemson.
- ◆ The series with Tech dates back to 1898, and the Bulldog hold a 215-164-2 edge. Last year, Georgia swept the series as it marked the first three-game consecutive weekend series during the regular season in 59 years. The Bulldogs won 6-5 in Athens, 12-0 in Atlanta and 9-3 at Coolray Field in Lawrenceville, which serves as the Triple-A home of the Gwinnett Stripers. Proceeds of the neutral site game went to Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. This year's series will just be a home-and-home. Georgia faces Tech in Atlanta on May 18. Tech lost a home series to No. 17 Florida State 2-1 last weekend.
- ◆ Georgia's Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Scott Stricklin** lettered as a catcher at Kent State under Danny Hall from 1991-93, earning All-Mid-American Conference honors. Following five seasons of professional baseball, Stricklin served as a volunteer coach for Hall at Tech in 1998 and 1999 and then returned as an assistant from 2002-04 before becoming the head coach at Kent State from 2005-13 and then Georgia in 2014. As a head coach, Stricklin is 16-9 against Tech including 14-6 at Georgia.
- ◆ Georgia has had its share of close games in 2021. The Bulldogs are 7-3 in one-run contests and 3-0 in extra innings. Georgia has posted seven walk-off wins this year, the most by a Bulldog squad since 2001 when the SEC Champions registered 10 under Ron Polk en route to the College World Series.
- ◆ Redshirt junior right fielder **Connor Tate** (.362-9-28) is one of the leading hitters in the SEC. He has hit seven of his nine home runs in league play where he is batting .352 with perfect fielding in 33 total chances. Tate has reached base safely in 19 straight games. Tate's 55 hits is tied for first in the SEC, and he is fourth in batting average.
- ♦ Redshirt junior infielder **Josh McAllister** (.344-7-20), one of the leading hitters in SEC action at .333, had to leave last Saturday's game with a hamstring injury. It marked the third time this year that it has sidelined him. Most recently, he missed seven games and had returned to the lineup in the UK series on April 16. He has provided superb defense at second base and has made starts at shortstop and third base, posting a .989 fielding percentage with just one error in 87 total chances. When McAllister is out, the Bulldogs usually slide **Garrett Blaylock** over to second and **Parks Harber** plays third.

COLUMN NOTES: DID YOU KNOW?

- ♦ On Apr. 15, it was announced that lke Cousins head baseball coach Scott Stricklin had agreed to a contract extension through 2026. He came to Georgia from Kent State in June of 2013. Earlier this year, Stricklin missed eight games due to COVID-19 including the first two SEC series (UT, @ A&M). Georgia went 4-4 without their skipper.
- ◆ Twice this season Georgia has hit Back-to-Back-to-Back Home Runs and before this year, the last time they did it just once was 1987!

This year, Georgia did it against Lipscomb on March 12 (Connor Tate, Riley King and Josh McAllister) as part of a 10-0 victory. Then on Apr. 8 at #1 Vanderbilt, the Bulldogs did it again, this time it was Tate, King and Garrett Blaylock as part of a 14-2 rout.

- ◆ Redshirt junior OF **Connor Tate** led the Bulldog attack against the top-ranked Commodores, batting .583 (7-for-12) with two doubles, three home runs and six RBI. He was named a National Player of the Week by *Collegiate Baseball*, and he was the SEC Player of the Week.
- ♦ Sophomore RHP **Jonathan Cannon** was named the NCBWA National Pitcher of the Week and the SEC Pitcher of the Week after he tossed a careerhigh seven shutout innings with 9 strikeouts and no walks in clinching an SEC road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt in April.
- ◆ Against #1 Vanderbilt's vaunted pitching staff that led the nation with a 2.31 ERA, Georgia slugged .585 with eight doubles and nine home runs in winning that road series. Georgia's pitching staff posted a 2.77 ERA and registered 42 Ks against the league's best offense that ranked second nationally in slugging percentage at .544.
- ◆ Three Bulldogs have already earned a UGA degree. Riley King (Exercise & Sports Science), Mason Meadows (Business Management) and Logan Moody (Communication Studies). King and senior Chaney Rogers have started at four different spots in their career. King has made starts at 2B-3B-LF-RF while Rogers has started at 1B-LF-RF-DH.
- ♦ On Sunday, Apr. 18, Georgia held its annual Vs. Cancer Game. Along with honoring the memory of their STAR, Nicholas Chaclan (CHECK-lin), the team wore gold shoelaces to bring awareness to #VsCancer. Some Bulldogs have kept them in their cleats.
- ♦ Senior Cole Tate (.295-2-18) tied a school record with a pair of triples in a game, helping Georgia to a 7-5 road win in 10 innings over Missouri on Apr. 24. Tate provided a go-ahead two-run triple in the 10th against the Tigers. He became the first Bulldog with two triples in a game since 2010 when Zach Cone did it versus Ga. Tech. Tate is just the seventh Bulldog to accomplish this feat.
- ♦ Junior RHP **Darryn Pasqua** (2-2, 3.46 ERA, 2 SV) picked up a win and a save in two relief appearances this past week. He got a victory over Clemson by pitching the final two innings and notched a save by taking care of the 10th inning at Missouri last Saturday. For the year, he has 31 strikeouts and only one walk in 16 appearances covering 26 innings.
- ◆ Redshirt sophomore LHP **Ben Harris** (4-0, 1.73 ERA, 1 SV) has been a pivotal member of the bullpen this season. In SEC action, he is 3-0 with a 2.20 ERA in seven relief outings, limiting opponents to a .057 batting average. He has issued only six walks with 30 strikeouts in 16.1 innings of league play. He got the Saturday win at Missouri, pitching four hitless frames with eight strikeouts.
- ◆ Georgia is 7-3 in one-run games this year, including five walk-offs. Georgia has seven total walk-offs including three via the HR.

#10 SCOTT STRICKLIN

UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 8TH SEASON AT UGA; 17TH OVERALL

Now in his eighth year at the helm, lke Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. In April of this year, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a



special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally (USA Today Sports Top 25). The Bulldogs had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall) and a school record 26 Bulldogs earned a spot on the SEC Academic Honor Roll. Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. During a nine-year stint with the Golden Flashes, he posted a 350-188 record, winning five Mid-American Conference regular season crowns and five MAC Tournament titles. Also, the Golden Flashes were honored in Omaha in 2012 for having the highest team Grade Point Average of all the eight participants at the CWS, owning a 3.09 GPA.

Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in ERA during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins.

Stricklin graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (18) and Keaton (13), and a son, Cale (16).
