Tech Competing in 30th NCAA Finals

After beginning the spring season in early January with only two returning players with appreciable experience, Georgia Tech has steadily developed and improved and is set to begin play in its 30th NCAA Championship as the No. 22 seed on Friday morning at Grayhawk Golf Club in Scottsdale, Ariz.

After last year's postseason was cancelled due to COVID-19, the Yellow Jackets are back in the championship finals with three new players in its starting lineup as they tee off at 10:05 a.m. Eastern time Friday morning and 3:25 p.m. Saturday afternoon, paired with Louisville and Sam Houston State for the first two rounds. Tee times and pairings for the remaining rounds of stroke play will be determined by team score. Thirty teams will play 54 holes Friday through Sunday, with the field cut to 15 for the final round of stroke play Monday, after which the individual champion will be crowned, and the top eight teams after 72 holes will advance to a match play bracket to determine the team champion on Wednesday.

Though only two of the Jackets have championship experience, Tech is in familiar territory as a program, having competed in the NCAA Championship more times since 1985 (29) than all but four schools – Oklahoma State, Arizona State, Florida and Texas – all of whom are in the field this year. Since the NCAA added match play to the format to determine its champion in 2009, the Yellow Jackets have advanced to match play four times and looks to return for the first time since 2014.

How the Jackets Got Here

Georgia Tech sits No. 26 nationally in the most recent Golfstat rankings and No. 26 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Index, having finished in third place at the NCAA Tallahassee Regional. The Yellow Jackets opened with an 11-under-par round of 277 at the Seminole Legacy Golf Club and finished at 16-under-par 860, two spots above their No. 5 seed. Freshman Christo Lamprecht (T5) and junior Ben Smith (T8) finished in the top 10 individually.

The Yellow Jackets tied for fifth place at the 2021 Atlantic Coast Conference championship against a field that included four top-10 teams and 10 altogether that reside among Golfstat's top 50 teams. Also this spring, the Jackets won the Wyoming Desert Intercollegiate in February in California, and posted runner-up finishes at the Calusa Cup and Linger Longer Invitational.

Tech's quintet to compete in the NCAA regional has quite a different look from the team that competed in 2019 and advanced to the NCAA Championship in Fayetteville, Ark. Since then, Andy Ogletree and Tyler Strafacci each won a U.S. Amateur championship, and Luke Schniederjans became the first Yellow Jacket in more than 50 years to win the Georgia Amateur championship. They all graduated in May of 2020 and elected to move on rather than take advantage of an extra year of eligibility, leaving quite a void to fill.

Four members of the Yellow Jackets' current travel squad had no prior experience in either the Atlantic Coast Conference or NCAA Championship events. Only senior **Noah Norton (Chico, Calif.)**, a two-time All-ACC honoree, and junior **Connor Howe (Ogden, Utah)**, who had combined to play 118 of those 160 rounds, return to compete during the 2021 postseason and have NCAA postseason experience.

Both players have significant amateur achievements on their resumes - Norton won the 2019 Patriot All-American and has twice advanced to match play at the U.S. Amateur, while Howe won the Southeastern Amateur last summer. They have remained solidly entrenched in the Tech lineup this spring, combining for five top-10 finishes.

Freshman **Christo Lamprecht (George, South Africa)** has been a regular in the Yellow Jackets lineup since the second spring event in January, and has risen to become the Yellow Jackets' top-ranked player with four top-10 finishes (three top-5) and a team-best 71.42 stroke average.

Head coach **Bruce Heppler** has rotated five other players through the two other spots in the lineup. Junior **Ben Smith (Novi, Mich.)** entered the lineup for the Calusa Cup in early April and has given the Jackets a pair of top-10 finishes. Senior **Will Dickson (Providence, R.I.)** and redshirt sophomore **Bartley Forrester (Gainesville, Ga.)**, who owns the only collegiate victory (2020 Puerto Rico Classic) among the current members

of the team, has seen action in six events this spring and both played in the No. 5 spot in the Tech lineup in Tallahassee.

Tee Shots

- Georgia Tech has won one tournament this spring, the Wyoming Desert Intercollegiate, and has a pair of runner-up finishes at the Calusa Cup and the Linger Longer Invitational. The Calusa Cup had a limited field that included five teams ranked in the Golfstat top 15, and the Yellow Jackets finished behind only No. 2 Oklahoma, and ahead of No. 1 Florida State, No. 7 Wake Forest, No. 8 Texas and No. 15 Florida.

- Tech finished third, two spots above its seed at the NCAA Tallahassee Regional, finishing ahead of No. 3 seed Liberty, which finished fourth, and No. 4 seed LSU, which did not advance.

- Tech tied for fifth place at the ACC Championship in Milton, Ga., one stroke shy of advancing to the match play portion of the championship. The Yellow Jackets finished ahead of Wake Forest, who was the top seed at the NCAA Cle Elum Regional, and one stroke behind FSU, the top seed in Tallahassee.

- Georgia Tech is currently ranked No. 26 nationally in Golfstat, its highest of the season after starting out at No. 40 in the first ranking on Feb. 28.

- According to the Golfweek/Sagarin ratings, Tech has faced the 40th-most difficult schedule in Division I -- Tech has gone 5-19-1 vs. the nation's top 25 teams, 21-24-2 vs. the top 50, 50-30-2 vs. the top 100.

- Though Tech began the spring with an inexperienced team on the golf course, the Yellow Jackets started two seniors, two juniors and a freshman in the ACC Championship and NCAA regional.

- Collectively, Tech's ACC Tournament lineup has compiled 11 individual top-10 finishes, four by freshman Christo Lamprecht, three by senior Noah Norton, and two two each by Connor Howe and Ben Smith.

- No Tech player ranks higher than No. 73 in the Golfstat rankings - Lamprecht is No. 73, having jumped nearly 30 spots since the beginning of April.

- No Tech player was voted to the All-ACC team for the first time since 2016, and for only the third time since 1985.

- Tech's 2019 NCAA Finals team had four payers with stroke averages under 72. Only Christo Lamprecht is under 72 (71.42) on this team.

- Georgia Tech's collective average team score of 286.67 is nearly six strokes higher than the 2019 championship team (281.03, which ranked fourth in the nation).

Tech's NCAA Championship History

Georgia Tech has reached the NCAA Championship finals 29 times since 1985 (30 times in program history), which is tied for fifth most in that time period behind Oklahoma State (35), Arizona State (33), Florida (32) and Texas (32). Tech has posted nine top-8 finishes in the last 15 tries.

The Yellow Jackets have qualified for match play four times since the advent of the stroke-play/match-play format in 2009, finishing third in 2010, second in 2011, second in 2013, fifth in 2014. Tech did not advance out of its regional in 2012, 2016, 2017 or 2018.

Tech lost to the eventual champion three times in its four appearances in match play - Augusta State by the score of 3-2 in the quarterfinals in 2010 and 2011 and to Alabama (3-0-2) in 2013.

Tech has been the runner-up in the NCAA Championship four times (1993, 2000, 2002 and 2005, all before the introduction of match play). Only Oklahoma State, which has 18, Texas (6) and Purdue (5) have more.

In 1993 and 2002, the Yellow Jackets led after 54 holes, but finished second by one shot to Florida in 1993, and by four shots to Minnesota in 2002.

In 2000, the Yellow Jackets rallied to tie Oklahoma State after 72 holes, but lost to the Cowboys on the first hole of a playoff. Tech and OSU matched the lowest 72-hole team score in NCAA Championship history (36-under-par 1,116) at the Grand National Lake Course in Opelika, Ala. In 2005, Tech finished 11 shots behind Georgia, and seven shots ahead of third-place Washington.

Since Bruce Heppler became Tech's coach, the Jackets have finished in the top eight 11 times.

Three Tech players have won national collegiate championships. Troy Matteson did it most recently in 2002 at Ohio State. Watts Gunn (1927) and Charlie Yates (1934) won national titles under a match play format before the NCAA took sponsorship of the championship in 1939.

Tech and NCAA Match Play

The 2009 NCAA Championship featured a new twist with the team champion determined via match play. The top eight teams after 54 holes of stroke play advance to a match play tournament format.

The NCAA added a fourth round of stroke play in 2016 for the top 15 teams and nine individuals not on those teams, after which the

national individual champion and the top eight teams for match play will be determined.

Match play is a format that Bruce Heppler has supported vigorously. Under Heppler, Georgia Tech finished in the top eight of the NCAA Finals seven times in 10 tries under the 72-hole, stroke-play format. Tech is one of only two teams (Oklahoma State is the other) to have advanced to match play four times in the six years the current format has been in effect.

In the stroke-play/match play era, the Yellow Jackets have finished 10th, third, second, second and fifth, respectively, in the stroke-play portion of the NCAA Championship in five tries (Tech did not advance out of its regional in 2012 or 2016). Tech lost to the eventual national champion three of the four times it has qualified for match play (Augusta State in the 2010 and 2011 quarterfinals, Alabama in the 2013 semifinals).

Tech has had success in other match-play events in recent years, reaching the finals of the Callaway Collegiate Match Play Championship four times in six appearances.

Georgia Tech Match Play History

While match play in college golf may be infrequent, Georgia Tech is no stranger to it, having participated in 10 regular season match play events since 2000, as well as three times since the NCAA added match play to determine its champion. Here is a history of Tech's participation.

Jackets to Add 2 for 2021-22

Georgia Tech has signed one junior prospect and accepted one transfer to add to its roster for 2021-22, signing **Benjamin Reuter** from the Netherlands to a letter-of-intent and adding transfer **Ross Steelman**, formerly of Missouri.

Ranked No. 64 among European under-18 golfers and No. 241 among all European amateurs (No. 524 overall in WAGR), Reuter won the Dutch national under-15 championship three consecutive years (2016, 2017, 2018) before finishing second in the country's U18 championship in 2019 and seventh in 2020. Reuter also has performed well in other Dutch national events against all-aged competition - he finished eighth and third in the national stroke play championship the last two years, as well as 22nd and second the last two years in his country's national open championship.

Steelman, a second-team All-SEC performer this year at Missouri, makes the transition after finishing in a tie for third place overall, competing as an individual at the 2021 NCAA Noblesville Regional (Missouri did not compete as a team). He had a 70.24 scoring average in 2020-21 and is Golfstat's 29th-ranked player in the nation, and No. 33 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Index. He stands No. 223 in the World Amateur Golf Ranking, and No. 127 in the Scratch Players World Amateur Ranking, and was medalist at his U.S. Open local qualifier on May 10, in Kansas City.

Tech in NCAA Regional Competition

Georgia Tech has advanced through an NCAA regional 25 times in 30 tries, and all but four times since the NCAA went to a six-regional qualifying format in 2009. Head coach Bruce Heppler's teams have won five regional tournaments outright, most recently in 2014, and tied for one other.

The NCAA began using regional qualifying tournaments in 1989, first with the 81 teams split among three sites (27 teams each), then among six sites with either 13 or 14 teams each beginning in 2009. Since the NCAA went to six regional sites in 2009, Tech has advanced

to the championship finals seven times - third in 2009 (Bowling Green, Ky.), third in 2010 (Milton, Ga.), tied for third in 2011 (Radford, Va.), fourth in 2013 (Tallahassee, Fla.), first in 2015 (Raleigh, N.C.), fourth in 2019 (Pullman, Wash.) and third in 2021 (Tallahassee, Fla.). No NCAA championship events were held in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Tech's first four victories all occurred in 27-team regionals in 1991 (New Haven, Conn.), 1998 (Daufuskie Island, S.C.), 1999 (Providence, R.I.) and 2002 (Roswell, Ga., tied with Clemson). Only the 2014 win in Raleigh occurred in a 13-team field.

Tech's ACC Championship History

Georgia Tech has won 18 ACC men's golf championships, putting the Yellow Jackets in a tie with Wake Forest for the most titles in conference history. Tech's titles have all come from 1985 to the present. Wake Forest's most recent title came in 1989.

Tech has won the ACC Championship 10 times in the last 14 years, including the last two in a row. The Yellow Jackets won the 2019 championship with a tournament record score of 827 (37-under-par), breaking the previous mark of 831 (-33) set by the Jackets in 2011.

The 2020 ACC Tournament was not held after the 2020 spring season was cut short due to COVID-19.

Tech has won 13 of its conference titles under current head coach Bruce Heppler, 11 of those outright (1999, 2001, 2002, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019) and two shared (2006, 2007). The Yellow Jackets won five championships (1985, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994) under previous head coach Puggy Blackmon.

Twelve of Tech's ACC titles have been won at the Old North State Club in New London, N.C., site of the event 22 of the last 25 years. The first occurred in 1999 by 10 strokes over North Carolina and Duke. Tech won its 2018 crown without an individual finishing higher than 12th place.

Georgia Tech has produced 10 ACC individual champions, including Bob McDonnell (1985), David Duval (1991, 1993), Mikko Rantanen (1994), Bryce Molder (2000), Cameron Tringale (2006), Chesson Hadley (2010), Paul Haley (2011), Albertson (2013, 2015) and Ollie Schniederjans (2014). Albertson and Duval are among five ACC players.

Tech Golf APR Perfect for 15 Straight Years

Bruce Heppler's golf program again earned a perfect four-year APR score of 1000 for the four-year period ending in the 2018-19 academic year in the NCAA's survey announced in May. The Yellow Jackets have earned a perfect four-year score every year since its inception in 2006, and has also received an APR Public Recognition Award every year. Among Power 5 conferences, Tech is one of two men's golf teams and 12 programs overall that have achieved the feat.

APR is an annual scorecard of academic achievement calculated for all Division I sports teams. It measures eligibility, graduation and retention each semester or academic term and provides a clear picture of the academic performance for each team in every sport.

Heppler ACC Coach of the Year 10 times

Georgia Tech Bruce Heppler has been named ACC Coach of the Year 10 times in his 25-year tenure on The Flats. That is the most for one coach in conference history.

Tech won the Atlantic Coast Championship in April for the 18th time, matching Wake Forest for the most in conference history. The Yellow Jackets have won six tournaments altogether, more than any other Division I team in 2018-19, bringing to 59 the total number of titles earned by the Jackets under Heppler. He has coached Tech to 13 of its 18 ACC titles.

Tech Lineup Notes

WILL DICKSON (SENIOR, PROVIDENCE, R.I.) - Has three top-20 finishes to his credit this spring after seeing action in just two events over his first three years at Tech ... Tied for 41st at the ACC Championship, and is fifth on the team in stroke average (73.85 over 20 rounds) ... Played first two rounds (73-77) of the NCAA Tallahassee Regional but was replaced by Bartley Forrester for the final round ... Began to show promise last fall by finishing 13th or higher in all four amateur events he played, including a fourth-place effort in the Orlando International Amateur in December ... Was Tech's top finisher in both January events (15th at Camp Creek Invitational, 11th at Southwestern Invitational), and tied for 15th in a strong field at the Calusa Cup ... Golfstat ranking is 319, Golfweek/Sagarin 318 ... Graduated May 8 with a degree in business administration.

BARTLEY FORRESTER (SOPHOMORE, GAINESVILLE, GA.) - The only member of Tech's current team to win a collegiate tournament, sharing medalist honors at the Puerto Rico Classic in February of 2020 in his second career start ... Had a solid summer in amateur competition, tying for seventh place at the Palmetto Amateur and 19th at the

Southeastern Amateur ... Highest finish in five events this spring was a tie for 18th at the Amer Ari Intercollegiate ... Other finishes all between 27th (Linger Longer Invitational) and 46th (Camp Creek Invitational) ... Was Tech's alternate player for the ACC Championship and NCAA Tallahassee Regional ...
