2021-22 Men's Basketball - STUDENT Ticket Policy

First come, first served with your valid BuzzCard. No sign-up/registration needed unless otherwise mentioned. The GTAA reserves the right to distribute student tickets via a ticket lottery if demand is high for a certain game. Such changes will be communicated to the student body in a timely manner.

Only the first ~900 students will be allowed to enter. When the student ticket allotment has been reached for a game, no more students will be allowed in under the student ticket program. If the student section reaches capacity yet inventory remains in non-student sections, students will be given a ticket as they enter to sit in a reserved, non-student section seat.

You will use your BuzzCard for entry to all games. It must be a *valid student ID (*current student, paid athletic fee). No physical ticket or printout will be required unless otherwise mentioned. It is recommended that students check this student ticket webpage regularly for any updates. Other details:

- **Student General Admission Seating Areas:**
 - Section 108: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)
 - Section 109: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)
 - Section 110: Rows 2-5 (Courtside)
 - Section 113: Rows 1-24 (Behind Basket)
 - o Courtside: Sections 108/109/110: Rows 2-5; Restricted to students with wristbands only. See Courtside Seat Policy below.
 - **All other sections are reserved for regular ticketed patrons. **
- Courtside Seat Policy The 200 courtside seats are reserved for GT Students. These seats are available to the first 200 GT students who wish to sit courtside. Students sitting courtside MUST acquire a new wristband for each game. Wristbands are required for courtside seat access and are limited to 200. You must show your BuzzCard to obtain a wristband. Wristbands must be attached immediately. Also, no visiting team colors may be worn in this area. Wristbands will likely be "sold out" shortly after doors open. Please DO NOT take a courtside seat if you will not sit there the whole game.
- ALL students must enter through the West Entrance (On Fowler Street across from the Byers Tennis Complex).
- Doors open 1 hour before tip-off.
- "Camping Out" Overnight is STRICTLY PROHIBITED
- Student must enter games using their own BuzzCard. Violators will have that card confiscated and turned over to the BuzzCard office.

Additional Student Ticket Policies

- Students without a paid athletic fee will <u>NOT</u> be able to participate in the student ticket program.
- BuzzCards will be swiped at the student entrance to gain admittance.
- Students must enter games using their own BuzzCard. Violators will have the card confiscated and turned over to the BuzzCard office.
- **NO** Student GUEST Tickets will be available for purchase. Student guests should look to purchase an individual game ticket (if available).
- The GTAA reserves the right to sell student section tickets to the general public during games that take place over Winter break. Additionally, student section tickets may be sold if student turnout is at less than 500 students at tip-off.
