TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ At 8-0, the No. 14 Georgia Bulldogs have matched their best start since the 2012 club went 8-0. The 2009 squad reached 14-0 for the finest start.

After a 7-6 win this past Tuesday over Wofford at Fluor Field in Greenville, S.C., Georgia now continues a stretch of six games in six different stadiums! The Bulldogs have a three-game set with No. 19 Ga. Tech (8-1), featuring game one Friday at Tech at 6 pm, followed by Saturday's game in Athens at 2 pm. The series concludes Sunday at Coolray Field in Lawrenceville at 2 pm and serves as the 19th annual Spring Classic For Kids baseball game to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta (CHOA). Proceeds from the ticket sales at Coolray go toward funding critical patient and family initiatives in the Aflac Cancer and Blood Disorders Center of CHOA. Next week, Georgia faces Ga. Southern Tuesday at SRP Park in North Augusta, S.C. and then the Eagles again Wednesday at their home field in Statesboro.

◆ The Bulldogs are batting .313 with nine home runs and rank 14th nationally in ERA (1.90). Georgia has a .980 Fielding Percentage. Tech is batting .342 with 19 home runs, a 3.94 ERA and a .971 FLDG%.

◆ **Series History:** In records dating back to 1898, Georgia leads the all-time series 215-166-2. Tech won both campus meetings last year (7-5 in Athens, 7-6 in 14 innings in Atlanta) with no neutral site game due the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic. The Bulldogs swept the series in 2020. In the Spring Baseball Classic, Georgia holds a 12-6 edge including 1-0 at Coolray Field. A Classic series review is listed on page seven.

Georgia's Ike Cousins head baseball coach **Scott Stricklin** lettered as a catcher at Kent State under Danny Hall from 1991-93, earning All-Mid-American Conference honors. Following five seasons of professional baseball, Stricklin served as a volunteer coach for Hall at Tech in 1998 and 1999 and then returned as an assistant from 2002-04 before becoming the head coach at Kent State from 2005-13 and then Georgia in 2014. As a head coach, Stricklin is 16-11 against Tech including 14-8 at Georgia.

◆ **Top Performers In 2022:** Graduate CF **Ben Anderson** is off to a hot start, ranking among the SEC leaders in batting at .545 (12-for-22) with three doubles, one triple, two home runs and four RBI in six games. He sets the tone as the leadoff batter including blasting a home to start the 2022 campaign against Albany. He became the first Bulldog to do that in available records dating back to 1975. Then this past Saturday, Anderson rested in game two of a doubleheader, paving the way for redshirt freshman centerfielder **Dwight Allen II** to leadoff. Allen smashed his first career home run to give Georgia two centerfielders who have started games off this year with a home run – including one to start a season!

◆ Sophomore pre-season All-SEC DH/C **Corey Collins** (.333-1-4) has hit safely in all six games he's played this year and 14 straight dating back to last year.

◆ Graduate shortstop **Cole Tate** (.406-1-4) has tied his career-best with an eight-game hitting streak to start 2022 while Anderson and Collins are next with six-game streaks this year.

◆ Pre-season All-America RHP **Jonathan Cannon** (2-0, 0.00 ERA) is living up to the pre-season billing. In two starts covering 14.1 innings. Cannon has yet to allow a run and that leads the country. He has nine strikeouts and no walks. He pitched a career high 8.1 scoreless innings in beating Akron 1-0 this past Friday and was honored as SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week.

◆ Sophomore LHP **Luke Wagner** (3-0, 0.00 ERA) has been in the right place at the right time, picking up a trio of wins in just 7.1 innings of relief.

◆ Senior RHP **Jack Gowen** (0-0, 0.00 ERA, 2 SV) is 2-for-2 in save chances and yet to allow a run in three innings with two walks and five strikeouts over three appearances.

SPRING BASEBALL CLASSIC FOR CHOA

The Georgia Bulldogs will battle Georgia Tech in the 2022 Spring Baseball Classic for Kids on March 6 at Coolray Field at 2 pm. The 2022 game will be the 19th meeting to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta.

Georgia holds a 12-6 edge in the series that began at Turner Field and then SunTrust Park before moving to Coolray Field in 2020. From 2004-2019 when it was in the Major League park, there were more than 20,000 tickets sold annually. It ranked as one of the nation's largest attended college baseball games each year. The game has raised more than \$200,000 annually for the not-for-profit pediatric healthcare system.

Notable Georgia wins in the Classic including a 10-3 decision in the first-ever meeting in 2003, a 17-0 rout in 2013, a combined one-hit shutout in 2015, an 8-7 thriller to complete a season sweep in 2017 and a 9-3 victory at a sold out Coolray Field for a season sweep in 2020.

**UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH
9TH SEASON AT UGA; 18TH OVERALL**

Now in his ninth year at the helm, Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin has returned the Bulldogs to one of the top programs in the country. In April of 2021, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally as it had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall). Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, handled pitching staffs that were ranked No. 1 and No. 2 in the nation in ERA during his final two playing seasons at KSU. A 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins. He graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from Kent State in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (19) who attends UGA, and Keaton (14), and a son, Cale (17).
