## MESSICK TOPS FSU ROTATION

- » Redshirt sophomore Parker Messick has picked up where he ended 2021, when he was named the ACC Pitcher and Freshman of the Year.
- » Messick is 4-1 with a 2.35 ERA and 76 strikeouts, the most in the country. Over his past two games, Messick has thrown 15.0 with six hits allowed, no runs and 25 strikeouts.
- » Thursday, Messick was named a midseason All-American by D1Baseball and is on the mid-season watch list for the Golden Spikes Award.
- » Messick was superb against No. 16 Notre Dame (4/1/22), allowing just two hits and no walks while striking out 11 batters over a career-high 8.0 innings. He was named the College Baseball Foundation co-Pitcher of the Week.
- » Messick has twice been named the ACC Pitcher of the Week this season, for his 13-strikeout, 0-walk performance vs. Samford (2/25/22) and his career-high 14-strikeout, 4-hit game against Duke (3/25/22).
- » Messick's 14 strikeouts were a career high and joined teammate Ross Dunn as the only players in the ACC this year with 14 strikeouts in a game.
- » Messick's games against Samford and Duke are FSU's two shutouts on the season.
- » At Wake Forest, Messick's 11 strikeouts set a career-high for a road game.
- » In addition to ACC POTW honors, Messick was also named Perfect Game National Pitcher of the Week against Samford. He allowed just one hit and hit one batter over 7.0 innings against the Bulldogs.
- » On Opening Day against James Madison, Messick struck out 11 batters and allowed one run in 5.2 innings.
- » Messick became the first FSU pitcher since Mike Compton in 2015-16 to start on Opening Day in consecutive seasons.
- » Messick entered 2022 as the Preseason Pitcher of the Year from Perfect Game and a first team Preseason All-American. He is one of 45 players on the Golden Spikes Award Midseason Watch List.
- » Messick was rated the No. 3 starting pitcher by D1Baseball in the preseason.
- » Messick finished 8-2 with a 3.10 ERA and 126 strikeouts in 2021 and was a third team All-American and second team Freshman All-American.

- » Messick hit a home run in his first collegiate at-bat against Virginia Tech (3/14/21). At No. 6 Miami (3/19/21), he DH'd and pitched, throwing 6.2 innings with 10 strikeouts and going 1-for-4 with 3 RBI at the plate.
- » Last season at Georgia Tech, Messick pitched 6.0 innings in FSU's 9-0 series-opening win. It was FSU's first shutout vs. Georgia Tech since 2000 and the first in Atlanta since 1985.

## 13+ STRIKEOUTS

- » Florida State has started four different starting pitchers this season - Parker Messick, Bryce Hubbard, Ross Dunn and Carson Montgomery - and all four have at least one game with 13+ strikeouts.
- » **No other pitcher in the ACC has a 13-strikeout game this year:**

## PITCHING AMONG NATION'S BEST

- » From D1Baseball's Aaron Fitt: "Florida State has college baseball's best pitching staff. The all-lefty weekend rotation of Parker Messick, Bryce Hubbard and Ross Dunn is as good as it gets, and FSU has another first-round talent as its midweek starter in Carson Montgomery, plus a balance of rock-solid veterans and exciting young arms in the bullpen."
- » Messick, Hubbard, Dunn and Montgomery are a combined 13-4 on the season. Messick leads the country with 76 strikeouts, while Hubbard and Dunn rank in the Top 35:

- » Dunn is second in the country with 15.47 strikeouts per nine innings, while Messick is eighth with 14.87.
- » As a team, FSU has struck out at least 10 batters in 24 of 28 games this season. In the 17-inning game against NC State (3/20/22), FSU struck out 26 batters, a new school record.
- » In a 12-inning game against Stetson (4/6/22), FSU finished with 25 strikeouts, including a career-high 13 by starter Carson Montgomery.
- » In D1Baseball's midseason player rankings, FSU is the only team in the country with three starting pitchers in the Top 25 - No. 5 Hubbard, No. 6 Messick and No. 21 Dunn.

# GAME NOTES

## HUBBART AMONG NATION'S BEST

- » Third-year sophomore Bryce Hubbart is the first Seminole to win his first four starts since Cole Sands in 2018. At Wake Forest, Hubbart allowed one hit and struck out nine batters in 5.2 innings pitched.
- » Hubbart is 5-1 - one victory behind the national leaders - and ranks 27th nationally with 57 strikeouts.
- » Hubbart was named the NCBWA Pitcher of the Month for February. The LHP from Windermere did not allow a run in 11.0 innings against James Madison and Samford, with 22 strikeouts in that span.
- » Hubbart improved to 3-0 with a 7-4 win against Cal (3/5/22). Hubbart struck out 12 batters in a career-high 7.2 innings, with a walk and two runs allowed.
- » Hubbart won his first ACC Pitcher of the Week award for his opening weekend game against JMU, when he struck out a career-high 13 batters in just 5.0 innings with no walks.
- » Against Samford, he struck out nine batters in 6.0 innings without allowing a run.
- » Hubbart is the No. 5-rated starting pitcher by D1Baseball and No. 31 on D1's top draft-eligible players list for 2022.
- » He finished 6-5 with a 3.80 ERA in 2021 and had 94 strikeouts in 71.0 innings pitched.
- » Against Troy (5/1/21), Hubbart set his previous high with 12 strikeouts. As a team, FSU had 17 strikeouts and no walks against the Trojans:

- » Hubbart & Messick were both named to the ACC All-Freshman Team a year ago. Hubbart is a second team Preseason All-American from Baseball America and a third team All-American from D1Baseball and Perfect Game.
- » Hubbart was a Cape Cod League All-Star over the summer while helping lead the Brewster Whitecaps to the league title.

## DUNN SHINES IN BACK-TO-BACK OUTINGS

- » Ross Dunn earned his first career win at Wake Forest (3/13/22), striking out 14 batters and allowing just four hits in 7.0 innings pitched.
- » The 14 strikeouts are the most for a Seminole pitcher in a road game since Randy Choate had 15 at Maryland on April 26, 1997.

- » Dunn's strikeouts and innings pitched were career highs. His previous bests came the prior week against Cal (3/6/22), when he struck out 11 batters in 6.0 innings with just one run allowed.
- » After a two-run home run in the first inning, Dunn surrendered just two more hits at Wake Forest.
- » Against NC State, Dunn did not allow an earned run over 6.0 innings. He struck out nine batters and ranks 35th in the country with 55 on the season. He is second in the country with 15.47 strikeouts per nine innings.

- » For his effort at Wake Forest, Dunn was named the Rapsodo/D1Baseball Player of the Week and one of Collegiate Baseball's Players of the Week.
- » Dunn is the No. 21-rated starting pitcher in D1Baseball's midseason rankings.

## MONTGOMERY EARNS MIDWEEK SLOT

- » Sophomore Carson Montgomery has a 3.89 ERA in seven starts this year and won three straight games, the first wins of his career.
- » Against FGCU (3/8/22), Montgomery threw 5.2 innings with seven strikeouts. He allowed just one run in the Noles 10-4 win.
- » Against Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22), Montgomery allowed five runs in five innings, but just two runs were earned and he allowed only two hits to the Wildcats in FSU's 17-9 win.
- » Montgomery set a career-high with 7.0 innings against UCF (3/22/22), with eight strikeouts, in FSU's 10-2 win. He allowed just four hits and threw just 84 pitches.
- » Montgomery struck out a career-high 13 Stetson hitters (4/6/22) but came away with a no-decision.
- » Montgomery, the nation's top recruit that reached campus prior to the 2021 season, struck out nine batters in back-to-back midweek starts in 2021, despite throwing just 8.2 combined innings in that span.
- » Montgomery started both games against Florida in 2021, finishing with a 2.00 ERA over 9.0 innings. He struck out 14 batters, including 9 in 4.2 innings in FSU's 10-2 win in Tallahassee.

## NOLES SECOND IN NATION IN K/9 IP

- » Florida State ranks second nationally with 12.5 strikeouts per nine innings, with 371 over 266.1 innings pitched.
- » FSU has 32 strikeouts more than No. 2 Mississippi State (339).
- » The Seminoles set a school record with 26 strikeouts against NC State (3/20/22), topping the previous mark of 25 set vs. Furman in 1956.
- » FSU struck out 25 Stetson hitters (4/6/22), including 13 by Carson Montgomery. The 25 strikeouts were the most in Stetson history.
- » The Noles opened the season with 47 strikeouts in three games against James Madison, a school-record for a three-game series.
- » FSU struck out NC State 46 times over three games this season, tied for the second-most in a three-game series in school history.
- » Against NC State, UCF and Duke, FSU also set a school record with 52 strikeouts over any three-game stretch.
- » Last year, FSU ranked fourth with 11.4 strikeouts per nine innings and struck out at least 10 batters in 40 of 55 games. This year, FSU has reached double-digit K's in 24 of 28 games.

» With Jaime Ferrer's eighth-inning home run vs. Duke (3/27/22), Florida State hit a home run in 12 consecutive games, tied for the fourth-longest streak in school history:

### FERRER'S HR WALKS-OFF NC STATE IN 17th

- » Freshman Jaime Ferrer hit a walk-off solo home run in the 17th inning vs. NC State to win the game and clinch the series for FSU (3/20/22).
- » The game was the second of a doubleheader, and the team's combined to play 26 innings in the day, the most in a single day in FSU history.
- » The team's combined for 54 strikeouts, setting a new NCAA record. FSU's 26 strikeouts pitching and 28 strikeouts batting were both school records.
- » Alex Toral hit a game-tying two-run home run in the bottom of the 12th inning after NC State had taken the lead.
- » Davis Hare (3.1 IP, 7 K) and Wyatt Crowell (W, 5.1 IP, 5 K) combined to keep FSU afloat out of the bullpen. The strikeouts and IP for both players were career bests.
- » The 17-inning game took 5:45 to complete and tied for the second-most innings played in school history:

### TORAL, TIBBS COMBINE TO BEAT CAL

- » Trailing 3-1 entering the bottom of the eighth against Cal (3/4/22), FSU had just one run and three hits against strong Golden Bears' pitching.
- » In the 8th, freshman James Tibbs singled and, with two outs, Alex Toral hit a 430-foot bomb to right field that tied the score 3-3.
- » In the ninth, Florida State drew three walks and, also with two outs, Tibbs singled past the second baseman for the Noles walk-off 4-3 win.
- » The win was FSU's first in a one-run game this year and the first walk-off of the season.
- » Sophomore Tyler Martin, who had not played all season, pinch-hit in the ninth and drew a four-pitch walk. Martin was the last Seminole freshman with a walk-off hit, a single against Mercer in 2020.
- » Against FGCU, Tibbs hit a 451-foot grand slam and Toral reached base via HBP and walk. Toral reached safely in his first 17 games as a Seminole and leads FSU with 25 RBI and 7 home runs.

### 0-0 INTO EXTRAS

- » Florida State and Notre Dame were scoreless through 11 innings, just the second time in FSU history that both teams were scoreless that deep into a game.
- » It was just the fifth 0-0 game that went to extra innings, and the first since 1970:

### NEWCOMERS HELP FROM DAY ONE

- » Florida State welcomed in three high-profile transfers this offseason, and all three have seen significant action this year.
- » First baseman Alex Toral was a four-year starter at Miami, where he hit 37 home runs and hit .261 in 164 games. Toral led the ACC with 24 home runs in 2019.
- » Against James Madison, Toral hit three doubles, a grand slam and had nine RBI in his first three games for the Seminoles. Against Cal (3/4/22), Toral's two-run home run tied the game in the eighth inning before FSU won on a walk-off in the ninth.
- » Toral had a 2-R double and 3-R home run against Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22). He has both of FSU's 5 RBI games this season.
- » Toral reached safely in his first 17 games as a Seminole. He leads FSU with 7 home runs, 25 RBI and 16 walks. He is second with nine doubles.
- » Toral now has 44 career home runs, the seventh-most nationally among active players.
- » Third baseman Brett Roberts is one of seven Noles with at least three home runs and is hitting .255 through 28 games. He has nine extra base hits - five doubles, a triple and three home runs. Roberts' homered in his first AB as a Nole and again at Mercer (3/1/22).
- » In his first career game against Florida (3/29/22), Roberts had a hand in all three FSU runs - scoring the first two and plating Logan Lacey on a sacrifice fly. He singled twice and drew a walk.
- » Roberts had a 10-game hitting streak earlier this year, one of three Noles with a double-digit hitting streak (Ferrer 10, Lacey 13).
- » Roberts scored a career-high three runs against Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22), with a hit, two walks and a hit by pitch. He is second on the team with 15 walks.
- » He had a season-high three RBI against Duke (3/26/22), including his third homer of the season.
- » Roberts hit .331 in 62 career games at Tennessee Tech, including .343 over 204 at-bats in 2021. He hit 9 home runs and had 52 RBI at Tennessee Tech.
- » Shortstop Jordan Carrion missed opening weekend vs. James Madison, but has started at shortstop the past 25 games. He had a walk-off single in the 12th inning against Stetson (4/6/22), scoring Roberts from second base.
- » In his FSU debut at Jacksonville, Carrion had a hit, RBI, scored a run and stole a base. He had a career-high three hits against UCF (3/22/22).
- » Carrion spent his freshman season at Florida, hitting .244 over 37 games. On the mound, Carrion did not allow an earned run over seven appearances, with one save and eight strikeouts in 6.2 innings pitched.

## FRESHMEN STAND OUT EARLY

- » Three Florida State freshmen started on Opening Day, and all three have contributed early for the Seminoles.
- » DH Jaime Ferrer had the biggest hit of the season against NC State (3/20/22), a walk-off home run in the 17th inning to win the game and clinch the series.
- » Ferrer leads FSU with 36 hits, 11 HBPs and 10 doubles. He is second with 9 multi-hit games, batting average (.330) and home runs (5).
- » He has both of FSU's four-hit games this season (at Wake Forest and vs. NC State) while starting the first 28 games of his career.
- » At Wake Forest (3/13/22), three of his four hits were doubles.
- » Ferrer had a hit in his first 10 games as a Seminole, one of three Noles with a double-digit hitting streak this year. He had a 12-game streak of reaching base.
- » LF James Tibbs has made 21 starts and reached base in 20 of his 21 starts. He is one of three everyday players hitting over .300 (.305).
- » His walk-off single against Cal (3/4/22) set the tone for the weekend series as FSU won its third straight series to start the year.
- » Tibbs' first home run came on the first pitch he saw as a Seminole on Opening Day vs. James Madison. He added a 451-foot grand slam against FGCU (3/8/22) and a solo home run vs. Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22).
- » Treyton Rank has started 12 games this season (3 at SS, 7 at 2B, 2 in LF). He has a double, triple and four RBI and is a perfect 3-for-3 on the basepaths.

## LACEY TRUE UTILITY MAN

- » Tallahassee native Logan Lacey hit .417 with a three-run home run against James Madison while starting all three games in center field.
- » The senior has made 28 starts in CF, 3 in LF, 4 in RF and 47 at third base over three seasons at FSU.

## SEMINOLE BASEBALL TRADITIONS

### ANIMALS of SECTION B

- » Formed in 1977, the Animals of Section B are college baseball's most recognized fan group that support the Noles.
- » The name originated in 1978 when Sol Carroll, "FSU's No. 1 Fan", brought donuts to the section. After a while, the section threw the donuts at Sol, who in turn called the fans "Animals" and the name stuck.
- » When Seminole Field (now Dick Howser Stadium) opened in 1983, the Animals were located in Section B, thus the full name The Animals of Section B.
- » The Animals have a song and cheer book used to rattle opposing teams. They have a 'K' counter that racks up as FSU pitchers record strikeouts; they also have duck calls for when the bases are loaded (ducks on the pond), among a number of other recognizable traditions.

### O CANADA

- » The Canadian national anthem was first sung by the Animals of Section B in 1988 during the Calgary Winter Olympics.
- » On its origins: "It was just watching the Olympics every day and hearing the anthem every day. It was in their minds. [FSU] was losing and they thought, 'Hey. Let's hum the Canadian National Anthem.' And they won, and it's been a tradition ever since." - Shannon Thomas, Animals 'Zookeeper'.
- » The anthem now can be heard every home game before the Seminoles bat in the fifth inning.

### FLYING HIGH CIRCUS

- » Founded in 1947 by Jack Haskin, FSU's Flying High Circus is an extra-curricular activity under the Division of Student Affairs.
- » The Flying High Circus is located past the right field wall at Dick Howser Stadium.
- » Made up entirely of current Florida State students, it is primarily an aerial stage presentation with no animal acts.
- » Student performers rig all their own equipment, sew their own costumes, produce lights and sound for performances and set up the Big Top tent on campus.
- » A one-semester, one credit hour Introduction to Circus course is offered to students which includes the basics of juggling, walking the high wire, aerial ballet, and rigging.
- » The circus generates its own revenue with shows at Halloween and in April on campus and over the summer at Calloway Gardens in Georgia.

- » Lacey is hitting .288 with seven doubles, a triple and five home runs. His 22 RBI, 34 hits and five home runs are both second on the team, and he leads FSU in runs scored with 19.
- » Against Florida (3/29/22), Lacey set a season high and tied his career mark with three hits. He had another three-hit game against No. 16 Notre Dame (4/3/22).
- » At Wake Forest, Lacey hit .333 with two doubles and two RBI. Both doubles came in the series opener (3/11/22), the fourth time in his career he has had multiple doubles in a game.
- » Lacey scored a career-high three runs against Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22), with two hits, a walk and an RBI.
- » Against NC State, Lacey hit .357 (5-for-14) with two doubles, a three-run home run - his team-high fifth of the year - and four RBI. He was intentionally walked twice in FSU's 17-inning win in the series finale.
- » Against FGCU (3/8/22), Lacey hit his fourth home run of the season while starting his first game of the year at third base.
- » Lacey hit his third home run of the season against Cal (3/5/22), a 447-foot bomb off the scoreboard at Howser.
- » Lacey tallied the first triple of his career at Mercer (3/1/22).
- » Lacey is ranked No. 57 on D1Baseball's list of the nation's top outfielders entering the year.

### GREENE, MATHIS CONTRIBUTE

- » Catcher Brock Mathis transferred from Oklahoma State in January and is immediately making an impact for the Seminoles.
- » Mathis is hitting 11-for-35 over 16 games, with two doubles and four home runs. At Wake Forest, Mathis hit a home run in the ninth inning of game one; threw out a runner and had two hits in game two of the series; and was 1-for-4 with a run scored in FSU's 3-2 game three win.
- » Mathis hit a three-run home run against Bethune-Cookman (3/16/22), setting a season-high for RBI. He added a two-run homer against NC State (3/20/22) that extended his hitting streak to 8 games.
- » Jackson Greene has started 14 games at second base. He hit his fourth career home run - and first of the season - at Wake Forest (3/13/22), spurring FSU's 5-1 game two win. He hit 3-for-7 at Wake, with a walk and was hit by a pitch. He also had a sacrifice fly and led FSU on the weekend with three RBI.
- » He hit a pinch-hit, game-tying, two-run home run against Stetson (4/6/22) with two outs in the bottom of the ninth. FSU went on to win the game in 12 innings and snap a five-game losing streak, one shy of the school record.
- » Against Bethune-Cookman, Greene was 2-for-3 with two RBI.

- » Greene hit his fifth career home run - and first Dick Howser Stadium - against Duke (3/25/22). Greene is now hitting .291 on the season.
- » Greene drew a career-high three walks against NC State (3/19/22).

### OPENING WEEKEND v. JAMES MADISON

- » Jackson Nezuh earned his first career win vs. James Madison (2/20/22), throwing 1.2 innings in relief without allowing a run. Jonah Scolaro notched five outs to earn his 10th career save in the season opener (2/18/22).

### AAA34K

- » Pitching coach Jimmy Belanger stresses 'AAA34K' to his pitchers - any pitch, any time, anywhere, three pitches for strikes.
- » The philosophy helped FSU put together one of the top pitching staffs in the country.
- » Florida State leads the country with 371 strikeouts and is second nationally with 12.5 strikeouts per nine innings. The Seminoles 26 strikeouts against NC State (3/20/22) set a new school record, breaking the previous record of 25 that had stood since 1956.
- » All three weekend starters - Parker Messick, Bryce Hubbard and Ross Dunn - rank in the Top 35 nationally in strikeouts.

### SIMMONS FIGHTS BACK FROM CANCER

- » Pitcher Dylan Simmons was scheduled to enroll at FSU in summer 2019, but was diagnosed with Stage I lymphoma in late May of that year.
- » Instead of enrolling at FSU, Simmons stayed home in Jacksonville for chemotherapy and radiation treatments at the Mayo Clinic.
- » Simmons was declared 'cancer-free' in December and enrolled at FSU for the spring 2020 semester.
- » On Opening Night (February 14, 2020), it was just 260 days since Simmons first received his cancer diagnosis.
- » In 2022, Simmons has made seven pitching appearances, including a scoreless 1.0-inning outing at Jacksonville (2/22) and vs. Duke (3/27).

## MARTIN LEADS FSU AT THE PLATE

- » DH Tyler Martin made his first starts of the season against No. 16 Notre Dame (4/1-3/22) and had a hit in all three games. He had a double and two RBI against the Irish.
- » In 2021, Tyler Martin led FSU with a .445 on-base percentage, 46 walks and 14 HBPs.
- » Martin finished Top 10 in the ACC in runs (54), walks, OBP and HBP.
- » Martin played all 72 games between 2020-21 before missing the beginning of the 2022 season due to injury. He is hitting .285 with 76 hits, 15 extra-base hits and has drawn 66 walks while striking out just 35 times for his career.
- » Martin's first appearance in 2022 - a four-pitch walk as a pinch hitter vs. Cal (3/4/22). Martin was pinch-run for on the base paths before James Tibbs' walk-off single led FSU to a 4-3 win.
- » Martin is the son of head coach Mike Martin, Jr. and the grandson of legendary FSU coach Mike Martin.

## 'MEAT' 8-3 vs. RIVALS

- » Florida State head coach Mike Martin, Jr. is 8-3 against Florida, Miami and Clemson over his first two seasons.
- » In 2020, FSU beat No. 1 Florida 2-0, snapping FSU's 11-game losing streak in the series before the season was canceled.
- » In 2021, FSU beat No. 5 Florida and swept No. 6 Miami in the same week.
- » The Noles improved to 4-0 against Miami with a 6-3 win in the ACC Tournament (5/28).
- » FSU took 2-of-3 games against Clemson in Tallahassee late in the 2021 regular season.

## 43 STRAIGHT NCAA REGIONAL APPEARANCES

- » Florida State earned a postseason bid for the 43rd consecutive season in 2021. The Noles have played in 58 NCAA Tournaments, second-most ever.
- » FSU's 43-season streak is the second-longest consecutive streak in history, one behind Miami's 44-season run.
- » The Seminoles 58 all-time appearances trail only Texas for the most in the CWS-era (since 1947).

## RECRUITING PHILOSOPHY

- » Third-year head coach Mike Martin, Jr., along with assistants Mike Metcalf and Jimmy Belanger, have produced three straight Top 10 recruiting classes - No. 3 in 2019, No. 6 in 2020 and No. 7 in 2021.
- » Looking for players 'with an edge' that play hard, Metcalf, FSU's recruiting coordinator, says FSU is also interested in fast-paced athletes that shine in the classroom, in the community and on the field.
- » Martin, Jr. has also stressed the importance of mental health for his student-athletes and players regularly meet with clinical and sport psychologists.

## FIRST STARTS ON THE MOUND

- » Three Seminoles made their first career starts on the mound in 2021 - second-year player Parker Messick and freshmen Carson Montgomery and Ross Dunn.
- » Messick came out of FSU's bullpen in the shortened 2020 season. Montgomery was the nation's top prospect to reach campus before the 2021 season and is FSU's highest-rated recruit ever to make it to campus.
- » Dunn, from Salt Lake City, Utah, was originally committed to Kentucky and came to FSU when former Wildcats coach Jimmy Belanger became the Seminoles pitching coach.
- » Dunn is FSU's third player from the state of Utah (Alan Gentry and Ken Heath from Layton, mid-80s).
- » Bryce Hubbard was the only Seminole pitcher to make his first career start in 2020.
- » Messick, Hubbard, Dunn and Montgomery have started all 16 games in 2022 (4 each).

Mike Martin, Jr. enters 2022 in his third season as the Florida State head coach and his 25th season on the Seminole coaching staff. Despite dealing with COVID issues that disrupted his first two years, Martin is 60-40, winning 60 percent of his games and sporting an 8-3 record against rivals Miami, Florida and Clemson. After reaching the Oxford Regional in 2021, FSU's 43 consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament are one shy of the all-time record and by far the longest active streak in the country.

In 2021, Florida State finished 31-24 while boasting the Atlantic Coast Conference Player and Pitcher of the Year in Matheu Nelson and Parker Messick, respectively.

Nelson led the country with 23 home runs and was top 10 in slugging percentage, RBI and total bases. He was named the Perfect Game/Rawlings National Hitter of the Year and was the Buster Posey & Johnny Bench Award winner as the nation's best catcher. A unanimous first team All-American, Nelson was drafted with the 35th overall pick in the 2021 MLB Draft by the Cincinnati Reds. He was the second Seminole, and first since Jeff Ledbetter in 1982, to lead the country in home runs.

On the mound, Messick finished 8-2 with a 3.10 earned run average and 126 strikeouts in 90.0 innings. Also the ACC Freshman of the Year, Messick spearheaded a staff that ranked Top 10 nationally in strikeouts per nine innings (4th, 11.4), strikeout-to-walk ratio (7th, 3.19) and ERA (7th, 3.45). Messick was named a third-team All-American while teammate Bryce Hubbart, a third-team All-ACC selection with 94 strikeouts in 71.0 innings in 2021, also returns as the duo leads the FSU rotation in 2022.

Florida State swept the season series against Miami, winning all three games in Coral Gables and a fourth in the ACC Tournament in Charlotte.

Despite the MLB Draft getting reduced to 20 rounds (from a usual 40), the Seminoles had seven players selected, the most in the first 20 rounds for FSU since 1995. Along with Nelson, Robby Martin, Hunter Perdue, Jack Anderson, Elijah Cabell, Conor Grady and Tyler Ahearn were drafted and began their professional careers. After his first season, pitcher CJ Van Eyk was selected in the second round and Shane Drohan in the fifth round as the 2020 draft was reduced to just five rounds.

In his inaugural campaign, Martin and the Seminoles finished 12-5 and capped the year off with a 2-0 win at No. 1 Florida. The win snapped Florida's 11-game win streak in the series and was the Gators' only loss of the year.

Florida State has produced 11 consecutive recruiting classes ranked in the Top 10, including all three with Martin Jr. as head coach - No. 3 in 2019, No. 6 in 2020 and No. 7 by D1Baseball in 2021.

Martin was elevated to head coach on June 21, 2019, after 22 years as a Seminole assistant coach at his alma mater. Focusing on hitting and recruiting, his offenses had a combined .300 batting average in his tenure.

Martin has coached five players that were named National Player of the Year - Nelson, James Ramsey, Buster Posey, Tony Thomas and Shane Robinson. Since Martin joined the Seminole staff prior to the 1998 season, Florida State has 23 first team All-Americans, 93 total All-Americans and 34 players have reached the Major Leagues. In all, Seminoles have earned All-ACC honors 119 times and Martin oversaw 67 hitters get drafted between 1998 and 2019, with nine additional Seminoles drafted since becoming head coach.

Martin has two sons, Tyler, an infielder for the Seminoles, and T.J.
