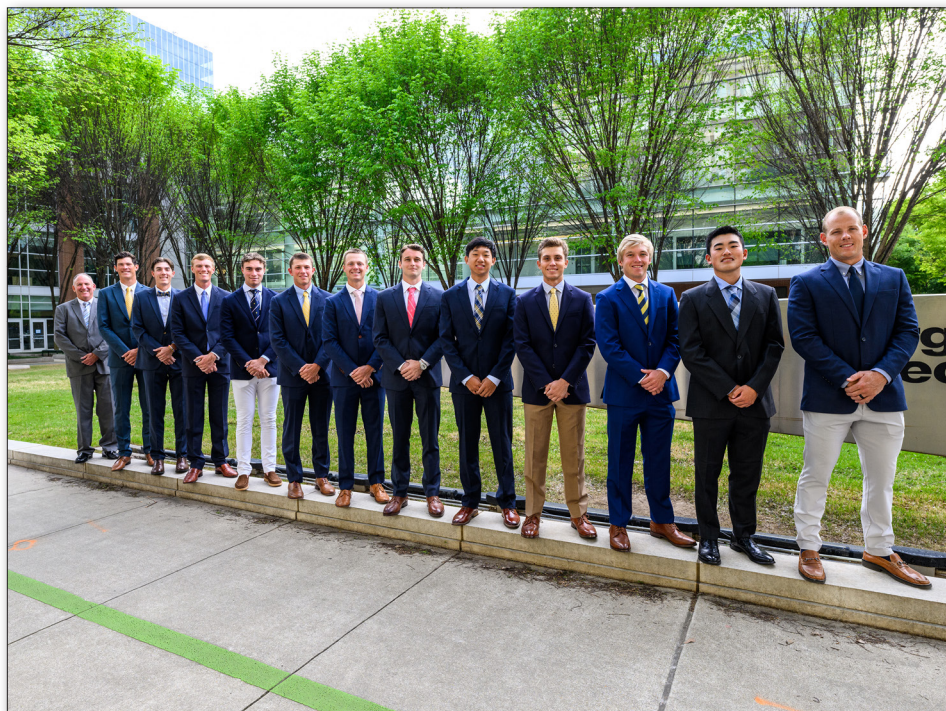

Tech Looks for 19th ACC Title

Going in search of the 19th championship on program history, Georgia Tech's golf team begins post-season competition this weekend with the 68th Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Golf Championship, which will be conducted Friday through Monday (April 22-25) at Shark's Tooth Golf Club in Panama City, Fla. The Yellow Jackets have captured 10 of the last 15 championships, most recently winning the 2019 title at the Old North State Club in New London, N.C. It was the 18th in program history, tying Wake Forest for the most in conference annals. The championship was not held in 2020 due to COVID-19. Tech finished fifth last year, the first ACC Championship played under the new stroke play/match play format. The Yellow Jackets fell one stroke shy of advancing to match play at the Capital City Club Crabapple Course in Milton, Ga.

At No. 11 in the current Golfstat national rankings, Georgia Tech sits behind North Carolina (No. 5) and ahead of Notre Dame (No. 13), Wake Forest (No. 17), Clemson (No. 23), Florida State (No. 24) and NC State (No. 25). Tech's four tournament wins this year lead the ACC, and the seven top-25 teams have combined for 16 tournament wins in what has been a very strong year for the conference. Louisville (No. 40) and Duke (No. 45) also reside among the top 50 teams in the nation. That's nine of the 12 teams that will be competing this weekend.

The Yellow Jackets are the No. 2 seed based on Golfstat rankings and will be paired with top-seeded North Carolina and third-seeded Notre Dame for the first two rounds on Friday, which begins at 7:30 a.m. The groups involving Tech, UNC and Notre Dame begin play at 8:30 a.m. on the first tee. Saturday's third round tees off at 9 a.m.

Clemson took the 2021 ACC Championship, outdueling North Carolina and Florida State in the match play tournament after finishing a distant second to the Tar Heels in 54 holes of stroke play. UNC freshman Peter Fountain was the individual medalist.

Tech's ACC Championship History

Georgia Tech has won 18 ACC men's golf championships, putting the Yellow Jackets in a tie with Wake Forest for the most titles in conference history. Tech's titles have all come from 1985 to the present. Wake Forest's most recent title came in 1989.

Tech has won the ACC Championship 10 times in the last 14 years, including the last two in a row. The Yellow Jackets won the 2019 championship with a tournament record score of 827 (37-under-par), breaking the previous mark of 831 (-33) set by the Jackets in 2011.

The 2020 ACC Tournament was not held after the 2020 spring season was cut short due to COVID-19.

Tech has won 13 of its conference titles under current head coach Bruce Heppler, 11 of those outright (1999, 2001, 2002, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019) and two shared (2006, 2007). The Yellow Jackets won five championships (1985, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994) under previous head coach Puggy Blackmon.

Twelve of Tech's ACC titles have been won at the Old North State Club in New London, N.C., site of the event 22 of the last 25 years. The first occurred in 1999 by 10 strokes over North Carolina and Duke. Tech won its 2018 crown without an individual finishing higher than 12th place.

Georgia Tech has produced 10 ACC individual champions, including Bob McDonnell (1985), David Duval (1991, 1993), Mikko Rantanen (1994), Bryce Molder (2000), Cameron Tringale (2006), Chesson Hadley (2010), Paul Haley (2011), Albertson (2013, 2015) and Ollie Schniederjans (2014). Albertson and Duval are among five ACC players.

How the Jackets Got Here

With four starters back from the 2021 squad that finished 15th at the NCAA Championship and adding two key contributors who have formed the core of the 2021-22 team, Georgia Tech has won four tournaments in nine outings this year. Tech won

the Maui Jim Intercollegiate and the Hamptons Intercollegiate in the fall, and added titles in the Watersound Invitational and The Calusa Cup this spring, elevating the Yellow Jackets to No. 11 in the Golfstat rankings and to No. 13 in the Golfweek/Sagarin Index.

Tech owns a 23-18 mark head-to-head against the nation's top 25 teams, according to Golfstat, and is 45-24-1 against teams in the top 50, according to the Golfweek/Sagarin Index. The Yellow Jackets rank among the nation's top 10 in a number of statistical categories, according to Golfstat — No. 1 in stroke average (70.81) and first-round stroke average (70.45), No. 8 in last-round stroke average (71.05), No. 4 in par-4 scoring average (4.03), No. 5 in par-5 scoring average (4.93), No. 5 in aggregate comparison to par (-0.57) and No. 9 in total birdies (469).

Each of the Jackets except Reuter and Smith have at least two top-10 finishes this year, and three Tech players are listed among Golfstat's top 75 players nationally. At No. 26, sophomore Christo Lamprecht (George, South Africa) holds the highest Golfstat ranking among the Yellow Jackets with five top-10 finishes this year following his tie for fourth at The Calusa Cup. Junior Bartley Forrester (Gainesville, Ga.), ranked No. 78, captured a share of medalist honors at The Calusa Cup and has finished no lower than 18th in Tech's last four events this spring. Junior Ross Steelman (Columbia, Mo.), like Forrester, has four top-10 finishes, two of them this spring, while junior Connor Howe (Ogden, Utah) has a pair of top-10 finishes in 2021-22.

All six Tech golfers who have played 21 rounds or more are averaging 72.19 strokes per round or better, led by Lamprecht's 69.89. Tech may also have one of the tallest teams in collegiate golf, with Lamprecht at 6-foot-8, Forrester and Steelman at 6-5 each, freshman Benjamin Reuter (Naarden, The Netherlands) at 6-3, Howe at 6-2 and senior Ben Smith (Novi, Mich.) at 6-1.

Lamprecht, Forrester and Howe have been a part of Georgia Tech's starting lineup for all nine tournaments in 2021-22 and will lead the Yellow Jackets in the ACC Championship along with Ross Steelman and either Ben Smith or Benjamin Reuter. Steelman missed one event, The Goodwin in late March, due to mononucleosis, but has been a part of the starting five for each of the other eight tournaments. Smith and Reuter have essentially split manning the No. 5 spot for most of the events this year. Reuter will play No. 5 for Tech on Friday, with Smith ready as a substitute if needed.

Tee Shots

- Tech may also have one of the tallest teams in collegiate golf, with Christo Lamprecht at 6-foot-8, Bartley Forrester and Ross Steelman at 6-5 each, freshman Benjamin Reuter at 6-3, Connor Howe at 6-2 and Ben Smith at 6-1.

- Only sixth-ranked Washington, with five tournament victories this year, has more wins than Georgia Tech's four. Vanderbilt and Arkansas are the only other college teams to win as many as four,

- Tech's No. 11 Golfstat ranking is its highest of the year, up from No. 20 at the end of the fall season.

- Tech has a 23-18 head-to-head record against teams ranked among the nation's top 25 this year, including a 1-1 mark against No. 5 North Carolina, 1-1 against No. 15 Notre Dame, 2-1 vs. No. 17 Wake Forest, 4-0 vs. No. 23 Clemson and 1-0 against No. 24 Florida State.

- According to the Golfweek/Sagarin ratings, Tech faced the 23rd-most difficult schedule in Division I -- Tech is 44-24-2 against the nation's top 50 teams, 81-24-4 against the top 100.

- Tech returns four starters who finished fifth in last year's ACC Championship, third in the NCAA Tallahassee Regional and 15th at the NCAA Championship, and all four will be in Panama City this weekend. The Yellow Jackets will start three juniors (Bartley Forrester, Connor Howe, Ross Steelman), one sophomore (Christo Lamprecht) and one freshman (Benjamin Reuter) Friday at the ACC Championship, with a senior, Ben Smith, available to substitute.

15 individual top-10 finishes, five by Lamprecht, four each by Forrester and Steelman and two by Howe.

- Lamorecht is Georgia Tech's highest ranked player in the Golfstat rankings at No. 26, and two others are in the top 100 - Forrester at No. 78 and Howe at No. 82.
- No Tech player was voted to the All-ACC team last year, only the third time since 1985.
- All five starters for Tech this weekend have stroke averages under 72, ranking from Lamprecht's 69.89 to Reuter's 71.86.
- Georgia Tech's collective average team score of 280.30 is more than seven strokes better than last year's team (287.38).
- Tech's average drop score this year is 75.41, bettered by only five other teams, according to Golfstat (No. 2 Oklahoma State 75.11, No. 3 Vanderbilt 74.70, No. 6 Washington 75.03, No. 13 Notre Dame 75.37, No. 15 Auburn, 74.47).

Tech's NCAA Championship History

Georgia Tech has reached the NCAA Championship finals 29 times since 1985 (30 times in program history), which is tied for fifth most in that time period behind Oklahoma State (35), Arizona State (33), Florida (32) and Texas (32). Tech has posted nine top-8 finishes in the last 15 tries.

The Yellow Jackets have qualified for match play four times since the advent of the stroke-play/match-play format in 2009, finishing third in 2010, second in 2011, second in 2013, fifth in 2014. Tech did not advance out of its regional in 2012, 2016, 2017 or 2018.

Tech lost to the eventual champion three times in its four appearances in match play - Augusta State by the score of 3-2 in the quarterfinals in 2010 and 2011 and to Alabama (3-0-2) in 2013.

Tech has been the runner-up in the NCAA Championship four times (1993, 2000, 2002 and 2005, all before the introduction of match play). Only Oklahoma State, which has 18, Texas (6) and Purdue (5) have more.

In 1993 and 2002, the Yellow Jackets led after 54 holes, but finished second by one shot to Florida in 1993, and by four shots to Minnesota in 2002.

In 2000, the Yellow Jackets rallied to tie Oklahoma State after 72 holes, but lost to the Cowboys on the first hole of a playoff. Tech and OSU matched the lowest 72-hole team score in NCAA Championship history (36-under-par 1,116) at the Grand National Lake Course in Opelika, Ala. In 2005, Tech finished 11 shots behind Georgia, and seven shots ahead of third-place Washington.

Since Bruce Heppler became Tech's coach, the Jackets have finished in the top eight 11 times.

Three Tech players have won national collegiate championships. Troy Matteson did it most recently in 2002 at Ohio State. Watts Gunn (1927) and Charlie Yates (1934) won national titles under a match play format before the NCAA took sponsorship of the championship in 1939.

Tech and NCAA Match Play

The 2009 NCAA Championship featured a new twist with the team champion determined via match play. The top eight teams after 54 holes of stroke play advance to a match play tournament format.

The NCAA added a fourth round of stroke play in 2016 for the top 15 teams and nine individuals not on those teams, after which the national individual champion and the top eight teams for match play will be determined.

Match play is a format that Bruce Heppler has supported vigorously. Under Heppler, Georgia Tech finished in the top eight of the NCAA Finals seven times in 10 tries under the 72-hole, stroke-play format. Tech is one of only two teams (Oklahoma State is the other) to have advanced to match play four times in the six years the current format has been in effect.

In the stroke-play/match play era, the Yellow Jackets have finished 10th, third, second, second and fifth, respectively, in the stroke-play portion the NCAA Championship in five tries (Tech

did not advance out of its regional in 2012 or 2016). Tech lost to the eventual national champion three of the four times it has qualified for match play (Augusta State in the 2010 and 2011 quarterfinals, Alabama in the 2013 semifinals).

Tech has had success in other match-play events in recent years, reaching the finals of the Callaway Collegiate Match Play Championship four times in six appearances.

Georgia Tech Match Play History

While match play in college golf may be infrequent, Georgia Tech is no stranger to it, having participated in 10 regular season match play events since 2000, as well as three times since the NCAA added match play to determine its champion. Here is a history of Tech's participation.

Tech in NCAA Regional Competition

Georgia Tech has advanced through an NCAA regional 25 times in 30 tries, and all but four times since the NCAA went to a six-regional qualifying format in 2009. Head coach Bruce Heppler's teams have won five regional tournaments outright, most recently in 2014, and tied for one other.

The NCAA began using regional qualifying tournaments in 1989, first with the 81 teams split among three sites (27 teams each), then among six sites with either 13 or 14 teams each beginning in 2009. Since the NCAA went to six regional sites in 2009, Tech has advanced to the championship finals seven times - third in 2009 (Bowling Green, Ky.), third in 2010 (Milton, Ga.), tied for third in 2011 (Radford, Va.), fourth in 2013 (Tallahassee, Fla.), first in 2015 (Raleigh, N.C.), fourth in 2019 (Pullman, Wash.) and third in 2021 (Tallahassee, Fla.). No NCAA championship events were held in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Tech's first four victories all occurred in 27-team regionals in 1991 (New Haven, Conn.), 1998 (Daufuskie Island, S.C.), 1999 (Providence, R.I.) and 2002 (Roswell, Ga., tied with Clemson). Only the 2014 win in Raleigh occurred in a 13-team field.

Tech Golf APR Perfect for 15 Straight Years

Bruce Heppler's golf program again earned a perfect four-year APR score of 1000 for the four-year period ending in the 2018-19 academic year in the NCAA's survey announced in May. The Yellow Jackets have earned a perfect four-year score every year since its inception in 2006, and has also received an APR Public Recognition Award every year. Among Power 5 conferences, Tech is one of two men's golf teams and 12 programs overall that have achieved the feat.

APR is an annual scorecard of academic achievement calculated for all Division I sports teams. It measures eligibility, graduation and retention each semester or academic term and provides a clear picture of the academic performance for each team in every sport.

Heppler ACC Coach of the Year 10 times

Georgia Tech Bruce Heppler has been named ACC Coach of the Year 10 times in his 25-year tenure on The Flats. That is the most for one coach in conference history.

Tech won the Atlantic Coast Championship in April for the 18th time, matching Wake Forest for the most in conference history. The Yellow Jackets have won six tournaments altogether, more than any other Division I team in 2018-19, bringing to 59 the total number of titles earned by the Jackets under Heppler. He has coached Tech to 13 of its 18 ACC titles.

Jackets to Add 3 for 2022-23

Georgia Tech's golf program signed three prospective student-athletes to letters-of-intent during the November signing period, a pair of top-100 junior players in **Hiroshi Tai** of Singapore by way of Windermere, Fla., and **Aidan Tran** of Fresno, Calif., as well as an Atlanta-area prospect in **Brady Rackley**.

Tai, who served a two-year stint in the Singapore navy following high school graduation, enrolled at Tech in January, while Tran and Rackley will join the program next fall.

Ranked as high as No. 45 in his high school graduation year of 2020, Tai enrolled at Georgia Tech in January following a two-year military service commitment to his home city-state of Singapore. Tai rose as high as No. 40 in the Junior Golf Scoreboard (No. 11 in his class), and No. 521 in the World Amateur Golf Ranking.

Ranked as high as No. 51 in the Class of 2022 according to the American Junior Golf Association, Tran comes to Georgia Tech with three victories and seven other top-10 finishes in AJGA events since 2018, including a 10-stroke victory in 2021 in the AJGA Junior at San Jose. He also earned a top-10 finish at the AJGA Ping An Bank Open Championship and reached the round of 32 at the California Amateur Championship after tying for 12th place in stroke play. He is ranked No. 22 in his class in the Golfweek/Sagarin Boys Index, and No. 43 by the Junior Golf Scoreboard.

A four-year varsity player, Rackley led The Lovett School to both state and region championships while finishing second as an individual in the state championship last spring (2021). In his 2020-21 season, Rackley had two tournament wins and 10 top 5 performances. He was awarded a spot on the 2021 all-State golf team and selected as the 2021 Bobby Jones award recipient for his success on and off the course.
