STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech plays its fifth game in 10 days, and wraps up this five-game road swing, meeting Belmont for the second time in a week on Sunday. The game will be broadcast on ESPN+. Fans can also TuneIn to hear Richard Musterer's call on the GT Gameday App.
- Georgia Tech extended its all-time advantage against Belmont to 3-0 in the first meeting between the teams in the Gulf Coast Showcase a week ago Sunday. Bianca Jackson scored a game-high 24 points to lift Georgia Tech to a 58-52 victory to close out the three-day tournament over the Thanksgiving holiday. Belmont hit seven three-pointers in the game, but was held to a 5-for-9 showing at the free throw line, while GT was 18-for-25.
- The Yellow Jackets will close out this five-game road swing on Sunday and return to McCamish Pavilion on Dec. 11 for its first home game in three weeks. Bianca Jackson has been a driving force in Tech's five-game swing, leading the Jackets offensively with a 15.5 points per game average through the four games thus far. Jackson has led Tech in the last two games with a pair of 20-plus point outings. With her performances over the last four games, Jackson has moved into the team lead in scoring, averaging 13.8 points per game.
- Georgia Tech has seen solid production from its freshmen to start the season. Tonie Morgan is third on the team in scoring, averaging 8.0 points per game. She recorded her personal-best in scoring with a team-high 17 points against South Florida in the Gulf Coast Showcase. Coming off the bench, freshman Kara Dunn is fourth on the team in scoring at 5.8 ppg. She dropped a season-high 13 points against Kennesaw State and put together a solid showing in the Gulf Coast Showcase, averaging 7.7 points and 5.0 rebounds per game.
- In keeping with the newcomer flair, sophomore Kayla Blackshear is leading the team in rebounding, averaging 5.4 per game. She recorded her first double-digit scoring total against KSU, posting 11 points to complete the trio of Jackets in double figures. Blackshear is currently fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 5.4 points per game.
- Experience has been shining through to open the season as transfers Cameron Swartz and Bianca Jackson have been leaders for the Yellow Jackets. Swartz has led the Jackets in scoring in four games and posted six games scoring in double-figures. Jackson has contributed six double-figure scoring games, including dropping a game-high 24 points in the win over Belmont on Nov. 27. On the season, Jackson and Swartz are leading Tech offensively, averaging 13.8 and 13.3 points per game, respectively.
- The Yellow Jackets capped last season making its 11th appearance in the NCAA Tournament, earning the No. 9 seed. Tech made consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the Yellow Jackets made six-straight appearances from 2007-2012.
- Tech finished the 2021-22 season with a 21-11 overall record and 11-7 Atlantic Coast Conference mark. The Jackets earned the No. 6 seed in the ACC Tournament and faced Wake Forest in the second round, gutting out a 45-40 win despite playing without first-team all-conference performer Lorela Cubaj for nearly three quarters. The win pushed Tech into the quarterfinals for the 33rd time in program history.

ACC/BIG TEN CHALLENGE

Closing out the ACC/Big Ten Challenge with the 15th installment, Georgia Tech ended the series on a high note with a win at Michigan State. The win was the first on the road in the Challenge since 2009 for the Yellow Jackets, who finished the Challenge with a 9-6 record. In the Challenge, GT has secured wins over Michigan State (A-2022), Wisconsin (H-2019), Purdue (H-2017), Illinois (H-2013), Nebraska (H-2011), Northwestern (H-2010), Penn State (2009), Michigan State (H-2008) and Iowa (2007).

The ACC won the 2022 edition of the Challenge, marking the 11th ACC/Big Ten Challenge win and moved its all-time advantage in the series to 11-1-3. Collectively, the ACC finished with a 112-80 record against the Big Ten in the Challenge.

On Nov. 29, the ACC, Southeastern Conference and ESPN announced the formation of the ACC/SEC Challenge for men's and women's basketball, scheduled to begin as part of the 2023-24 season. Each of the 28 games (30 starting in 2025-26) will be carried on an ESPN platform.

GULF COAST SHOWCASE BREAKOUT

Freshman Tonie Morgan put together a pair of impressive performances in the first two games of the Gulf Coast Showcase. The Tallahassee, Fla., native led Tech offensively (vs. USF, vs. Air Force), producing back-to-back double-figure scoring performances to average 15.5 points per game. Morgan also led Tech on the glass in both games for a team-best 8.0 rebounds per game average and assists, totaling nine (4.5 assists per game average). In the three games, Morgan averaged 11.7 points, 6.7 rebounds and 26.1 minutes per game, while accumulating a team-high 10 assists. On the season, Morgan is third on the team in scoring, averaging 8.0 ppg, while leading the team in assists (19).

Bianca Jackson led Georgia Tech in the three-game tournament, averaging a team-best 13.3 points per game. She dropped a season-high 24 points against Belmont in the final game, helping the Jackets overcome a five-point deficit late in the ballgame to secure the win. One point shy of matching her career-high in scoring, Jackson finished the tournament shooting 87.5 percent (7-8) from the free throw line and 41.7 percent from the field.

SCORELESS FROM THREE

Georgia Tech held the Lady Bulldogs of Georgia scoreless from three-point distance on Nov. 20. Georgia went 0-for-7 from long range, marking the first opponent this season held without a three-pointer.

The Yellow Jackets have held at least one opponent a season without a three-pointer in the Nell Fortner Era. The last time dates back to last season against Kennesaw State (11/11/21), which went 0-for-6. In 2020-21 season, Tulane (12/3/20) was held scoreless from three-point range (0-11) and in 2019-20, Notre Dame (2/2/20) went without a three-pointer (0-7).

STIFLING DEFENSE

Nell Fortner teams have become known for their stifling defense, and this squad is no different. In Georgia Tech's first three games of the season (Georgia State, Kennesaw State and Auburn), they held every opponent to under 30.0 percent shooting. Georgia was the first program to shoot over 30.0 percent, marking the best field goal percentage to date by an opponent, connecting on 45.2 percent (28-62) from the field. Through eight games, Georgia Tech has held five opponents to under 35 percent shooting.

Through Dec. 1 games, Georgia Tech ranks 11th nationally in field goal percentage defense at 33.0 percent. South Carolina currently leads the nation in that statistical category, holding opponents to 27.3 percent. In the ACC, Duke leads the conference at 31.6 percent and sits sixth overall in the nation (GT is third in the ACC).

In result of its defense, the Yellow Jackets also rank 30th nationally in scoring defense, having held five of its opponents 52 points

or less (Georgia scored 66 to mark the most). The Jackets rank third in the ACC in scoring defense behind Virginia Tech (46.1) and Duke (50.8).

In the Nell Fortner era at Georgia Tech (since 2019-20), the lowest field goal percentage an opponent was held to was 16.7 percent (9-54) by Georgia State on Nov. 20, 2019. The highest field goal percentage by an opponent is 56.4 percent (31-55) by South Carolina in the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 on March 28, 2021.

REBOUNDING GAME

Through Tech's first eight games, the Yellow Jackets have averaged 39.5 rebounds per game, paced by Kayla Blackshear at 5.4 rebounds per game. Tech won the rebounding battle in its first two games against Georgia State and Kennesaw State, but dropped the battle in back-to-back-to-back games at Auburn (51-39), against Georgia (47-24), and vs. South Florida (50-34). Tech pulled out the win despite losing the battle on the glass at Auburn thanks to its defense and holding Auburn to a low shooting efficiency. Tech snapped a three-game skid losing the battle on the glass against Air Force, winning the rebounding game, 45-23.

Auburn proved heavy on the boards and finished with 29 offensive rebounds, converting for 22 second chance points. With its 29 offensive boards, the Tigers were able to attempt 26 shots. The 29 offensive rebounds marked the most by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era at GT. The previous high was 19 twice - at Clemson (1/7/21) and at Florida State (2/18/21).

The last time an opponent secured 29 offensive rebounds or more dates back to Tech's game at Tennessee on Nov. 17, 2013 when the Lady Vols recorded 33 offensive boards. Tennessee finished with 32 defensive rebounds for a total of 65 boards and took the game, 87-76. Since the 2013-14 season, Georgia Tech has allowed opponents to pull down 20 or more offensive rebounds 18 times.

HOW MANY ATTEMPTS?

In Georgia Tech's game at Auburn on Nov. 16, the Tigers recorded 76 field goal attempts, marking the most field goal attempts by an opponent in the Nell Fortner era (since 2019-20). In her four seasons, only two teams have attempted 70 or more field goals, the other being Notre Dame (70) last season on Feb. 17, 2022.

While Auburn attempted 76 field goals, they were held to a mere 26.3 percent (20-76) efficiency thanks to Georgia Tech's defense.

ATL'S TEAM

Georgia Tech captured a 60-42 win over Georgia State on Nov. 10 to open the 2022-23 season led by Cameron Swartz with 19 points and Bianca Jackson with 18 points. The Yellow Jackets shot 87.5 percent (21-24) from the free throw line and dominated on the glass, 50-30, led by Kayla Blackshear and Tonie Morgan with eight rebounds each.

Georgia Tech limited the Panthers to single digits in both the first and second quarters to gain a comfortable halftime lead. GSU outscored Tech, 20-14, in the third frame to rally, but it wasn't enough to overcome the Jackets.

Six Yellow Jackets made their White and Gold debuts on Thursday. Tech's starting lineup featured four new faces to Georgia Tech, while leading returning rebounder and scorer, Nerea Hermosa, held down the recognizable returners.

The Yellow Jackets followed that performance with a victory over Kennesaw State, keeping with the local flair. A trio of Jackets finished in double-figures led by Swartz (14), Kara

Kennesaw State was limited to single offensive scoring totals in three of four quarters and were held to a 28.1 percent shooting efficiency. No Owls finished the game in double-digits.

APPROACHING A MILESTONE

Georgia Tech's Nerea Hermosa is closing in on a prestigious career milestone, the 1,000 career points club. Currently, Hermosa owns 782 career points in three seasons, needing just 218 points to become the 34th player in Georgia Tech women's basketball history to hit 1,000 career points.

Last season, the Yellow Jackets lauded two players into the club - Lotta-Maj Lahtinen and Lorela Cubaj.

Also closing in on the prestigious club is fifth-year transfer Bianca Jackson. Sitting at 942 career points between South Carolina, Florida State and Georgia Tech, Jackson seeks just 58 points to hit the milestone.

NEW FACES

The Yellow Jackets feature a lot of new faces this season, and fans got their first official look at the squad on Nov. 10. The Yellow Jackets started four new players against Georgia State with four returners also coming off the bench. Tech's newcomers accounted for 71.4 percent of the minutes in the season-opener. A total of 11 Yellow Jackets saw game action against Georgia State.

FINAL TUNEUP

The Yellow Jackets hosted Clayton State in its final preseason tune-up on Nov. 3 in an exhibition contest, squeaking out a 69-62 win. Tech was led offensively by Cameron Swartz

(12) and Kara Dunn (11), while Eylla Love led the Jackets on the boards with 12. The Jackets got off to a strong shooting start, connecting on 53.3 percent from the field in the first quarter before hitting 39.1 percent over the final three quarters. Tech also struggled from the free throw line, hitting 50.0 percent (12-for-24) led by Avyonce Carter's 4-for-4 effort. Both teams were hindered by turnovers with Tech committing 25 to Clayton State's 24. The Lakers shot 40.9 percent from the field.

ACC PREDICTIONS

Georgia Tech was picked to finish eighth in the preseason Atlantic Coast Conference poll, as picked by the Blue Ribbon Panel. The Yellow Jackets finished sixth in the league last season and advanced to their second consecutive NCAA Tournament.

However, Tech lost three of its starters to graduation and eligibility, including its leading rebounder (Lorela Cubaj - 11.1 rpg) and scorer (Lotta-Maj Lahtinen - 10.9 ppg). Cubaj, who averaged a double-double behind 10.0 ppg, led the ACC in rebounding. Cubaj finished ninth in the nation in rebounds and 16th in rebounds per game.

ANN MEYERS DRYSDALE WATCH LIST

Georgia Tech fifth-year transfer, Cameron Swartz was one of 20 shooting guards named to the watch list. The reigning ACC Most Improved Player, Swartz transferred to Georgia Tech for her fifth year of eligibility after leading Boston College in scoring last season, averaging 16.1 points per game. The local native ranked sixth overall in the ACC in scoring and earned an all-ACC first team nod.

Swartz was one of five players from the ACC on the list, joining Celeste Taylor (Duke), Hailey Van Lith (Louisville), Jakia Brown-Turner (NC State), and Ashley Owusu (Virginia Tech).

HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech hit the transfer portal over the summer and welcomed two transfers to The Flats for their fifth seasons of eligibility. Joining the 2022-23 roster are Bianca Jackson (Florida State) and Cameron Swartz (Marietta, Ga.)

Jackson - A native of Montgomery, Ala., Jackson played the last two seasons at Florida State, helping the Seminoles to a pair of NCAA Tournament appearances. At FSU, she appeared in 45 contests, starting 26 and averaged 9.8 points per game in two years. Last season, she finished third on the team in scoring, posting 6.7 ppg, switching to a shooting guard. Her first season with the Seminoles, Jackson averaged a team-best 14.1 ppg as a redshirt-junior. She played her first two seasons at South Carolina (2017-19) before transferring to Florida State. Jackson played in 57 games in two seasons, helping the Gamecocks reach the NCAA Tournament Sweet 16 in 2019. She was named SEC All-Freshman Team in 2017-18.

Swartz - A three-year starter at Boston College (2019-22), Swartz averaged 12.9 points per game over her career as an Eagle. She played in 82 games, starting 71. Swartz started all 33 games her senior season, earned all-ACC first team recognition and was named ACC Most Improved Player. She averaged a team-high 16.1 points per game, led the team in three-pointers (60) and three-point percentage (35.5 percent). Swartz led the ACC in scoring in conference play and finished sixth overall. Last season, she increased her scoring average by 6.5 points, rebounding by 1.2, field goal percentage by plus-four percent and 3-point field goal percentage by over 10 percent from her junior season. Swartz played her freshman season at Colorado, taking the floor in seven games.

Also arriving from the transfer portal, Kayla Blackshear was a mid-year transfer from Alabama, joining the team in January. Blackshear appeared in the Crimson Tide's first three games of the 2021-22 season, averaging 10.2 minutes per game off the bench. Blackshear contributed 5.0 points and 3.0 rebounds per game in the first three games.

BIG SHOES TO FILL

Georgia Tech will have some big shoes to fill this season, having lost three of its starters from last season, including its leading scorer and rebounder. The Yellow Jackets lost All-American starters Lorela Cubaj and Lotta-Maj Lahtinen, who led the team in rebounding (11.1 rpg) and scoring (10.9 ppg), respectively. Cubaj, an honorable mention all-American last season, was the Georgia College Player of the Year for the second straight year and was selected No. 18 overall in the WNBA Draft. Cubaj finished the season as the ACC's leading rebounder by nearly two rebounds per game above Elizabeth Kitley (VT) in second place.

The Yellow Jackets return two starters from last year's squad - center Nerea Hermosa and guard/forward Eylla Love. Two of the top four scorers from last season, Hermosa averaged 10.6 ppg to Love's 10.5 ppg. They accounted for 34.6 percent of the team's offense last year. Hermosa also returns as the team's leading rebounder, having finished second on the team, securing 5.6 rebounds per game on average.

GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech has made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Last season's appearance marked the 11th in the Big Dance. The Jackets fell to Kansas in the first round, traveling to Palo Alto, Calif., for the contest.

ACC WINS

Nell Fortner has guided Georgia Tech to three-straight seasons of double-digit ACC wins, marking the first time in program history for such a feat.

Prior to Fortner's arrival, Georgia Tech had posted double-digit ACC wins just once, going 12-4 in 2011-12. Tech's outright third-place finish in 2021 marked the best overall finish in program history as the Jackets tied for third in 2012.

WHAT RETURNS

Georgia Tech returns two of its top three scorers from last season, and 41.2 percent of its scoring overall. Nerea Hermosa comes back as the team's leading returning scorer after averaging 10.6 points per game as a junior. Eyllia Love scored one point less than Hermosa and averaged 10.5 ppg to rank third overall on the team. Tech had four players last season average 10.0 points per game or higher, led by Lotta-Maj Lahtinen at 10.9 ppg.

On the glass, Georgia Tech has big shoes to fill after losing its leading rebounder in Lorela Cubaj (11.1 rebounds per game). The Jackets return 34.8 percent of its rebounding this season, paced by Hermosa who averaged 5.6 rpg last season. Hermosa was the team's second leading rebounder after Cubaj as the Jackets have lost two of its top three rebounders (Digna Strautmene - 5.3 rpg).

WHAT'S NEW?

The Yellow Jackets will look quite a bit different this season, welcoming seven newcomers (three transfers plus four freshmen).

The Yellow Jackets will also have some holiday fun, participating in the Gulf Coast Showcase in Estero, Fla., over Thanksgiving week. Tech will face South Florida in the first game followed by either Air Force or Michigan in its second game. Tech has the potential to face Baylor, Belmont, Saint Louis or Villanova in the final game. The tournament will be played at Hertz Arena and streamed on FloHoops.

HOME SWEET HOME

All time, the Yellow Jackets are 403-224 (.620) when playing at home. The Jackets have won the last nine-consecutive home openers dating back to the 2012-13 season. Last season, Tech defeated Kennesaw State in its home opener, 72-45.

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 369-220 (.625) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue – 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn – 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 12 seasons of experience as a head coach – one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and four at Georgia Tech (2019-22) – and has compiled a 226-150 (.598) overall record in the college ranks.
