#### **TOP STORYLINES**

- Georgia Tech baseball looks to continue their hot start to the 2023 campaign when they travel south to in-state foe Georgia Southern on Feb. 21.
- Georgia Southern is one of Tech's most common opponents, having played 136 times since 1947. Tech owns a 104-32 advantage over the Eagles.
- Tech has won 12 of the last 13 matchups dating back to 2014.
- A revamped Yellow Jackets club is looking to replace the No. 1 offense in the country last season, and is bolstered by the No. 3-ranked recruiting class.
- Opening weekend did not disappoint for the bats as Tech hit .308 with 17 extra-base hits and five home runs.
- **Jake DeLeo** earned National Player of the Week honors for hitting .417 with three home runs on the weekend.

- **John Giesler** led the way, however, hitting .556 with five hits, two doubles and one triple.
- Stephen Reid also hit .417 with two home runs.
- After a tough Friday night pitching game with cold temperatures and 20 mph gusts, Tech pitching reset and issued just two walks the rest of the weekend -- none by either starter.
- Logan McGuire went 5.0 innings on Saturday with six strikeouts and just two runs allowed like **Jackson** Finley went 5.0, allowed just one run and two hits with three strikeouts.
- Luke Schmolke will make his first start of his freshman campaign with the Jackets, making one appearance over the weekend for Tech and not allowing a hit in 1.1 innings.
- The 6-foot righty was rated the No. 6 RHP out of North Carolina and No. 12 North Carolinian overall in the class.

#### IT STARTS AT HOME...

- "It Starts at Home" has been the offseason motto for Georgia Tech, putting an emphasis on getting victories at Mac Nease Baseball Park at Russ Chandler Stadium after going 26-11 in 2019.
- Since 1985, Tech has won a whopping .755 percent of its games at home (988-321-1).
- Tech was excellent at home in 2022, recording a 22-9 record at Mac Nease Baseball Park at Russ Chandler Stadium.
- $\bullet$  Since 2002, Tech has only hit below .300 at home in two full season 2017 and 2021.
- In 2022, Tech hit a gaudy .349 at home.

#### **OPENING DAYS**

- Georgia Tech has experienced significant success when opening the season at home.
- The Yellow Jackets are an impressive 28-1 in home openers on The Flats, since 1994 when skipper Danny Hall arrived.
- Tech has also won 17-straight home openers at Mac Nease Baseball Park at Russ Chandler Stadium.

#### **OFFENSE**

- Georgia Tech baseball will look to revamp its offense after losing its top five hitters to the MLB Draft last season.
- Tech's offense last year was one for the ages as it topped the charts in multiple categories.

- Tech's runs per game were its most since 2001 and its average was its highest since 2005.
- Tech's slugging and home run totals were both the third bests in program history.
- Despite losing a bunch of its top hitters, the Jackets will still return power and experience at the plate.
- **Stephen Reid** returns in right field after hitting .333 for 16 home runs and 63 RBI last season.
- **Drew Compton** started all 60 games at third base last year and hit .275 for 14 home runs and 58 RBI -- a down year for him.
- **Jadyn Jackson** was red-hot at the plate in the fall after hitting .252 last year. Jackson entered late to shore up the middle infield defensively, starting the final 28 games.
- **Jake DeLeo** will look to have his first fully healthy year in a while after being limited to just 30 games last season. Despite limited action, he hit .286 for 19 RBI and two home runs.
- **John Giesler** stands to be a front-runner to be in the starting lineup at first base after hitting .323 in 22 games last season.
- Jack Rubenstein will be Tech's veteran catcher after Kevin Parada was drafted 11th overall by the New York Mets.
- Rubenstein mashed .333 for 15 hits in 27 games and 10 starts last season.
- Transfer **Angelo Dispigna** will play in the outfield for Tech after hitting .266 with 14 doubles and a team-high 15 home runs for Mercer last season.
- Through just three games and one series, Tech hit .308 with 17 extra-base hits as multiple players stepped up for the offense.
- Tech also set the program record for most triples in a single game on Feb. 17 vs. Miami (Ohio) with four.

### INFIELDERS

- Georgia Tech baseball will look for its middle infield to be just as potent offensively (losing the NCAA-leader Chandler Simpson) and be as dynamic defensively in 2023.
- Up to the task will **Jadyn Jackson** and **Kristian Campbell**.
- Recruited as a top-10 shortstop out of the state of Georgia, Jackson was a constant in the Tech dugout before getting his chance to start against Virginia last season.

- He started the final 28 games of the season and made his name on terrific plays at the shortstop position.
- Jackson's defensive prowess last year has earned him a spot in the starting lineup at shortstop, making a circus SportsCenter top-10 play at UVA to save the game.
- Rated as the No. 5 shortstop and No. 10 player overall in the state of Georgia out of high school, Campbell redshirted last season and will vie for a starting job in the middle infield
- Having a terrific fall, Campbell was listed as the breakout player to watch by *D1Baseball*.
- Campbell went 1-for-1 in his first collegiate game on Feb. 17 but suffered an injury and is considered day-to-day.
- In his stead at second base has been **Nicholas Romano**, who was exceptional, hitting .300 (3-for-10) with a double and three RBI.
- As for the corners, Georgia Tech will look to steady veterans in **Drew Compton** at third and **John Giesler** at first.
- Rated as the No. 16 third baseman in the country by D1Baseball, Compton will look to bounce back from a "down" year.
- Compton hit .231 opening weekend with a double and two triples on Friday (tying his triple total from all of last year).
- Compton suffered a hamstring injury on the double on Sunday and is day-to-day.
- Compton started all 60 games at third base last year and hit .275 for 14 home runs and 58 RBI -- a down year for him
- . Compton is a career .288 hitter with 30 home runs.
- Compton's ability at the plate was evident from the very get-go when he became just the third Yellow Jacket since 2015 to homer in his very first collegiate plate appearance.
- Teammate **Nicholas Romano** joined the list in 2022, when he pinch hit and launched a homer himself.

- Compton really showed his potential in the 2021 NCAA Tournament, mashing four home runs in the Nashville Regional.
- Compton was the first Yellow Jacket to have four or more home runs in a NCAA Tournament since Matt Wieters had five in 2006 (three in Regionals, one in Super, one in the College World Series).

#### **OFFENSI**

- Giesler has been a mainstay leader in the dugout for Tech and will look to get his first consistent action in the starting lineup this season at first.
- Giesler led Tech's offense Opening Weekend, hitting
   556 (5-for-9) with two doubles, a triple and five RBI to slug
   1.000 and reach base at a .714 clip with only one strikeout.
- In 22 games last season, Giesler took advantage, hitting .323 for 10 hits, one double and a home run for eight RBI. He reached base at a .450 clip.
- First base is a loaded position for Georgia Tech, also featuring **Jackson Finley**, **Angelo Dispigna** and **Carsten Sabathia** on the depth chart.

#### **OUTFIELDERS**

- Georgia Tech will debut a new-look outfield when compared to last year's opening day lineup.
- The lone returner will be veteran Jake DeLeo, who shifts over and will play centerfield.
- DeLeo blasted into 2023 by earning National Player of the Week honors after just the first weekend of play.
- DeLeo hit .417 with five hits, a double and a team-best three home runs (two on Sunday) against Miami (Ohio).
- He accounted for 12 of Tech's 36 runs as he drove in six and crossed the plate six times himself.
- DeLeo suffered an oblique injury last year and was limited to just 30 games.
- Despite limitation, DeLeo still hit .386 for 22 hits, two home runs and 19 RBI, scoring 19 times as well.
- DeLeo entered in a big spot against then-No. 7 Louisville in the 2022 ACC Tournament, crushing a double to clear the bases and secure the win for Tech.
- In 2021, DeLeo became the first Yellow Jacket since Wade Bailey in 2017 to record five hits when he went a perfect 5-for-5 in the rubber match at then-No. 12 Virginia Tech.
- Starting the final 51 games of the season in right field was slugger **Stephen Reid**.
- Through three games, Reid has continued his hot hitting, currently at .417 with five hits, a triple and two home runs.
- Reid was red-hot last year, hitting .333 for 72 hits, eight doubles and 16 home runs for 63 RBI.
- Reid's power at the plate was on full display against Kennesaw State last season, hitting two home runs, one a grand slam, for six RBI.
- Reid also smashed two homers out against Mercer last year, including the go-ahead two-run bomb in the fourth.
- Entering the outfield rotation will be Mercer transfer **Angelo Dispigna**.
- In his first weekend of action for Georgia Tech, Dispigna hit .333 with three hits and two doubles.

- At Mercer, Dispigna hit .266 with 14 doubles and a teamhigh 15 home runs last season.
- Georgia Tech's designated hitter spot in the lineup may be one of the hottest competitions on the team and in the ACC.
- Nicholas Romano, who hit .292 could be a candidate, as well as two-way athletes **Jackson Finley** and freshman **Riley Stanford** -- all capable of tremendous power.
- Also a possible option is freshman Carsten Sabathia.
- A first-baseman by trade, Sabathia stands as an intimidating presence in the box at 6-4, 240 pounds with a lot of power in his young bat.
- He is the son of MLB great C.C. Sabathia.

#### PITCHING

- Georgia Tech has stockpiled depth in its pitching staff thanks to two-straight classes flush with power arms.
- Despite being younger, Tech returns Josiah Siegel, Dalton Smith, Cody Carwile, Camron Hill, Logan McGuire, Aeden Finateri, Joseph Mannelly, and Dawson Brown.
- It also regains the full services of **Ben King** and **Jackson Finley**.
- Georgia Tech's starting lineup for Opening Week will be Brown on Friday, McGuire on Saturday and Finley on Sunday.
- In a blustering night of 40 degree temps and 20 mph winds, Brown struggled in his first start, going just 2.2 innings and allowing five runs, walking an uncharacteristic five batters while striking out six.
- McGuire responded and was outstanding, going 5.0 innings on Saturday and punching out six and walking none, while allowing just two runs on four hits (both solo homers).
- Finley continued the dominance on Sunday and went another 5.0 innings, allowing just one run on just two hits, walking none and striking out three.
- Tech will look to find a consistent core of starting pitchers after looking to 11 different arms overall to start on the mound in 2022.
- Tech's top returning ERA leader is Siegel, who finished with a 3.97 ERA, 2-0 record and .266 opponents batting average.
- Siegel turned in a Herculean effort in last year's Knoxville Regional, pitching career long 6.1 innings and 98 pitches in relief and allowing just three hits and one run against Campbell, saving the bullpen for the showdown against No.
   1 Tennessee.
- Smith finished last season with a 2-0 record and 4.35 ERA despite just eight appearances due to injury and will look to be a bigger presence in the bullpen in 2023.
- Brown was one of Tech's main closer last season, finishing with a team-high five saves, despite a 8.77 ERA.
- In 2021, Brown featured a 2-0 record and 4.40 ERA, but has yet to be a full-time starter for the Jackets.
- Dawson is son of Georgia Tech Hall of Famer and six-time all-star and two-time ERA title winner Kevin Brown. Kevin helped the Marlins to the 1995 World Series before signing the first \$100 million contact with the LA Dodgers in 1998.
- Carwile returns after sporting a 5.68 ERA last season in his frosh campaign, holding opponents to a .231 average.
- Carwile was up and down in his first two career starts of his career, allowing just two earned runs across 4.0 innings against NC State before getting taken for four runs in 1.2 innings at then-No. 2 Virginia.
- Another strong freshman for Tech last year was McGuire, who snagged a 4-2 record despite a 7.02 ERA.
- McGuire is known for his pounding the zone, finishing with a 36:4 strikeout-to-walk ratio last season.

- McGuire made four starts last season, highest of any returning arms.
- Finley returns to the mound after fully recovering from Tommy John Surgery two seasons ago.
- He wound up pitching four innings late but has not seen consistent action since his freshman season.
- Finley's start on Sunday will be the first of his career at Georgia Tech.
- Hill finished last season with a 6.57 ERA in 18 appearances and one start last season, earning one save in his freshman campaign.
- Was named a New England League All-Star after being the Martha's Vineyard Sharks' closer, sporting a 0.52 ERA with a 16.41 strikeouts per 9 inning.
- Newcomers to watch will be freshmen Riley Stanford, Luke Schmolke, Noah Samol, and transfers Terry Busse and Jackson Vaughan.
- Stanford enters as the No. 9-ranked outfielder nationally in the class of 2022, throwing in the upper-90s on the mound as a two-way player.
- Schmolke, who is competing for a midweek starting position, was the No. 6-ranked right-hander out of North Carolina and a top-60 arm nationally, throwing mid-90s with a complete arsenal.
- Samol joins Tech as the top-ranked lefty from the state of Ohio and a top-35 arm nationally, standing a whopping 6-7 on the mound.
- Busse transfered to The Flats from John A. Logan junior college, where he made 22 appearances out of the bullpen to help them win a regional.
- Busse earned two saves in 27.1 innings, striking out 44 batters to the tune of an ERA of 3.29.
- Vaughan joined the Jackets after two years at the University of Pacific.
- Vaughan sported a team-leading 3.27 ERA in 2022, striking out 32 in 33 innings.
