#### TWIBB NOTES (This Week In Bulldog Baseball)

◆ Follow The Bulldogs: Georgia (6-2) starts a stretch Friday of five games in five different parks as the Bulldogs face rivals Georgia Tech and Georgia Southern. Georgia plays host to #16 Tech (9-0) Friday at Foley Field at 6 p.m. Saturday's contest will take place on Tech's campus at 2 p.m. Sunday's action will begin at 3 p.m. at Coolray Field, home of the Gwinnett Stripers, the Triple-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves. Sunday's game is the 20th annual Spring Baseball Classic to benefit Children's Healthcare of Atlanta. After the Tech series, Georgia heads to N. Augusta, S.C., to begin a two-game set with Georgia Southern (5-3). Tuesday's contest will be at SRP Park, home of the Augusta Green-Jackets. The Bulldogs will be the home team and first pitch will be at 6:35 p.m. Wednesday's game will be in Statesboro, home of the Eagles.

◆ Series History: In records dating back to 1898, Georgia leads the all-time series with Tech 216-168-2. Tech won both campus meetings last year (7-0 in Athens, 11-7 in Atlanta) and then Georgia snapped a four-game losing streak in the series with a 12-3 win at Coolray. The Bulldogs swept the 2020 series. In the Spring Baseball Classic, Georgia holds a 13-6 edge including 2-0 at Coolray Field.

◆ Swinging It: Through eight games, Georgia has been smashing the baseball, tallying a .330 batting average with 21 doubles, 17 home runs and a .601 slugging percentage. Redshirt-freshman Charlie Condon has put a jolt in the lineup, batting a team-best .556-2-15. Juniors Parks Harber and Corey Collins have four homers apiece. On the mound, the Bulldogs have a 5.27 ERA while the club is fielding .971. The probable weekend rotation will be juniors LHPs Jaden Woods (1-0, 5.40 ERA) and Liam Sullivan (1-0, 0.00 ERA) plus senior RHP Nolan Crisp (1-0, 3.68 ERA).

◆ Coach/Player Connections: Georgia's Ike Cousins head baseball coach Scott Stricklin lettered as a catcher at Kent State under Danny Hall from 1991-93, earning All-Mid-American Conference honors. Following five seasons of professional baseball, Stricklin served as a volunteer coach for Hall at Tech in 1998 and 1999 and then returned as an assistant from 2002-04. He became the head coach at Kent State from 2005-13 and then Georgia in 2014. As a head coach, Stricklin is 17-13 against Tech including 15-10 at Georgia. Freshman RHP/3B Leighton Finley suits up for the Bulldogs while older brother Jackson (RHP/ OF) plays for Tech.

◆ SEC Preseason Poll: Georgia is picked to finish fifth in the East, according to a preseason poll of SEC coaches who voted Tennessee and LSU as the projected champions with the Tigers winning the league. In the East, the coaches predicted order was UT, UF, Vandy, USC, Georgia, UK and Mizzou. Ten teams on this year's slate advanced to the NCAAs in 2022.

Back Wearing The Red & Black: The Bulldogs return six starters around the diamond, 12 pitchers who saw action last year plus welcome 18 newcomers. There are six graduates including 24-year-old outfielders Ben Anderson and preseason second team All-SEC Connor Tate, both in their sixth campaign due to a redshirt season and a COVID-year. Anderson was the 2022 SEC Baseball Scholar-Athlete of the Year. A few more veterans back are juniors Corey Collins, Fernando Gonzalez and Parks Harber.

Georgia has two graduate transfer pitchers: Kyle Greenler (Elon), Dalton Rhadans (Wofford); two graduate transfer infielders: Will David (Samford) and Mason LaPlante (Yale) plus two Division 1 transfers in pitcher Zach DeVito (Tulane) and infielder Sebastian Murillo (Long Beach State).

The youngsters in the lineup will be sophomore Cole Wagner and redshirt freshman Charlie Condon while freshman Justin Thomas has made a pair of starts on the year.

Streaks: Graduate Connor Tate has hit safely in all eight games while redshirt freshman Charlie Condon has a seven-game streak. Tate has a career-best 13-game streak dating to 2022. The Bulldogs have hit at least one home run in every game this year. The Bulldogs have 17 homers but have allowed 18 (14 solo).

Weekend Rotation: Junior LHP Jaden Woods (1-0, 5.40 ERA) and junior LHP Liam Sullivan (1-0, 0.00 ERA) are the top two candidates for the weekend rotation while senior Nolan Crisp (1-0, 3.68 ERA) has emerged to claim the final spot after the first two weekends. Woods is the team's highest rated prospect for the 2023 MLB Draft according to Baseball America who ranked the top 200. Woods came in at No. 89 while junior C/OF Corey Collins was No. 188. This season, Collins is batting .364-4-9. He has appeared in seven games with six starts (3-C, 3-RF).

Princeton Series Review: Georgia eventually got its four-game series in with the Tigers, outscoring them 44-24. Friday's action was suspended in the sixth inning due to rain. On Saturday, Georgia picked up a pair of wins and then the teams split a doubleheader on Sunday. The Bulldogs tallied 46 hits including 17 for extra bases (eight home runs). Princeton hit only .233 but did club 10 home runs (nine solo and one threerun shot). Georgia's leading hitters in the series were redshirt-freshman OF Charlie Condon (.636-1-6) and graduate DH Connor Tate (.615-1-7).

Georgia got tremendous starts from junior left-handers Jaden Woods (4.2IP. 1H. 0R. 1BB. 11K) and Liam Sullivan (7IP. 0H. 0R. 2BB. 11K) in the first two games. Sullivan earned SEC Co-Pitcher of the Week honors. Graduate Dalton Rhadans was the team's top reliever, notching a save after providing three innings with three strikeouts in the 12-7 win.

Georgia's defense was much better compared to Opening Weekend. Against Princeton, the team fielded .985 with only a pair of miscues after making five in the Jacksonville State series.

# HEAD BASEBALL COACH SCOTT STRICKLIN

#### #10 SCOTT STRICKLIN UGA'S IKE COUSINS HEAD BASEBALL COACH 9TH SEASON AT UGA; 18TH OVERALL

Ike Cousins Head Baseball Coach Scott Stricklin is in his10th season at the helm of the Bulldog program.

The 2022 club battled through an array of pitching injuries to post a 36-23 mark and an appearance in the NCAA Chapel Hill (N.C.) Regional. On March 19, 2022 he



became the fifth active coach in the SEC with 600 career wins when the Bulldogs beat No. 24 Miss. State 12-11. In April of 2021, it was announced he had agreed to a contract extension to lead Georgia through 2026.

The 2021 team spent 11 weeks in the nation's top 25 rankings and reached as high as No. 5 before a slew of injuries eventually took its toll. Still, Georgia notched a road series over No. 1 Vanderbilt. It marked the Commodores only home series loss. Georgia went 1-2 at the SEC Tournament and ended the year with a 31-25 mark.

Georgia was one of just two schools to have earned a top eight National Seed for the NCAA Championships in both 2018 and 2019. Georgia was a No. 8 seed in 2018 and a No. 4 seed in 2019, which marked the best in school history. Then in 2020, the Bulldogs were poised to have a special year, selling out its season tickets, when the global COVID-19 pandemic hit. Georgia finished 2020 ranked as high as No. 2 nationally as it had jumped out to a 7-0 start, swept rival Georgia Tech for the third time in the past four years and tallied a 14-4 mark when the season was canceled. Four Bulldogs signed professional contracts including first round pick Emerson Hancock (sixth overall). Georgia was the only SEC program to receive NCAA APR recognition, 10 Bulldogs earned a degree, and the program posted a record 3.14 GPA for the spring. Hancock was just the fourth student-athlete in school history to be both a first round draft pick and first team Academic All-American.

Stricklin, who led his alma mater Kent State to five NCAA Regionals and the 2012 College World Series (CWS), was named head baseball coach at the University of Georgia on June 3, 2013. Stricklin, a two-time All-Mid-American Conference catcher, was a 23rd round draft pick of the Minnesota Twins in 1993, he played five seasons and reached the Triple-A level with the Twins. He graduated magna cum laude with a bachelor's degree in marketing from KSU in 1995. He and his wife Cheri have three children: daughters Sydney (19) who attends UGA, and Keaton (14), and a son, Cale (17).
