BACK IN THE PEACH STATE

Wofford leaves South Carolina for just the second time this season as it travels back to Georgia for a midweek match-up against Georgia Tech. After weather forced this past weekend's series against Xavier to move from Cincinnati to Spartanburg, the Terriers suffered their first home sweep since 2016 to fall to 14-5 on a four-game losing streak. The Yellow Jackets are 14-6 (3-3 ACC) after dropping two-of-three at No. 2 Louisville. Wofford and Georgia Tech have met nine times prior, but not since 2007. The Yellow Jackets won that contest 11-8 on April 3 in Atlanta and have claimed all nine of the all-time meetings.

OUICK HITS

- The Terriers won their first three series of the season before dropping all three to Xavier over the weekend.
- First-baseman Ryan Galanie earned two SoCon weekly honors last week: Player of the Week and Student-Athlete of the Week.
- Galanie currently leads the SoCon in all thre Triple Crown categories: .441 average, six homers and 25 RBI
- The Terrier pitching staff as a whole has been pinpoint, giving up only 27 walks this season. At a rate of 1.39 per nine innings, this is the lowest mark in the NCAA.
- Wofford was picked as the SoCon's preseason favorite in both the coaches and media polls.
- Five Terriers were honored on the Preseason All-SoCon Teams: Matthew Marchal, Luke Stephens, Ryan Galanie and Brice Martinez on the first team with Trey Yunger on the second team.
- Senior righty Matthew Marchal was tabbed as the league's Preseason Pitcher of the Year and has garnered Preseason Second-Team All-American honors by Collegiate Baseball.
- The Terriers have secured back-to-back SoCon regular season titles for the first time in program history.
- Wofford has stolen 100 or more bases in nine-straight full seasons dating back to 2013, the longest active streak in Division I.

ABOUT WOFFORD

This is the 16th season under the direction of head coach Todd Interdonato. Leading the team are eight seniors, including two All-SoCon players from last season in Ryan Galanie and Matthew Marchal. Overall, 24 players are returning from last season's squad, and they are joing by 13 newcomers: 12 freshmen and a junior transfer. Marchal is the top returning pitcher, leading the Terriers in ERA (2.52), innings (85.2) and strikeouts (93) last season. The bullpen in bolstered by the returning tandem of Luke Stephens and Holden Wilder. With the departure of last season's saves leader Dalton Rhadans, Stephens is poised to step into the closer role. Wilder led the team in wins with eight. Galanie led Wofford in slugging (.653), runs (66), RBI (59) and home runs (17) and boasts the top returning hit total (72). Brice Matinez owns the highest batting average among returners (.331). Last season's steals leader was Jack Renwick with 35, and he's the leading bunter among returners with six sacrifices.

CONSISTENCY IN THE SOCON

Since the 2015 season, only one school has posted .500 or better records in SoCon play every season - Wofford. The Terriers were 13-10 in 2015, 12-12 in 2016, 13-11 in 2017, 15-9 in 2018 and 14-9 in 2019. In 2021, the Terriers were 21-9 and finished 16-4-1 in 2022. During the seven-season span, Mercer was below .500 in 2018, Samford was below the mark in 2017 and UNCG was 12-18 in 2021.

BACK-TO-BACK

With a win in the series opener on May 19, 2022 at VMI, Wofford secured the regular season SoCon crown for the second-straight season. The back-to-back titles are the first in program history, and the Terriers are the first team to repeat as regular season champs in the SoCon since Mercer won three consecutive from 2015-17.

FEELS LIKE THE FIRST TIME

Multiple Terriers notched firsts during the first weekend of the campaign. Five freshman pitchers made their debuts, and four recorded

Branton Little was the fifth to make his debut, and Weber started for his first nod to open a game. Sophomore Marshall Toole lifted his first homer, and Lucas Mahlstedt notched his first save. Transfer junior Dixon Black earned his first hit and RBI as a Terrier. More firsts have come since then. It was better late than never for senior Cameron Gill, who launched his first homer, a grand slam, in the opener against Kent State. Zac Cowan earned his first win the follwing day. In the second game of the Sacred Heart series, David Wiley lifted his first-career homer, a grand slam. Andrew Mannelly clubbed his first homer, a two-run shot over the King Field scoreboard in right, against Cincinnati on March 10. At Georgia, Aaron Thomas launched his first-career long ball. In the Xavier series, both Trey Yunger and Ben Schulte clubbed their first-career long balls.

NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK

Wofford welcomes 13 new players to the team in 2023, 12 freshmen and a junior transfer. The freshmen include infielders Cooper Erikson, Logan Collins and James Layman. Catcher Alex Nevils joins the fray, and the outfielders are Andrew Mannelly, Logan Tribble and Stan Zagrodnik. The freshmen arms are right-handers Charlie Weber and Branton Little and lefty Ryder Moye. Champ Davis and Zac Cowan are both listed as two-way players, and the duo can each play infield in addition to being right-handed pitchers.

DUAL THREAT

Two of the freshmen Terriers are listed as two-way players: Zac Cowan and Champ Davis. The duo are each listed as an infielder/right-handed pitcher, becoming Wofford's first two-way players since Ty Reginelli played as both a hitter and pitcher in the 2018 season. It is yet to be seen to what extent either of the new Terriers will act as a two-way player, but the potential is afoot for the first time in Spartanburg in five years.

HOME SWEET HOME

There is no place like home for the Wofford Terriers, as they have been dominant in the friendly confines of Russell C. King Field for a decade. The Terriers have posted at least a .500 home record for 10-straight seasons. Wofford was 15-18 at home in 2012, but since going 16-16 at home in 2013, the Terriers have not since dropped below the .500 mark in a season, and only two seasons saw a record of exactly .500 (2013 and 14-14 in 2017). Wofford was 21-6 at home in 2021 and finished 24-4-1 at home last season. This season, the Terriers are 12-4 in Spartanburg. Overall, Wofford is 395-102-1 at home during that 11-year span. The Terriers have not quite had the same success away from home in that span, only posting marks above .500 in four consecutive seasons dating back to 2019, which was the last season Wofford was at least .500 at neutral sites as well (3-3). Over that 10-year stretch from 2013-22, the Terriers are just 95-113 on the road and 16-22 at neutral sites.

SERIES BUSINESS

Wofford won its first nine series of the 2022 season before taking its first series loss to Samford, the longest stretch of series wins to open a season in program history. The Terriers finished 11-1-1 in weekend series with six sweeps (Lafayette, Gardner-Webb, UNCG, ETSU, The Citadel and VMI). Wofford did not lose a home series, winning all but one (a 1-1-1 split with Western Carolina). Wofford picked up where it left off by winning the first three series of 2023, but Xavier spoiled the party by sweeping the Terriers in the fourth series. It was Wofford's first home series loss since losing two-of-three to Furman from May 10-12, 2019. This

the first home sweep Wofford has suffered since 2016, when the Terriers dropped three in a row to Western Carolina from April 1-3.

HOT AND COLD

After losing the first game of the season, the Terriers bounced back in a massive way by winning 14 contests in a row before falling to Georgia 10-8 in midweek action March 13. That 14-game winning streak is the longest in program history, topping the original mark of 13 games set in 1983 when the Terriers won their first 13 games of the season from March 4-21. After such a hot start to the campaign, the Terriers have since cooled down. That loss to Georgia has spurned a four-game losing streak, Wofford's longest skid since losing four in a row from April 24-30 last season.

THE FIRST BLOW

Striking first was key in Wofford's games last season, as the team to score first won all but 16 of the 59 contests. The Terriers were 32-4 when scoring first, but they were 10-12-1 when their opponents dealt the first blow. The trend seems to be holding in 2023, as Wofford is 10-2 when scoring first this season, yet they are 4-3 when the opponent scores first.

SMALL BALL

The Terriers use a combination of stolen bases and sacrifice bunts to advance on the basepaths. Wofford has dropped down 31 sac-bunts, tops in the nation. With seven sacrifices, Jack Renwick leads the team and is one of five players tied for first nationally. With 58 steals, the Terriers are second in the SoCon and eighth nationally. Wofford's 3.05 steals per game check in at eighth in the country. Jack Renwick and Trey Yunger each own 10 swipes to lead the team, tying for sixth in the league.

TOP DOGS

Wofford ranks among the conference and national leaders in many statistical categories. The Terriers lead the SoCon in sacrifice bunts (31), K/BB ratio (7.15), K/9 (9.9), WHIP (1.18) amd walks allowed per nine innings (1.39). Of those marks, three lead the country: sac-bunts, K/BB ratio and walks per nine. Wofford's WHIP ranks 14th nationally. Wofford sits second in the league in walks (106), ERA (4.94), fielding percentage (.975), hits-by-pitch (35), on-base percentage (.414), shutouts (two), stolen bases (58) and steals per game (3.05).

WALKING ON SUNSHINE

Wofford excelled at working the count in 2021, drawing a program record 301 walks as a team, 11th-best in the nation. Last season, Wofford continued to see the ball well and work counts, drawing 277 free passes to rank third in the conference. This aided Wofford's on base percentage, helping elevate it to a .419 mark, first in the SoCon and seventh in Divison I. The Terriers have drawn 106 walks this season, second most in the SoCon and 47th nationally, and their .414 OBP is second in the league and ranks 41st in the country.

NOTHING FOR FREE

While drawing plenty of walks at the dish, Wofford does not issue many on the mound. Terrier pitchers allowed the fourth-fewest walks per nine innings in the country in 2022 at just 2.79. This lifted the club's K/BB ratio to 3.18, eighth-best in the nation. In 2023, the Terriers have only issued 27 free passes. At a rate of 1.39 per nine innings, Wofford owns the lowest walk rate in the country. This aids in the country's 14th-best WHIP at 1.18. With a K/BB ratio of 7.15, the Terriers are first in the NCAA. Having not yet issued a walk this year, Lucas Mahlstedt is the only qualified

pitcher in the nation to have not yet issued a free pass, owning a nation's-best walks per nine rate of zero. Zac Cowan's rate of 0.43 is second in the SoCon and fourth nationally. Mahlstedt's 0.83 WHIP leads the league and ranks 25th in the country, and Cowan's 0.90 WHIP is fourth in the league.

WE GOT ICE

Among the numerous ways Wofford players reach base is the hit-by-pitch, of which the Terriers wore plenty last season. With 91 hit batsmen, Wofford was second in the SoCon and 33rd in the country. Wofford hitters have been pegged 35 times this season, second in the conference and 33rd nationally.

ICE IN THEIR VEINS

A few Terrier hitters have been clutch with runners on base this season. Top slugger Ryan Galanie is 16-of-35 with runners on base for a .457 average. He is just as impressive with the bases empty, touting a .424 clip with 14 hits in 33 at-bats. Notably, three Terriers take their play up a notch when the table is set for them. Jack Renwick is hitting .171 with the bases empty (6-of-35), but he is batting .321 (9-of-28) with runners on. Similarly, Trey Yunger bats .313 (10-of-32) with runners on, but with no one on his average dips to .229 (8-of-35). But no one has been more impressive with runners on base than Marshall Toole, who is hitting .542 (13-of-24) with runners on base, yet his average with the bases empty is just .267 (8-of-30).

BAND OF THIEVES

The Terriers are deadly on the basepaths with a total team effort. Thirteen different Terriers stole at least one base last season, and 12 had at least three. Eleven had seven or more swipes, and six were in double-digits (Jack Renwick, 35; Trey Yunger, 17; Marshall Toole, 16; Ryan Galanie, 13; Lawson Hill, 12; Brice Martinez, 11). With 38 players on the roster, this marked one-third of the team with a steal. With 20 position players, over half of them boasted a swiped bag. This season, 12 of the 15 position players to play have swiped a base. Two are in double-digits, as Jack Renwick and Trey Yunger each boast 10. Six total Terreirs have at least five steals. Of the three players yet to swipe a base, none of them have attempted one yet.

BASE THIEVERY

Wofford led the nation with 163 total stolen bases (second at 2.91 bases per game) at the end of the 2013 regular season. Since then, Wofford has stolen at least 100 bases for nine-straight full seasons, the longest active streak in the nation.

YARD WORK

The Terriers hit 66 home runs in 2017, the most since hitting 74 in 2008. Since then, Wofford's long ball numbers had been decreasing. The Terriers had 49 home runs in 59 games in 2018. The team only hit 28 home runs in each of 2019 and 2021. Wofford

hit 51 homers in 2022, the most since that 2017 season, showing a turnaround in regards to the dinger. With 17 home runs, Ryan Galanie led the team. John Dempsey was not far behind with 12 four-baggers. The Terriers have tallied 18 homers this year, led by Ryan Galanie with six.

EXTRA BASES

In 2013, the Terriers had just 22% of the hits in the season go for extra bases. Since that season, Wofford has steadily increased the number of extra bases.

GRAND MARCHAL

RHP Matthew Marchal was tabbed First-Team All-SoCon at the conclusion of the 2022 season. The senior ace entered 2023 as a Preseason All-American (second team, Collegiate Baseball) and as the SoCon Preseason Pitcher of the Year. In 2023, he owns a 2-1 record with a 4.81 ERA over seven starts. Marchal boasts 33 punchouts in 24.1 innings. Those strikeouts are enough to rank third in the SoCon, and his K/9 rate is 12.21, second in the league. With a K/BB ratio of 5.50, he sits fifth in the league. Toeing the rubber frequently, Marchal's seven starts are tied for most in the nation with ETSU's Landon Smiddy.

COUL AS ICE

Sophomore RHP Coulson Buchanan broke out as a freshman last season, earning SoCon All-Freshman Team honors. Now a full-time member of the rotation, Buchanan has taken his game to another level. He touts a 2-1 record in six starts (seven total apperances) with a 4.61 ERA in 27.1 innings. Buchanan has struck out 34 batters to sit second in the SoCon, and his K/9 rate of 11.20 ranks third. With a K/BB ratio of 4.86, the righty is sixth in the conference. When the pressure is on, Buchanan is cool as ice. Buchanan has faced 45 at-bats with runners on base, and he has held the opposition to only a .156 average in those situations, surrendering just seven hits total. The mark is actually lower than his batting average against with the bases empty, a .344 clip with 21 hits allowed in 61 at-bats.

AIN'T IT GRAND?

Last season the Terriers only powered two grand slams. It took Wofford sluggers just seven games in 2023 to match that total and only 10 games to top it. In fact, the Terrier hitters lifted a pair of grand slams in just one weekend. Cameron Gill opened the Kent State series with one, his first-career homer. Ryan Galanie added his own in the series finale on Sunday. The very next weekend, David Wiley added the team's third of the season against Sacred Heart, and he became the second Terrier of the campaign to notch his first-career homer with a slam.

CONTROL IN THE CLUTCH

Holding a lead late was imperative for Wofford last season, as the Terriers hardly coughed up a lead in the final third of a game. Wofford was 31-1 when leading after the sixth, 33-1 when leading after the seventh inning and 35-0 when leading after eight. However, the Terriers struggled to make late comebacks when not leading. The Terriers were 11-15-1 when trailing or tied after the sixth, 5-13 after the seventh and 2-14 after the eighth. So far in 2023, the Terriers have not coughed up any lead after the fifth inning. On the flip side, Wofford has only overcome one deficit after the sixth, and it has not come back from a deficit yet after the seventh.

AGAINST THE POWER 5

In now 12 of the last 15 seasons, Wofford has at least one win over a Power 5 conference team. In 2015, Wofford played seven games against teams from Power 5 conferences with a 3-4 overall record. In 2016, Wofford was 1-4 with a win over Kentucky. In 2017, the Terriers played Clemson, South Carolina and Pittsburgh and were 1-2. In 2018, Wofford played Kentucky, Clemson, Georgia and Boston College (1-3). The lone Power 5 opponent in 2019 was Ohio State, and Wofford won 8-6. In 2020, Wofford won at Auburn (4-3), and in 2021, the Terriers were scheduled to play Georgia (canceled) and Duke (L, 6-9). In 2022, Wofford dropped both games with Georgia and a contest at Clemson. The Terriers notched a win over their first Power 5 opponent in 2023, topping Michigan State 12-9. Wofford has since lost at Georgia, and it will square off against three more Power 5 foes.

WHAT A RELIEF

The Wofford bullpen specializes in locking down games. The relief efforts are led by righties Lucas Mahlstedt, Luke Stephens and breakout freshman Zac Cowan. Mahlstedt owns a 1.88 ERA with a 1-0 record and a pair of saves. Over 24.0 innings, he has struck out 25 hitters while allowing only five runs. Mahlstedt's ERA is second in the SoCon, and he leads the league in K/BB ratio (0.00) and WHIP (0.83). Mahlstedt is the only qualified pitcher in the nation to have not yet issued a walk, leading the NCAA with a walks per nine of zero. Stephens is 2-1 on the campaign with a save in 16.0 innings over seven apperances. He boasts a 2.81 ERA with 10 punchouts and a .271 batting average against. Cowan has shined as a freshman, touting a 3-1 record with 26 strikeouts in 21.0 innings of work. Cowan's three wins are fifth in the SoCon. His 0.90 WHIP is fourth in the league, and his 0.43 BB/9 clip is second in the conference and fourth in the country.

GALANIE'S YARD WORK

Senior slugger Ryan Galanie had a breakout season for the Terriers last season and has continued to thrive this year. A Preseason All-SoCon First-Team selection, Galanie immediately proved he deserved it by claiming the opening SoCon Player of the Week honor of 2023. He is slashing .441/.553/.765, leading the conference in average and slugging while ranking third in OBP. His average is 23rd nationally, and his OBP sits 16th. Galanie leads in the conference in all three triple crown categories: the aforementioned batting average, six home runs and 25 RBI. Galanie's 30 hits are second in the conference, 52 total bases third and his seven stolen bases rank eighth.

THE SHARPEST TOOLE

After a quality rookie campaign in 2022, outfielder Marshall Toole was named to the SoCon All-Freshman Team. He has stepped up a notch in 2023, opening his sophomore campaign with an 15-game on-base streak. Now a full-time starter, he owns a .389 batting clip. Toole featured as a key contributor and conference leader for the Terriers early in the season, but he has been out of the lineup for the last four games with an injury.

In 2022, the baseball team had 23 members named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll. The SoCon Academic Honor Roll recognizes student-athletes who had a 3.0 grade point average for the academic year. In addition, Wofford had seven players named to the SoCon Spring All-Academic Team.

IN-SEASON BIRTHDAYS

Several Terriers have birthdays during the season, including Mike Eggert (February 20), Coulson Buchanan (March 4), Marshall Toole (March 17), Andrew Mannelly (March 20), Dom Marcoccio (March 21), Lucas Mahlstedt (March 26), Jack Renwick (April 4), Andrew Calhoun (April 17), Charlie Weber (April 19) and Connor Larson (May 23).

JUST PEACHY

The vast majorty of Wofford's roster is comprised of players from the Peach State of Georgia. Fifteen Terriers hail from the Peach State, six more than the next-highest state (nine, South Carolina). The only other state to feature multiple players on the roster is Florida with two, and the 11 other states represented each contribute only a single Terrier.

BATTLE OF THE BREEDS

The Terriers have six opponents on the schedule this season that also have dog mascots (Southern Illinois, UNC Asheville, Georgia, Siena, Samford and The Citadel). Four of them are the Bulldogs, and the other two are the Salukis (SIU) and Saints (short for Saint Bernard, Siena). Wofford went 10-4 against its fellow canine foes last season in the battle of breed supremacy. Wofford has faced three of those dog foes this season (SIU, UNC Asheville and Georgia), going 3-2 against them.

BATTLING THE POLLS

The Terriers played five games last season against ranked opponents, going 2-3. After dropping a pair of midweeks to #15 and #13 Georgia, Wofford took two-of-three from #18 Dallas Baptist. The first win was Wofford's first over a ranked team since beating #14 Auburn 4-3 on the road on March 11, 2020. The second win was historic as it marked the first time in program history that the Terriers notched two ranked wins in a single season, and subsequently it secured Wofford's first-ever series win over a ranked squad.

TO BE THE BEST...

With Michigan State also on the slate, the Terriers will square off against five different Power 5 programs. Two of them were already ranked in the preseason polls: Tennessee and Wake Forest.



With 415 career wins, he is first all-time among Wofford baseball coaches in that category.

Interdonato has led the program to unprecedented success, including the first regular season Southern Conference championship and SoCon Coach of the Year honors in 2021. Both he and the team repeated in each regard in 2022. The team has won 30 or more games in seven of the last eight seasons. In 2014, the overall record of 32-28 was the first winning record since 1992 and the first in the Division I era at Wofford. That was followed by a 39-22 record in 2015, then the most wins in school history. In 2018 the team posted a 36-22 record, followed by a 36-25 record in 2019. The 2022 squad set a new mark for program wins with a 42-16-1 record. It was the first 40-win season in program history. The team posted ten or more wins in the Southern Conference in each of the last nine years, including a record 21 wins in 2021. In both 2014 and 2015, the Terriers reached the SoCon Tournament semifinals, while the team played in the championship series in both 2019 and 2022. Wofford has reached 100 or more stolen bases in nine-straight seasons, including leading the nation in total stolen bases in 2014 and 2015. Twelve players have been selected in the MLB Draft during his time on the coaching staff.

In 2022, Wofford repeated as the Southern Conference Regular Season Champions with a 16-4-1 conference clip and a 42-16-1 overall mark. Catcher Lawson Hill was named SoCon Player of the Year by the Media, and Interdonato claimed his second consecutive Coach of the Year award. They were among a program-record 11 total Terriers to be recognized in the SoCon year-end honors, including the five first-team selections of Matthew Marchal, Lawson Hill, John Dempsey, Ryan Galanie and Brennen Dorighi. Dalton Rhadans and Josh Vitus earned second-team honors, and the All-Freshman Team included Carter Bailey, Coulson Buchanan and Marshall Toole. Along with his All-SoCon honor, Galanie earned CoSIDA Academic All-District and All-America recognitions. The Terriers only lost one weekend series all season, and they claimed their first-ever series win over a ranked opponent by taking two-of-three on the road at No. 18 Dallas Baptist. Wofford entered the Top 25 rankings for the first time in program history, and the Terriers remained ranked for three-straight weeks and reached as high as No. 22 in the Baseball America Top 25. Wofford led the SoCon in both hitting and pitching with a combined batting average of .314 and an ERA of 4.66. The Terriers also topped the league in on-base percentage (.418), runs scored (485), stolen bases (145) and runners picked off (16). The 506 pitching strikeouts were a program record and tied for second in the conference.

During the 2021 season, Wofford won the first regular season Southern Conference Championship in school history. The team was 36-21 overall and 21-9 in league play, which were the most conference wins in school history. Outfielder Colin Davis was named SoCon Player of the Year, Elliot Carney was named SoCon Pitcher of the Year and Interdonato was named Coach of the Year. They were joined by Dalton Rhadans, Jack Renwick, Lawson Hill and Nolen Hester receiving All-SoCon honors. Renwick and Trey Yunger were named to the All-Freshman Team. The Terriers had a .291 batting average that ranked second in the league, while four players had averages over .300. The team posted a 5.01 ERA that was third in the Southern Conference and the .259 opposing batting average ranked first. The team combined for 492 strikeouts, which was second in the league.

Following the season, Colin Davis was selected in the seventh round of the MLB Draft by Seattle and Hayes Heinecke was a 13th round selection by St. Louis. It was the third time in school history Wofford had two players selected in the same year. In addition, 28 players were named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

The Terriers were 14-3 overall in 2020 before the season was cut short. In what would become the final game, Wofford earned a 4-3 win at #14 Auburn.

In 2019, Wofford won 36 games, tied for the second-most in school history. The 14-9 record in the Southern Conference to finish second overall, the highest in school history. In the Southern Conference Tournament, Wofford reached the championship series for the second time in school history before falling to Mercer. Seven Terriers earned All-Southern Conference honors, highlighted by Hayes Heinecke being named Freshman of the Year. Heinecke, Brett Rodriguez, John Dempsey, Hudson Byorick, Colin Davis and Mike Brown were named All-SoCon, with Heinecke, Dempsey and Matty Brown earning All-Freshman Team recognition. Heinecke and Dempsey added Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-America honors. The Terriers set several new school records and were ranked among the top four Southern Conference teams in most offensive categories. The squad placed 22 on the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll, with Alec Cargin earning CoSIDA Academic All-District honors.

The Terriers won 36 games in 2018, the second-most wins in school history. In league play, the 15-9 record put Wofford third overall in the standings and set a new school mark for SoCon wins. Pitcher Adam Scott and outfielder McClain Bradley were named All-Southern Conference second team, with outfielder Colin Davis and catcher Lawson Hill picked up All-Freshman Team accolades. Davis was also named a Collegiate Baseball Freshman All-American. Pitcher Adam Scott, who set school records in career innings pitched, career strikeouts and single season strikeouts, finished his career ranked third in SoCon history with 389 strikeouts. He was drafted in the fourth round (133rd overall) by the Cleveland Indians. Academically, 21 played were named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll and McClain Bradley earned CoSIDA Academic All-District recognition.

In 2017, the Terriers won 28 games. In the Southern Conference, the 13-11 mark was just the second winning season in league play. Six players earned All-Southern Conference recognition following the season, with first baseman Brett Hash on the first team. Catcher Carson Waln, outfielder McClain Bradley, and designated hitter Cody Miller picked up second team honors, while Brett Rodriguez and Matt Ellmyer earned spots on the All-Freshman Team. The team finished in the top five in eleven categories in the Wofford single season records, including strikeouts per nine innings (first) and RBIs (second). Pitcher Spencer Kulman signed a free agent contract with the San Diego Padres following the season. Twenty players were named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll and McClain Bradley was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District Team.

During the 2016 season, Wofford won 30 games, marking the third straight year with 30 or more wins. The team was 12-12 in the Southern Conference, just the second .500 or better mark in league play for the Terriers. The Terriers had series wins over The Citadel, VMI and ETSU. Pitchers Matthew Milburn and Will Stillman, along with shortstop Derek Hirsch, earned second team All-Southern Conference honors. Among conference leaders, Wofford was first in stolen bases, second in fielding percentage, second in triples and fifth in walks received. The team set a new school record for fielding percentage (.972). Following the season, Will Stillman was selected in the 6th round and Matthew Milburn was picked in the 29th round on the MLB Draft. Stillman was the highest draft choice from Wofford since 1983. Academically, 22 players were named to the Southern

Conference Academic Honor Roll and Derek Hirsch and Alec Paradowski earned CoSIDA Academic All-District recognition.

In 2015, the 39-22 overall record marked the most wins in school history. In the Southern Conference, Wofford was 13-10 with series wins over VMI, The Citadel, Samford, UNCG, and Furman. The Terriers third place finish in the SoCon standings was the highest in school history. Wofford advanced to the SoCon Tournament semifinals for the second straight season before falling to #2 seed Samford.

The Terriers led the nation in stolen bases with 138, were second in stolen bases per game with 2.26, ranked 13th in on base percentage and 15th in batting average. Wofford set new school records in four team categories. Senior first baseman Conor Clancey was named a Louisville Slugger second team All-American, while senior designated hitter Matt Ramsay earned CoSIDA Academic All-America honors. Clancey, Ramsay, pitcher Will Stillman, pitcher Matt Milburn, and outfielder James Plaisted were named All-Southern Conference. In addition, pitcher Adam Scott, outfielder Kody Ruedisili and designated hitter Matt Ramsay earner All-Southern Conference Tournament honors. Following the season, pitchers Luke Leftwich (7th round/Phillies) and Will Stillman (29th round/Red Sox) were selected in the MLB Draft. In addition, 22 players were named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

In 2014, Interdonato led the team to 32 wins and the semifinals of the Southern Conference Tournament. Overall, the Terriers were 32-28 overall. They were 12-14 in the league to finish tied for fifth place and had series wins over Georgia Southern, The Citadel, UNCG, and Samford. The Terriers led the nation in stolen bases with 153, stolen bases per game with 2.55, and were 21st in home runs. On the season, Wofford set new school records in six team categories. Wofford had the #6 seed and a bye in the Southern Conference Tournament. In the tournament, the Terriers reached the semifinals for the first time since 2007 before falling 12-3 to Samford. Following the season, nine players were named to the Southern Conference Spring All-Academic Team, while 26 earned spots on the SoCon Academic Honor Roll.

During the 2013 season, the Terriers were 20-36 overall and had a 10-20 mark in the Southern Conference. The ten SoCon wins were the most since the 2002 season. The team had a school-record 163 stolen bases, which led the nation. Pitcher J.D. Osborne was selected by the Houston Astros in the 36th round of the MLB Draft and pitcher Will Stillman was named to the SoCon All-Freshman squad. Nine players were named to the Southern Conference Spring All-Academic Team, while 21 were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll.

In 2012, Wofford posted a 22-32 mark and finished 9-21 in the Southern Conference. The Terriers had series wins over Elon, Georgia Southern, and Western Carolina, along with a 5-4 victory in eleven innings at #6 ranked South Carolina. Pitcher Brandon Yarusi was named second team All-Southern Conference and junior pitcher Alex Wilson was selected in the 15th round by the Atlanta Braves. In the classroom, eleven players were named to the Southern Conference Spring All-Academic Team and 25 were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll. Catcher David Roney was selected to Phi Beta Kappa.

During the 2011 season, the Terriers were 22-33 overall and 9-21 in the SoCon. The Terriers had series wins at Georgia Southern, who would go on to win the SoCon title, and against The Citadel. Mac Doyle earned All-Southern Confernce second team hon-

ors. Following the season, pitcher John Cornely was drafted in the 15th round by the Atlanta Braves. Academically, the Terriers placed twelve on the Southern Conference Spring All-Academic Team and a total of 26 players were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll.

In 2010, the team was 17-38 overall and were 9-21 in Southern Conference play. Among the highlights were series wins over UNC Greensboro and Samford, plus a 6-4 victory over Duke for the program's first ever Division I win over an ACC opponent. At the conclusion of the season, Kyle Behrendt and Mac Doyle earned All-Southern Conference honors. In addition, Mac Doyle was named a second team All-American, just the second for Wofford since moving to NCAA Division I. In the classroom, the Terriers placed eleven on the Southern Conference All-Academic Team and a total of 26 players were named to the SoCon Academic Honor Roll.

During the 2009 season, Wofford was 17-32 overall and finished 7-22 in conference play. Highlights during the 2009 season included a 16-8 win over South Carolina on March 11 and an epic 18-inning battle at Elon. The Terriers won two of three games over Furman and Davidson in league play. Junior Michael Gilmartin was named All-Southern Conference for the third straight season and was drafted by the Oakland A's.

In his first season at the helm, the Terriers posted a 24-35 overall record and were 6-21 in the Southern Conference. In the 2008 SoCon Tournament, the Terriers defeated The Citadel in the opening round to advance. On the field, Michael Gilmartin earned All-Southern Conference honors for the second time in his career. In the classroom, Kyle Behrendt was named to the CoSIDA Academic All-District team. Overall, the team had thirteen players named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll.

This is Interdonato's 18th season on the staff at Wofford, spending the first two seasons as the hitting coach and offensive coordinator for the Terriers. While coaching third base, he was responsible for all offensive decisions during the game. In addition, he was the recruiting coordinator, handling all aspects of recruiting for the program.

In 2007, Wofford set school records for base hits, runs scored, doubles, home runs, total bases and RBIs. The Terriers led the nation in home runs per game at 1.71 (108 in 63 games), and were fourth nationally in slugging percentage (.519) and tenth in OPS (on-base percentage plus slugging percentage) at .903. Wofford also tied the then-school record for wins in a season with 30. Interdonato's influence on the Wofford offense began in 2006. The Terriers stole 90 bases and set school records with 103 doubles, 777 total bases and 66 hit by pitch during the 2006 season.

A 2000 graduate of UNC Asheville, Interdonato came to Wofford after working as an assistant coach at Fort Scott (Kan.) Community College in 2005. He previously served a two-year tenure as an assistant at Gardner-Webb, where he received an MBA in 2004. At Fort Scott, Interdonato served as the primary hitting and outfield coach while taking complete responsibility for the offensive progress of the program.

Interdonato began his coaching career as an assistant with UNC Asheville in the 2002 season where he was the primary hitting and outfield instructor. He was also responsible for placing players in summer collegiate leagues.

He has also served as a summer league coach, leading the Salisbury (N.C.) Pirates of the Southern Collegiate Baseball League. As the head coach of the Hornell Dodgers in the New York Collegiate League, he earned New York Collegiate Baseball League Coach of the Year honors in 2005.

Interdonato played his first two collegiate seasons at South Mountain Community College in Phoenix, Arizona. He then received a baseball scholarship to UNC Asheville. He was a co-captain in the 2000 season when he batted .320 with six home runs and a team-best 38 RBIs. He was named a Big South Conference Player of the Week in March 2000. A first baseman/outfielder, Interdonato also saw action on the mound. He had over 25 appearances as a starter and reliever in each of his two campaigns with the Bulldogs.

After graduating from UNC Asheville, Interdonato signed a professional contract with the Evansville (Ind.) Otters of the Frontier League.

Interdonato and his wife, the former Melissa Jones, were married in July 2012 and reside in Greer, South Carolina with their dog, Elvis. They have two daughters, Keegan and Kierlan.




