## GEORGIA STATE (18-18) at GEORGIA TECH (20-16)

Tuesday, April 18 | 8 p.m. | Mac Nease Ballpark | ACCN

### LEADING OFF

> After winning four of their last five games, Georgia State plays a pair of midweek games, beginning Tuesday with an 8 p.m. contest at Georgia Tech on the ACC Network. The Panthers then host Mercer Wednesday at 6 p.m. at the GSU Baseball Complex.

> Georgia State won the first meeting against Georgia Tech with a 12-11 walk-off victory in 14 innings at Coolray Field on March 28. Will Mize drove in the tying run with a two-out single in the bottom of the ninth, and shortstop Matt Ruiz scored the winning run on a wild pitch. Mize, Dylan Strickland and Max Ryerson homered for GSU.

> The Panthers have defeated Tech in each of the last three seasons.

> Georgia State is No. 1 in the Sun Belt and No. 5 in Division I with 71 home runs, led by Luke Boynton with 11, Dylan Strickland with 10, and JoJo Jackson and Max Ryerson with nine each.

> The Panthers' total of 71 home runs is the fifth-highest season total in program history. The GSU season record is 82, set in 2010. The next best season totals are 77 (2000), 75 (2022) and 74 (2009).

> Georgia State also ranks in the top three in the Sun Belt in batting average, scoring, on-base percentage, slugging and stolen bases.

> Sixteen different Panthers have hit at least one homer, including three freshmen--Michael Maginnis, Colin Hynek and Jaden Anderson--whose first career hit was a home run. Seven different players have hit six or more homers.

> Max Ryerson leads the Sun Belt in batting average at .405 and on-base percentage at .521. He has nine homers and 25 RBI, and his OPS is 1.197.

> Ryan Watson earned his 16th career victory last Friday vs. Arkansas State to move into a tie for fourth place in GSU history. The super senior right-hander also became Georgia State's career leader in combined wins (16) and saves (12) with 28.

> Fourth-year head coach Brad Stromdahl earned his 400th career victory vs. James Madison on April 8. Stromdahl (403-193 overall) took over the Georgia State program in 2020 after seven seasons as the head coach at Georgia Gwinnett, where he started the program from scratch in 2013 and compiled a record of 328-104. He led the Grizzlies to the Avista-NAIA World Series three times, including his last two years (2018-19).

> Former Major League pitcher Chad Bell is in his first season as the Panthers' pitching coach. Bell played 10 seasons of professional baseball, reaching the Majors with the Detroit Tigers in 2017-18.

> Panther alum Hunter Gaddis (GSU 2017-19) is now pitching for the Cleveland Guardians. A fifth-round draft pick out of GSU in 2019, he made his MLB debut in 2022, becoming Georgia State's second Major Leaguer.

### WHO'S HOT

> Cameron Jones leads the Sun Belt and ranks No. 4 in Division I in stolen bases with 27. That is the second-highest season figure in program history, seven behind the school record.

> Jones stole four bases in Game 1 at James Madison, coming within one of the school record of five, set by Henry Reese vs. Samford in 1985.

> Luke Boynton's 11th homer was a grand slam in Friday's win over Arkansas State as he took over the team lead. He hit three homers in the Clemson series and two in the Coastal Carolina series. The junior first baseman has 23 career homers.

> Dylan Strickland was named National Player of the Week by Collegiate Baseball and Sun Belt Conference POTW on March 20 after going 7-for-14 with five homers, 10 RBI and nine runs scored in four games. He hit all five homers in the Troy sweep.

> Strickland hit five homers in a span of seven plate appearances over Games 2 and 3 vs. Troy. After homering twice in his last three at-bats in Game 2, he tied the Georgia State record with three home runs in his first four at-bats in the series finale.

> On the season, Strickland is hitting .361 with 10 homers and 27 RBI. He is eighth in the Sun Belt in average and homers.

> Starting pitcher Rafael Acosta has a 2.00 ERA for his last three starts. The senior right-hander has allowed just four runs in 18.0 innings with 14 strikeouts vs. Coastal Carolina, James Madison and Arkansas State. He earned the win at JMU with a career-long outing of 7.0 innings, allowing one run on three hits with five strikeouts in the 3-1 victory.

> Freshman reliever Brady Jones pitched a 1-2-3 ninth inning in 3-1 win at James Madison to earn his first career save, and then added his second save in Game 3 vs. Arkansas State.

> Shortstop Mat Ruiz, the transfer from USF, and third baseman Will Mize share the team lead in RBI with 33. Both also have six homers.

> Sophomore outfielder JoJo Jackson is hitting .317 with nine homers and 28 RBI. He is fourth in the Sun Belt with 28 walks.

**SERIES NOTES**

> Georgia State has defeated Georgia Tech in each of the last seasons. The Panthers won at Tech the last two years, 10-1 in 2021 and 9-5 last season, before this year's 12-11, 14-inning win at Coolray Field.

> Brad Stromdahl is 3-2 against Tech as a head coach, and during his tenure as a GSU assistant coach, he helped the Panthers to three wins over the Jackets (2007, 2009 and 2011), all on the road and all over ranked Tech teams.

>The two Atlanta schools have met 84 times since 1971, including every year since Georgia State reinstated its program in 1992 through

2019. They did not meet in the abbreviated 2020 season. Georgia Tech leads the series 70-14.

**PRESEASON ACCOLADES**

> Max Ryerson was named to Collegiate Baseball's Preseason All-America third team as well as the Preseason All-Sun Belt Conference first team. The super senior outfielder was honored as Sun Belt Conference Newcomer of the Year and first-team All-Sun Belt in 2022, when he hit .335 with 22 homers and 62 RBI.

> Joining Ryerson on the Preseason All-Sun Belt team is junior outfielder and pitcher Cameron Jones, a two-time, first-team all-conference selection and one of five national finalists for the 2022 John Olerud Award as the nation's top two-way player. He achieved the rare feat of leading the Panthers in batting average (.374) and ERA (3.00) in 2022.

**2022 HIGHLIGHTS**

> Georgia State is coming off a 30-win season in 2022, reaching the 30-win mark for the first time since 2015 (ninth time overall). The Panthers' 15 Sun Belt wins equalled the program record, set in 2015.

> Behind a school-record 22 home runs from Max Ryerson, the Panthers hit 75 homers last season, the third-highest season total in program history and the most with the current bats.

> The Panthers' pitching staff set a school record in 2022 with 505 strikeouts while recording 17 saves, the second-highest total in program history.

## HEAD COACH BRAD STROMDAHL

Record at GSU: 75-89 (4th Year) | Career Record: 403-193 (11th Year)

Now in his fourth season as the Georgia State head baseball coach, Brad Stromdahl is transforming the Panther program, creating a winning culture and building the foundation for success.

Before he was introduced as the 10th head baseball coach in GSU history on June 26, 2019, the former Panthers' assistant built an NAIA powerhouse at Georgia Gwinnett College, and in 10 seasons as a head coach, he has produced nine winning seasons and won 69 percent of his games with a career mark of 385-175. Not counting the abbreviated 2020 season, Stromdahl has averaged 42 wins per year.

In 2022, Stromdahl led the Panthers to a 30-27 overall record and 15-15 mark in the Sun Belt Conference for their first winning season since 2015. The successful campaign was fueled by an offense that smashed 75 home runs--the third-highest figure in school history and most with the current bats--and a pitching staff with a program-record 505 strikeouts.

Max Ryerson broke the Georgia State season record and led the Sun Belt with 22 homers while becoming Georgia State's first All-American since 2014. The junior outfielder was also named Sun Belt Conference Newcomer of the Year. Shortstop Griffin Cheney added 16 homers to earn all-conference and all-region honors, while Cameron Jones was one of five finalists for the John Olerud Award as the nation's top two-way player while earning first-team All-Sun Belt honors for the second straight year.

Following the season, the former walk-on Cheney was drafted in the ninth round by the Texas Rangers to become the third-highest draft pick in program history, and pitcher Seth Clark signed a free agent contract, also with the Rangers.

Stromdahl's first season at the helm of the Panther program was cut short in 2020, but he and his staff immediately made an impact on the field and the recruiting trail.

The Stromdahl Era got off to an impressive start as his Panthers earned a walk-off victory over 2019 NCAA Regional participant Cincinnati on Opening Day 2020 and followed with victories over St. John's and St. Peter's. After the 3-0 start, GSU received votes in the national polls.

The Panthers went on to compile a 9-7 record in the shortened season. Outfielder Elian Merejo was selected as the breakout player in the Sun Belt Conference after hitting .407 with five homers and 13 RBI in 16 games. Shortstop Will Mize and right-handed pitcher Chad Treadway were named to Collegiate Baseball's Freshman All-American team.

The 2021 season saw Stromdahl's Panthers make more huge strides while playing perhaps the most difficult non-conference schedule in the nation with 20 games against teams from the Southeastern, Atlantic Coast and Big 12 Conferences. GSU opened the season with 14 straight games against nationally-ranked, Power 5 foes.

Despite a roster dominated by freshmen and sophomores, Georgia State emerged from that gauntlet with four victories over Top 15 opponents, highlighted by a

stunning victory at No. 2 Vanderbilt that is the highest ranked win in program history. The Panthers also knocked off No. 10 Georgia Tech and earned back-to-back wins over No. 14 West Virginia.

That grueling non-conference slate prepared the squad for a strong finish in the Sun Belt Conference as the Panthers reached .500 in league play for the first time since 2015 and earned their first victory in the conference tournament since 2015.

Two-way standout Cameron Jones and outfielder Josh Smith were named to the 2021 All-Sun Belt team, and pitcher Tyler Koch signed a professional contract with the Sioux City Explorers of the American Association.

After starting the Georgia Gwinnett program from scratch in 2013, Stromdahl compiled a 328-104 record in seven seasons as head coach at the Lawrenceville, Ga., school, averaging 47 wins per season. He earned his first head coaching position after five seasons (2007-11) as an assistant coach at Georgia State, serving as recruiting coordinator and hitting instructor during the Panthers' most successful run.

Stromdahl's Grizzlies posted four 50-win seasons, reached the Avista-NAIA Baseball World Series three times, claimed the No. 1 ranking in the NAIA coaches' poll, captured four Association of Independent Institutions (A.I.I.) titles and boasted an NAIA Player of the Year. Nine Grizzlies were drafted by Major League Baseball organizations in his final six years at GGC.

Stromdahl earned A.I.I. Coach of the Year honors in five of his seven seasons at GGC: 2019, 2018, 2016, 2015 and 2014.

Stromdahl and the Grizzlies made back-to-back trips to the Avista-NAIA World Series in Lewiston, Idaho, in his last two seasons, reaching the semifinals in both 2018 and 2019. The Grizzlies finished the 2019 season ranked No. 4 in the NAIA with a 48-13 record. Three players garnered NAIA All-America accolades, and two Grizzlies were selected in the 2019 Major League Baseball draft with Cam Coursey going in the 13th round to the Arizona Diamondbacks and Matthew Swain in the 23rd round to the Minnesota Twins.

In 2018 Stromdahl led GGC to a 50-12 record season and a berth in Avista-NAIA World Series. His 2016 squad won a school-record 57 games and climbed to No. 1 in the NAIA for the second straight year after opening the season with 25 straight wins, after his 2015 team, featuring NAIA Player of the Year Ty Abbott, earned the program's first No. 1 ranking. That team finished 50-14 with an offense that was No. 1 in the nation in stolen bases and No. 2 in runs scored and a pitching staff that led the NAIA in strikeouts.

Stromdahl guided Georgia Gwinnett to its first Avista-NAIA World Series in 2014, the program's second year of existence and first year of post-season eligibility and less than 10 years after the school opened its doors. The Grizzlies posted a 53-13 record with two wins over eventual NAIA champion Cumberland while leading the nation in triples and ranking second in 11 statistical categories, including runs scored (589), hits (723) and stolen bases (201). The squad reached No. 4 in the national poll before ending the year at No. 7, and Stromdahl was named Coach of the Year by the A.I.I., ABCA NAIA East Region and the Georgia Dugout Club. Eight players earned all-

conference honors with Tyler Carpenter named honorable mention All-America.

Carpenter was also one of three Grizzlies to be selected in the 2014 MLB Draft, going in the 25th round to the Los Angeles Angels. He was joined by 23rd-round picks John Fidanza (Arizona) and Zeke McGranahan (Baltimore).

Stromdahl was tabbed as Georgia Gwinnett's first head coach in the fall of 2011, and when the Grizzlies played their inaugural season in 2013, he directed a 30-win campaign, including two wins over ranked opponents.

During his five-year tenure as an assistant at Georgia State (2007-11), Stromdahl helped the Panthers average more than 35 victories over his final four seasons, highlighted by the 2009 Colonial Athletic Association title and NCAA Atlanta Regional berth--both firsts for the program--and a GSU-record 39 wins. He served as the hitting instructor for the most prolific offensive teams in GSU annals as the Panthers hit .300 or better in each of his five seasons, led by the 2010 squad that shattered nearly every offensive school record with a .356 batting average, a Division I-leading 10.5 runs per game and 82 home runs.

Before coming to Georgia State, Stromdahl spent three seasons at Central Michigan (2004-06), where his primary responsibilities were hitting instruction, working with infielders and assisting with recruiting. CMU made three straight appearances in the Mid-American Conference Tournament, including the MAC regular-season title in 2004 and a 42-18 record in 2005.

He spent one season at Marshall (2003) and four seasons at Division II Southwest Minnesota State (1999-02), his alma mater, while also coaching summer baseball in the Coastal Plains League (2004) and the Northwoods League (2006).

Stromdahl played collegiately for two seasons at Bethany Lutheran College in Mankato, Minn., and two seasons at Southwest Minnesota State before pursuing professional baseball. He received his bachelor's degree in business administration from SMSU in 2002 and then earned a master's in sports administration from Central Michigan.

Stromdahl, 44, grew up in Napa, Calif., before finishing high school in Minocqua, Wis. He is married to the former Tessa Rieger, and the couple has two sons, Leo William, born in 2011, and Hugo Walter, born in 2014.
