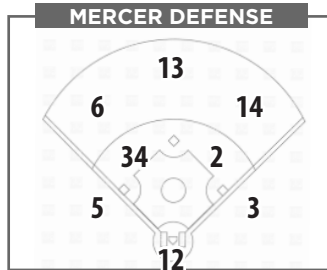

MERCER VS. GEORGIA TECH

- » Georgia Tech leads the all-time series with Mercer, 72-26.
- » The teams split the meetings in 2022.
- » Highlight wins for Mercer:
 - 2011 vs. No. 5 GT
 - 2011 vs. No. 9 GT
 - 2013 vs. No. 12 GT
 - 2014 vs. No. 23 GT
 - 2022 vs. No. 13 GT

IN THE NUMBERS

- » Ty Dalley leads the Southern Conference in home runs with 13. Eric Toth is tied for second at 12.
- » Trevor Austin ranks seventh in Division I among active players for games played (221) and 26th for hits (226).
- » Mercer is 13th in Division I for fielding percentage at .980. Only 20 schools are fielding .980 or above.
- » The Bears have turned 36 double plays this season which ranks 16th in Division I.
- » Mercer ranks 17th in Division I in home runs with 71 this season.
- » Treyson Hughes ranks 17th in Division I and first in the SoCon for runs scored with 52.
- » Wes Franklin ranks ninth in Division I and first in the SoCon for saves with eight this season.

PLAYER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- » Carter Sanford was named a *Collegiate Baseball* National Player of the Week and the SoCon Player of the Week on April 24 after batting .667 with four home runs and nine RBI.

PITCHER OF THE WEEK HONORS

- » RHP Josh Harlow was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week after striking out a career-high 11 batters against William & Mary.
- » RHP Josh Farmer was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week after throwing seven scoreless innings against Baylor.
- » LHP Colton Cosper was named SoCon Pitcher of the Week after striking out six in five scoreless innings against Western Carolina.

PLAYING IN-STATE PROGRAMS

- » Mercer will play every NCAA D1 in-state opponent but Georgia this season.
- » Mercer will have home-and-home matchups with Georgia Tech, Georgia Southern, Georgia State, and Kennesaw State throughout the season.

PLAYING POWER OPPONENTS

- » Mercer has Florida State, Baylor, Texas, and Georgia Tech on the schedule this season.
- » At the beginning of March, the Bears traveled to the Lone Star state for a midweek tie with Texas and a weekend series against Baylor.
- » A trip to Florida State is on the schedule as the last non-conference series of the year.

ONCE A BEAR, ALWAYS A BEAR

- » Former Mercer Bear, Kyle Lewis, was recently traded to the Arizona Diamondbacks from the Seattle Mariners
- » Lewis became the first Mercer Bear to be named the AL Rookie of the Year.
- » During his time as a Bear, Lewis racked up the accolades. He was a two-time SoCon Player of the Year. Following his 2016 season, Lewis was named the 2016 Golden Spikes Award winner.
- » Lewis is the only Bear to win the Golden Spikes Award.

BEARS IN THE NCAA TOURNAMENT

- » The Bears have made four NCAA Regional Appearances in program history.
- » The Bears made the NCAA Regionals during the 2010, 2013, 2015 and 2019 seasons.
- » The last win for the Bears in NCAA Regional play came against Elon on June 5, 2010. Mercer came away with a 13-7 victory.

#WINNERSWIN

- » Since joining the SoCon in 2015, Mercer has won three regular season titles ('15, '16, '17) and two tournament titles ('15, '19).
- » The 2019 season was the fourth trip to the SoCon Championship title game in five years as a league member. Mercer finished as runner-up to Western Carolina ('16) and Samford ('18).
- » Mercer's 198 overall wins and 74 SoCon wins since 2015 are the most among all league teams.
- » Mercer has captured three SoCon Player of the Year honors (Kyle Lewis, '15 & '16; Ryan Hagan, '17) and one SoCon Freshman of the Year accolade (RJ Yeager, '18).
- » Craig Gibson has been named SoCon Coach of the Year twice ('15, '17).

ALL-TIME WINS LEADER

- » On Friday, March 31, 2023 Mercer's Head Coach Craig Gibson won his 649th career against Western Carolina by a final score of 2-1.
- » With this win, Gibson passed Barry Myers as the winningest coach in Mercer baseball history.
- » Gibson joins Myers as the only two coaches to have over 600 career wins. Coach Myers has 648 wins in 26 seasons.

DEFENDING ORTHOGEORGIA PARK

- » Mercer hosts 34 regular-season games at OrthoGeorgia Park this season. Mercer has hosted at least 27 games each year since 2010.
- » The Bears' longest home stand this spring is 11 games (March 31 to April 16).
- » The program is 215-89 overall at home since the start of the 2012 campaign.

WINNING TRADITION



Mercer head coach Craig Gibson has built his alma mater into one of the nation's most consistent programs since taking over in 2004. Mercer is one of just three NCAA Division I programs to win at least 35 games in each of the past 12 full seasons (since 2010), joining the elite company of LSU and Vanderbilt.

With a philosophy based in the concepts of striving for excellence in the classroom, reaching out in the community and team achievement on the field, Mercer head coach Craig Gibson has led his alma mater to unparalleled success over 19 seasons at the baseball program's helm.

Since taking over for the legendary Barry Myers in 2004, Gibson (602-408) has guided the Bears from the depths of the Atlantic Sun Conference to the top of the Southern Conference, all while establishing Mercer as one of the most respected programs in the southeast. Consistency has become the standard under Gibson, as Mercer is one of just three NCAA Division I programs with 35 wins in each of the last 12 years, joining, LSU and Vanderbilt.

A large part of that success is due to the program's dominance at OrthoGeorgia Park at Claude Smith Field. The program is 215-89 overall at home since the start of the 2012 campaign, including a 24-4 mark in 2014 to rank seventh in the nation with a .857 winning percentage.

A total of 29 Bears have been taken in the MLB Draft since Gibson took over in 2004. None have been as prolific as Kyle Lewis, who won the 2016 Golden Spikes Award as the nation's top player before being selected with the 11th overall pick in the '16 draft by the Seattle Mariners.

There was no shortage of individual success for Gibson – who earned career victory No. 400 on March 1, 2016 – and Mercer in 2016, which was highlighted by Golden Spikes Award winner and consensus All-American Kyle Lewis' rise to stardom. Lewis became Mercer's highest draft selection, going at No. 11 overall to the Seattle Mariners. Gibson's mentorship helped the junior center fielder develop into one of college baseball's premier position players as he ranked among national statistical leaders in batting average (.395), bases on balls (66), hits (88), home runs (20), on-base percentage (.535), runs scored (70), RBIs (72) and slugging percentage (.731). Lewis became the most decorated student-athlete in Mercer University history as he captured his second straight SoCon Player of the Year honor, was named a Rawlings Gold Glove winner and earned five National Player of the Year recognitions from the likes of USA Baseball, Baseball America and the American Baseball Coaches Association (ABCA), among others.

The Bears have captured a number of program-defining victories over some of the nation's elite with Gibson at the helm. Mercer has secured 20 wins over ranked foes under Gibson's tenure including wins over No. 1 Florida (2006, 2018), No. 1 Clemson (2006), a two-game series sweep at No. 2 Miami (2007), a neutral-site win over No. 6 Ole Miss in the Coca Cola Classic (2009), a pair of wins vs. No. 6/9 Georgia Tech (2011), a three-game series sweep of No. 24 FGCU (2013), a three-game road sweep of No. 8 East Carolina (2017), and back-to-back midweek wins over No. 10 Florida State and No. 13 Georgia Tech (2022).

Gibson broke into the high school coaching scene in 1989 as the head baseball coach at Jupiter Community High School (Jupiter, Fla.). He held the role for two years before taking over at Suncoast Community High School (Riviera Beach, Fla.) for one season. Gibson concluded his prep coaching career in 1993 as the head coach at Palm Beach Gardens High School (Palm Beach, Fla.).

Gibson started his career at Mercer as a student-athlete, starring for the Bears on the baseball diamond while earning his bachelor's degree in history and health, physical education and recreation in 1986. A hard-hitting first baseman for the Bears, Gibson was named the Atlantic Sun Conference Player of the Year as a junior in 1985 while leading Mercer to the conference title. Gibson is one of only three Bears to earn ASUN Player of the Year honors. Following his playing career, Gibson served as a graduate assistant coach under Barry Myers for two years while earning his master's of education in social science in 1988.

A native of Macon, Ga., Gibson and his wife, Diane, have two children, Lindsey and Tyler.
