# TECH GOLF NOTEBOOK

## Quick Preview

In search of the 19th conference championship in program history, Georgia Tech's golf team begins post-season competition this weekend with the 69th Atlantic Coast Conference Men's Golf Championship, which will be conducted Friday through Monday (April 21-24) at the Country Club of North Carolina in Pinehurst, N.C.

The Yellow Jackets have captured 10 of the last 16 championships, most recently winning the 2019 title at the Old North State Club in New London, N.C. It was the 18th in program history, tying Wake Forest for the most in conference annals. The Demon Deacons won their 19th all-time title last year, edging the Jackets, 3-2, in the championship match in Panama City, Fla.

At No. 12 in the current Golfstat national rankings, Georgia Tech sits behind North Carolina (No. 2) and Florida State (No. 6) and is the No. 3 seed in the championship, which begins with 36 holes of stroke play on Friday. Virginia (No. 16) is the only other ACC team in the top 25 of the current Golfstat rankings, while defending champion Wake Forest (No. 29), Louisville (No. 30) and Duke (No. 35) reside inside the top 50. NC State (No. 53), Clemson (No. 54) and Notre Dame (No. 56) are just outside the top 50.

The Yellow Jackets are paired with the Tar Heels and Seminoles for the first two rounds on Friday, which begins at 7:30 a.m., utilizing split tees with continuous play through 36 holes of golf. The groups involving Tech, UNC and FSU begin play at 8:30 a.m. on the first tee. Saturday's third round tees off at 9 a.m., with pairing based on 36-hole scores.

In last year's ACC Championship, Tech finished second in the 54-hole stroke-play portion of the championship, then defeated Florida State, 3-1-1, to advance to the championship match. The Yellow Jackets finished second by eight strokes to North Carolina in the 54-hole stroke play portion of the championship, while Christo Lamprecht and Ross Steelman finished third and sixth, respectively, individually to lead the Jackets.

## Team Update

Tech has been ranked as high as No. 8 this spring in the Golfstat rankings, and currently sit No. 12 after logging two more runner-up finishes at the Linger Longer Invitational and The Goodwin. But the Jackets hold a season-high No. 6 spot in the Golfweek/Sagarin Index, having played the nation's 11th-toughest schedule with an 21-23-3 mark against the nation's top 25 teams by that measure.

Statistically, Tech ranks ninth nationally in average individual score, No. 2 in final-round scoring average, No. 10 in par-3 scoring, and No. 14 in par-4 and No. 17 in par-5 scoring.

Four of the five starters who teed it up for Tech in last year's ACC Championship are back for this edition. Heppler will field the same starting lineup that has competed in the Jackets' first four tournaments this spring, including All-American Christo Lamprecht and fifth-year senior Connor Howe, who are the only Yellow Jackets to be a part of the starting five for every event this year.

Lamprecht, a 6-8 junior from South Africa who is a semifinalist for the Ben Hogan Award, won the Inverness Invitational in the fall and has finished in the top 10 in each of Tech's four spring events, including runner-up finishes at the Watersound Invitational, Linger Longer Invitational and The Goodwin. Howe, from Ogden, Utah, has recorded top-10 finishes in Tech's last two events (Linger Longer Invitational, The Goodwin).

Also competing are freshman Hiroshi Tai of Singapore, a two-time winner in the fall (Maui Jim individual event, Golf Club of Georgia Collegiate), tied for ninth at Watersound for his best finish this spring; senior Ross Steelman (Columbia, Mo.), who has finished 12th or better in each of Tech's four spring events; and senior Bartley Forrester (Gainesville, Ga.), who tied for 14th at Watersound and 11th at The Goodwin.

Sophomore Benjamin Reuter (Naarden, The Netherlands), who has competed in five events this year and has a pair of top-10 finishes, is the Yellow Jackets' alternate player.

Lamprecht (No. 9) and Steelman (No. 18) and are Tech's top two players in the Golfstat rankings, while Lamprecht rates No. 5 and Steelman 13th in the Golfweek/Sagarin Index. Howe is listed among the top 100 in both rankings (No. 60 in Golfstat, No. 71 Golfweek/Sagarin).

## Tee Shots

- Three Tech players competed in the U.S. Amateur and all advanced to match play. Christo Lamprecht finished sixth in the 36-hole stroke play qualifier and advanced to the round of 32 in match play. Bartley Forrester, who also won the Monroe Invitational last summer, and Ross Steelman each tied for 39th in stroke play, with Forrester advancing to the round of 32 while Steelman lost his round of 64 match.

- Three Tech players competed for their home countries in the World Amateur Team Championship - Christo Lamprecht for South Africa, Benjamin Reuter for the Netherlands and Hiroshi Tai for Singapore.

- Tech played in the NCAA Championship for the 30th time since 1985, a number eclipsed by only four other programs in Division I.

- Tech has yet to record a victory in a stroke-play tournament in 2022-23, but has finished as a runner-up five times.

- Tech's current team stroke average of 280.38 (-3.62 in relation to par) would be the best in team history if maintained, and it ranks 12th in the nation. The current program record is 281.03, set in 2018-29, and last year's team holds the second-best mark at 281.59.

- All five Tech starters at the ACC Championship have stroke averages under 72.00, ranging from Christo Lamprecht's 69.21 to Hiroshi Tai's 71.92. Lamprecht's average is better than Bryce Molder's current Tech record of 69.43 set in 2001.

- Tech has compiled a 20-24-3 mark head-to-head against the nation's top 20 teams, according to Golfstat (22-23-3 against the top 25 according to the Golfweek/Sagarin Index), and is 66-24-3 against teams in the top 50, according to the Golfweek/Sagarin Index.

- Tech's five ACC Championship starters combined for 16 top-10 individual finishes.

- Statistically, Tech ranks ninth nationally in individual average score (71.09), second in final-round average (70.43), eighth in fewest bogeys per round (2.65).

- Tech may have one of the tallest teams in collegiate golf, with Christo Lamprecht at 6-foot-8, Bartley Forrester and Ross Steelman at 6-5 each, freshman Benjamin Reuter at 6-3 and Connor Howe at 6-2.

## Tech's ACC Championship History

Georgia Tech has won 18 ACC men's golf championships, putting the Yellow Jackets one behind Wake Forest for the most titles in conference history. Tech's titles have all come from 1985 to the present. Before the Demon Deacons outlasted the Jackets in the championship match in 2022, Wake Forest's most recent title came in 1989.

Tech has won the ACC Championship 10 times in the last 16 years, most recently in 2019. The 2020 ACC Tournament was not held after the 2020 spring season was cut short due to COVID-19.

Tech has won 13 of its conference titles under current head coach Bruce Heppler, 11 of those outright (1999, 2001, 2002, 2009, 2010, 2011, 2012, 2014, 2015, 2018, 2019) and two shared (2006, 2007). The Yellow Jackets won five championships (1985, 1991, 1992, 1993, 1994) under previous head coach Puggy Blackmon.

Twelve of Tech's ACC titles have been won at the Old North State Club in New London, N.C., site of the event 22 of the last 26 years. The first occurred in 1999 by 10 strokes over North Carolina and Duke. Tech won its 2018 crown without an individual finishing higher than 12th place.

Georgia Tech has produced 10 ACC individual champions, including Bob McDonnell (1985), David Duval (1991, 1993),

## Tech's NCAA Championship History

Georgia Tech has reached the NCAA Championship finals 30 times since 1985 (31 times in program history), which is tied for fifth most in that time period behind Oklahoma State (36), Arizona State (34), Florida (33) and Texas (33).

Tech has posted 16 top-8 finishes in the NCAA Championship, 11 of those since Bruce Heppler became the head coach.

The Yellow Jackets have qualified for match play four times since the advent of the stroke-play/match-play format in 2009, finishing third in 2010, second in 2011, second in 2013, fifth in 2014.

Tech lost to the eventual champion three times in its four appearances in match play - Augusta State by the score of 3-2 in the quarterfinals in 2010 and 2011 and to Alabama (3-0-2) in 2013.

Tech has been the runner-up in the NCAA Championship four times (1993, 2000, 2002 and 2005, all before the introduction of match play). Only Oklahoma State, which has 18, Texas (6) and Purdue (5) have more.

In 1993 and 2002, the Yellow Jackets led after 54 holes, but finished second by one shot to Florida in 1993, and by four shots to Minnesota in 2002.

In 2000, the Yellow Jackets rallied to tie Oklahoma State after 72 holes, but lost to the Cowboys on the first hole of a playoff. Tech and OSU matched the lowest 72-hole team score in NCAA Championship history (36-under-par 1,116) at the Grand National Lake Course in Opelika, Ala. In 2005, Tech finished 11 shots behind Georgia, and seven shots ahead of third-place Washington.

Three Tech players have won national collegiate championships. Troy Matteson did it most recently in 2002 at Ohio State. Watts Gunn (1927) and Charlie Yates (1934) won national titles under a match play format before the NCAA took sponsorship of the championship in 1939.

## Tech and NCAA Match Play

The 2009 NCAA Championship featured a new twist with the team champion determined via match play. The top eight teams after 54 holes of stroke play advance to a match play tournament format.

The NCAA added a fourth round of stroke play in 2016 for the top 15 teams and nine individuals not on those teams, after which the national individual champion and the top eight teams for match play will be determined.

Match play is a format that Bruce Heppler has supported vigorously. Under Heppler, Georgia Tech finished in the top eight of the NCAA Finals seven times in 10 tries under the 72-hole, stroke-play format. Tech is one of only two teams (Oklahoma State is the other) to have advanced to match play four times in the six years the current format has been in effect.

In the stroke-play/match play era, the Yellow Jackets have finished 10th, third, second, second and fifth, respectively, in the stroke-play portion of the NCAA Championship in five tries (Tech did not advance out of its regional in 2012 or 2016). Tech lost to the eventual national champion three of the four times it has qualified for match play (Augusta State in the 2010 and 2011 quarterfinals, Alabama in the 2013 semifinals).

Tech has had success in other match-play events in recent years, reaching the finals of the Callaway Collegiate Match Play Championship four times in six appearances.

## Georgia Tech Match Play History

While match play in college golf may be infrequent, Georgia Tech is no stranger to it, having participated in 10 regular season

match play events since 2000, as well as three times since the NCAA added match play to determine its champion, and once in the two years the Atlantic Coast Conference has implemented it as part of its format. Here is a history of Tech's participation.

Tech has a 26-14-1 record in match play since 2000, including a 1-4 mark in NCAA Championship matches and a 1-1 record in the ACC Championship.

## Tech in NCAA Regional Competition

Georgia Tech has advanced through an NCAA regional 26 times in 31 tries, and all but four times since the NCAA went to a six-regional qualifying format in 2009. Head coach Bruce Heppler's teams have won six regional tournaments overall, two of them shared titles, most recently in 2021, when the Yellow Jackets tied Oklahoma State.

The NCAA began using regional qualifying tournaments in 1989, first with the 81 teams split among three sites (27 teams each), then among six sites with either 13 or 14 teams each beginning in 2009. Since the NCAA went to six regional sites in 2009, Tech has advanced to the championship finals seven times - third in 2009 (Bowling Green, Ky.), third in 2010 (Milton, Ga.), tied for third in 2011 (Radford, Va.), fourth in 2013 (Tallahassee, Fla.), first in 2015 (Raleigh, N.C.), fourth in 2019 (Pullman, Wash.) and third in 2021 (Tallahassee, Fla.). No NCAA championship events were held in 2020 due to COVID-19.

Tech's first four victories all occurred in 27-team regionals in 1991 (New Haven, Conn.), 1998 (Daufuskie Island, S.C.), 1999 (Providence, R.I.) and 2002 (Roswell, Ga., tied with Clemson). The 2014 win in Raleigh and the 2021 victory in Columbus occurred in a 13-team field.

## Jackets to Add 1 for 2023-24

AJGA All-American Kale Fontenot of Lafayette, La., signed a national letter-of-intent to join Georgia Tech's golf team during the November signing period.

Fontenot earned honorable mention All-America honors by the American Junior Golf Association in early November following a 2022 year in which he captured one tournament victory and a pair of runner-up finishes in junior golf events. Fontenot is listed No. 31 in the Rolex AJGA Boys Rankings. He also is ranked No. 32 overall in the Junior Golf Scoreboard (No. 25 in the class of 2023), and No. 66 in the Golfweek Boys Rankings (No. 31 in

the class of 2023).

In six junior golf events in 2022, Fontenot notched runner-up finishes at the Stewart Cink Championship in Birmingham, Ala., and the 50th Southern Junior Championship in Charleston, S.C. He also tied for 15th at The PING Invitational in Stillwater, Okla., 16th at the Sam Burns at The Landings Club in Savannah, Ga., and 24th at the Insperty Invitational/Patrick Reed AJGA Junior Championship at The Woodlands, Texas. He qualified to play in the 2022 U.S. Amateur championship as the medalist at his qualifier in Shreveport, La.

Fontenot won the Louisiana Junior Amateur Championship in 2021 and 2022, and he helped Ascension Episcopal High School to the 2021 and 2022 Division III state titles in Louisiana, finishing third individually in each championship.

## Tech Golf APR Perfect Again

Bruce Heppler's golf program again earned a perfect four-year APR score of 1000 for the four-year period ending in the 2020-21 academic year in the NCAA's survey announced in May. The Yellow Jackets have earned a perfect four-year score every year since its inception in 2006, and has also received an APR Public Recognition Award every year. Among Power 5 conferences, Tech is one of two men's golf teams and 12 programs overall that have achieved the feat. Tech has scored a perfect 1,000 in the single-year APR for 18 straight years.

APR is an annual scorecard of academic achievement calculated for all Division I sports teams. It measures eligibility, graduation and retention each semester or academic term and provides a clear picture of the academic performance for each team in every sport.

## Heppler ACC Coach of the Year 10 times

Georgia Tech Bruce Heppler has been named ACC Coach of the Year 10 times in his 25-year tenure on The Flats. That is the most for one coach in conference history.

Tech won the Atlantic Coast Championship in April for the 18th time, matching Wake Forest for the most in conference history. The Yellow Jackets have won six tournaments altogether, more than any other Division I team in 2018-19, bringing to 59 the total number of titles earned by the Jackets under Heppler. He has coached Tech to 13 of its 18 ACC titles.

## **Bartley Forrester (Senior, Gainesville, Ga.)**
