Men's Basketball Season Parking Information

Season parking passes are available for renewal online or by calling 888.TECH.TIX or 404.894.5447. Since the renovation of McCamish Pavilion in 2012, the McCamish Parking lot (E65) has been assigned in the following order:

- 1. Golden Jackets with season tickets in priority point order
- 2. Courtside Season Ticket Holders in priority point order.
- 3. Society Members with season tickets in priority point order. 4. Remaining season ticket holder, in priority point order.

Important Dates to Remember

The parking renewal deadline is **June 30**. If you purchased a season parking pass in 2022-23, your lot location is listed on your renewal form and is only guaranteed as long as the minimum A-T Priority Point requirement (A-T Points as of June 30) is met for desired parking location and is paid in full or set up on a payment plan by the **June 30** deadline. If payment is taken after the **June 30** deadline your parking location from the previous season is no longer guaranteed. After **June 30**, <u>ALL</u> unpaid parking orders will be removed from our system to prepare for relocation and new order requests.

Processing of relocation requests and new parking orders will begin August 1st based on the minimum A-T Priority Point requirement for each lot and the subsequent A-T Priority Point order. Any requests received after this date will also be processed in A-T Priority Point order, subject to remaining availability in lots. Please note that several lots fill quickly during this time.

Minimum A-T Priority Point Requirements

ALL parking assignments will be completed according to Alexander-Tharpe Fund Priority Points. Please use the chart on the next page to make requests based on A-T Priority Point total. Please note that meeting the minimum A-T Priority Points requirement does not guarantee parking in these areas, only that you qualify to park there.

Golden Jackets

Courtside Season Ticket Holders

- Accounts with at least one (1) Courtside seat will receive one (1) complimentary parking pass in McCamish Lot
- One (1) McCamish pass is allotted per three (3) season tickets.
- If requested, Courtside Season Ticket Members who purchase four or more (4+) tickets may receive a second complimentary pass in the McCamish Lot.
- Courtside Season Ticket Members who are also Society Members, are eligible for a 3rd complimentary pass only if their account has six or more (6+) season tickets. The 3rd pass would be designated in a lot other than the McCamish Lot.

A-T Giving Societies (Former Life Members) of the Alexander-Tharpe Fund

- After all Courtside accounts are filled, Golden Jackets with season tickets will have one parking pass issued in McCamish Lot.
 - If a Golden Jacket has five or more (5+) tickets, they may purchase a second parking pass – but this pass is not guaranteed to be in the McCamish Lot.
- After Golden Jacket orders are filled, any remaining McCamish Lot spaces will be issues to Society Member Season Ticket Members in A-T Priority Point order.
 - If a Society Member purchases five or more (5+) tickets, they may purchase a second parking pass – but this pass is not guaranteed to be in the McCamish Lot.

Relocation Requests

Requesting a new parking pass or change in parking location:

To request a new parking pass or to relocate your parking location, you may list your preferences on your renewal application form prior to the **June 30** deadline. Please note the minimum A-T Priority Point requirements when you list your preferences to assist us as we work through the requests. If your preference is available, we will place you in that location for 2023-24

Season parking is allocated to any patron who renews or enrolls in the payment plan by the June 30 deadline and meets the minimum renewal point for that lot. The patrons with the highest number of A-T Priority points will have the best parking available on gameday. To accomplish this, point limits have been set within each lot so that we can guarantee parking for those returning patrons. You will still need to renew by the June 30 deadline in order to obtain your parking spot.

For those patrons who wish to relocate their season parking lot and/or change the total quantity of passes, the following procedures are followed:

- (a) If the parking pass is paid for by the **June 30** deadline and you do not indicate a wish to change parking locations, we will automatically return you to your 2022-23 parking location if there is space remaining in this lot when we reach you're A-T Priority Point level as we work down the renewal list.
- (b) If the parking pass is paid for by the June 30 deadline and you wish to change your parking location, we will automatically assign you to your first indicated choice if there is space remaining in this lot when we reach you're A-T Priority point level as we work down the renewal list. If your first choice is not available, we will relocate your parking into your second choice if designated.

Removing a Parking Pass

To remove a parking pass from your account, contact the Georgia Tech Ticket Office. Please note that we will remove any parking passes that are not renewed and paid for by the June 30 deadline to make room for those patrons requesting new and/or additional

parking passes. If you have multiple parking passes and wish to remove only one or a portion of your order, please contact the Georgia Tech Ticket Office.

ADA Parking

Everyone who parked in ADA parking areas in 2022-23 is guaranteed parking in the same area for 2023-24 if they renew by the **June 30** deadline. We will not remove your parking unless payment is not received by the **June 30** deadline. Once this date has passed, we will begin filling the remaining spaces in these areas with other ADA patrons that have requested to park in these locations. Please note that ADA placard and/or ADA parking permit must be displayed on game day.
