## NUMBERS TO KNOW

**11.3** Duke Baseball has tallied 527 strikeouts so far this season, a mark of 11.3 K/9. That number is fourth in the country and second in the ACC behind Wake Forest (12.0).

**1** Freshman **James Tallon** needs one save to tie the single season record of 11 set by **Kenny Koplove**.

**3.61** The Blue Devils pitching staff, anchored by young arms is posting a 3.61 ERA on the season, fourth in the country and second in the ACC.

## LEADING OFF

- Duke Baseball recorded 252 of its 390 runs scored so far this season from the fourth to eighth innings. That number accounts for 64.6% of the Blue Devils' runs this season.

- The Blue Devils have recorded 141 two-out RBI this season, accounting for 36.1% of the runs scored this season. Graduate transfer **MJ Metz** leads the team with 20 two-out RBI, followed closely by graduate transfer **Giovanni DiGiacomo** with 18.

- Duke Baseball held strong in the top-10 of the *D1 Baseball* poll on Monday morning, after playing just one game due to exam break. The No. 10 ranking is the second highest in program history, behind being ranked No. 9 at one point in the season in 2018. The Blue Devils were also tabbed No. 9 by *Baseball America* and No. 6 by *Collegiate Baseball*.

- Two of the most explosive offenses collide at the site of the ACC Tournament with a lot to play for this weekend. No. 10 Duke looks to solidify a spot in the ACC Tournament, hosted by the Durham Bulls Athletic Park, and remain in sole control of the Coastal Division lead. Georgia Tech enters play with a .328 average at the plate following a loss to Kennesaw State on Wednesday night. They are led by Kristian Campbell and Angelo Dispigna, both batting over .380 this season. Jackson Finely leads the long ball tally with 17 on the season and also posts a 2-4 record on the mound with a 4.98 ERA. No. 10 Duke has some power of its own, approaching the single season home run record. The Blue Devils have tallied 82 long balls this season and had their 15-game home run streak snapped on Wednesday against Rider. Junior **Alex Stone** continues to stay hot at the plate, posting a 21-game hitting streak that began on April 1 against Pittsburgh.

- Junior **Luke Storm** produced one of the biggest performances for No. 10 Duke on Sunday against Longwood, helping guide a come from behind victory in the bottom of the eighth inning. Duke scored eight runs, as Storm collected six of his seven RBI in the inning. The switch hitter produced a two-run home run and a grand slam to lift Duke to a 13-9 victory.

- Duke pitching is having one of the best historical seasons under head coach Chris Pollard, producing 527 strikeouts this season. The number moves into a tie with the 2021 squad that also posted 527 strikeouts. The mark is now tied for fourth all-time in a single season, behind 2019 (598), 2018 (575), 2022 (563) and 2021 (527).

## TALLON MOVES UP THE LIST

Freshman closer **James Tallon** has been nearly untouchable as the Blue Devils back end arm. On Wednesday, the southpaw collected his 10 save of the season, moving into a tie for 2nd all-time in a single season and 12th all-time in his career. The program record for a single season was set by **Kenny Koplove** (11) in 2015. Tallon was recently named to the Stopper of the Year Watch List by the NCBWA.

## CONTROL YOUR DESTINY IN THE COASTAL

With a half game lead in the Coastal division, Duke baseball controls its own destiny for the two-seed in the ACC Tournament. Both Miami and Duke have off weekends from conference play this week, before heading back into ACC play May 12-14. The Hurricanes travel to Pittsburgh to take on a surging Panthers squad, while Duke welcomes Georgia Tech to town for an ACC tilt. The Blue Devils and Hurricanes meet in Coral Gables, Fla., the final weekend of year to determine the Coastal division crown.

## BOMBS AWAY

Duke Baseball has been destroying the cover off the baseballs, crushing 82 home runs this season. That mark is 24th nationally and is on pace to break the single season team record of 90 home runs. The 82 round trippers are third most in a single season for Duke and the most under head coach **Chris Pollard**.

## THE MARGINS AREN'T CLOSE

Duke Baseball has put up video game numbers this season, both on the mound and at the plate. In the 33 games that the Blue Devils have won, they have outscored their opponents by a combined 240 runs. On the flip side, The Blue Devils have lost their 13 contests by a combined run total of 49. Duke had its first margin of victory greater than four runs on Friday night against Pitt, when the Panthers defeated Duke 13-1. The only other margin of victory greater than four this season was at No. 13 Virginia on Saturday, where Duke fell 10-2.

## GET THROUGH THE SIXTH WITH THE LEAD

Duke Baseball improved to 26-0, 27-0 and 30-0 respectively when leading after the sixth, seventh and eighth innings this season.

## 17th MULTI-HIT GAME FOR THREE?

Sophomore **Alex Mooney** led the team for the longest stretch in multi-hit games with 17, before junior's **Alex Stone** and **Jay Beshears** closed the gap. The trio at the top of the lineup all have 17 multi-hit games, while Stone and Beshears both have one game with four hits.

## STONE AND BESHEARS RBI MACHINES

Junior's **Jay Beshears** and **Alex Stone** continue to produce at the top of the order for the Blue Devils this season. Beshears, an impact transfer according to DIBaseball earlier this season, and Stone have tallied 15 multi-RBI contests this season. That mark is four clear of **Alex Mooney** with 11. Both Stone (50) and Beshears (47) are now creeping towards the top-10 single season RBI list, approaching **Griffin Conine** for 10th place with 56. The school record was set by **Ed Corey** with 76 in 1998.

## LAST TEN STAND OUT

Two Blue Devils have shined over the past 10 games, as Duke Baseball is 8-2 during that stretch. Junior **Alex Stone** (.378) and junior **Jay Beshears** (.366) have both posted averages above .360 during that span. Stone is slashing .378/.689/.429 during that span, while Beshears is slashing .366/.463/.469.

## STONER HITS HISTORIC MARK

Junior backstop **Alex Stone** was named to the 2023 Buster Posey Catcher of the Year Watch List earlier this season by the Wichita Sports Commission and has since heated up down the stretch. After starting the season slow, Stone has posted a .359 average in his last 21 games, collecting a hit in each of those contests. He has added five doubles and eight home runs during that stretch, tallying 28 RBI, while homering in all three games against No. 13 Virginia to guide Duke to its third-straight top-15 ACC series victory.

## HISTORIC APRIL UNDER POLLARD

Duke Baseball posted a historic April under head coach **Chris Pollard**, finishing the month 15-3 with nine top-15 victories and three top-15 series victories. It was the best month under Pollard and lifted Duke to No. 10 in the country in just two weeks of being ranked.

## STRIKEOUTS ARE SKYROCKETING

Duke Baseball has skyrocketed up the national and league standings in strikeouts the past month, tallying 527 total punchouts. That number is tied for fourth all-time in a single season and fourth most under Pollard. The mark is fourth nationally and second in the league, behind only Wake Forest.

## UNDEFEATED WHEN SCORING 10+

The Blue Devils have been lights out when scoring 10 or more runs in a contest this season, improving to 16-0 on Sunday afternoon against Longwood. Duke scored nine runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to defeat Longwood 13-9 to begin the month of May.

## HEALY PERFECT IN APRIL

Freshman **Andrew Healy** was named to the Dick Howser Trophy Player of the Month for April on Wednesday, after a perfect 5-0 record and a 0.00 ERA. Healy walked just three batters and struck out 23 in his five appearances. Opponents had an average of .169 off the lefty in April.

## HARD HATS AND THE FIRE EXTINGUISHER

Duke Baseball enjoys to be within themselves and have a good time. When the Blue Devils score a run, the entire dugout chants "HOUSE" and the hard hat comes out to signify the blue collar job someone has done to produce a hard earned run. "Pack a Lunch" is another key phrase thrown around the program, dating back to the early days of construction. The old school lunchbox signifies the job blue collar workers do, packing a lunch and working on the fly. A new addition as of late for the Duke program is the fireman helmet. The helmet is awarded to a pitcher who comes into dirty innings and extinguishes the opponent to calm down the game.

## HE GOT THE CALL

On Thursday afternoon, former Blue Devil **Matt Mervis** joined **Marcus Stroman** in the big leagues, getting the call up from the Iowa Cubs to the Chicago Cubs. Mervis had produced six home runs in his first 24 games of the season in triple-A, after a historic minor league climb in 2022. The addition of Mervis to the Duke MLB Alumni tallying brings the number to 44.

The Washington, D.C., native is the first former Blue Devil to reach the big leagues since James Marvel made his debut on September 8, 2019.

## RECORD SEASON FOR THE DEVS

On top of the two key milestones to watch this season for Duke, the Blue Devils are on track to rewrite the record book in a big way. At this current point, Duke has top-10 marks in a single season in slugging, on base percentage, runs scored, home runs, RBI, walks, saves, shutouts, fewest hits allowed, fewest runs allowed, earned runs allowed, average against and strikeouts.

## 40 WINS IS IN SIGHT

Duke Baseball has never won 40 games in a regular season in its 131 year history, but that number is in sight. With just seven regular season games to play, the Blue Devils need to win out to accomplish the feat. The school record for victories in a season was set at 45 by the 2018 squad who went to the Lubbock Super Regional, before falling to Texas Tech.

**GOW 'BOUT THAT:** *Alex Gow* was lights out against No. 9 East Carolina on Tuesday last week, working four innings of no-hit baseball. Gow struck out two batters and held an explosive ECU offensive hitless, before handing the ball off to talented freshman *Owen Proksch*.

**NEW GUY ON THE BLOCK:** Gow arrives in Durham after a successful career at Kenyon University, where he was a two-way star for the Owls. The righty finished his career with a 3.55 ERA and collected 198 strikeouts along the way. His 152.0 innings on the mound were highlighted by 66.2 and 99 strikeouts his senior season in 2022. During that career campaign, Gow recorded a 7-1 record in his 10 starts and opponents batted .223 off him.

**TWO-WAY PRODUCT:** The two-way star out of California not only held a sub 3.60 ERA at Kenyon, but also produced a career average at the plate of .335. Gow accumulated 424 at bats, driving in 84 total runs and collecting 40 extra-base hits.

**STELLAR SENIOR SEASON:** The North Coast Athletic Conference Pitcher of the Year and 2nd Team All-Region Utility recipient, had the best season on the mound of his career, dialing up a 7-1 record in 10 starts and producing 1.75 ERA in 66.2 innings of work. He tallied 99 strikeouts, a career-high, and allowed just 17 walks. Gow worked four complete games in 2022, including striking out 13 against Wabash College on April 10, 2022.

**Chris Pollard** became Duke University's 25th head baseball coach in June 2012, taking the reigns of the Blue Devil program after successful stints at Pfeiffer University and Appalachian State University.

**Pollard at Duke Notables:**

- In addition to guiding the Blue Devils to six straight 30-win seasons, Pollard led Duke to an at-large bid to the 2016 NCAA Tournament, ending the program's 55-year drought without making the postseason event.
- Pollard became the fastest Duke head coach to reach 100 wins with the Blue Devils, recording his 100th victory at Duke on March 15, 2016 against Maryland Eastern Shore.
- In 2021, Pollard became the first coach in Duke history to reach 100 career ACC wins, one of six active coaches to achieve the mark.
- Duke reached the NCAA Super Regional in 2018 and 2019 and NCAA Tournament three consecutive years (2018, 2019 and 2021) for the first time in program history.
- Pollard led the Blue Devils to capture the 2021 ACC Baseball Championship title, the first ACC title in 60 seasons and the first in the current tournament format.
- During Pollard's tenure at Duke he has helped produce 36 Major League Baseball Draft selections, 16 All-ACC picks, four Freshman All-Americans and three All-Americans.
