STARTING LINEUP

The Panthers head south to Atlanta to face the Georgia Tech Yellow Jackets in a crucial three-game ACC set. With the Panthers up one game on the Yellow Jackets in the ACC standings, and a possible trip to the ACC Championships in Durham, NC on the line, this series could have massive implications.

Pitt has won three of their last four games, but most recently coming off a loss at No. 12 West Virginia. Georgia Tech is currently on a five-game winning streak, with wins over Miami, Gardner-Webb, and Mercer.

BACKYARD BRAWL

The Panthers fell to No. 12 West Virginia 10-0 in seven innings at West Virginia on Wednesday. The Mountaineers scored at least one run in each of the first four frames. **Noah Martinez** (2-3, 2 singles), **Jack Anderson** (1-1, 2 BB), and **Sky Duff** (1-4) all recorded hits for Pitt. The Panthers had runners in scoring position multiple times throughout the ballgame, but did not have the timely hitting to get runs on the board.

SETTING RECORDS AND CHASING MORE

Sky Duff worked a walk in the eighth inning of their series finale win over Notre Dame, the 149th of his Pitt tenure, setting the program's new career record. His career total now stands at 163.

With his double in the series-opener against Cal, **Sky Duff** tied John Shultz (2008-11) for Pitt's career doubles record with 53 doubles. He is now only one double shy of becoming the career doubles benchmark for Pitt baseball. This season, Duff is the team leader in runs scored with 46 and is tied for the team lead in doubles with 14.

TERRIFIC TRANSFER

A transfer from Central Connecticut State, **Noah Martinez** has made a massive impact for the Panthers this season. Martinez is leading the team in hits (50) and RBIs (42) and is sole second in on base percentage (.457), batting average (.314), and home runs (9). He has the most single-season walks (42) by a first year Panther in Pitt Baseball history.

HESS HASN'T MISSED A BEAT

After missing the first 12 games of the year with an injury, **Kyle Hess** has made an impact since his return to the lineup. Hess sports a team-best .325 batting average, ranks second in slugging percentage (.575) and fourth in hits (40). His four triples lead the team, and put him in a tie for first in all of the ACC.

PANTHERS SEND PAC-12 PACKING AS THEY SWEEP CAL

Pitt swept California in their three-game set, outscoring the Golden Bears 29-14 throughout the weekend. The Panthers had back-to-back starters have single-game career highs in strikeouts, **Logan Evans** struckout 10 batters on Saturday and **Kyle Mosley** struckout seven batters on Sunday.

Many Panthers found success at the plate this weekend. Jack Anderson led the way with two three-hit games, he finished with 4 RBI, 3 doubles, and 1 BB. **Noah Martinez**, **CJ Funk**, **Kyle Hess**, and **Jayden Melendez** all had four-hit weekends. Funk and Melendez each had a three-hit game of their own in the series finale. Funk reached base in all five plate appearances on Sunday, going 3-3 with 3 RBI and 2 walks. Melendez went 3-5 with 2 RBI Sunday afternoon, he kickstarted his tremendous weekend at the dish by hitting a grand slam in Friday's series opener.

NOTES

THEY GET ON BASE

Two Panthers have double-digit reached base streaks going. **Sky Duff** has reached base in each of the last 26 games while **Noah Martinez** has a 17 game on base streak of his own. **Jack Anderson** has failed to reach base in just one game this season, reaching safely in 41 of 42 games so far this year.

SERIES OPENING SHUTOUT WIN AGAINST NO. 2 WAKE FOREST

The Panthers opened up their series against No. 2 Wake Forest with a shutout victory last Friday night, winning 3-0. Pitt's pitching staff dominated on the mound in game one behind the likes of **Jack Sokol**, **Dylan Simmons**, and **Nash Bryan**.

Friday starter **Jack Sokol** went five strong innings, allowing no runs on three hits while striking out two. **Dylan Simmons** was the bridge from starter to closer that the Panthers needed out of the bullpen, he threw three innings in relief and only surrendered two hits. **Nash Bryan** came on in the ninth to shut the door on the Demon Deacons and earned his fifth save of the year.

Pitt hit multiple home runs in a game for the 18th time this year as **Jayden Melendez** and **Justin Acal** both hit solo shots in the early innings. Acal finished the day 3-3 and made a diving stop up the middle in the late innings to add to his spectacular day.

BELL EARNS MILESTONE VICTORY

In their series opening win against No. 2 Wake Forest, head coach **Mike Bell** earned his 100th win as Pitt's skipper, and the 100th of his career.

MULTIPLYING HOMERS

Pitt has hit multiple home runs in 19 games this year. The Panthers have hit at least three home runs in a game five times this year, including a season-high four against Virginia Tech on March 25.

A total of nine Panthers have hit multiple home runs on the season so far, with **CJ Funk** (12), **Noah Martinez** (9), **Justin Acal** (8), and **Jayden Melendez** (7) leading the way.

WALK THIS WAY

Pitt has worked 260 walks on the season, they rank 15th in the country. **Noah Martinez** is third in all of the ACC and 15th in the country with his 42 walks. **Jack Anderson** is second on the team and 5th in the ACC with 41 walks, while **CJ Funk** and **Sky Duff** are right behind him, with 39 walks a piece, ranking them sixth in the ACC.

WE'VE GOT THE FUNK

CJ Funk has shown both power and patience at the plate this season. He leads Pitt with 12 home runs, a .632 slugging percentage, and 96 total bases. He sits second on the team in RBI (39), tied for second in walks (39), while his on base percentage of .448 is good for third best. His 12 multi-RBI games are a team high.

A PAIR OF JACKS

Jack Anderson has his name in the top five of several statistical categories for the Panthers this season. He leads the team in on base percentage (.467), is second on the team in hits (45), third in batting average (.304), fourth in RBI (30), and ranks sixth in home runs (5). Anderson had a 37 game on base streak prior to the series finale against Wake Forest.

Jack Sokol has struck out at least five batters in six of his starts this season and has fanned at least nine in three of those games, including a season-high 10 in seven innings against Mount St. Mary's earlier this month. Sokol's 58 strikeouts this season are a team high and ranks him thirteenth in the ACC. He ranks ninth in the ACC in strikeouts looking with 19.

THRIVING OUT OF BULLPEN

Nash Bryan, **Matthew Fernandez** and **Dylan Simmons** have been impactful arms out of the bullpen for Pitt this season.

Bryan leads the team in wins (5) and saves (6) and owns a 3.41 ERA. He has struck out 38 while giving up just 12 earned runs on 30 hits and 10 walks over a team-high 21 appearances and 31.2 innings. His six saves have him sitting sixth in the ACC for saves.

Fernandez has made 16 appearances, striking out 49 batters over 40.0 innings. Simmons has fanned 46 over 17 appearances in 30.0 frames.

OFF TO A GOOD START

Freshman **AJ Nessler** was off to a strong start to his collegiate career before a hit by pitch to his hand against Notre Dame sidelined him, likely for the season. At the time of his injury, Nessler was third on the team in batting average (.293), third in RBI (28) and fifth in on base percentage (.407) and hits (29).

SERIES WIN AT NO. 7 VIRGINIA

The Panthers found themselves down early in both of their wins against Virginia, battling

back and ultimately coming out victorious. Pitt would use the long ball against Virginia as they hit five home runs on the weekend. **Justin Acal** lead the way for the Panthers as he went on to hit two two-run home runs, while **CJ Funk**, **Kyle Hess**, and **Noah Martinez** added to their home run totals, each hitting solo shots.

RHP **Logan Evans** won game two of the series, improving his record to 2-1. After surrendering a three-run home run to the third batter of the game, Evans would retire 21 of the next 25 batters he faced, striking out nine in the process. He finished with a final line of 7 IP, 4 H, 3 ER, 9 K.

Graduate Student **Kyle Hess** hit .455 and recorded seven hits in the series. He would hit a home run in game three, knocking in six runs in total on the weekend.

PITT BATTLES BACK TO TAKE SERIES FINALE FROM NOTRE DAME

Pitt dropped the first two games of its ACC series against Notre Dame last weekend at Charles Cost Field, losing the first two games by scores of 10-8 and 11-2. In the Saturday series finale, Pitt scored six runs in the bottom of the eighth inning to overcome the Fighting Irish, 9-5.

The Panthers faced a 5-2 deficit heading into the bottom of the seventh. Noah Martinez drew a two-out walk and later scored on a base hit to right by Kyle Hess to make it a two-run ballgame.

Nash Bryan then struck out a pair of Notre Dame batters in the top of the eighth, including a punch out that came after a single by the Fighting Irish put a runner on with two outs.

Pitt kicked its rally into full gear in the home half of the eighth. Making his first collegiate start, Caleb Sturtevant got it started with a two-out double down the left field line. Sky Duff then coaxed a walk, the 149th of his Pitt tenure to set the program's new career record. Brett Heckert followed with a pinch-hit single to left that scored Sturtevant and cut the deficit to one for the Panthers. Martinez then tied the game with a single to right that plated Duff. Pitt wasn't done yet, however, as Jack Anderson blasted a three-run home to center to put the Panthers in front. Hess then followed with a homer to right, giving Pitt a four-run advantage going into the ninth.

Bryan then locked down the victory for Pitt by getting the Fighting Irish to ground into a double play after a leadoff single and then inducing a game ending fly out to center after Notre Dame had put a runner on base by way of a Pitt error.

Four Panthers put together multi-hit efforts in the victory. Martinez posted a 3-for-4 afternoon that included a double, a walk, an RBI and two runs scored. Hess collected three hits, including a double and his third home run of the season, to go along with two RBI and two runs scored. Funk added a single to go along with his home run, and Sturtevant recorded the first multi-hit game of his career by finishing 2-for-4 with a double and a run scored.

On the mound, Logan Evans gave Pitt a strong start, striking out four over 6.1 innings. Bryan then worked 2.2 scoreless frames of relief and struck out three on his way to his fifth pitching win of the season, improving to 5-2 on the year.

PITT PICKS UP ROAD WIN AT YOUNGSTOWN STATE

Jayden Melendez and **Sky Duff** each hit two-run home runs to highlight a 13-7 victory for Pitt over Youngstown State Tuesday at Eastwood Field.

Eight of the nine hitters in Pitt's lineup collected a hit in the victory, with **Kyle Hess** leading the way by way of a 2-for-5 performance that included a triple, two RBI, a walk and a run scored. **CJ Funk**, **Justin Acal** and **Anthony LaSala** each collected a double to help the Panthers tally six extra-base knocks on the day. Pitt amassed 14 walks in the win, with **Jack Anderson** coaxing four of them and Funk drawing three.

PANTHERS LOSE TWO OF THREE AT DUKE

Pitt dropped two of three games at Duke last weekend. After taking the series opener by a score of 13-1, the Panthers suffered losses of 11-7 and 8-0 in the final two games.

The series opener saw **Jack Anderson** hit two home runs and **CJ Funk** hit another to help muscle Pitt past Duke. Anderson accounted for four of Pitt's 13 hits, going 4-for-6 with a three-run homer and a two-run round-tripper. Eight of Pitt's nine starters in the lineup collected a hit. **Anthony LaSala** finished with a double and a single while **Noah Martinez** hit a pair of singles.

PITT DROPS MIDWEEK GAME AT PENN STATE

Pitt fell to host Penn State, 16-8, last Tuesday at Medlar Field at Lubrano Park in University Park, Pa. **Johnny Long III** led Pitt at the plate with a 3-for-5 effort that included a pair of RBI.

NOTES

SERIES VICTORY OVER VIRGINIA TECH

Pitt took two of three games from Virginia Tech at Charles Cost Field to earn its first ACC series win of the 2023 season. The Panthers won the series opener, 5-4, then bounced back from a 20-12 defeat in game two with another 5-4 victory in the series finale. Pitt took a series from the Hokies for the first time since sweeping Virginia Tech at home in 2017.

Both victories were of the comeback variety as the Panthers rallied from a 4-3 deficit in the seventh inning on Friday, then came back from down 4-0 on Sunday. Pitt's seventh-inning rally on Friday saw **Jack Anderson** deliver a game tying single and **Justin Acal** draw a bases-loaded walk for the go-ahead run. Sunday's comeback was started by a home run by **Johnny Long III** in the fifth. **CJ Funk** tied the game in the eighth with his team leading eighth home run of the season, then **Sky Duff** drove in what proved to be game winner with an RBI double.

The Panthers finished the weekend with six home runs. **Noah Martinez** hit .417 in three games, matching Duff for the team lead with five hits. Duff finished the weekend with a double, his first home run of the season and three RBI. Acal hit .333 with a pair of homers on Saturday - his second two-home run game of the year - and drove in five runs on the weekend.

Nash Bryan was strong out of the bullpen, making a pair of appearances without allowing a run, a hit or a walk in 2.2 innings. He earned the win on Friday and picked up the save Sunday. He is now 4-2 on the year with a pair of saves. **Jonathan Bautista** gave Pitt 3.1 innings out of the pen on Sunday, striking out four. **Dylan Simmons** fanned five in three innings in his lone appearance on the mound on the weekend in Friday's win.

PANTHERS EARN MIDWEEK WIN OVER KENT STATE

CJ Funk, **AJ Nessler** and **Jack Anderson** provided Pitt with three home runs en route to an 8-3 victory over Kent State last Wednesday at Charles Cost Field.

Holden Phelps gave Pitt a strong start on the mound, striking out four in three innings of work.

The Panthers went in front in the fourth inning on Funk's two run home run to center. The round tripper was Funk's team leading seventh of the season. Pitt tacked on three more runs in the sixth as Nessler blasted a three-run home run to center to make it a 5-1 lead for the Panthers.

The middle innings saw relievers **Logan Evans**, **Kyle Mosley** and **Matthew Fernandez** provide Pitt with four scoreless frames. Evans struck out two of the four batters he faced. Mosley permitted just one walk. Fernandez went two innings and fanned one.

Kent State cut into the Pitt lead with a two-run home run in the eighth, but the Panthers put the game out of reach in the home half courtesy of Anderson belting a three-run homer over the wall in left center.

Nash Bryan then came on to pitch the ninth and struck out the side to end the game.

PITT DROPS LONE GAME AGAINST NORTH CAROLINA

Pitt dropped a 17-7 decision to North Carolina last weekend. The game concluded on Saturday after being suspended Friday after four innings of play due to weather conditions. Games two and three of the series were canceled due to weather conditions.

North Carolina pounded out 17 runs on 19 hits in the series opening victory, including six home runs. The Tar Heels put up multiple runs in five innings, including three in the second, four in the third and five in the fifth.

Noah Martinez, **Johnny Long III** and **Tommy Tavarez** led Pitt with two hits apiece. Tavarez recorded his team leading sixth multi-hit game of the year. **CJ Funk** hit a two-out solo home run in the bottom of the first inning while **Kyle Hess** belted his second home run of the season - a two run shot to right center in the bottom of the third.

PITT WRAPS UP FIRST WEEKEND OF ACC PLAY WITH WIN OVER FLORIDA STATE

Kyle Hess hit a two-run home run in the sixth inning to help lift Pitt to its first ACC win of the 2023 season with an 8-6 victory over No. 21-ranked Florida State in Tallahassee. The game entered a lightning delay with one out in the bottom of the eighth and was ultimately called as final after seven innings.

Trailing 6-5 entering the top of the sixth inning, the Panthers put together a three-run frame to take the lead and ultimately win the game. **Justin Acal** drew a one-out walk, then stole second base. One out later, Acal scored on a single to right field by **Johnny Long III**, who advanced to second on a Florida State fielding error on the play. That set the stage for Hess to hit his first home run of the season, a two-run blast over the wall in center field.

Matthew Fernandez worked around a leadoff walk to retire the Seminoles in the home half of the sixth. **Jonathan Bautista** then came on in the seventh and forced Florida State

to strand two runners. Fernandez struck out five in four innings of relief while Bautista fanned one in one scoreless inning of work. Fernandez was credited with the win to improve to 1-2 on the year. Bautista earned his first save of the season.

PANTHERS FALL AT SOUTH FLORIDA

Holden Phelps put together a strong start on the mound, but Pitt ultimately fell to South Florida, 2-1.

In his second start as a Panther, Phelps struck out a season-high seven over 5.2 innings of work. He retired the first 14 batters he faced and 16 of the first 17 before running into a jam in the bottom of the sixth inning. He gave way to **Quin Konuszewski**, who got a strikeout to end the inning. **Matthew Fernandez** then gave Pitt two scoreless innings of relief, permitting just one hit and one walk.

Noah Martinez homered to right center for his team leading sixth round tripper of the year in the top of the first for Pitt's lone run of the game.

PITT SPLITS FOUR GAMES IN DELAND

The third weekend of the 2023 season saw Pitt finish with a split of four games in DeLand, Fla., as it began its spring break trip. The Panthers split a pair of games against both Mount St. Mary's (L, 7-4; W, 10-2) and host Stetson (L, 6-5; W, 9-2).

Noah Martinez led Pitt's bats, slashing a team-best .471/.882/.526 and leading the squad in runs (6), hits (8) and total bases (15) while tying for the team lead in home runs (2) and tying for second in RBI (4). **AJ Nessler** continued the strong start to his rookie campaign, driving in a team-high five runs. In just his third game as a Panther, **Justin Acal** hit a pair of homers in the win over Mount St. Mary's.

Pitt's pitching staff saw several strong performances, led by right-hander **Jack Sokol**, who tallied 10 strikeouts in the 10-2 win over Mount St. Mary's. **Erubiel Candelario** worked five innings and permitted just one earned run on two hits and four walks while striking out one in the 9-2 victory over Stetson. **Brady Devereux** worked 3.1 scoreless innings of relief while **Dylan Simmons** fanned five in two appearances and 3.1 scoreless innings while allowing just one hit and one walk. **Nash Bryan** struck out four over two appearances and 3.2 innings, including a 1-2-3 ninth inning in the win over Stetson. **Jonathan Bautista** made two appearances and fanned three in 2.2 frames. **Matthew Fernandez** struck out seven in four innings of relief in the loss to Mount St. Mary's. He struck out four batters in the sixth inning.

OPENING UP THE HOME SCHEDULE WITH A 'W'

The Panthers rallied late with a five-run eighth inning to beat Bucknell, 11-8, in the 2023 home opener at Charles Cost Field.

CJ Funk led Pitt at the plate with a 3-for-4 effort that included a grand slam in the third inning. In his first game and start as a Panther, **Justin Acal** collected a pair of hits. **Dylan Simmons** struck out four over 1.1 frames of relief. **Quin Konuszewski** was credited with the pitching victory. **Nash Bryan** came on to close things out in the top of the ninth and got a strikeout swinging and a strikeout looking to end the game. He earned his first save as a Panther. **Holden Phelps** made his first start on the mound as a Panther and struck out four in four innings of work.

PITT TAKES WEEKEND SERIES FROM HARVARD IN PORT CHARLOTTE

Pitt earned a 3-1 series win over Harvard in Port Charlotte, Fla. The Panthers won game one, 12-10, in dramatic fashion on a walk-off grand slam by **Noah Martinez**. Pitt bounced back from an 8-4 setback in the first game of a Saturday doubleheader to beat the Crimson in seven innings, 11-3, in the second game of the twin bill. The Panthers clinched the series victory in the Sunday finale courtesy of a 17-7 triumph in eight innings.

On the weekend, Pitt hit .318 as a team with 17 extra-base hits, including 10 doubles, two triples and five home runs over the four-game set.

Four Panthers hit .375 or better on the weekend, led by freshman **AJ Nessler**. Nessler led the Panthers in batting average (.471), slugging percentage (.765), hits (8) and triples (2). He registered multiple hits in all three of Pitt's wins over the Crimson, starting with a 2-for-4 effort that included a triple, a walk, an RBI and a run scored in the Friday comeback. In the second game of the Saturday doubleheader, he finished 3-for-4 with another triple, drove in a run and scored another in an 11-3 victory. Nessler finished the weekend off by going 2-for-5 with a double, two RBI and a run scored in the 10-run Sunday victory.

HOMER HAPPY

The Panthers finished the weekend series with Harvard having gone deep five times - including a pair of grand slams. In addition to **Noah Martinez's** game-winning grand slam in the series opener, **Jack Anderson** hit one to break the game open in the Sunday finale. Martinez homered again in the second game of the Saturday doubleheader against the Crimson. **CJ Funk** went deep to set the tone in the Saturday twin bill, while **Jayden Melen-**

dez hit his first home run as a Panther in the Sunday finale.

PITT OPENS 2023 AGAINST MAINE

Pitt opened its 2023 campaign with a three-game set against Maine in Sarasota. The Panthers edged the Black Bears, 11-10, on Opening Day before dropping the final two games of the series by scores of 11-7 and 8-5.

MAKING THEIR DEBUTS

The Panthers saw 16 players make their Pitt debuts in the series against Maine.

A pair of freshmen found their way into the starting lineup in **Anthony LaSala** (second base) and **AJ Nessler** (left field) for all three games. LaSala came up big at the plate in his first career start in the 11-10 Opening Day win over the Black Bears, going 3-for-4 with two RBI and two runs scored to help key the victory for Pitt. Nessler finished the weekend with a team-high six RBI and smacked his first collegiate home run in Saturday's 11-7 loss to Maine.

Noah Martinez, a transfer from Central Connecticut State, started all three games at first base. He went 1-for-3 with a pair of RBI in the season opener, then crushed his first home run as a Panther in the 8-5 loss.

Sophomore catcher **Jayden Melendez**, a transfer from Florida International, made his first start at Pitt behind the dish on Saturday. Freshman **Carlos Martinez** and graduate student **Brett Heckert**, a transfer from Allegheny College, both saw action as pinch hitters while freshman **Caleb Sturtevant** made his collegiate debut as a defensive replacement on Opening Day.

Nine new faces took to the mound on the season's opening weekend.

A trio of transfers - **Kyle Mosley** (Hill College), **Ethan Firoved** (Tallahassee Community College) and **Erubiel Candelario** (Marist College) - made up the starting rotation. Mosley and Candelario both struck out five in their Pitt debuts. Out of the bullpen, six transfers saw action against Maine, including **Holden Phelps** (Missouri), **Zack Oswald** (Harford Community College), **Matthew Fernandez** (Miami Dade Community College), **Nash Bryan** (Seton Hill), **Dylan Simmons** (Florida State) and **Jack Sokol** (Pensacola State). Phelps worked 3.1 innings of relief in Saturday's loss, striking out three. His 0.60 WHIP is tops on the team while his 2.70 ERA ranks second.

BAUTISTA, DEVEREUX DELIVER OUT OF 'PEN IN WIN

A pair of veteran arms on the Pitt pitching staff helped the Panthers secure victory in the season opener. **Jonathan Bautista** worked three scoreless frames, striking out one. **Brady Devereux** then got the call to lock down the victory in the top of the ninth inning with one out and the bases loaded. After getting the second out at second on a fielder's choice, Pitt won the game on a Devereux strikeout. The redshirt junior righty earned his first career save with the effort.

A LOOK BACK AT 2022

Pitt continued the program's ascension under head coach **Mike Bell** in 2022, posting a winning record with 29 victories, which tied for the program's most since joining the conference in 2014. The Panthers recorded five ACC series victories, including triumphs over a pair of top-five ranked squads (Louisville and Clemson). The Panthers qualified for the ACC Tournament for the second year in a row and just the third time since joining the league. Pitt advanced to the semifinals for the first time since 2018 as the No. 11 seed, logging wins over No. 7-seeded Georgia Tech and No. 2-seeded Louisville. The Panthers ended the regular season with an RPI ranking of 69, the 37th-toughest strength of schedule, 12 wins against quadrant one teams and 10 wins against the NCAA Tournament field.

COACHING STAFF BACK FOR '23

Pitt returns its entire coaching staff from the 2022 campaign in '23.

Mike Bell enters his fifth season as head coach of Pitt baseball. Bell was hired in July of 2018, becoming the fifth head coach in Pitt baseball history and bringing 14 years of Division I coaching experience to the Panther program. He joined Pitt after a seven-year stint as the associate head coach and pitching coach at Florida State. Bell signed a new contract in August of 2022 that will ensure his leadership of the Panthers through at least the 2027 season.

Bell has guided the Panthers to 97 victories over his four-plus seasons as head coach. Pitt has tallied four all-region honorees, nine All-ACC selections and five MLB Draft picks during the Bell era.

Assistant Coach/Recruiting Coordinator **Ty Megahee** is also back for a fifth season. He works with the Panther offense and infielders in addition to serving as the recruiting coordinator.

Joe Mercadante enters year two as an assistant coach. He primarily works with the outfielders and assists Megahee in the recruiting and offensive efforts.

Former Major League catcher **Devin Mesoraco** is in his third year serving as a volunteer coach. He works primarily with the program's catchers.

Rounding out Pitt's coaching staff are director of player development **Drew Linder** and director of operations **Austin Thompson**. Linder is in his fifth year with the Panthers while Thompson is in his third.

PITT RETURNS 15 PLAYERS FROM 2022 SQUAD

The Panthers bring back 15 players from the 2022 team. Returners include sophomore infielder **Tommy Tavarez**, graduate student infielder **Sky Duff**, junior outfielder **Dom Popa**, redshirt junior right-handed pitcher **Brady Devereux**, sophomore left-handed pitcher **Quin Konuszewski**, junior catcher **Johnny Long III**, sophomore catcher **Luke Lambert**, red-shirt junior infielder **Cameron Barto**, graduate student outfielder **Kyle Hess**, sophomore right-handed pitcher **Jonathan Bautista**, sophomore right-handed pitcher **Kyle Demi**, senior catcher/infielder **Jack Anderson**, sophomore left-handed pitcher **Will Droll**, junior outfielder **CJ Funk** and junior right-handed pitcher **Logan Evans**.

WELCOME TO PITTSBURGH

Pitt has added 24 newcomers to its roster for the 2023 season. The class of newcomers features 11 freshmen and 13 transfers.

Joining the Panthers for the 2023 campaign are infielder **Justin Acal**, right-handed pitcher **Nash Bryan**, right-handed pitcher **Erubiel Candelario**, left-handed pitcher **Sam Falace**, right-handed pitcher **Matthew Fernandez**, left-handed pitcher **Ethan Firoved**, infielder **Brett Heckert**, infielder **Nolan Kutney**, infielder **Anthony LaSala**, right-handed pitcher **Gavin Lill**, outfielder **Carlos Martinez**, infielder **Noah Martinez**, catcher/infielder **Jayden Melendez**, right-handed pitcher **Kyle Mosley**, outfielder **AJ Nessler**, left-handed pitcher **Zack Oswald**, right-handed pitcher **Holden Phelps**, left-handed pitcher **Ryan Reed**, infielder **Drew Ripepi**, right-handed pitcher **Dylan Simmons**, right-handed pitcher **Ryan Slattery**, right-handed pitcher **Jack Sokol**, outfielder **Caleb Sturtevant** and infielder **Matt Travisano**.

REPLACING PRODUCTION

Pitt will be tasked with replacing production both in the lineup and on the mound from the 2022 team.

Notables from the lineup who have departed include Jeffrey Wehler, Tatem Levins, Bryce Hulett and Ron Washington, Jr.

Wehler led the team in runs (48) and doubles (17) while ranking second in hits (65) and third in RBI (37).

Levins, who was selected in the eighth round (No. 246) of the 2022 Major League Baseball Draft by the Seattle Mariners, started all 56 games for the Panthers, leading the squad in batting average (.321), slugging percentage (.613), OPS (1.048), hits (68), extra base hits (27), home runs (16) and total bases (130).

Hulett ranked third on the team with 58 hits and fourth with 34 RBI. Washington, Jr. ranked fifth on the squad with 48 hits, including 15 home runs and 10 doubles to rank second on the team in both categories.

On the mound, the Panthers lost two of its three weekend starters in Matt Gilbertson and Billy Corcoran.

Gilbertson boasted a staff-best 3.74 ERA and went 9-3 on the season in 2022, leading the squad in innings pitched (96.1) and strikeouts (88).

Corcoran, who signed as an undrafted free agent with the Arizona Diamondbacks, sported a 4.43 ERA last year. He ranked among the ACC leaders in fewest walks allowed (1st - 8), innings pitched (8th - 85.1) and wins (T-8th - 7). He was also tied for third in NCAA in walks allowed per nine innings (0.84) and fifth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (8.62).

Pitt also lost reliever Baron Stuart, who signed with the New York Yankees as an undrafted free agent. Stuart appeared in a team-high 27 games out of the bullpen and logged a team-high seven saves, which ranked fifth in the ACC and tied for the fourth-most in a single season in program history.

BACK ON THE MOUND

Junior right-handed pitcher **Logan Evans** is the lone carryover from last year's starting rotation. He started all 14 games he appeared in, tying for second on the team in starts, while ranking third on the team wins (4), innings pitched (66.2) and strikeouts (52). Heading into the 2023, Evans is ranked as the 132nd-best starting pitcher in the country per D1Baseball's top-200 list.

Pitt returns several familiar faces to its pitching staff in 2023, including redshirt junior right-hander **Brady Devereux** and sophomore righty **Jonathan Bautista**. Devereux made a career-high 25 appearances out of the bullpen a year ago, going 4-2 with a 4.58 ERA and 1.40 WHIP and striking out 33 while allowing 14 walks over 39.1 innings of relief. Bautista appeared in 15 games on the mound last year, including five starts. He recorded one save and logged 23 strikeouts in 26.1 innings.

NOTES

NEW ARMS

The Panthers will boast a bevy of new arms on the pitching staff in 2023.

- Junior righty **Kyle Mosley** started for three years at Hill College, striking out 83 hitters over 60.2 innings in 2022. D1Baseball has him ranked as the 153rd-best starting pitcher on its top-200 list.

- Sophomore southpaw **Ethan Firoved** made 15 appearances and 13 starts on the mound at Tallahassee Community College in 2022, going 10-3 with one complete game and 96 strikeouts over 76.2 frames en route to Panhandle Conference Pitcher of the Year honors.

- Junior right-hander **Jack Sokol** made five appearances, including three starts as a freshman at Auburn in 2021, posting a 1-1 record and striking out nine batters in 11.2 innings of work. He spent the 2022 campaign at Pensacola State.

- Graduate student righty **Erubiel Candelario** played four years at Marist College, making 34 appearances on the mound with 19 starts. He posted a career record of 10-6, one save, a 4.17 ERA and 120 strikeouts over 123 innings of work. Candelario Earned 2022 All-MAAC First Team honors after starting 14 games and totaling a conference-best eight wins, striking out 88 batters over 76.1 innings.

- Junior right-hander **Dylan Simmons**, who played in 60 games over three years at Florida State, pitched 18.2 innings, striking out 19. He also hit .278 with 30 hits, including eight doubles, to go along with 16 RBI. Simmons was named a 2020 Freshman All-American by Collegiate Baseball after hitting .378 with four doubles, seven RBI, four runs scored and eight walks drawn.

- Graduate student right-hander **Nash Bryan** made 45 appearances over three seasons on the mound at Seton Hill, striking out 96 while issuing only 18 walks over 64.1 innings and sporting a 2.11 ERA. He struck out 54 against just nine walks and posted a 2.73 ERA over 24 appearances and 33 innings.

- Junior righty **Matthew Fernandez** made 17 starts at Miami Dade Community College in 2022, going 7-5 and striking out 110 against just 39 walks over 91.1 innings as his team finished as Florida state runners-up. He spent his 2021 freshman year at Florida International, where he made 13 appearances with 10 starts and struck out 37 in 40.2 innings.

HESS, FUNK RANKED AMONG NATION'S TOP OUTFIELDERS

D1Baseball ranked both graduate student **Kyle Hess** and junior **CJ Funk** among the top 150 outfielders in the country heading into the 2023 season, with Hess ranked 98th and Funk ranked 108th.

Hess has played in 143 career games with 136 starts and has a career slash line of .288/.374/.496. He has registered 153 career hits, including 36 doubles, nine triples and 19 home runs to go along with 56 walks, 82 runs scored and 120 RBI.

Funk has played in 79 career games with 70 starts and owns a career slash line of .275/.455/.542. He has tallied 66 career hits with 16 doubles, three triples and 14 home runs to go along with 69 walks, 50 RBI and 71 runs scored. Last season, he started 45 of the 46 games he played in and slashed a career-best .298/.476/.631 with a career-high 42 hits, including nine doubles, three triples and five home runs, to go along with 41 walks, two stolen bases, 24 RBI and 35 runs scored.

THE SKY IS LIMIT

Another mainstay in the Pitt lineup is graduate student infielder **Sky Duff**. A 2021 ABCA/Rawlings All-East Region Second Team and All-ACC Third-Team selection at third base, Duff has played in 183 career games with 177 starts. He sports a career slash line of .295/.429/.399 and has recorded 199 career hits with 48 doubles, two triples and six home runs to go along with 146 walks, 12 stolen bases, 84 RBI and 139 runs scored.

REPPING THE STEEL CITY

A pair of Panthers represent their hometown of Pittsburgh in the starting lineup -- senior catcher/infielder **Jack Anderson** and freshman infielder **Anthony LaSala**.

A native of Mars, Pa., Anderson played in 50 games with 42 starts in his first season as a Panther in 2022 after transferring from State College of Florida. He slashed .280/.393/.453 a year ago with 45 hits, including eight doubles, a triple and six home runs, and tallied 29 walks, 26 RBI and 26 runs scored.

A graduate of Hopewell High School where he won a WPIAL championship, LaSala has played in 29 games, starting in 26 of them. He has 12 hits and has scored 11 runs, while also smacking four doubles. He has been very solid defensively for Pitt, only committing three errors in his 29 games, and helping turn 15 double plays on the season.

DEPTH AT CATCHER

Pitt has depth at catcher in junior **Johnny Long III**, sophomore **Jayden Melendez** and sophomore **Luke Lambert**.

Long III saw limited action a year ago after spending his first two years (2020-21) of his collegiate career at Florida Gulf Coast. He was named to the 2021 ASUN All-Freshman Team after appearing in 42 games and making 39 starts that season, hitting .289 (37-128) with six doubles, one home run, 18 RBI and 24 runs.

Melendez played in 41 games with 38 starts at Florida International in 2022, hitting .232 with 32 hits, including five doubles and three home runs, to go along with 12 RBI and 13 runs scored. His brother, MJ, currently plays for the Kansas City Royals.

Lambert played in 23 games with one start in his 2022 freshman season, hitting .250 with seven hits, including a double.

FORMER PANTHERS FREURE, WEST SELECTED TO 2023 WBC ROSTERS

A pair of former Pitt baseball players were selected to rosters for the 2023 World Baseball Classic, with right-handed pitcher R.J. Freure earning a spot on Canada's roster and right-handed pitcher Derek West being named to the roster for the Netherlands.

Freure appeared in 48 outings, including one start, in his two-year career (2017-18) as a Panther, owning a career record of 8-2 with two saves. He threw 96.2 innings with a 4.47 ERA. His 27 games played in 2018 are tied for the third-most by a pitcher in a single season program history while his 95 strikeouts that season rank as the fifth-most. Freure was drafted in the sixth round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros with the 192nd overall pick. He has spent the last four seasons in Minor League Baseball, most recently suiting up for the Rome Braves - the High-A affiliate of the Atlanta Braves - in 2022. In 77 minor league games, he has gone 14-13 with four saves and a 4.43 ERA and has registered 277 strikeouts over 223.1 innings.

West appeared in 31 games with 19 starts in his two seasons of competition at Pitt in 2018 and '19 after missing his first two years due to injury. He posted a career record of 6-6 with a 3.57 ERA and logged 118.1 innings of work, tallying 129 strikeouts and a .236 opponent average. His 82 strikeouts in 2019 are tied for the 15th-most in a single season in program history. West was drafted in the 28th round of the 2018 MLB Draft by the Atlanta Braves with the 832nd overall pick but did not sign. He was then taken in the 14th round of the 2019 MLB Draft by the Houston Astros with the 436th overall pick. West has spent the last three minor league seasons in Houston's system and split the 2022 season between High-A Asheville and Double-A Corpus Christi. He has played in 60 games, boasting a 6-3 record with 108 strikeouts over 93.2 innings.

FORMER PANTHER HARRIS MAKES OPENING DAY ROSTER FOR NATIONALS

Former Panther Hobie Harris made the 2023 Opening Day roster for the Washington Nationals. Harris appeared in 44 games, including two starts, in his two years with the Panthers. He struck out 81 batters in 92.0 career innings pitched. Harris was drafted in the 31st round of the 2015 MLB Draft by the New York Yankees with the 933rd overall pick.

Harris made his MLB debut on April 1, working one scoreless inning of relief and striking out one.

SCOUTING THE YELLOW JACKETS

Georgia Tech is on a hot streak as of late, winning five in a row and six of their last eight games.

Offensively the Yellow Jackets have three sluggers who are each in the top four for batting average and slugging percentage on the team. Kristian Campbell leads the team in batting average (.412) and holds a .605 slugging percentage. Both Jake DeLeo (.379 BA, .684 SLG) and Angelo Dispigna (.383 BA, .623) are two of only three players who have started in every game for Georgia Tech. Their projected starting pitcher for Sunday's game, Jackson Finley, leads the team in home runs (17) and slugging percentage (.757)

Out of the bullpen they will likely go to Ben King, who has a team low ERA of 3.44 with 41 strikeouts in 34 innings, or Jackson Vaughn, who has thrown 32.2 innings in 19 appearances. If they have a lead in the ninth they will call on Terry Busse to close it out, he leads the team in saves (7) in 32.2 innings.

Mike Bell enters his fifth season as head coach of Pitt baseball in 2023. Bell was hired in July of 2018, becoming the fifth head coach in Pitt baseball history and bringing 14 years of Division I coaching experience to the Panther program. He joined Pitt after a seven-year stint as the associate head coach and pitching coach at Florida State. Bell signed a new contract in August of 2022 that will ensure his leadership of the Panthers through at least the 2027 season.

Bell has guided the Panthers to 99 victories over his four-plus seasons as head coach. Pitt has tallied four all-region honorees, nine All-ACC selections and five MLB Draft picks during the Bell era.

Pitt continued the program's ascension under Bell in 2022, posting a winning record with 29 victories, which tied for the program's most since joining the conference in 2014. The Panthers recorded five ACC series victories, including triumphs over a pair of top-five ranked squads (Louisville and Clemson). The Panthers qualified for the ACC Tournament for the second year in a row and just the third time since joining the league. Pitt advanced to the semifinals for the first time since 2018, logging wins over No. 7-seeded Georgia Tech and No. 2-seeded Louisville. The Panthers ended the regular season with an RPI ranking of 69, the 37th-toughest strength of schedule, 12 wins against quadrant one teams and 10 wins against the NCAA Tournament field.

Starting pitchers Matt Gilbertson (Second Team) and Billy Corcoran (Third Team) were named All-ACC selections, becoming the first tandem of Panther pitchers to earn All-ACC honors in the same season. Gilbertson was also named to the 2022 ABCA/Rawlings East All-Region Second Team after posting a team-best 9-3 record and leading the team in ERA (3.74), WHIP (1.17), starts (15), innings pitched (96.1) and strikeouts (88). Corcoran signed as an undrafted free agent with the Arizona Diamondbacks after ranking among the ACC leaders in fewest walks allowed (1st; 8), innings pitched (8th; 85.1) and wins (T-8th; 7). He also tied for third in the NCAA in walks allowed per nine innings (0.84) and fifth in strikeout-to-walk ratio (8.62).

Catcher Tatem Levins was selected in the eighth round (No. 246) of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Seattle Mariners, becoming Pitt's highest draft pick since 2018 and the 94th draft selection Bell has worked with during his coaching career. Levins started all 56 games for the Panthers, leading the squad in batting average (.321), slugging percentage (.613), OPS (1.048), hits (68), extra base hits (27), home runs (16) and total bases (130).

Right-handed pitcher Baron Stuart was also signed by the

New York Yankees as an undrafted free agent following the 2022 campaign. He appeared in a team-high 27 games out of the bullpen and logged a team-high seven saves for the Panthers, which ranked fifth in the Atlantic Coast Conference and tied for the fourth-most in a single season in program history.

The 2021 campaign saw Bell direct Pitt to its most successful season in the ACC. The Panthers set program records for their highest ranking in the polls (No. 14 by Baseball America), consecutive weeks in the polls (nine), RPI (50) and strength of schedule (30). In ACC play, Pitt set program-bests in ACC series wins (six) and ACC victories (16). The Panthers went 18-12 against teams that made the NCAA Regionals, tied for the second-best record against such opponents in the nation. The Panthers won 17 times against quadrant one teams and became just the second team to sweep Florida State and Miami in the same season.

With Bell serving as the pitching coach for the first time since becoming head coach of the Panthers, Mitch Myers was selected in the 12th round of the MLB Draft with the 368th pick by the Oakland Athletics. Myers was one of a program-best four Panthers selected to the All-ACC Third Team, joining Sky Duff, Nico Popa and David Yanni. Duff earned a selection to the ABCA/Rawlings All-East Region Second Team. A member of the 2019 Second Team, Popa became the first Panther to earn All-ACC honors twice. The all-time leader in program history in games played, starts and walks, Yanni had his best season as a Panther in 2021.

In 2020, Bell guided Pitt to a 10-6 record before the season was cut short due to COVID-19. Revamping the roster with 21 newcomers, Bell led the Panthers to a 10-1 start to the year, tied for the second-best start through 11 games in program history. Pitt's offense played a huge part, ranking second in the nation in doubles per game (2.88), 37th in slugging percentage (.447) and 38th in scoring (7.3 runs per game).

Since 2005, Bell has helped lead three teams to four College World Series appearances – Tennessee (2005), Oklahoma (2010) and Florida State (2012 & 2017). He has coached nine first round draft picks, 36 Top-10 round picks, 94 overall Draft picks, 19 Major Leaguers, and helped guide 12 Top-25 recruiting classes. In 2012, he was named the Perfect Game Assistant Coach of the Year and was named the No. 13 recruiter in the country by D1Baseball.com prior to the 2017 season.

In five of his seven seasons, Florida State pitchers recorded 500 or more strikeouts, including a pair of top 10 seasons in 2017 (640, fifth-most) and 2018 (635, seventh-most). The Seminoles posted a 314-136-0 record in his tenure, reaching a Super Regional on three occasions and advancing to the College World Series twice. Florida State captured three ACC titles in Bell's time in Tallahassee, taking home conference tournament titles in 2015, '17 and '18.

Bell made stops at Oklahoma and Tennessee in his time prior to Florida State. In his first seven seasons at the Division I level, including four at Oklahoma and three at Tennessee, he helped recruit and develop 22 pitchers who were selected in the Major League Baseball draft. That includes three first-round selections – including 2006 No. 1 overall pick Luke Hochevar.

In four seasons at Oklahoma, Bell's pitching staffs established a number of new standards. His 2011 group posted a 3.00 ERA, which was the Sooners' lowest since 1978. Four of his hurlers earned All-Big 12 honors, including Second Team All-American Michael Rocha. The Sooners posted a 41-17 record and were ranked No. 15 in the USA Today/ESPN Coaches poll. In 2010, his pitching staff was instrumental in leading OU back to the College World Series for the first time since 1995.

Beyond his Division I experience, he spent two seasons as the pitching coach and recruiting coordinator at Division II perennial power Florida Southern, where the Mocs twice finished in the top 20 nationally in ERA. He launched his coaching career in 2002 at Brandon High, where he led the team to a district title and a regional runner-up finish as the head coach, earning Hillsborough County Coach of the Year honors.

A left-handed pitcher and first baseman for the Seminoles, Bell reached the College World Series as a player at Florida State in both 1994 and '95. Bell posted a two-year record of 14-4 with a 3.00 ERA and was twice named to the ACC Academic Honor Roll. He earned a bachelor's degree in physical education at Florida State in 1996 and previously spent two seasons as a pitcher at Hernando Community College, where he was a two-time All-Suncoast Conference selection.

Selected in the 20th round of the 1995 draft by the Montreal Expos, Bell spent six years in the minors, including the final three with the Baltimore Orioles' organization where he reached the Double-A level.

Bell is married to the former Alicia Favarato, a Florida State graduate, and the couple has two children, daughter, Alexis (17), and son, Kyler (15).

PITT COACHING STAFF



Ty Megahee enters his fifth season as assistant coach of Pitt baseball in 2023. He works with the Panther offense and infielders in addition to serving as the recruiting coordinator. In his career, Megahee has coached in three NCAA Tournaments, including serving on a No. 1-seeded Auburn team in 2010. He has worked with 55 MLB draft selections, four MLB players, 55 All-Conference honorees and four conference players of the year. In 2015, Megahee coached Golden Spikes Award winner Kyle Lewis, as the eventual Seattle Mariners' draft pick was named the nation's top collegiate baseball player.

Before coming to Pitt, Megahee spent three seasons as the assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at Western Kentucky, where he served as the infield coach and headed the development of the Hilltoppers' position players. He joined the Hilltoppers' staff after a two-year stint at Mercer University, where he helped the Bears to a record of 73-30 (34-16 SoCon) in addition to a 2015 league title and NCAA Regional bid. In his two years with the Bears, 10 players were named to the All-SoCon teams, as he coached 2015 SoCon Player of the Year Kyle Lewis in 2015.

Before joining the Bears' staff, Megahee was an instrumental part of SEC powerhouse Auburn's staff for four seasons. He served as the Tigers' infield and catchers coach, helping the Tigers to a record of 136-101 (60-60 SEC). The 2010 Tigers squad won the SEC Western Division title en route to being the No. 1 overall seed in the NCAA Tournament.

Megahee got his collegiate start at Mercer in 2005, serving as a volunteer assistant coach for three seasons before accepting a full-time role at Monmouth for the 2009 campaign. He has also worked in the summer ball scene, coaching the Florence Red Wolves of the Coastal Plains League in 2006.

He started his playing career at Darton College (2002-03) before transferring to Mercer for his final two seasons of eligibility. A two-year starter with the Bears (2004-05), he was named the Doyle E. Watson Leadership Award winner in 2005 and earned Academic All-Conference recognition that season.

Megahee earned a bachelor's degree in education in 2006 from Mercer, obtaining a master's in education from Mercer in '08. Megahee and his wife, Susan, have two children, Mallory and Mason.



Joe Mercadante enters his second season as assistant coach of Pitt baseball in 2023. Mercadante primarily works with the outfielders and assists fellow assistant coach Ty Megahee in the recruiting and offensive efforts.

Mercadante previously spent four years at Stetson as an assistant coach, serving as the primary hitting coach while working directly with the catchers. In addition, he was named recruiting coordinator following the 2018 season.

Rising from a volunteer coach to an assistant, Mercadante spent seven years (2005-11) at Miami working with the Hurricanes' hitters and defensively with the catchers in addition to scheduling games and assisting in recruiting efforts. During that time, he helped the squad make seven-consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances, which included four regional championships (2005, '06, '08, '10) and two College World Series appearances (2006, '08).

He spent one year as assistant coach and recruiting coordinator at UCF in 2012. During his one season with the Knights, Mercadante helped lead UCF to an NCAA regional championship appearance and a No. 10 national ranking during the regular season. He helped five players receive all-conference honors while three hitters were selected in the 2012 MLB Draft.

Following the 2012 season, Mercadante took over as head coach of the Central Florida Gators, ranked as one of the top travel team programs in the nation by Perfect Game. He produced three Under Armor All-Americans, three Perfect Game All-Americans and two players who went on to play for USA Baseball. In addition to his coaching, scouting and recruitment duties with the Gators, he has also served as Event Coordinator and Director for The Next Level Baseball Education, which included coordination and scheduling for the Orlando Scorpions.

Mercadante graduated from P.K. Yonge High School in 1999. He was a four-year letterman and named the team MVP as a senior. Out of high school, he attended Jefferson Davis Community College in Brewton, Ala., and helped lead the team to a JUCO Regional title and a berth in the Junior College World Series. He then transferred to Delgado Junior College in New Orleans for his sophomore season. Mercadante arrived at the University of Florida in 2002 and hit .471 in a reserve role for the Gators.

After serving as an assistant coach at P.K. Yonge in 2004, Mercadante coached summer baseball in the Virginia Valley League with the Covington Lumberjacks.

Mercadante is a 2003 graduate of the University of Florida, where he earned a bachelor's degree, Cum Laude, in Exercise and Sports Sciences in 2003. He earned his master's degree in the same field from Florida in June of 2006.

Mercadante and his wife, Katie have two sons, Roman and CT.



Devin Mesoraco was named volunteer assistant coach for Pitt baseball in September of 2020 by head coach Mike Bell. Mesoraco works primarily with the program's catchers.

Mesoraco joined the Panthers after spending eight years as a catcher in the big leagues. He made his MLB debut with the Cincinnati Reds on Sept. 3, 2011 and spent nearly his entire career with the organization before ending it with the Mets in 2018. He was selected to the MLB All-Star Game in 2014 and finished that season with 25 home runs and 80 runs batted, leading all major league catchers in home runs and slugging percentage (.534). He wrapped up his professional tenure with a career-batting average of .232, 58 homers and 192 RBI's.

Selected by the Reds with the 15th overall pick of the 2007 MLB Draft, Mesoraco had a decorated prep career at nearby Punxsutawney Area High School. He set school records in walks, runs, hits, doubles, home runs and stolen bases. As a senior he led the Chucks to the PIAA Class AAA State Championship and was named the Pennsylvania Gatorade Player of the Year.

Mesoraco lives in Pittsburgh with his wife Kira and son Luke.
