NEW YEAR, NEW FACES

Just five of the 12 players on this year's team played on the 2022-23 team. Six of the other seven players are transfers and Ariana Dyson is the only freshman on the team.

Coach Gardner also brought in a new coaching staff as three of the four assistant coaches are in their first year with the program. Ali Trani was elevated to Assistant Coach after serving last year as the Director of Basketball Operations.

2022-23 SEASON RECAP

It was a tight conference race last season as the Bears entered their final conference game of the year at Wofford with a chance to secure at least a share of the regular season SoCon title. The Bears ultimately dropped that game to the eventual regular season champion Wofford Terriers who finished 10-4 in conference play with the Bears two games back at 8-6.

Mercer finished fourth in the SoCon in scoring offense at 64.8 points per game, and sixth in scoring defense at 65.2 points per game allowed. The Bears were excellent from the stripe, leading the conference at 79.4 percent from the free-throw line. Mercer also led the SoCon in three-point field goal percentage at 38.1 percent for the season.

Amoria Neal-Tysor averaged 17.2 points per game which was tied for the leading scorer in the SoCon. Neal-Tysor was named First Team All-SoCon for the second consecutive season to close out her career.

THE 2023-24 SLATE

Mercer is set to host 14 games inside Hawkins Arena this season. That includes seven non-conference and seven conference games. All seven conference games will be played on Thursday's and Saturday's.

Highlighting the home non-conference schedule is the Georgia Bulldogs who will make their first trip to Macon since the 2020-21 season.

Mercer's first two conference games of the season are on the road at SoCon tournament champion Chattanooga

followed by a trip to ETSU. The Bears will close the regular season with a three-game homestand against Furman, Wofford, and Samford.

SCOUTING GEORGIA TECH

Georgia Tech is coming off a 13-17 season in 2022-23. The Yellow Jackets went 4-14 in conference play.

The Yellow Jackets were picked to finish 12th in the 15-team league (ACC) in the preseason media poll.

In four years with Nell Fortner at the helm, the Yellow Jackets have reached the NCAA Tournament twice (2022 and 2021). Tech made consecutive appearances in the NCAA Tournament for the first time since the Yellow Jackets made seven-straight appearances from 2007-2014, and reached the Sweet 16 in 2021 for just the second time in program history.

Georgia Tech is averaging 71.4 points per game and is allowing just 60.3 per game. They are shooting from 45.1 percent from the field which ranks seventh in the ACC. The Yellow Jackets also are in the middle of the pack in the ACC in rebounding as they have a +4.5 rebounding margin which is ninth best in the ACC.

Georgia Tech's leading scorer is sophomore guard Tonie Morgan who is averaging 16.3 points per game. She is shooting 48.6% from the field. Kayla Blackshear is Georgia Tech's second leading scorer and leading rebounder as she averages 14.6 points and 7.3 rebounds per game.

Freshman Rusne Augustinaite dropped a career-high 30 points in the ACC/SEC Challenge against Florida. Augustinaite went 10-for-20 from the field. It marked the fifth game this season the freshman posted double-figures. Augustinaite is third on the team in scoring at 12.5 points per game.

ENJULINA GONZALEZ

Mercer sophomore guard Enjulina Gonzalez was named to the Preseason All-Conference team. Last season, Gonzalez was named to the SoCon All-Freshman Team after her strong freshman season.

As a freshman, Gonzalez averaged 10.2 points, 3.2 rebounds, and 2.2 assists per game. She shot 51.2 percent from the field which was fifth best in the SoCon.

Gonzalez scored a career-high 34 points on 15-for-21 (71.4%) shooting at Chattanooga on January 14.

DPOY RETURNS

Senior Summah Evans is out with an injury to start the season but she enters her senior season with the Bears after a strong junior season in which Evans was named SoCon Defensive Player of the Year. Evans led the team in rebounding at 7.6 rebounds per game last year.

JONES NAMED SOCON PLAYER OF THE WEEK

Senior forward Stacie Jones was named the SoCon Player of the Week for the first week of the season on November 14.

Jones had quite the first week as Mercer Bear. Jones had a double-double in her first two games of the season, including a career-high 16 rebounds in the season opener at Western Kentucky.

In the first week of the season - over three games - Jones averaged 14.3 points and 10.7 rebounds per game.

LOCKE AND JOHNSON BIG GAMES VERSUS MARIST

Ashlee Locke had a career-high 17 points and Mackenzie Johnson had a double-double to help the Bears earn a 73-67 overtime win over Marist on Thanksgiving day in the Savannah Hoops Invitational.

Locke's previous career-high was 11 points. Johnson had her first double-double of the season with 16 points and 15 rebounds to go with six assists and two steals. Locke had a career-high 17 points to go with six rebounds.

The duo combined to score all 11 of Mercer's points in overtime.

HOME OPENER WIN

Stacie Jones recorded her second double-double in as many games and Mercer outscored Florida Atlantic 25-12 in the third quarter to defeat the Owls in Mercer's home opener, 70-62 Thursday night in Hawkins Arena.

The Bears trailed 35-32 at halftime, but used a big third quarter, outscoring the Owls 25-12 to take a 10-point lead into the fourth quarter. The Bears did a much better job of limiting their turnovers after having 26 turnovers in the season opener at Western Kentucky, the Bears committed just 10 on the night.

Carrying over from the season opener for Mercer was it's excellent performance on the glass, as it outrebounded the Owls 47-38, including 21 offensive rebounds.

Jones led the Bears with 20 points and 13 rebounds and did it on an efficient night from the floor as she was 8-for-12 (75%) from the field. Florida Atlantic's Aniya Hubbard led all scorers with 28 points.

HAWKINS ARENA

Hawkins Arena was originally opened in 2005 as The University Center and immediately vaulted Mercer to a position among not only the best, but most efficient facilities for any university of its size. The arena facility not only provides a premiere venue for athletics competition – basketball and volleyball – but as serves as a centerpiece for Mercer’s vibrant campus life.

The 3,200-seat main arena was renamed Hawkins Arena in the spring of 2012 in response to a \$1 million donation by Macon cardiologist, Dr. Chuck Hawkins, and his wife, Kathy. Hawkins Arena is home to Mercer’s men’s basketball, women’s basketball and women’s volleyball teams.

Hawkins Arena served as host to the 2010, 2011, 2012 and 2013 Atlantic Sun Men’s and Women’s Basketball Tournaments.

The facility is comprised of three main floor levels. The bottom level is home to Mercer’s Athletics Department offices and conference rooms. The lower level (arena floor level) houses team/locker rooms for each of Mercer’s varsity programs, visiting team and officials locker areas, sports medicine offices and athletics training facilities, as well as an aquatics area. The upper level includes Mercer’s ticket office, Board of Trustees meeting room, the President’s Dining Room, Bear Market and Heritage Hall.

Adjacent to the arena via the upper level of the facility is a food court and solarium-style eating and congregation area, floor-to-ceiling windows overlooking the pool, weight room and exercise rooms, a fitness center, offices for University Center employees and offices for Recreation Sports and Wellness.

SUSIE GARDNER

HEAD COACH ◊ 25TH SEASON OVERALL ◊ 14TH SEASON AT MERCER ◊ GEORGIA '86



Mercer University named veteran NCAA Division I coach Susie Gardner as the school's 10th women's basketball head coach on June 24, 2010.

Entering her 25th season as a head coach and 14th with Mercer, coach Gardner has 467 career wins including more than 400 Division I wins on her resume. She has transformed Mercer into one of the top mid-major programs in the NCAA, let alone the Southeast.

Gardner has accumulated 231 wins at Mercer, making her the all-time winningest coach in program history. Gardner's teams have amassed 20-plus wins in seven of the last 11 seasons, including five consecutive 20-or-more win seasons from 2014-2019.

The 2022-23 season saw the Bears finish 12-16 overall and 8-6 in conference play. In a very competitive year in the SoCon, Mercer entered the last regular season game of the year with a chance to earn at least a share of the regular season conference title. Amoria Neal-Tysor was named First Team All-SoCon, Summah Evans was named SoCon Defensive Player of the Year, and Enjulina Gonzalez was named to the All-Freshman Team.

The 2021-22 season saw the Bears (23-7, 13-1 SoCon) claim their fourth Southern Conference Tournament title in the last five years, advancing to the NCAA Tournament to face top-seeded UConn in Storrs, Connecticut. Additionally, it was Mercer's sixth SoCon crown in the last seven years. The Orange and Black defeated Furman 73-54 in the SoCon Championship to earn a trip to the Big Dance. Senior Amoria Neal-Tysor excelled offensively in the tournament and scored 26 points in the championship game. Gardner also coached Shannon Titus to her third-consecutive SoCon Defensive Player of the Year award as she became the first player in program history to be named the conference's best defender multiple times after the 2020-21 season.

Under Gardner's tutelage, in the 2021-22 season, Mercer finished second in the SoCon in points per game (64.4) and opponent points per game (56.9). The Bears also led the league in field-goal percentage (.418) and three-point field-goal percentage (.362).

In the 2020-21 season, the Bears (19-7, 10-3 SoCon) claimed their third Southern Conference Tournament title in the last four years, advancing to the NCAA Tournament to face top-seeded South Carolina in San Antonio. Additionally, it was Mercer's seventh SoCon crown in the last six years. The Orange and Black defeated Wofford 60-38 in the SoCon Championship to earn a trip to the Big Dance and set a new conference title game record for fewest points allowed. Junior Amoria Neal-Tysor excelled offensively in the tournament and was named the Most Outstanding Player after averaging 25.7 points per game while shooting 45.3 percent from the floor (29-of-64) and 40.7 percent (11-of-27) from beyond-the-arc. Gardner also coached Shannon Titus to her second-consecutive SoCon Defensive Player of the Year award as she became the first player in program history to be named the conference's best defender multiple times. Titus' 73 steals led the SoCon and ranked sixth nationally, while her 41 blocks were the third-most in the conference. In addition to her defensive prowess, Titus also became Mercer's 27th 1,000-point scorer and the sixth under Gardner.

In the 2019-20 season, Gardner coached the SoCon Defensive Player of the Year in Shannon Titus, who put together one of the best defensive seasons in program history. She became the first Mercer player with 75+ steals and 50+ blocks in the same season and was the only player in Division I to accomplish that feat. Under Gardner, Mercer led the SoCon in blocks, blocks per game, steals, steals per game and turnovers forced while ranking 14th in the country in blocks.

In the 2018-19 season, coach Gardner guided the Bears to an undefeated, 14-0 record in the SoCon for the second consecutive season as the Bears finished the season 25-8 overall. The Bears finished the regular season having won their last 34 consecutive regular season conference games. Mercer also claimed both the Southern Conference regular season and tournament titles for the second consecutive season. The Bears played in the NCAA Tournament against the No. 2 seed Iowa Hawkeyes in which Mercer led after three quarters before falling, 66-61. Amanda Thompson was named Player of the Year by the coaches and Keke Calloway Player of the Year by the media. Coach Gardner was named Coach of the Year.

Prior to the start of the 2016-17 season, Gardner authored a children's book to help promote children's literacy titled "1, 2, 3 Team!". The book, which touches on teamwork and how to be a good teammate, is geared towards readers ages four to eight. Gardner was named a finalist for the Georgia Author of the Year Award in the Children's Book category.

In her time at Mercer, Gardner has coached four SoCon Players of the Year, including Kahlia Lawrence who has thrice garnered the award. In addition, Gardner has coached three Freshman of the Year winners, four Defensive Players of the Year, 14 First Team All-Conference honorees and five Second Team All-Conference winners. Seven freshmen have been awarded a spot on the conference All-Freshmen team under Gardner's tutelage. Gardner has been named SoCon Coach of the Year four times. (2016, 2018, 2019 and 2022). Gardner's teams also excel in the classroom as 41 student-athletes have been named to the Academic All-Conference Team under her guidance.

Gardner has taken the Bears to seven postseason tournaments in ten seasons. Prior to Gardner's arrival, Mercer had not competed in postseason play since 1985. Under Gardner's guidance, Mercer has made the NCAA Women's Basketball Tournament four of the past five years, two Women's National Invitation Tournaments and two Women's Basketball Invitational Tournaments.

Before arriving at Mercer, Gardner spent three seasons (2007-10) as an assistant coach at the University of Florida. She joined the Gators after four seasons (2003-07) as the head coach at the University of Arkansas, giving her seven seasons as a coach in the Southeastern Conference.

With Gardner at the Razorbacks' helm in 2004-05, Arkansas earned a trip to the WNIT tournament. Prior to that, she had the SEC Player of the Year in 2003-04. Arkansas was a combined 64-54 during Gardner's tenure and her 2005-06 team raced out to the best SEC start in the Lady 'Hogs program history.

Gardner cut her teeth as a Division I head coach at Austin Peay State University in Clarksville, Tenn., where she had a highly successful seven-season run (1996-2003) and was 112-93. The Lady Gobs accomplishments during that period included three Ohio Valley Conference tournament championships (2001, 2002 & 2003), and OVC regular season title (2003) and three NCAA post-season berths (2001, 2002 & 2003). Gardner was tabbed as the OVC "Coach of the Year" in 2003. She also produced the OVC Player of the Year in both 2003 and 2004, with her players also garnering the league's Freshman of the Year awards twice (2000 and 2001).

From 1992-95, Gardner was the assistant coach at Western Athletic Conference power San Diego State University. In her three seasons with the Aztecs, she was a part of a program that won three-consecutive WAC tournament championships and, subsequently, also made three NCAA tourney appearances. SDSU was 69-20 with Gardner on staff and garnered two WAC regular season crowns in 1994 and 1995.

Gardner is no stranger to middle Georgia or the Southeast region, having spent two seasons as a graduate assistant at the University of Georgia (1986-88) following a highly-successful four-year career for the Bulldogs under legendary head coach Andy Landers. UGA made the NCAA Final Four in 1983 and 1985 with Gardner on the squad - including a national runner-up finish in 1985 - and reached the NCAA tournament both of her years as a graduate assistant, as well. The Bulldogs won the SEC title in 1983, 1984 and 1986 as Gardner played alongside other noteworthy Georgia players like Teresa Edwards, Janet Harris and Katrina McClain.

Gardner was a member of the 1983 Sports Festival South Team which earned a gold medal. She was also a member of the USA's Select Team which competed in Canada.

Gardner earned her Bachelor of Science degree from Georgia in 1986, followed by a Master of Education degree in 1988.

JOCELYN BROWN

ASSISTANT COACH ◊ 1ST SEASON AT MERCER ◊ APPALACHIAN STATE '06



Jocelyn Brown enters her first season with Mercer in the 2023-24 season. Brown joins the Bears after spending three seasons (2018-21) as an Assistant Coach at Western Kentucky. In 2019-20, Brown helped coach the Lady Toppers to a 22-7 record overall and a perfect 13-0 home record. WKU extended its 20-win season streak to eight consecutive, a new program record. At the conclusion of the season, Brown was named one of 50 Impactful Assistant Coaches in NCAA Division I by Silver Waves Media.

In her first season on staff with the Lady Toppers, Brown helped to lead WKU to its seventh consecutive 20-win season as the squad won six of its final eight games to finish with a 20-15 record. WKU reached the semifinals of the C-USA Tournament before falling to eventual champion Rice and made a run to the third round of the Postseason WNIT, knocking off Miami (Ohio) on the road and Morehead State.

Prior to WKU, Brown spent four seasons as an assistant coach at Penn State from 2014-18, working closely with the program's guards as well as serving as the Nittany Lions' recruiting coordinator. During her four years with the program, Brown helped to push Penn State from a six-win season in 2014-15 to 38 combined wins in 2016-17 and 2017-18; in addition, Teniya Page, one of the athletes with which Wyatt worked most closely, earned back-to-back All-Big Ten honors as well as a WBCA Honorable Mention All-America nod in 2017.

Prior to her time at Penn State, Brown spent four seasons (2011-14) on staff at Georgia State, who competed against the Lady Toppers at the time as a member of the Sun Belt. With the Panthers, Brown coached Kendra Long to an All-Sun Belt Third Team selection and the Georgia State school record for most three-pointers in both a single season and a career. She also was instrumental in inking the top junior college player in the nation for Georgia State in 2012.

In her first stint as an assistant coach, Brown was an assistant at East Carolina in 2008-09 and 2009-10, leading the Pirates to back-to-back top-100 recruiting classes. In her final season in Greenville, Brown also helped East Carolina to 23 wins, the first 20-win season for the program since 1992, and the Pirates earned their first postseason win in school history with a 78-76 victory over Drexel in the WNIT.

Brown spent two seasons (2006-08) as a graduate manager at Georgia under legendary coach Andy Landers. During her time in Athens, the Lady Bulldogs were 50-17 and earned two NCAA Tournament bids. She also acted as the co-camp director at Georgia.

A native of Lawrenceville, Georgia, Brown has spoken several times at the WBCA's "So You Want to be a Coach" clinic at the Women's Final Four and also spoke at the Nike Assistant Coaches Roundtables in 2010 and 2014. While in college, she spent four summers as an assistant director with Peach State Basketball, Inc. coordinating instructional camps and high school showcases.

As a player, she started her collegiate career at Kennesaw State where she averaged 7.7 points and 5.8 rebounds in 27 appearances. She then transferred to Appalachian State. As a senior, Brown was selected as a team captain and started 21 of 28 games. Brown averaged 9.3 points with 28 blocks during the 2005-06 campaign.

Brown received her bachelor's degree in exercise science with a minor in biology and psychology from Appalachian State in 2006. She also earned her master's degree in exercise science from Georgia in 2008.



LINDSAY HIERONYMUS

ASSISTANT COACH ◊ 1ST SEASON AT MERCER ◊ TRANSYLVANIA '16



Lindsay Hieronymus enters her first season in 2023-24 as assistant coach with Mercer. She joins the Bears after spending last season as Assistant Women's Basketball Coach at Miami Ohio.

While at Miami, Hieronymus implemented and oversaw data and statistical analysis, including analysis of practice, games, and opponent scouting. She oversaw team rebounding, including implementing new technique and scheme. With Hieronymus' guidance, in the 2022-23 season, the RedHawks ranked third in the conference in overall rebounding and rebounding margin. A big improvement for Miami after the previous season they ranked ninth in both categories. She also assisted in many other aspects of the program, including recruiting, scouting, fundraising, male practice players, and wing and forward development.

Prior to joining Miami (OH), Hieronymus served as the Director of Basketball Operations for the Eastern Kentucky women's basketball program for the 2020-21 and 2021-22 seasons and served as an assistant coach in the spring of 2021. Hieronymus joined the Eastern Kentucky women's basketball program as the director of player development in the summer of 2019.

During her time at EKU, Hieronymus had various responsibilities, including general management and assistance with women's basketball daily operations, organization and coordination of daily schedule, coordination of team travel and meals, co-director of 2019 Elite Camp, assistance with practice and game planning, statistical tracking of practice and games, assist in official and unofficial visits, and creation of digital content for social media and recruiting. In 2021 she was also the director of EKU's Elite Camp and assisted with opponent scouting reports.

Hieronymus was an assistant coach at Averett University from 2017-2019, and was a part of winning the first regular season USA South title in school history in 2018.

She was also the liaison to other branches of the department including academics, branding, and marketing, fundraising, facilities, and scheduling.

A native of Lexington, Kentucky, Hieronymus was a four-year member of the women's basketball team at Transylvania University, where she helped the program win three conference regular season championships and one conference tournament title while making two NCAA Tournament appearances. A captain and starter during her senior campaign, Hieronymus twice earned academic all-conference honors from the Heartland Collegiate Athletic Conference and was on the league's all-sportsmanship team her senior year. She also received Transylvania's Female Senior Leadership Award in 2016.

Hieronymus graduated from Transylvania with a bachelor's degree in biology in 2016. She completed her Master of Business Administration with a concentration in leadership from Averett University in 2019.



ALI TRANI

ASSISTANT COACH ◊ 4TH SEASON AT MERCER ◊ UNC ASHEVILLE '19



Ali Trani will transition into her new role as an assistant coach for the Bears beginning the 2023-24 season. Trani spent the 2022-23 season with Mercer as the Director of Player Personnel and Basketball Operations.

She joined Mercer after one season as an assistant coach at Washington College during the 2021-22 season.

As the Director of Player Personnel during the 2022-23 season, Trani coordinated all aspects of travel including lodging, transportation, team itineraries, food, and away practice/game management. She managed and oversaw the team's budget as well as provided on court coaching and skill development and assisted coaches in scouting opponents.

She executed and planned the women's basketball team's Elite, Team, and Day Camps which are held over the summer. Additional responsibilities included administering and supervising the team's graduate assistants and managers.

Trani had experience with Mercer prior to joining the team in 2022, as she served as a graduate assistant with the team from 2019-2021. As a graduate assistant she aided the assistant coaches in organizing, recruiting, and developing the women's basketball players. She also evaluated recruits via film and organized the team's recruiting database through ARMS.

Trani played collegiate basketball at UNC Asheville. During her four year career, she was a two-time Big South Conference Tournament Champion and Big South regular season champion. She was a part of back-to-back NCAA Tournament teams with UNC Asheville.

Trani graduated from UNC Asheville in 2019 with a BS in Health and Wellness Promotion. She earned her masters degree from Mercer in 2021 in Higher Education Leadership.



JORDAN WALKER

ASSISTANT COACH ◊ 1ST SEASON AT MERCER ◊ WESTERN MICHIGAN '20



Jordan Walker enters her first season as assistant coach for Mercer in the 2023-24 season. She joins Mercer after an impressive collegiate career that included two seasons at Western Michigan before transferring to Tennessee where she concluded her playing career after three seasons as a Lady Vol.

In her playing career, Walker scored over 1,300 points with more than 700 rebounds and 400 assists.

At Tennessee, Walker started in 77 of 96 games played over her three seasons. She was Tennessee's fourth all time grad transfer. Walker averaged 6.3 points, 4.1 rebounds, 3.0 assists, and 1.1 steals during her time in Knoxville. She also helped lead Tennessee to three NCAA Tournament appearances. Walker led the Lady Vols in assists her last two seasons and ranked in the top five in the SEC in assist to turnover ratio.

At Western Michigan, Walker started in 54 of 64 games. She averaged 11.8 points, 4.9 rebounds, 2.2 assists and 1.8 steals per game. She scored in double figures in 38 of her 64 games and posted three double-doubles during her time at WMU. She also had 12 games of 20 or more points and two 30+ point games.

Walker grew up in Muskegon, Michigan where she had a highly successful high school career including being named Miss Basketball in the state of Michigan in 2017. Walker graduated from WMU in 2020 with a bachelor's degree in political science and a minor in communications. She earned a master's degree from Tennessee in business administration (MBA) with a concentration in entrepreneurship and innovation in May of 2022.

She then earned her second master's degree in May of 2023 in the Agricultural Leadership, Education and Communications (ALEC) Department with a concentration on Name, Image, and Likeness and Women's Leadership. Walker was also an active participant in leadership programs such as the So You Want To Be A Coach Program and the Above The Rim Summit.
