### **STORYLINES**

- Georgia Tech closes out this two-game road swing and stretch of four-of-five on the road, traveling to No. 6/7 NC State for a Sunday matinee. The Yellow Jackets and Wolfpack will tip at noon on the CW with Kylen Mills and Isis Young.
- Georgia Tech returned to winning ways on Thursday, pulling out a come-from-behind victory at Clemson. The Jackets led by 11 points in the second guarter, but the Tigers came out dominating in the third frame to take the lead entering the final period. Kara Dunn scored 15 points in the fourth guarter and converted 7-of-7 at the free throw line to lift the Jackets to victory. Dunn finished with 24 points overall and just missed a double-double with nine rebounds. Meanwhile, teammate lnes Noguero logged her second double-double with 11 points and a team-high 10 rebounds in the win.
- Georgia Tech and NC State are meeting for the 77th time in program history on Sunday. The Wolfpack lead the all-time series, 51-25, but the Jackets took last year's meeting in McCamish Pavilion, 68-62. Last season, the teams stood tied with just over five minutes remaining before Kayla Blackshear and Nerea Hermosa opened up a five-point GT lead. Tonie Morgan led the way for Tech with 17 points and 10 assists, while Blackshear added seven points and six rebounds. When competing in Raleigh, NC State holds the lead in the series, 24-9.
- Kara Dunn had her streak of 12-straight games scoring in double-figures snapped at Virginia Tech, but the sophomore has put together an impressive season thus far. On the season as a whole, Dunn ranks ninth in the ACC in scoring, averaging 15.35 points per game. In league games only, Dunn is 11th in scoring with a 16.43 points per game average.
- This season, Tonie Morgan has posted double-figure scoring totals in 22 outings. She has been held to single-digits only four times this season - against Mercer, at Duke, against Notre Dame and at Clemson. Meanwhile, Kayla Blackshear has recorded 15 games in double-figures to date. Combined, Blackshear and Morgan have scored 687 points on the season, accounting for 39 percent of Tech's offense.
- Tonie Morgan logged her fifth double-double of the season against Boston College with 15 points and 10 assists. It marked the third of her career on points and assists, having recorded two her freshman season. She became the sixth player in the ACC this season to record a double-double (or triple-double) on points/assists.
- Freshman Rusne Augustinaite has opened her collegiate career in style. The Lithuanian has finished 15 games in double-figures, highlighted by a career-high 30 points against Florida. She has led Tech from threepoint distance in 18 outings (tying for the team-high seven times). She is shooting 36.0 percent from threepoint distance with a team-best 58 made three-pointers. She is fifth in the ACC in 3-point field goals made.
- Career watch Kara Dunn surpassed 500 career points against Notre Dame, and now owns 567, while Tonie Morgan has boasts 680 career points. With 15 points at Syracuse, Kayla Blackshear now owns 524 career points at Georgia Tech.

### AT THE LINE

Georgia Tech's free throw efficiency came up huge in its win at Clemson as the Yellow Jackets were a perfect 11-11 at the free throw line. Kara Dunn led the way, going 10-10.

All of Tech's free throws came in the second half. More importantly, seven came in the fourth quarter (all from Dunn) as Tech erased a six-point deficit entering the final 10 minutes of play.

The last time a Georgia Tech team went a perfect 100 percent at the free throw line - minimum of 10 attempts - dates back to Jan. 25, 2015 when the Jackets were 14-14 against Virginia.

Individually, the last time a player was a perfect 10-10 (or more) at the charity stripe occurred in the 2015-16 season when two players were 11-11 in two different games (Irene Gari and Aaliyah Whiteside).

### **NOGUERO'S DOUBLE TROUBLE**

Sophomore Inés Noguero has posted up a pair of double-doubles this season. Most recently, Noguero logged 11 points and 10 rebounds in the win at Clemson for her second career double-double.

She picked up her first collegiate double-double against Mercer, posting 10 points and a career-high 12 rebounds. Noguero led the Jackets on the glass for her first time with her 12 defensive rebounds. She finished the game with six assists and a steal.

Noguero flirted with a double-double against New Mexico in the Cancun Challenge, finishing with 13 points and nine rebounds. She currently ranks fifth on the team in scoring, averaging 6.9 points and is third in rebounding at 5.2 rebounds per game.

### **MORGAN COMING UP STRONG**

With her fifth game with 20-plus points against Miami, Tonie Morgan improved her scoring average to then-15.2 points per game. Morgan leads the team in rebounding (6.8 rpg), assists (127), steals (42), free throws made (79) and field goals made (148). The sophomore from Tallahassee, Fla., owns 22 games this season scoring in double-figures - she's been limited to single digits just four times - and has scored 15 or more points 14 times.

Last season, Morgan put together a strong freshman season, finishing second on the team, averaging 9.8 points per game. She led the team in assists (114) and finished second in rebounding (5.6 rpg). As a freshman, Morgan logged 16 games in double-figures, highlighted by a then-career-high 18 points against Boston College in the ACC Tournament to close the season.

### **HOLDING STRONG AT WAKE**

At Wake Forest, Georgia Tech led by as many as 11 points in the third quarter before the Demon Deacons rallied back to take their only lead of the game at 7:08 in the fourth. Kara Dunn tied the game from the free throw line before Tonie Morgan returned the final lead to the Yellow Jackets with a layup at 6:07. Morgan went on to score 13 of Tech's final 16 points in the game, lifting the Jackets to victory (Sydney Johnson hit a field goal and Aixa Wone Aranaz connected on one at the free throw line).

Morgan finished with a team-high 22 points. She hit eight field goals and six free throws to record her fourth game this season with 20-plus points. The sophomore added six rebounds and three assists in the win.

### **SOPHOMORE CLASS**

In career records by class, Georgia Tech's sophomore class including Tonie Morgan and Kara Dunn, is pushing to rank in the top 10 in several statistical categories.

With 127 assists, Tonie Morgan currently sits in third in career assists by a sophomore - she needs two to move into sole possession of second. The record is 220 by Tiffany Martin (1994-95).

Both Morgan and Kara Dunn are on track to finish ranked in the top 10 in scoring. Morgan currently sits in 11th with 387 points for a 14.9 average, while Dunn sits in 12th.

### **MORGAN SETS PERSONAL BEST**

At Virginia Tech, sophomore Tonie Morgan topped her career-high in scoring she set earlier this season, scoring 26 points against the Hokies. She hit nine field goals and converted 8-of-9 attempts at the free throw line to record her third game with 20 or more points this season.

Morgan had previously set her career-high with 20 points in the season-opener against Coastal Carolina. She then matched her scoring record at Nebraska. To date, Morgan leads the team with 22 games scoring in double-figures this season. Last season, Morgan recorded 16 games in double-figures as a freshman.

### **JUST CALL HER THREE-POINT ARI**

Recently, freshman Ariadna Termis has lit up the court from three-point distance, dropping in a combined seven between Duke, UNC and Virginia Tech. At Duke, Termis was 2-for-3, setting a then-personal-best before the Spaniard topped her own record in the next game against North Carolina. Against the Tar Heels, Termis went 3-for-4 from three-point range, igniting a spark in the Jackets. She's capped the streak hitting a pair at Virginia Tech.

On the season, Termis has converted 9-of-21 three-point attempts for a 42.9 percent efficiency.

### A YEAR'S DIFFERENCE

Practice and focus in the offseason pays off and no one has seen it more than sophomore Kara Dunn. As a freshman last season, Dunn was fourth on the team in scoring and averaged 7.6 points per game. She shot 42.9 percent from the field and 25.0 percent from three-point distance.

With her focus in the offseason on improving her game, Dunn has seen an incredible difference. She leads the team in scoring, averaging 15.3 points per game. She is shooting 45.7 percent from the field and 27.5 percent from threepoint distance.

To date, Dunn owns 17 games scoring in double-figures and seven games with 20 or more points. Compared to last season when the Dallas, Ga., native had only nine games scoring in double-figures and two games with 20 or more points. She currently ranks 9th in the ACC overall in scoring and owns the individual scoring high in the ACC with 39 points against Georgia State.

### **JACKETS IN THE RANKINGS**

In conference games only, Georgia Tech is putting up some strong numbers in the rankings. Kara Dunn moved to 11th in scoring against league opponents, averaging 16.43 points per game, while Tonie Morgan is 12th, averaging 16.43 points per game. Additionally, Morgan nearly averages a double-double in ACC games only, pulling down 6.29 rebounds per game to rank tie for 15th in the league in rebounding.

In all games, Georgia Tech boasts two players in the top 20 of scoring - Kara Dunn (9th) and Tonie Morgan (12th). Two Jackets (Morgan, Blackshear) rank in the top 20 in rebounding. Rusne Augustinaite is fifth in three-point field goals made.

Morgan is one of two players in the ACC to rank in the top 15 of both rebounding and assists in all games (Alyssa Ustby of UNC being the other). In ACC games only, Morgan is one of three with Alyssa Ustby (UNC) and Saniya Rivers (NCSU). -- All Games --

### **DOUBLE-DOUBLE TRAIN**

With her double-double against Boston College on Jan. 21, Tonie Morgan now owns five this season, surpassing her season total from a year ago. Currently, Morgan owns nine career double-doubles (three coming on points and assists).

The last player to record more than four double-doubles in a season was Lorela Cubaj in 2021-22. The last guard to produce four or more double-doubles dates back to Aaliyah Whiteside (G/F) who recorded five in 2015-16. Whiteside finished with 10 total career double-doubles from 2012-16.

### **FINDING A WAY**

In Tech's ACC home-opener against Virginia, the Yellow Jackets just found a way. Only two Yellow Jackets finished in double-figures - Kara Dunn (24) and Tonie Morgan (18). But at halftime, Morgan was 1-for-8 from the field and 2-for-12 entering the fourth guarter. She had her most productive offensive quarter in the final period, converting 2-of-2 attempts. But the sophomore finished with 18 points for her 13th game in double-figures at the free throw line, converting 10-of-15 attempts, both career-highs.

### LIKE MOTHER. LIKE DAUGHTER

The Dunn family likes playing at Georgia. In Tech's win at Georgia on Dec. 16, sophomore Kara Dunn posted 21 points to mark her third game this season with 20 points or more, and her fourth-straight game in double-figures.

Her mother, Stephanie Dunn, formerly Wheeler, was a four-year letterwinner at Georgia (1992-95). Wearing No. 24, she was a member of the 1995 team that reached the Final Four under coach Andy Landers. She finished her career having played in 88 games.

### **FLIRTING WITH A TRIPLE DOUBLE**

Tonie Morgan has flirted with a triple-double multiple times in her career, most recently with 15 points, 10 assists and seven rebounds against Boston College on Jan. 21. This season, Morgan has flirted with a triple-double:

\*BC (1/21/24) - 15 points, 10 assists, seven rebounds;

\*UNC (1/18/24) - 15 points, 9 assists, 6 rebounds;

\*at Pitt (1/7/24) - 15 points, 12 rebounds, 8 assists;

\*at Georgia (12/16/23) - 12 rebounds, 11 points, 8 assists;

\*Georgia State (12/10/23) - 10 points, 9 rebounds, 7 assists;

\*Coastal Carolina (11/6/23) - 20 points, 7 rebounds, 7 assists.

The last Yellow Jacket to record a triple-double dates back to Milli Martinez against Morris Brown on Feb. 23, 2002. She posted 12 points, 10 rebounds and 10 assists in the game.

### **DUNN'S OFFENSIVE EXPLOSION**

Against Georgia State, sophomore Kara Dunn went off for a career-high 39 points in the win, marking the highest ACC individual scoring total this season. Dunn was 14-for-18 from the field, including 4-of-5 from three-point range and 7-of-9 from the free throw line, to earn ACC Player of the Week honors.

In the win, Dunn set career-highs in points, field goals, three-pointers, free throws, and free throw attempts.

Her 39 points marked the fourth-highest individual scoring total in Georgia Tech women's basketball program history and the most by a Yellow Jacket since 1999 when Niesha Butler dropped 40 points against Florida State (Jan. 2, 1999). Dunn was four points away from matching the program record of 43 points set by Marielle Walker in 1987.

### **GOING FOR THREE**

Georgia Tech as a team saw impressive contribution from three-point distance against Georgia State, hitting a season-high 10 three-pointers. Tech reached its season-high with five different Jackets connecting from long distance, paced by four three-pointers from Kara Dunn.

The 10 three-pointers marked the most since Tech hit 11 against Furman two seasons ago on Dec. 12, 2021.

In the Nell Fortner era at Georgia Tech, Tech teams have hit 10 or more three-pointers in a game six times: 2023-24 (once), 2021-22 (once), 2020-21 (twice), 2019-20 (twice) - with a high of 12 hit twice her first season against ETSU and at Georgia.

### **LENDING A HAND**

Georgia Tech ranks third in the ACC in assists on the season, averaging 15.77 per game. The Yellow Jackets dished out a season-high of 26 assists against Georgia State. The Jackets have dished out 20 or more assists in a game five times this season. Virginia Tech leads the ACC in assists with a 17.16 average.

Tonie Morgan leads the Yellow Jackets in assists with 127 on the year, good enough to rank sixth in the ACC in assists per game.

### **AUGUSTINAITE FOR 30**

Freshman Rusne Augustinaite dropped a career-high 30 points in the ACC/SEC Challenge against Florida. Augustinaite went 10-for-20 from the field, including a 6-for-10 showing from three-point range.

Augustinaite became the first Yellow Jacket to score 30 points in a game since Lotta-Maj Lahtinen had 30 against NC State on Dec. 31, 2020. She is the first freshman to score 30-plus points since Elizabeth Balogun did so twice in 2018-19. Balogun scored 30 points versus Seton Hall (12/20/18) before dropping 35 at North Carolina (1/31/19).

### **TONIE, TONIE, TONIE**

Tonie Morgan has dropped double-figure scoring totals in 22 games on the season. Currently averaging 14.9 points per game, Morgan is second on the team in scoring and is 12th in the ACC overall.

Morgan is currently leads the team in rebounding, averaging 6.8 rebounds per game, which places her for 10th in rebounding in the ACC. In defensive rebounds, Morgan is eighth in the ACC. Morgan is the only true guard ranked in the top 10 in the ACC in rebounding. Alyssa Ustby (UNC) is listed as a G/F and ranks fourth.

Morgan also leads Georgia Tech in assists with 127 on the season for a 4.88 assists per game average. She ranks sixth in the

### **CANCUN CHALLENGE**

Georgia Tech spent the Thanksgiving holiday in Cancun, Mexico, making a return trip to the Cancun Challenge. The Yellow Jackets made their third appearance in the holiday tournament, having taken part in 2015-16 and 2018-19. Tech is 4-2 when competing in the tournament, having posted a 1-1 record this year.

This season, Tech dropped its opening game to Creighton, but rebounded with a win over New Mexico. Previously, Tech faced Northern Iowa and High Point in 2015-16, splitting the games, and swept George Washington and Idaho State in 2018-19. Tonie Morgan was named to the All-Tournament Team after scoring in double-figures in both games and recording a double-double against New Mexico.

### **MORE FOR THE MONEY**

Georgia Tech has recorded 19 games this season with at least three players finishing in double-figure scoring numbers. The Jackets got the season rolling with three or more players in double-figures in the first four games of the season. Tech broke the streak against Creighton in the Cancun Challenge, being held to two players in double-figures. The only other times Tech was held to two players in double-figures was against Florida in the ACC/SEC Challenge, Virginia, at Duke, at Virginia Tech and at Wake Forest with two players.

Kayla Blackshear has led Tech offensively in seven outings, while Tonie Morgan led the way against Furman and has scored in double-figures in 22 outings. Also contributing double-figures in her first four games was freshman Rusne Augustinaite, putting on a strong showing to start her collegiate career.

### **HOMETOWN SHOWDOWN**

D'Asia Thomas-Harris had quite the showing at Rice, playing in front of her hometown crowd as the freshman grew up not 30 minutes from Houston. Thomas-Harris recorded her first career double-double behind 12 points and 13 points, setting a personal-best this season in rebounding. She came up clutch in the second half, leading the Jackets with eight rebounds in the final two periods. She was the first Yellow Jacket to post a double-double this season.

Thomas-Harris continued her success against Kennesaw State, recording her second-straight double-figure scoring outing with a season-high 15 points.

### **COMEBACK WIN**

Tech trailed by as many as 17 points in the third quarter at Rice, but stormed back in the final 12 minutes to come away with a 78-75 victory over the Owls. The Jackets dominated the second half, 47-30, and shot 51.7 percent paced by Kayla Blackshear and Tonie Morgan with 12 and 10 points, respectively, in the final two periods. In the second half, Tech converted 12-of-17 free throw attempts, while Rice went to the line for the first and only time in the second half with 1:10 remaining in the game, hitting both attempts. After not hitting a three-pointer in the first half, Tech was 5-for-6 from long distance in the second half, including a perfect 3-for-3 in the fourth quarter. In the win, five Yellow Jackets finished in double-figure scoring totals, while D'Asia Thomas-Harris recorded the first double-double of the season.

### STRONG FROM THE FLOOR

Tech topped its season-best shooting percentage from last season in just its season-opener, shooting 51.6 percent (33-64) from the field against Coastal Carolina. Last season, Tech's best shooting percentage was 50.8 percent (31-61) against Clemson (1/26/23).

Against the Chanticleers, four Yellow Jackets finished in double-figure scoring numbers led by 20-plus point performances from Kayla Blackshear (24) and Tonie Morgan (20).

The Jackets recorded its second-straight game shooting 50 percent or higher against Furman, connecting on 52.1 percent from the field. The third outing shooting over 50.0 percent came against Kennesaw State when Tech shot a season-high 58.0 percent from the field.

Georgia Tech recorded its first game against a league opponent shooting 50.0 percent in its win over Boston College on Jan. 21. The Jackets were 27-of-54 from the field with four finishing in double-figures.

### **2024 SIGNING CLASS**

On National Signing Day, head coach Nell Fortner announced the addition of four Atlanta locals to the 2024-25 roster. All four were named to the Atlanta Tipoff Club Girls High School Preseason Watch List, Atlanta Tipoff Club's late-season watch list and were named McDonald's All-American nominees. The signing class has been ranked No. 19 by ESPN. The signing class included:

Danie Carnegie (5-9, G, Conyers, Ga.) - A four-star recruit by ESPN HoopGurlz, Carnegie is the third-highest ranked recruit in Georgia. She has earned multiple state and regional accolades, including first team 6A all-State by the AJC.

Gabbie Grooms (5-9, G, Sharpsburg, Ga.) -The 2023 AJC 2A Player of the Year, Grooms was tabbed Class A Private All-State second team honors in 2022. She has scored over 1,000-career points at Landmark Christian. Her mother, Lady Hardmon, played basketball at Georgia (1989-92) before going on to play eight seasons in the WNBA.

Tianna Thompson (5-10, G, Mableton, Ga.) - Thompson helped lead The Galloway School to a 2023 state runner-up finish, and has earned AJC Class A Private All-State first- and second-team honors in 2022 and 2021. She has scored over 1,000-career points and is a four-star recruit by Prospects Nation, and is the top-ranked recruit in Georgia. Her father, Rich, ran track and field at Georgia Tech (1988-91) and was inducted into the GT Sports Hall of Fame in 2001.

Chazadi "Chit Chat" Wright (5-4, G, Decatur, Ga.) - A two-time all-State honoree by the AJC, Wright earned first-team 3A all-State in 2023 and first-team Class A Private all-State in 2022. She

has also earned Region 7 Class 3A Region Player of the Year honors and has amassed over 1,000-career points at Wesleyan.

### **50 SEASONS**

The 2023-24 season marks the 50th season of Georgia Tech women's basketball. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 773 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021 with Nell Fortner at the helm.

### **MORGAN'S INAUGURAL SEASON**

Tonie Morgan put together quite the freshman season last year, leading Georgia Tech in assists with 114 and finishing second on the team in scoring, averaging 9.8 points per game. She returns as the team's leading scorer. After an impressive freshman season, Morgan earned ACC All-Freshman Team honors and collected two ACC Rookie of the Week honors.

In the ACC, Morgan was one of only four freshmen to own a double-double last season, and was one of only three to own multiple double-doubles. Additionally, she was one of only four players overall in the league to own a double-double on points and assists. Morgan flirted with a triple-double on multiple occassions last season.

Finishing with 114 assists, Morgan ranks fourth in the Georgia Tech record book in the freshman class. Nina Bärlin ranks third with 117 assists as a freshman in 1999-00. Carmen Davis holds the freshman record at GT with 173 assists during the 1989-90 season.

### **BLACKSHEAR ON THE BOARDS**

Kayla Blackshear led Georgia Tech in rebounding last season, pulling down 6.4 rebounds per game on average. The junior finished the season with five games securing double-figure rebounding totals. Blackshear was one of three Yellow Jackets last season to record a game with double-figure rebounds, joined by teammate Tonie Morgan who recorded three. Morgan, the team's second leading rebounder last season, recorded the team's season-high, having pulled down 15 rebounds against Syracuse.

### **WHAT'S DUNN DONE**

Kara Dunn also put together a strong freshman season last year, finishing with nine games in double-figure scoring, including four with 15-plus points. She set a career-high in scoring with 21 points against Wake Forest in her second-straight game with 20-plus points. She was one of only three Yellow Jackets to score 20 or more points.

Dunn finished the season averaging 7.6 points per game, shot 42.9 percent from the floor and 73.5 percent from the free throw line. She returns as the team's second leading scorer behind Tonie Morgan. Dunn appeared in 28 games and earned the start in 14.

### **ACC/SEC CHALLENGE**

The 2023-24 season will mark the start of the ACC/SEC Challenge. In the inaugural matchups, Georgia Tech drew Florida and will host the Gators on Nov. 29 at 5 p.m. in McCamish Pavilion. Despite their relatively close proximity, the ACC/SEC Challenge matchup between Georgia Tech and Florida will be only the second meeting in series history and the first in 37 years. In the only previous matchup, the Yellow Jackets downed the Gators, 82-72, on Dec. 5, 1986 in Atlanta.

### HITTING THE PORTAL

Georgia Tech hit the transfer portal over the summer and welcomed two transfers to The Flats for their fifth seasons of eligibility. Joining the 2023-24 roster are Sydney Johnson (Powder Springs, Ga.) and Caitlyn Wilson (Cordova, Tenn.).

Johnson played four seasons at Boston University becoming the first Terrier in program history to be named first team all-Patriot League multiple times. Johnson finished her career at BU ranked 11th in program history with 1,255 career points, eighth with 330 career assists, ninth with 483 career field goals made and ninth with a 12.0 points per game average. In four seasons, she started 97 of her 105 career games played, was twice tabbed all-Patriot League first team (2022, 2023) and once to second team (2021). In 2023, Johnson was named to the all-Patriot League defensive team and tournament team after leading the Terriers with 107 assists and 55 steals, while ranking second with 12.8 ppg her final season. She was first named to the all-Patriot League tournament team in 2022.

Wilson played three seasons at Cincinnati, appearing in 77 games for the Bearcats and starting 42. She averaged 7.8 points and 1.8 rebounds, while shooting 32.6 percent from the field and 32.9 percent from three-point distance. Wilson hit at least 50 three-pointers each season to finish sixth in the Cincinnati record book in three-pointers made with 163. Wilson played her freshman season at Chipola Junior College in Marianna, Fla. She started 18-of-27 games and averaged 13.6 points, 3.4 made three-pointers, 3.2 rebounds and 2.0 steals per game to earn all-Panhandle Conference First Team honors.

### **GOING DANCING**

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history in 2021. Tech's appearance in 2022 marked the 11th in the Big Dance.

## HEAD COACH NELL FORTNER

5th Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 391-246 (.615) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue - 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn - 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 13 seasons of experience as a head coach - one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and four at Georgia Tech (2019-22) - and has compiled a 248-176 (.585) overall record in the college ranks.
