About Tech: Tech, under the direction of Danny Hall who is in his 31st year, checks in at 7-1. Tech's lone loss came to Cornell 11-4 last Sunday. Freshman CF Drew Burress (.414-9-20) leads the nation with nine home runs after going 4-for-4 with a school record four homers in a 10-0 win over Ga. State this past Tuesday. He has 15 hits on the year, 14 going for extra bases.

#### Bulldog News & Notes

\*The Bulldogs are 8-1 under Wes Johnson and feature one of the nation's top offenses with an NCAA-best 27 home runs and a .706 slugging percentage. Johnson matched the best start for a first-year Georgia baseball coach in the modern era by going 8-0, which is what the legendary Ron Polk did in 2000. The best-ever was by Hammond Johnson, who went 20-0 in 1908. The Bulldogs had two losses that year but those didn't count because they came against professional teams!

\*Nine Bulldogs have hit home runs with All-America **Charlie Condon** leading the way with seven. The 2023 squad hit 101 HR (Condon hit 25) which ranked third most in school history. The 2024 squad is on a school record pace to hit 168 in the regular season!

\*The pitching staff has a 5.35 ERA with two shutouts. The '23 staff had a 6.44 ERA and three shutouts. \*Georgia's 45-man roster features 17 returning lettermen and 28 newcomers. The Bulldogs hail from eight states, four countries (USA, Canada, Czechia & Panama) and 11 are graduates.

#### **Condon Showing Versatility And Triple Digit Exit Velo**

\*Consensus All-America **Charlie Condon** (.639-7-13) is the reigning SEC Player of the Week. A red-shirt sophomore on the Golden Spikes Award Watch List, he is projected to be a 1st Round pick in 2024. He carries multiple gloves as he plays third base (5 starts), first base (1 start) and the outfield (3 starts in LF). He has had multiple hits in all nine games this year. This past Wednesday against Michigan State, he tied a school record by smashing home runs in his first three at bats (CF then LF then RF) before being intentionally walked. Currently, he ranks second nationally with an SEC-best .639 batting average, ranks first with a 1.417 SLG% and third in OB% at .696. His exit velocity is routinely more than 100 mph and as high as 118. \*In week one, junior infielder **Slate Alford** earned SEC Co-Player of the Week honors. He posted an SEC best 15 total bases, three home runs and nine RBI in a sweep of Asheville. Currently, he is batting .325-3-10 from the leadoff spot. Alford and Condon have reached base in all nine games.

#### **Pitching Prospects**

\*Georgia will employ the same rotation for the Tech series as it has used for the first two series against UNC Asheville and Northern Kentucky. Against Asheville, the Bulldogs posted a 2.62 ERA with 34 strikeouts and 10 walks. Georgia registered a pair of combined two-hitters including one shutout. The Norse proved to be much stronger offensively as the Bulldogs still swept but had a 7.56 ERA with 29 strikeouts and 13 walks. \*The weekend rotation features graduate LHP **Charlie Goldstein** (2-0, 2.00 ERA), graduate RHP **Christian Mrcana** (1-0, 1.23 ERA) and sophomore RHP **Leighton Finley** (1-0, 5.14 ERA).

\*Graduate RHP **Brian Zeldin** (1-0, 2.25 ERA, 1 SV) has a team-high four relief appearances for a total of four innings with two walks and five strikeouts. He notched his first win as a Bulldog in this past Sunday's 12-11 walk-off over Northern Kentucky and collected his first save in a 4-3 tight contest with Presbyterian. \*Georgia has used 13 relievers this season as the Bulldogs look to establish roles before conference play begins in mid-March. The Bulldogs open SEC play at Kentucky (March 15-17). After the Tech series, Georgia will play Ga. Southern, Stetson and a four-game set with Northern Colorado.

#### FOLEY FIELD RENOVATION PROJECT UPDATE

The current \$45 million renovation of Foley Field will continue to elevate both the player and fan experience at UGA's baseball facility. The entire project is slated to be completed by the start of the 2025 season.

#### Wes JOHNSON lke Cousins Head Baseball

Coach 1st Season at UGA (Arkansas Monticello '94) RECORD: 8-1 (0-0 SEC)

Wes Johnson, the renowned pitching coach for LSU, was named the Ike Cousins head baseball coach at the Universi-

ty of Georgia on June 5, 2023.

A native of Sherwood, Ark., Johnson became the first pitching coach in Major League Baseball history to make the move directly from the college ranks to the big leagues when he was hired by the Minnesota Twins in November of 2018. He served as a collegiate pitching coach since 2008 with stints in the SEC at Mississippi State and Arkansas. Minnesota was the leading the American League Central in June of 2022 when he opted to return to college at LSU.

Johnson remained with the Tigers until their 2023 season was complete, culminating in their seventh national title. The Tigers made their first CWS since 2017 and won their first national title since 2009. LSU finished 54-17 and had a school record 13 players (eight pitchers) selected in the MLB Draft including the first (Paul Skenes, RHP, record \$9.2 million bonus/Pittsburgh Pirates) and second (Dylan Crews, OF) picks.

The Twins won their division in Johnson's first two years directing the pitching staff, and in 2020, the club ranked fourth in the Majors in ERA and WHIP. Kenta Maeda posted a 2.70 ERA and a 6-1 mark to earn a runner-up finish for the American League Cy Young Award.

During his time as a college coach, 38 of Johnson's pitchers have been drafted by MLB teams, and he has been at the forefront of utilizing technology.

As pitching coach at Arkansas, Johnson helped the 2018 Razorbacks reach the College World Series Finals as they finished 48-21. The top pitcher on that 2018 staff was Blaine Knight who went 14-0 with a 2.80 ERA and was a third-round pick of the Baltimore Orioles.

In his one season at Mississippi State, Johnson was instrumental in a dramatic turnaround by the Bulldogs going from worst to first. After winning only eight SEC games the previous year and having the highest ERA in the league, the 2016 club claimed the SEC regular-season title and advanced to an NCAA Super Regional. MSU won 44 games, its most since 1997.

In four seasons at Dallas Baptist University, Johnson helped the Patriots to three NCAA Regionas, had 14 pitchers drafted and his pitching staffs set single season records for almost every major statistical category.

Johnson earned a bachelor's degree in marketing from the University of Arkansas Monticello in 1994. He completed a master's degree in kinesiology in 2017. Johnson and his wife Angie, have three children: Ryan, Anna and Ava; and one grandson, Mason.
