THIS SERIES

> Georgia Southern hosts in-state rival Georgia Tech for the first midweek match-up of the season.

> Georgia Tech currently owns a three-game win streak over the Eagles after Georgia Southern defeated the Yellow Jackets 8-6 in Statesboro back in February 2022.

> Tech was picked to finish fifth in the Coastal Division of the ACC in the conference's preseason poll.

LAST TIME OUT

> Maryland narrowly defeated Southern on Friday, 5-4, then handled the Eagles on Saturday, 7-1, to take the series. Georgia Southern responded on Sunday with a 7-3 victory to salvage a game and get out of the series with a win.

STORYLINES

NOT HIS FIRST RODEO

Rodney Hennon, longtime Eagles' skipper, becomes the longest-tenured head coach in Georgia Southern baseball history during the 2024 season. Hennon passes legendary coach Jack Stallings, who lead the Eagles for 24 years from 1976-1999. Hennon also ties J.B. Searcase, a long time Georgia Southern admin, men's basketball coach, and baseball coach in 1948, as the longest-tenured coach in school history.

DEJA VU?

Georgia Southern looks to bounce back after a 27-29 finish in 2023, just the second losing season in the past 25 years for the Eagles. The last time the Eagles had a losing season, the following year saw the Eagles win the SoCon and compete in the Tallahassee Regional, where Sam Howard pitched a two-hit shutout against regional host and #5 National Seed Florida State.

BIG GAMES AT J.I.

Georgia Southern hosts a Big Ten foe for a three-game series for the second-straight year. Last season, the Eagles welcomed the Scarlet Knights of Rutgers to Statesboro for a three-game set. It's the fourth-straight season GS opens with a P5 opponent ('21 - Tenn | '22 - @ Tenn | '23 - WVU).

MORE NOTES

BEEN THERE, DONE THAT

Georgia Southern is one of three teams in Division I to play in at least five of the last seven conference championships. Oral Roberts (Summit League) and Wright State (Horizon League) are the other two with this distinction.

COMPETITIVE EXCELLENCE

Since the beginning of the 2018 season, when the Eagles have won four innings in a game (outscored their opponents in at least four innings in a game), they are 66-4.

NEW DIGS

Georgia Southern is planning a \$10 million renovation to J.I. Clements Stadium. The renovation includes a state-of-the-art clubhouse facility, which includes a team meeting room, indoor pitching lab and batting cages, new locker rooms directly connected to the dugout, weight rooms, a nutrition room, new coaches offices, players lounge, and a game-day patio space that includes grilling and tailgating areas.

PLAYING ON HARD MODE

Georgia Southern is known for having competitive and strong schedules year in and year out, and this season is no exception. This season, Southern will see several Power Conference opponents, including Maryland, Georgia Tech, Mississippi State, and South Carolina, while playing a tough Sun Belt schedule against the likes of Coastal Carolina, Southern Miss, and Louisiana. Warren Nolan is predicting the Eagles to have the 44th-ranked strength of schedule this year, third in the SBC only behind Coastal Carolina (#28) and Old Dominion (#43).

THIS STATE AIN'T BIG ENOUGH FOR BOTH OF US

Georgia Southern and Georgia will only meet once this season, taking on each other at the annual SRP Park College Showcase in North Augusta, S.C. The Eagles and Bulldogs will renew their rivalry on March 5.

JACK STALLINGS FIELD AT J.I. CLEMENTS STADIUM

> Home of Eagle Baseball since 2005, J.I. Clements Stadium has treated Georgia Southern well, holding a staggering .660 winning percentage at home (320-165).

> The stadium is named after former Eagles skipper J.I. Clements, who was the head of the program from 1949-66, and again in 1968. Clements led the Eagles to their first national championship in 1962.

> The field was dedicated to former Eagles head coach Jack Stallings on Feb. 19, 2005. Stallings is the winningest coach in school history with 859 victories in 24 seasons. Stallings also led the Eagles to the 1990 College World Series where they defeated Harvard in the first round. Stallings is one of two Eagles to have his number retired at J.I.

> J.I. Clements Stadium owns the distinction of being the only college baseball stadium with a completely manual scoreboard. The scoreboard is located in right field as part of the "Blue Monster," a 24 ft. wall that was added in a 2017 renovation of the stadium. While other schools, such as Loyola Marymount, have mostly manual boards, GS' is completely manual and has no electronics integrated at all.

RETIRED NUMBERS

> The Georgia Southern baseball program has two retired numbers that are never to be worn again by any player or coach. These numbers are Jack Stallings's #1 and Todd Greene's #20.

- Stallings was the Eagles' skipper from 1976 to 1999, taking the Eagles to its second-ever College World Series in 1990. Prior to GS, Stallings was the head coach at Florida State, where the Seminoles finished as national runner-up in the CWS in 1970. Stallings began his career as an assistant coach at Wake Forest. His collected 1,259 wins as a head coach. Stallings also coached the US Baseball team in the '70s and '80s.

- Greene owned the record for most homeruns hit by a freshman (26) before the record was broken by NC State's Tommy White. Greene is considered one of the greatest college baseball players ever, hitting .344 and hitting 88 homeruns in his career. His 88 HRs still ranks as third all-time for a career in NCAA history. Green spent time in the MLB with the Angels, Blue Jays, Yankees, Rangers, Rockies, and Giants.

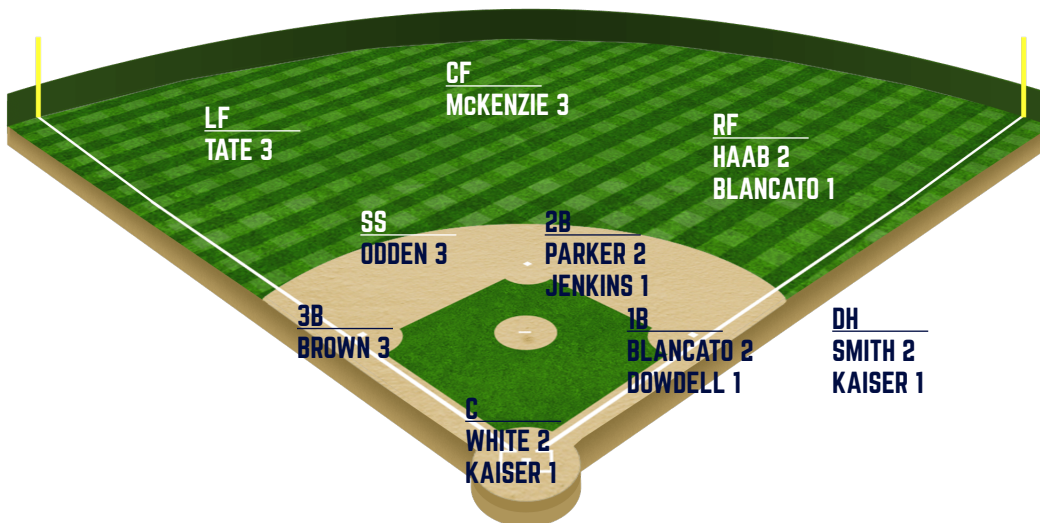

THE HENNON FILE

Georgia Southern head coach Rodney Hennon finished his 24th season in the Blue and White in 2023, which saw him with both his 800th game at Georgia Southern and his 900th game in his head coaching career. Hennon also tied legendary Eagles skipper Jack Stallings for the longest tenured baseball coach in school history with 24 seasons under his belt.

Rodney Hennon completed his 23rd season at Georgia Southern in 2022, where he led the Eagles to its first NCAA Regional since the 2014 season. The Eagles were labelled as the #16 National Seed and hosted the Statesboro Regional for the first time in program history. Coach Hennon also saw Georgia Southern earn its first 40+ win season in eight years, finishing with a 41-20 record. GS made its fifth SBC Championship game in six years, and won its most conference games since 2000, going 23-7 in a Sun Belt Conference that sent four teams to the postseason.

During the Coach Hennon Era, Georgia Southern has posted 30 or more wins in 21 of the 23 seasons and four 40-win seasons.

Hennon has guided the Eagles to seven NCAA Regionals including the 2014 Tallahassee Regional, where GS defeated #5 national seed Florida State 7-0. He has led the Eagles to 11 regular season or tournament conference titles including Southern Conference Tournament Titles in 2009, 2011 and 2014. The Eagles won their first Sun Belt Championship in 2019 by taking the East Division Crown after an 18-12 finish in league play.

Twice named Southern Conference Coach of the Year, Hennon came to Georgia Southern after two seasons (1998-99) as head coach of his alma mater Western Carolina. After accepting an offer to guide the Western Carolina program in July 1997, Hennon quickly added his own distinctive chapters to one of the winningest programs in the Southern Conference. During his inaugural campaign as head coach in 1998, Hennon led the Catamounts to a 45-15 overall record and a 20-6 SoCon mark, tying the WCU mark for most victories in a single year and ranking sixth among all NCAA Division I members in winning percentage. His players claimed both the Southern Conference's Pitcher and Player of the Year awards while seven signed professional contracts at the conclusion of the season.

Prior to taking over the WCU head coaching duties, Hennon served as a full-time assistant coach for his alma mater for three seasons. As an assistant coach, Hennon helped lead the Cats to a 42-20 record, a Southern Conference title, and NCAA Tournament appearance in 1997 as a member of the late Keith LeClair's staff. He joined the WCU baseball staff in 1994 as a part-time assistant after earning numerous on-field and classroom honors during his playing career from 1990 to 1993.

A Second Team All-SoCon choice in 1992, Hennon batted .367 to lead the SoCon in hits and runs scored, while sparking the Catamounts to the league regular season and tournament championship. Despite his all-tournament performance (eight hits and five RBI), WCU fell one game short of reaching the College World Series after falling to Florida State in NCAA South II Regional Championship play. A year later as a senior, Hennon earned First Team All-SoCon honors, again leading the league in hits and runs scored and helping the Catamounts to the NCAA South Regional in Baton Rouge, Louisiana. When he left WCU, he ranked first among the school's season leaders in games started and at-bats, while standing tied for 19th in runs scored and 23rd for hits.

Hennon earned his bachelor's degree in Economics from Western Carolina in 1993. In the classroom, he was a two-time GTE-CoSIDA Academic All-America choice as he posted a 3.55 grade point average during his four years of undergraduate work in WCU's College of Business. Hennon was also named to the Southern Conference Academic Honor Roll in each of his four years while competing as a student-athlete.



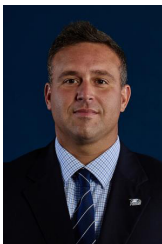

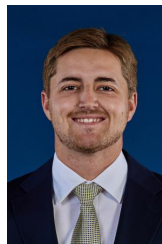

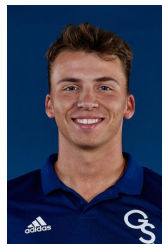
