### **QUICK HITTERS**

- Georgia Tech softball returns to The Flats for a midweek game against cross-town rivals Georgia State before hosting a portion of the I-75 Tournament this weekend, featuring six games against UNC-Greensboro (twice), Army (once), Robert Morris (once) and Ball State (twice).
- The Yellow Jacket offense was on full display last weekend at the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational, exploding for 32 runs across four games against some of the top pitching staffs in the nation.
- Tech owns 17 home runs, the fourth-most in Division I through the first two weeks of the year.
- The power production has come from everywhere in the lineup. Nine different Jackets have connected for a long ball this season (Dobbins (3), Black (3), Hunter (3), Allen (2), Sileo (2), Tucker (1), Edgmon (1), Domingue (1) and Minghini (1)), the most among Power 5 teams headed into the week.
- The White & Gold has hit 16 home runs over its last six games (since the first game of the Longwood doubleheader), the most in a six-game stretch in 13 seasons (18 HR - March 4-13, 2011).
- Senior 3B Mallorie Black earned her first ACC Player of the Week for leading the Jackets with a .727 avg/.786 obp/1.182 slug, over the course of four games against No. 9 Stanford, No. 12 LSU, No. 22 Northwestern and Minnesota (RV) last week. Black reached base multiple times in each game, going 8 for 11 over the course of the Clearwater Invitational, adding two doubles, a home run, two walks, a hit-by-pitch and a team-best six runs scored.
- Black's hitting streak ended at a career-best five games in the last outing vs. No. 22 Northwestern, going 0 for 1 with a walk and a HBP. Her on-base streak is now at a team-best six games.
- Among Power 5 teams, the Jackets are tied for the fourth-most doubles (19) and own the 7th highest slugging % (.615).
- Paige Vukadinovich has already hit a career-high 3 doubles this season, including two in her last game vs. Northwestern.
- In her fifth season on The Flats, Neleman has an opportunity to etch her name into the top of the program record books. She enters the week with the 2nd most career strikeouts in program history (583) after collecting 19 Ks in her first four appearances. The Marietta native is one save away from tying Kristen Adkins ('09-'11) for the 2nd most by a Jacket, her next shutout will tie her for the 5th most in program history (Nikki Johnson '94) and she is 9 appearances away from joining Hope Rush and Whitney Humphreys in a tie for the second most all-time after recording her 130th appearance last game.
- Impeccable defense has become the standard on The Flats under Coach Morales. Over the last three complete seasons, the Yellow Jackets committed just 104 errors, the fewest in the ACC by a comfortable margin (2nd Syracuse - 124 errors).
- That is the 9th fewest errors committed in Division I in the 2021, '22 and '23 seasons and the fifth fewest among Power 5 programs, behind only Oklahoma (79), Washington (93), Michigan (100) and Arizona (102).
- Jin Sileo and Ella Edgmon have spearheaded the defense from the shortstop and center field positions, combining for 36 putouts and 12 assists without committing an error this season.
- Seven Yellow Jackets are batting over .300 through the opening 10 games of the season (Allen, Tucker, Black, Sileo, Vukadinocich, Edgmon and Hunter) - the most in the Aileen Morales era and the most in 10 seasons. (2014).
- Sophia Voyles pitched 4.0 innings, striking out five against No. 2 Tennessee before the game was rained out last Sunday. She struck out four batters in a row, including three-time All-American Kiki Millov in the now unofficial game.

### **OFFENSE OPERATING IN THE BLACK**

- Senior 3B Mallorie Black was named ACC Player of the Week on Tuesday. It is her first-career ACC weekly honor following a dazzling display of offense over the weekend against some of the best pitching staffs in the nation at the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational.
- Black finished the weekend with a .727 batting average (eight for 11), two doubles, a home run, four RBI, two walks and a team-leading six runs scored, while also stealing a base and reaching via a hit-by-pitch.
- In total, Black slashed .727 avg./.786 obp /1.182 slugging while facing some of the highest ranked teams across Division I.
- She becomes the first Jacket to earn ACC Player of the Week Honors since Jin Sileo in April of 2022
- Black's weekend began with a leadoff single in the second inning against No. 9 Stanford. She would immediately steal second base against Stanford's catcher Aly Kaneshiro, the Power 5's leader in caught stealings from a season ago.
- The Cumming native would later collect her first RBI of the weekend, in the bottom of the 5th, driving in Madison Dobbins for Georgia Tech's fifth run of the day.
- Black's hits helped the Jackets tally 13 base knocks against Stanford, more hits than the Cardinal had given up all of last season and the most hits against since 2022 (97 games).
- In her second game of the day, against No. 12 LSU, Black posted her first-career 4 for 4 day at the dish mashing a home run and a double while scoring three runs and driving in two.
- Once again, she was the first Jacket to record a hit, reaching via a 1st inning single. Her hit advanced Sara Beth Allen, who had walked just before, into scoring position, which allowed for both Allen and Black to score on an LSU error later that inning, the first runs LSU had surrendered all season after shutting out its opponents in each of its previous five games.
- Black continued her offensive performance with a double in the bottom of the third before connecting for a solo home run to keep the game alive in the bottom of the sixth inning, her third of the season. She polished off her 4 for 4 day with an RBI single in the Jackets' four-run seventh, driving in Jin Sileo before coming home to score on a Tiffany Domingue homer.
- Her defense was on display throughout the game as well, recording two putouts and three assists from the hot corner without committing an error.
- The next day, Black would go 2 for 3 with two runs scored, a walk and another double in Georgia Tech's thrilling battle with Minnesota (RV). The senior from North Forsyth HS singled home Dobbins to start a four-run top of the 4th inning, before coming around to score on a double from Domingue.
- She kept the Tech momentum going in the 5th inning, lining a double to left field on the first pitch following a home run from Allen, although she would be stranded on second to end the inning. With one out and down four runs in the 7th inning, Black worked a walk, allowing for Dobbins to score on the resulting Minnesota error, and would come around to score on Emma Minghini's two-out three-run home run to tie the game at 11.
- Black's career-best hitting streak of five games came to an end against No. 22 Northwestern but her on-base streak extended to 7 games, going 0 for 1 with a walk and a hit-by-pitch.
- She came around to score after being hit by a pitch in her second at-bat of the game, once again being driven in by Domingue. She walked in the fourth inning as well, setting up runners at the corners and only one out, but was stranded on first.

### **DECORATED DEALING**

- Senior right hander Blake Neleman is in her 5th season on The Flats with 583 career strikeouts, the second most in program history.
- With six career saves, Neleman is currently in an nine-way tie for third in all-time career saves, tie with current teammate Chandler Dennis after Dennis recorded a save on opening day.
- She needs one save to tie Kristen Adkins (2009-11) for second and 11 more to tie Dina El Sheshai (1990-93) for the program record.
- -With 10 career shutouts, Neleman needs 11 to tie Nikki Johnson (1994) for fifth in program history.
- The Marietta product is just two appearances shy of tying Erin Voeltz (2001-04) for the 4th most appearances by a Georgia Tech pitcher and 77.1 innings away from tying Whitney Humphreys (2005-08) for the 5th most innings pitched by a Jacket.
- Last season, Neleman delivered 153 strikeouts, the fifth most in the ACC. Her 7.3 strikeouts per 7 innings ranks fifth in the conference as well.
- She allowed only 5.57 hits per 7 innings in the 2023 season, the 9th fewest among ACC pitchers returning for this season.
- The Jackets are one of only three ACC schools (along with Duke and Virginia Tech) to return every inning pitched from 2023 as all five pitchers return for the '24 campaign: Neleman (147.0), Dennis (130.1), Sophia

Voyles (41.2), Kinsey Norton (26.0) and Jaidyn Studebaker (1.1).

#### **MAKING HER MARK**

- -In her 7th season as Head Coach, Aileen Morales surpassed one of her former coaches on The Flats , Ehren Earleywine (2004-06), in victories last season. Morales (2018-present) is currently fourth in program history in career wins at Georgia Tech (158) as she reached the 150 mark as skipper at her alma mater with the win over Jacksonville State.
- In wins commanding Georgia Tech, Morales currently trails Kate Madden (1999-2003) with 161 for third, Regina Thomaselli (1991-98) with 239 for second and Sharon Perkins (2007-13) with 290 her second former coach as a player for first.
- In conference wins on The Flats, Morales (55) eclipsed 50 with a win over Virginia this season as she's second only to Perkins (99).
- In terms of win percentages, Morales is third in program history both overall (.533) and in ACC play (.426) behind both of her former coaches. Earleywine leads the way overall (.726) while Perkins is second (.678), and the roles are reversed in conference play for Perkins (.702) and Earleywine (.609).
- Morales earned her 250th career win as a head coach in the Queen City Classic as Tech topped Kent State, 7-4, on Feb. 26, 2023. She's now up to 266 career wins.

#### **TECH-TICAL EFFICIENCY AT THE PLATE**

- Georgia Tech's offense exploded for 19 runs and seven home runs in 10+ innings at the dish in the Jackets' 9-1 (6) and 10-2 (5) rune rule victories over Longwood on Sunday.
- The seven home run day is tied for the most Tech dingers in a single day since hitting nine in a DH vs Georgia Southern March 15, 2011.
- Madison Dobbins hit two home runs in the second game of the doubleheader, a solo shot and a grand slam, the first of her career, giving her a career-best five RBI.
- Mallorie Black walked off the opening game on the very first pitch of the bottom of the sixth it was her second HR of the weekend after hitting an opposite field blast in the 7th inning of Tech's 3-1 loss to Alabama on Friday.
- Gracyn Tucker hit her first collegiate home run to walk off the second game, capping off a 3 for 3 day at the plate for the freshman in her third career start.
- Ella Edgmon got the party started in the first game, ripping an inside pitch over the RF wall for her 3rd career HR and first at home. The slapper opened the flood gates for what would become a 7-run 3rd inning in the opening game.
- Sara Beth Allen collected her first dinger of the new year in game one against Longwood as a part of the 7-run 3rd inning.
- Reese Hunter set up Tucker for the walk-off homer when she blasted a two-run shot off the scoreboard in the bottom of the 5th in game 2, her first of the year and 4th as a Jacket.
- The Jackets 7 home runs came in the span of 8.0+ innings.
- Tech followed that performance with nine home runs over four games at the Clearwater Invite, as seven more Jackets added at least one HR
- Tech has hit 16 home runs over its last six games, the most in a six-game stretch in 13 seasons (18 HR March 4-13, 2011).
- It is the first time Georgia Tech has hit multiple home runs in six consecutive games since 2011 as well

#### **DEFENDING THE NEST**

- Defense has been a calling card of Morales' recent Georgia Tech teams, never more so than in 2023, when the Yellow Jackets set program records for the highest fielding percentage (.978) and the fewest errors (30) in a single season.
- Over the last three full seasons, there is no better defensive team in the ACC than Georgia Tech and the numbers aren't particularly close. Tech committed just 104 errors from 2021-2023, 20 errors fewer than the next closest ACC program (Syracuse 124).
- The Jackets 110 errors since 2021 is the ninth fewest in Division I and the

- The Jackets return eight of the nine most common starters from last year's record setting defense, including infield stalwarts Mallorie Black (3B), Jin Sileo (SS) and Grace Connelly (2B), all of whom played in all 53 games for the Jackets last season, combining for just 14 errors between the three of them (Connelly 6 / Black 5 / Sileo 3).
- The defensive prowess extends to the outfield grass as well, where Ella Edgmon and Paige Vukadinovich combined for 82 putouts and just one error during the '23 season, making a number of rangy plays in the process.

### **CHAOS ON THE BASE PATHS**

- The Yellow Jackets have been aggressive as a unit on the base paths, ranking fourth in the conference in triples per game (.21) and fourth in the ACC in stolen bases per game (1.64) last season.
- Georgia Tech reached double digit triples last season for the first time since 2014.
- Madison Dobbins and Paige Vukadinovich lead the returning Jackets after each posting a pair of triples in 2023.
- The White & Gold swiped 87 bags last year, the most since 2013, for an average of 1.64 per game, the 8th most in Power 5.
- Edgmon was a major factor in the stolen bases category, posting 18 steals on 19 attempts (94.7% success rate). That's the highest success rate of any Jacket with at least 15 attempts since 2014, when Hayley Downs swiped 20 bags on 21 attempts.
- Sileo (16 steals) and Madison Dobbins (12 steals) joined Edgmon in double digits, with Sileo cracking the Top 175 in Division I with her 16 swipes.  $\$
- Edgmon (132nd) and Sileo (174th) gave the Jackets two representatives in the Top 175 for steals last year, one of only 12 teams from a Power 5 conference to have such representation Louisville, Virginia, Florida St., Clemson, Virginia Tech, Baylor, Maryland, Missouri, Florida, South Carolina and Utah.
- Thus far, the Jackets are 5 for 5 in stolen base attempts, led by two from Edgmon.

### TREAD LIGHTLY AROUND SBA

- Senior slugger Sara Beth Allen was the most feared hitter in the Tech lineup last season, smashing 13 home runs tied for the most in a single season by a Tech hitter since 2011 while also drawing a teamhigh 33 walks.
- Her 13 dingers place her 7th among ACC returners this season while her .65 walks per game average has her third in the conference.
- The Jackson County product rattled off a team-best eight home runs in the Fall.
- She has proven to be patient enough at the plate to wait for her pitch so far in 2024, walking seven times

#### **AIN'T LIFE GRAND?**

- The Yellow Jackets blasted four grand slams last year off the bats of junior Grace Connelly (two), senior Mallorie Black and junior Emma Minghini.
- The four grand slams is tied for the most in a season since 2019.
- Connelly became just the 7th Jacket this century to record multiple grand slams in a single season and the first since Tricia Awald in 2021.
- Tech already is looking to eclipse that total this year with Madison Dobbins securing the first grand slam of her career in the second game of a doubleheader vs. Longwood.

#### LINE 'EM UP!

- Tech is slated to face nine ranked teams, including a pair of games on opening weekend against No. 11/14 Alabama at Mewborn Field.
- The Jackets will open the season at home with the 25th edition of the Buzz Classic, featuring opponents Villanova, Longwood and 2023 Women's College World Series participants, No. 11 Alabama.
- Georgia Tech will compete in the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational in the second week of the season, featuring match ups against the nation's top competition.
- Tech will play six games at the tournament to be broadcast on ESPN and the ESPN family of networks. The Jackets opponents for the weekend include three participants in the 2023 Women's College World Series (No. 2/4 Stanford, No. 2/3 Tennessee and No. 12/14 Oklahoma State) along with 2023 NCAA Tournament teams, No. 12/17 LSU, Minnesota and No. 24 Northwestern.
- The Jackets will play five games on linear television this season, with the Stanford game (Feb. 15) being broadcast on ESPNU and four more (2/15 vs. LSU, 2/17 vs. Northwestern, 3/15 and 3/17 vs. Notre Dame) will be broadcast on ACC Network.
- The following week will be the I-75 Tournament featuring six home games against four different opponents over the course of three days (Feb. 23-25). The Jackets will take on reigning Southern Conference champions, UNCG, along with Army, Robert Morris and Ball State.
- Tech will battle 13 opponents from the 2023 NCAA Tournament field, headlined by out-of-conference foes No. 11 Alabama (Feb. 9 & 10) and UNCG (Feb. 23 & 24), along with road games at No. 19/20 Auburn (April 5 & 6) and No. 6 Georgia (March 13). Tech will take on six NCAA Tournament teams at the Shriners Children's Clearwater Invitational Presented by EvoShield (Feb. 15-18).
- The White and Gold will battle four in-state opponents this season, taking on Georgia State (Feb. 21 & April 16), Mercer (Feb. 28), Kennesaw State (March 26 & April 23). The 2024 edition of Clean, Old-Fashioned Hate will take place in Athens on March 13.
- Tech hosts four ACC series at Mewborn Field: Pitt (March 1-3), Notre Dame (March 15-17), Louisville (April 12-14) and Virginia (April 26-28).
- The Jackets will take on four of the eight programs from last season's Women's College World Series: No. 11/21 Alabama (Feb. 9 & 10 at Mewborn Field), No. 2/4 Stanford (Feb. 15 in Clearwater, Fla.), No. 2/3 Tennessee (Feb. 17 in Clearwater, Fla.) and No. 12/14 Oklahoma State (Feb. 18 in Clearwater, Fla.) with a possibility of adding a fifth, in the ACC Tournament (May 8-11).

#### **NELEMAN'S NO-NO**

- Neleman's no-no in the 2021 ACC Tournament against Syracuse marked the fourth in Georgia Tech postseason history and fourth individual no-hitter in ACC Championship history.
- Neleman's no-hitter marked the 28th in program history. Of those 27 prior, only 12 went seven or more innings and were tossed by only one Jacket.
- Neleman is now the 15th Yellow Jacket in the record books with a no-hitter to her name.
- In the postseason, Neleman is just the second Jacket to heave seven or more innings for a no-hitter.
- Neleman's no-no was the first for Tech in the postseason since 2010. The Jackets had not tossed a no-hitter in the regular season since 2015.
- Neleman is just the sixth Yellow Jacket freshman to hurl a complete game no-hitter.

Alleen Morales, one of the most decorated student-athletes in Georgia Tech softball history and a former highly successful assistant coach at her alma mater, returned to The Flats as the program's sixth head coach on June 7, 2017.

In her fifth season on The Flats, Morales brought the Yellow Jackets back to national prominence by reaching their first NCAA Regional since 2012 and 12th in program history, earning a win in the first round. To get there, she led the White and Gold to a 38-18 overall record for the most wins and non conference wins (27) since 2011. Tech's 84.4 non conference win percentage and 24 home wins were also program bests. Morales' Jackets achieved a final RPI of No. 23, the highest since 2011 after tallying the eighth most wins and the 10th best win percentage all-time. Tech picked up a pair of ranked victories, including a thriller over Notre Dame and a mercy-rule triumph over Georgia marking the Jackets' largest margin of victory over the Bulldogs, their first win in the series since 2012 and the first on the road since 2007. Statistically, Morales guided Tech to rank fifth in the nation and second in the conference in walks as well as third in program history with a .395 on-base percentage. Georgia Tech also stood firm defensively to place second in the ACC and in single-season program history with a .975 fielding percentage. The Yellow Jackets went 6-0 against in-state opponents, compiling nine mercy rule wins and eight shutouts on the year. Morales also guided individual standouts to three all-ACC honors and two all-region selections on the way to one of the top turnarounds as a team in the country. On Feb. 22, Morales also earned her 100th win as head coach of the Yellow Jackets.

Tech returned to action in full capacity following the abbreviated 2020 year for Morales' fourth season on The Flats as the White and Gold finished 20-26 in the quarterfinal round of the ACC tournament. Morales achieved her 200th career win as a head coach during the season, also being selected into the Georgia Tech Hall of Fame as a member of the 2021 class for her playing career.

Year three for Morales was cut short due to Covid-19 as the Jackets remained above .500 at 12-11.

Morales followed her first season with more success in her second, coaching the team to its first ACC tournament win since 2012 with a decisive 8-0, five-inning run-rule win over Virginia in the opening round. She brought Tech over the 30 win mark for the first time since 2012, finishing with a 31-27 record, including the program's 1,000th win.

In her first year at the helm of the Georgia Tech softball program, Morales led the Jackets to their first postseason appearance since 2014. Tech recorded five ACC series wins for the first time since 2011, finishing sixth in the ACC. With 28 wins on the season, Tech surpassed with 25-win mark for the first time since 2013 and finished above .500 for the first time since 2012.

In her nine seasons as a student-athlete (2005-08) and assistant coach (2009-13) at Georgia Tech, she helped lead the Yellow Jackets to four Atlantic Coast Conference regular-season championships (2005, 2009-11), four ACC Tournament titles (2005, 2009-10, 2012), eight NCAA regionals (2005-12) and an NCAA Super Regional (2009). The Jackets averaged 43 wins per season during her nine years with the program.

Since leaving her alma mater following the 2013 campaign, she has added four seasons as a successful head coach to her resume, first at Young Harris College in Young Harris, Ga. (2014-15) and most recently at Radford University in Radford, Va. (2016-17).

After inheriting a program that won just 12 games in 2015, Morales engineered the biggest turnaround in NCAA Division I softball when she led Radford to a 35-26 record in her first season at the helm in '16. The Highlanders also climbed 96 spots in the Ratings Percentage Index (RPI) in her first season at the school, advanced to the Big South Tournament semifinals with their first postseason wins in four years and boasted two all-conference honorees.

Prior to her two-year stint at Radford, Morales compiled 51 wins in two seasons at the helm at Young Harris.

Morales began her full-time coaching career as an assistant coach at Georgia Tech from 2010-13. During that four-year stint, she helped lead the Yellow Jackets to two ACC regular-season championships, two ACC Tournament titles and three NCAA regional appearances while coaching 19 all-conference selections, four ACC Players of the Year and three all-Americans.

She got her start in coaching as a student assistant coach for Tech in 2009, helping the Yellow Jackets to the most successful overall season in school history, a 46-15 campaign that included ACC regular-season and tournament championships and the program's lone NCAA Super Regional appearance.

Morales arrived at Georgia Tech in January 2005 after graduating a semester early from Hardaway H.S. in Columbus, Ga. Despite beginning her collegiate career during what was scheduled to be her final high-school season, she hit .296 with five doubles, a triple, two home runs, 32 RBI and an ACC-best 44 stolen bases in 49 attempts as a freshman, en route to being named ACC co-Freshman of the Year and earning second-team all-conference recognition.

She went on to be a three-time all-ACC honoree as a middle infielder, earning first-team accolades as a junior and senior in 2007 and '08, and was also a three-time all-region selection. She earned third-team all-America honors

She remains Georgia Tech's all-time leader in games played (265), starts (265), at-bats (850) and stolen bases (154) and ranks among the program's top 10 in runs (second -216), hits (third -261), doubles (t-fifth -43) and triples (t-fifth -10). She also holds three of the top five single-season stolen base totals in school history, including a school-record 46 as a senior in 2008.

Over the course of Morales' four-year playing career, Georgia Tech won 185 games, claimed the 2005 ACC regular-season and tournament championships and advanced to the NCAA postseason four times. She was inducted into the Georgia Tech Athletics Hall of Fame in 2020.

Following the end of her collegiate playing career, she was selected by the Chicago Bandits in the second round of the 2008 National Pro Fastpitch Draft. She played two seasons with the Bandits and helped lead the squad to the NPF championship as a rookie in 2008.

She also boasts international experience as a player and coach with the Puerto Rican national team. She competed internationally for Puerto Rico from 2007-10 and served as an assistant coach for the 2012 squad that finished eighth at the International Softball Federation World Championship, PR's best finish in more than a decade.

A three-time second-team academic all-district selection as a student-athlete at Georgia Tech, Morales graduated with a bachelor's degree in business management in 2009. The Columbus, Ga. native earned a master's in sport management from Georgia Southern in 2013.
