BEAR CRAWLS

THE SERIES

- Georgia Tech leads the all-time series 59-26 including seven in the last 10.
- Last season's matchup in Macon was shortened to 5-1/2 innings due to weather, but the Bears came out with a 7-6 win. Mercer started the game down 2-0, but responded with back-to-back home runs, the second by current starting catcher Carter Sanford. Sanford hit his second homer of the game and third of the Bears' fifth inning to set the score at 7-3.
- The last time Mercer won consecutive games over Georgia Tech was in 2014.
- Mercer and Georgia Tech will play twice this season. The second game in Atlanta will be on May 14.

SCOUTING THE BEARS

- Mercer traveled to Stillwater to face Oklahoma State over the weekend and came back with one win. In the second game of Saturday's doubleheader, the Bears scored three runs in the fifth inning to take a 4-0 lead and only allowed a solo home run the rest of the way.
- Graham Yntema had the Bears' best pitching performance of the season in that game, pitching 5.0 innings with zero runs and four strikeouts. He is 2-1 on the season with a 2.84 ERA.
- Junior Jackson Cherry missed the first four games of the season due to injury but now leads the team at the plate with a .378 batting average.
- As a team, Mercer has the second-lowest ERA (3.99) and second-most home runs (22) in the Southern Conference.

SCOUTING THE JACKETS

- Georgia Tech was picked to finish fifth in the Coastal Division of the ACC in this year's pre-season poll.
- The Yellow Jackets opened the 2024 season with a dominant 21-8 win over Radford.
- Three out of the team's four losses of the season came in consecutive games - two against Georgia and one against Northeastern. The Jackets followed the three losses with three run-rule wins, defeating Youngstown State by 10 runs in eight, eight, and seven innings.
- Senior Trey Yunger, a transfer from Wofford, leads the team in batting average, hitting .410.

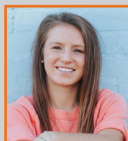

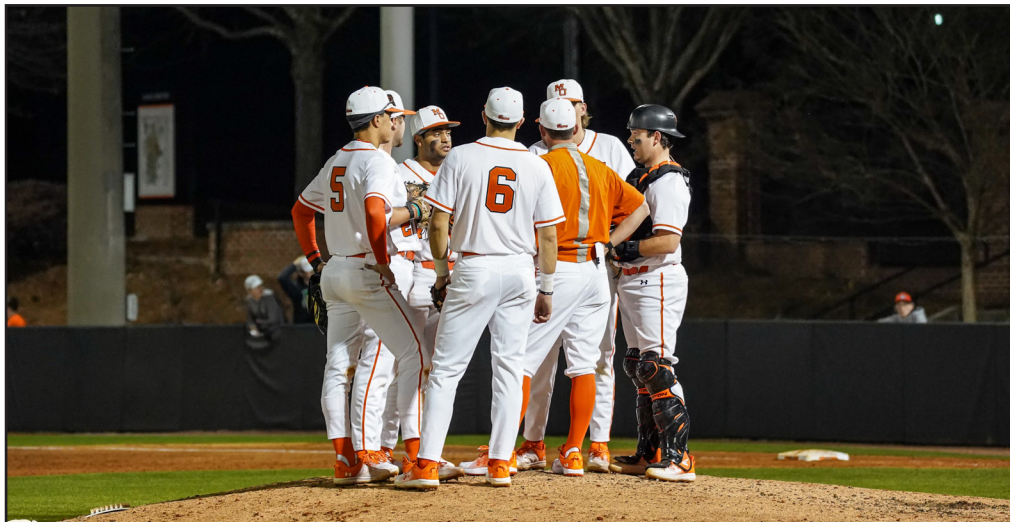

COACHING STAFF

HEAD COACH CRAIG GIBSON

Craig Gibson is in his 21st season as Mercer’s head coach. He is one of 21 active DI head baseball coaches with at least 20 years at the same institution for the entirety of his career. On March 31st of last season, he became the winningest coach in Mercer’s all-time history with a 2-1 win over Western Carolina. His roots with Mercer dig much deeper than coaching--a native of Macon, Gibson was an ASUN Player of the Year for the Bears as a first baseman in 1985. Gibson earned degrees in History and Health, Physical Education, and Recreation in 1986 and a Master’s of Education in Social Science in 1988.

Gibson coached high school baseball in Florida from 1989-1993 before returning to Macon to be an assistant coach at Mercer until accepting the head coaching position in 2004.

Mercer was a member of the Atlantic Sun Conference through the 2014 season. During this time, Gibson led the team to two ASUN tournament championships and NCAA Regional appearances. In 2013, he became the first person in history to be named both Player and Coach of the Year.

In Mercer’s first season in the Southern Conference, the team won both the regular season and tournament titles, a third NCAA Regional appearance, and a SoCon Coach of the Year honor. In 2016, center fielder Kyle Lewis was named the Golden Spikes Award winner, an All-American, and became the Bear’s highest ever draft selection, going at number 11 overall. Gibson was SoCon Coach of the Year again in 2017 and led the team to a fourth NCAA Regional in 2019.

The Bears have secured 21 wins over ranked opponents under Gibson’s leadership, including wins over No. 1 Florida (2006, 2018), No. 1 Clemson

ASSISTANT COACHES

Wille Stewart: 9th Season (UNC Asheville, 2000)
Stewart has been an assistant under Gibson since 2015. Prior to Mercer, Stewart spent time coaching at Georgia State, his alma mater UNC Asheville, and Elon. As a student athlete, he was an All-Big South First Team member. The second baseman earned a Bachelor’s Degree in Business and Marketing.

Tanner Gordon: 1st Season (Southern New Hampshire, 2014)
Gordon joined Mercer in the fall of 2023 after serving as an assistant coach at VCU. The pitching coach has 11 years of collegiate coaching experience as well as five seasons of collegiate playing experience, earning a Bachelor’s Degree in General Studies from Southern New Hampshire in 2014.

Matt Williams: 1st Season (Valdosta State, 2012)
Williams has been in the college coaching realm since 2010, including both assistant and head coaching positions. He played college baseball at Texas College and Valdosta State, where he earned Bachelor’s (2012) and Master’s (2015) Degrees in Business Education.
