# OF JAMES TIBBS III

- » James Tibbs III leads the ACC and ranks top 10 nationally with 23 home runs, 76 RBI, and .848 slugging percentage and 162 total bases.
- » Tibbs also leads FSU with 17 doubles and 37 walks.
- » Tibbs is the 7th player in FSU history to hit 50 career home runs and the first since Mike McGee in 2011; his 23 home runs in 2024 are tied for 10th in a season at FSU:

- » Tibbs has five multi-HR games this year, including against Pitt (5/11) and Stetson (5/14) over the past week.
- » Tibbs had his career-high seven-game hitting streak end vs. Miami; in that stretch, he hit .586 (17-for-29) with six doubles, four home runs, 16 RBI and 10 runs. He had multiple hits in all seven games.
- » Tibbs has had a hand in 3 of FSU's 5 back-toback home runs this year, most recently with Cam Smith in the 9th inning at Pitt (5/12).
- » Tibbs has thrown out 6 runners this season, including a perfect throw vs. Jacksonville (5/7) to retire a runner in the first inning.
- » Tibbs and Jaime Ferrer both retired runners vs. NC State (5/3), the first time the Noles had multiple outfield assists in a game since the 2023 season opener vs. James Madison.
- » Tibbs had multiple home runs in consecutive games against Western Carolina (2/25) and USF (2/27), his second and third career multi-HR games.
- » Tibbs hit a pair of home runs in the finale at No. 3 Clemson (3/24), his third multi-HR game of the season.
- » Tibbs is the first Seminole since Mike McGee (2009-11) with 10+ home runs in three straight seasons. McGee and Tibbs are the only Seminoles this millennium with consecutive seasons with 17+ home runs.
- » Before teammate Cam Smith did it last season against NC State and North Florida, the last Seminole with back-to-back multi-HR games was Buster Posey in 2008.
- » Tibbs hit a grand slam on Opening Day against Butler and against Western Carolina (2/25). Tibbs also set a career-high with 6 RBI against the Catamounts, most for a Nole in 2024.
- » Tibbs tied a career high with 4 hits vs. Illinois (3/2), including a 419' home run. He was 4-for-4 with a HR vs. Louisville (3/30).
- » Tibbs drew a season-high 3 walks against FGCU (3/6) and reached safely in FSU's first 18 games this year and 24 straight dating to last year.
- » He hit a double and triple vs. New Orleans (3/8), his second career triple.

# NOLES WIN SERIES AT NO. 6 DUKE

- » Florida State won 2-of-3 games at No. 6 Duke (4/26-27), its first ranked road series win of the year.
- » Jamie Arnold improved to 8-1 with a 4-2 win in the opener. FSU scored all four runs in the first inning, highlighted by Jaime Ferrer's 3-R HR.
- » The Noles led 7-2 in Saturday's game before holding on for a 7-6 win. John Abraham earned his first career save, stranding runners on 2nd and 3rd.

# SP JAMIE ARNOLD

- Sophomore Jamie Arnold is 8-3 with a 2.27 ERA; he earned his 8th win at No. 6 Duke, a 4-2 FSU victory.
- » Arnold struck out a career-high 17 batters over 7.0 innings and just 98 pitches at Pitt (5/10), the most for a Seminole since 1987 and 9th-most in a game in school history.
- » The last ACC pitcher with 17 strikeouts was Connor Thomas (GT) in 2018. Arnold struck out at least two batters every inning.
- » Arnold's 17 strikeouts are tied for the secondmost in the country this season:

- » Arnold is 5th in the country with 119 strikeouts. He is 7th in strikeout-to-walk ratio and 9th with a 2.27 ERA.
- » Arnold threw at least 5.0 IP in his first 11 starts before going just 3.0 IP in a rain-delayed contest vs. NC State (5/3).
- » Against Miami, Arnold matched his career-high with 7.0 innings pitched, with nine strikeouts.
- » He earned a no-decision at No. 3 Clemson after allowing one run with nine strikeouts in 7.0 innings.
- » Arnold also threw a career-high 7.0 innings at Boston College (4/5).
- » He has four double-digit K games this season - 17 at Pitt, 12 vs. ND and Wake Forest, 11 vs. Western Carolina.
- » Arnold began the season with 24.1 innings without allowing an earned run.
- » Arnold was named the ACC Pitcher of the Week after his outing against Western Carolina (2/24).
- » He added 6.0 shutout innings vs. Michigan State (3/2).

# 3B CAM SMITH

- After being named the top pro prospect in the Cape Cod League over the summer, Smith is one of the hottest names for the 2024 MLB Draft.
- » Smith reached base in 56 consecutive games, the 7th-longest streak on FSU's all-time list. His streak spanned a full calendar year, running from May 6, 2023 to May 7, 2024:

- » Smith's 17 doubles, .389 average, 63 runs and 81 hits lead FSU.
- » Smith and James Tibbs III are tied for the team lead with 27 multi-hit games.
- » Smith set a career high with five RBI and tied a career high with four hits at Pitt (5/12). He was 2-for-2 with three RBI in FSU's eight-run first inning.
- » Smith also had four hits against USF (2/27), including his first home run of 2024. His HR was the front end of a back-to-back with Tibbs.
- » Smith hit an inside-the-park home run vs. Michigan State (3/2), the first for a Nole since 2011
- » Smith added three runs against JU, including the go-ahead run in the 9th inning after a leadoff double, FSU's only extra-base hit. FSU scored three runs in the frame to beat the Dolphins, 7-4
- » Smith scored a season-high four runs against FGCU (3/6) and hit his 3rd home run of the year.

# 3 NOLES ON GOLDEN SPIKES WATCH LIST

- » Arnold, Smith & Tibbs were all named to the Golden Spikes Award midseason watch list. No. 1 Texas A&M was the only other team with three players recognized.
- » Four Seminoles have won the Golden Spikes Award, most in the country. The last Nole to win the award was Buster Posey in 2008.

# NOLES SWEEP FLORIDA. MIAMI

- For the first time since 1960, Florida State swept Miami and Florida in the same season. It was just the second same-season sweep of both teams in FSU history.
- The Noles combined to outscore Florida 45-15 over the three games, with a pair of run-rule wins 19-4 in 7 innings in Tallahassee and 14-3 in 8 innings in Jacksonville. It was FSU's first three-game sweep of Florida since 2000.
- » FSU's 19 runs were its most vs. Florida since 2001 and one shy of the Noles' highmark vs. UF.
- » The 15-run margin of victory is FSU's largest in series history.
- FSU hit .416 with 12 doubles and 9 home runs against Florida; Daniel Cantu and Drew Faurot both had eight hits and two home runs; Cantu led FSU with 10 RBI vs. the Gators.
- » In the series finale, FSU set a season high with 19 hits. FSU hit five home runs for the third time this year; the Noles had not done it in a game since 2021.
- » The Noles swept Miami in front of 19,157 fans over the three games, the highest three-game weekend attendance in Dick Howser Stadium history.
- » FSU beat the Hurricanes 5-4, 11-7 and 6-4. FSU's last sweep of Miami at home was 2012.
- » FSU finished the regular season 14-1 against in-state schools, the best winning percentage in program history:

# STOLEN BASES

- » Florida State is 55-for-64 on stolen base attempts.
- FSU had just 31 stolen bases over 54 games in 2023.
- » Florida State had seven stolen bases Sunday against Butler (2/18), its most in a game since 2016.
- » From 2017-2023, FSU's most stolen bases in a game was four. The Noles had at least four stolen bases in their first three games of 2024; FSU added four against Jacksonville (4/2).
- » Jordan Williams leads FSU with 14 stolen bases the most for a Seminole since future MLBers Ben DeLuzio (15) and Taylor Walls (14) in 2016.
- » Williams stole four bases at Pitt (5/12), the most for a Seminole since J.D. Drew had four in a game in 1997.
- » DeAmez Ross and Drew Faurot are 7-for-7.



# OF JAIME FERRER

- » Jaime Ferrer is second on the team with 14 home runs, including two at Boston College (4/5), his second career multi-HR game (at TCU, 2023).
- » Ferrer's nine home runs in ACC action are the most on the team (tied with Tibbs). He hit two at No. 6 Duke, including a 3-R HR in the first inning of FSU's 4-2 win to start the series.
- » His 14 home runs are a career best, topping his nine as a freshman.
- » He added two home runs in the doubleheader at No. 3 Clemson (3/23), with his second grand slam of the year. His three hits in game two against the Tigers were a season high.
- » Ferrer has 30 career home runs. Ferrer hit his first career grand slam against FGCU (3/6). His 5 RBI against the Eagles was a career high.
- » Ferrer has been hit by 13 pitches this year, most on the team. He has 42 HBP in his career, 5th in FSU history:

- » Ferrer started the first 152 games of his career before missing the UNF game. He came off the bench for a pivotal walk vs. Jacksonville (5/7) in FSU's 7-6 comeback win.
- » Ferrer has two outfield assists this season. Ferrer and Tibbs both threw out a runner vs. NC State (5/3).

# DINGES POPS IN DH ROLE

- » DH Marco Dinges is hitting .305 with 12 home runs over 46 starts. He hit two home runs at No. 3 Clemson (3/23-24) and one vs. Miami (4/13).
- » Dinges leads FSU with three grand slams, one shy of the school record. His grand slam vs. North Florida (4/23) was FSU's ninth of the year, a school record.
- » Dinges tied a career-high with five RBI against the Ospreys; he also hit a grand slam and had five RBI vs. Louisville (3/28) and Florida (4/9).
- » Against Louisville, Dinges added three hits including his first career triple - in game two; and added another triple in the finale.
- » Dinges hit the go-ahead RBI double in the ninth inning at No. 12 Wake Forest (4/20), leading to a 9-6 Seminole victory.
- » For the season, Dinges has 9 doubles, 2 triples and 12 home runs.
- » A transfer from Tallahassee CC, Dinges hit three homers vs. FGCU (3/6) and New Orleans (3/8 & 3/10). He added a fourth against Notre Dame.
- » Dinges was 2-for-4 with a solo home run, an RBI single and two sacrifice flies against FGCU. He entered the game with 3 RBI on the season and the HR was his first as a Nole.
- » Dinges made his first start at catcher against Bethune-Cookman (4/3).
- » Dinges had a 15-game on-base streak end at No. 6 Duke, the longest of his career.
- » Dinges' 9 sacrifice flies are 3rd in the country. Dinges' sac fly in the 9th inning vs. JU (5/7) tied the game that FSU eventually won in the 11th inning.

- » He had three hits and a pair of runs against FGCU (3/6).
- » Lodise tallied five hits over two games at Boston College (4/6-7) and had a game-tying RBI in both games. He hit a two-run home run vs. Florida (4/9) to cap FSU's scoring in the 19-4 win.
- » Lodise has 6 of FSU's 15 sacrifice bunts.

- » Cantu tied a career high with 5 RBI vs. No. 6 Florida (3/26), including his second HR of the year. He added a pair of doubles in FSU's 14-3 win.

- » Max Williams hit a leadoff home run at Wake Forest, FSU's first leadoff HR of the year. He added a second home run in the series.
- » Williams ran his hitting streak to eight games and on-base streak to 10 games, both career highs.
- » Williams had a career-high four hits vs. Mercer (4/16).
- » Against North Florida (4/23), Williams was 2-for-2 with a triple, single and two walks. Williams leads FSU with four triples on the year.
- » Williams hit a go-ahead two-run home run in FSU's eventual 5-4 win over Miami (4/11) and had a career-high 3 RBI in the game.
- » Williams earned his first outfield assist at FSU, ending the fourth inning with an out at the plate. Trailing 3-1, FSU outscored Boston College 11-1 to win 12-4 on April 5.

# PLATOON AT CATCHER

- » Jaxson West has started 28 games at catcher, hitting .281 with 7 doubles, 1 triple, 1 home run, 21 RBI and 29 runs.
- West is reaching base at a .424 clip with 22 walks and four HBP; he has struck out just 14 times.
- West was 2-for-3 with three runs and four RBI in FSU's 19-4 win over Florida (4/9). He hit his first home run as a Seminole in the contest. His RBI and runs were career highs.

- » Dorsey leads FSU with five pick-offs; he has half of FSU's 10.
- » Andrew Armstrong is 5-0 on the season. He earned his 100th career strikeout against Jacksonville (5/7).
- » Brennen Oxford and Joe Charles lead FSU with 22 appearances on the season; for his career, Oxford's 97 appearances are 8th among active players.
- » Oxford is 2-0 with a 2.88 ERA in 2024.
- » Noah Short ranks 10th among active players with 94 career appearances.
- » Oxford earned the win vs. Miami (4/12) with a career-high 4.2 innings. He struck out a careerhigh 6 batters vs. Western Michigan.
- » Connor Hults leads FSU's bullpen with a 2.53 ERA and four saves; seven Seminoles have at least one save (Hults - 4; Dorsey & Oxford - 3; Charles -2; Ben Barrett, John Abraham, Short - 1).
