QUICK HITTERS

• Tech is coming off a 2-1 weekend in the GT Invitational, featuring wins over New Mexico State and Coastal Carolina after dropping the opening match of 2024 to UCLA in five sets.

• The Yellow Jackets were ranked No. 19 in the latest AVCA/TARAFLEX DI Coaches Poll.

• The poll marks the 72nd consecutive week that GT Volleyball has been in the Top 25, dating back to the 2020 fall preseason poll.

• Tech was picked to finish top five in the ACC by the league's coaches for the fifth consecutive year, coming in at No. 4

• Senior outside hitters Tamara Otene and Bianca Bertolino were each selected preseason all-ACC.

• The Jackets return five starters from last year's Sweet 16 team including the team leaders in kills (Otene – 406), hitting percentage (Liv Mogridge - .433), aces (Bertolino – 62) and blocks (DeAndrea Pierce – 64).

• All four Tech representatives from the 2023 ACC postseason awards are back for more in 2024: Bertolino and Otene (1st Team All-ACC) and Heloise Soares and Larissa Mendes (All-Freshman Team).

• Georgia Tech now boasts seven athletes from outside the United States, (38.9 % of the roster) tied with Wisconsin for the most international roster among Power 4 programs.

• This will be head coach Michelle Collier's 11th season on The Flats, tying AVCA Hall of Famer Shelton Collier for the longest tenured coach in program history. At GT, she has 199 wins (2nd most behind Shelton Collier), 111 ACC victories (program record) seven NCAA Tournament match victories (program record) & is the first coach to have led the Jackets to four straight NCAA Tournament appearances.

• Senior Bianca Bertolino had a tremendous start to her season, posting a pair of double-doubles (vs. UCLA and New Mexico State) while racking up a team-best 47 digs (tied with libero Sofia Velez). Bertolino's 47 digs is the most by any Power 4 outside hitter.

• The Jackets are the only Power 4 team, and one of 10 across Division I, to have three players at 35+ digs after three matches - Bertolino and Velez each have 47 and Tamara Otene made 36.

• Sophomore right side Larissa Mendes is off to yet another hot start. She set a new career high with 23 kills in Tech's four-set victory over New Mexico State last Sunday, the most kills by a Georgia Tech underclassman since three-time All-American and Olympic medalist, Julia Bergmann, made 31 against Lipscomb back in 2021 (April 14, 2021 - NCAA Tournament Round 1 in Omaha, Neb.). Mendes made those 23 kills on .500 hitting, her fourth career .500+ hitting performance. She led the team with 149 kills in non-conference matches last season.

• Setter Luanna Emiliano is one of the most experienced setters in college this season, the UTRGV transfer owns 3,663 career assists (9th most among active DI players) and 1,142 career digs, the 5th most among active Division I setters.

NOTES

ON THE BRINK

Already the second winningest coach in program history, Coach Michelle Collier owns 199 wins as she nears 200 on The Flats. She will be the 2nd coach in program history to reach 200 wins at Tech, along with AVCA Hall of Famer Shelton Collier (1991-2001 - 271 wins).

Senior Bianca Bertolino stands at 873 career kills, the ninth most by a Yellow Jacket in the modern scoring era (since 2008). She is 56 kills away from tying Mikaila Dowd (2018-21) for 8th place.

Bertolino became just the 10th Jacket in the modern scoring era to achieve 1,000 career digs on The Flats when she broke into the quadrupole digits during the Sweet 16 match at Nebraska last year. She holds 1,051 career digs now, the eighth most in the modern scoring era and 49 away from tying Julia Bergmann for 7th.

At 124 career aces, Bertolino sits 4 shy of tying Jenn Beemsterboer (1987-90) for the 10th-most aces in program history - all scoring eras. She is currently 3rd in the modern scoring era, 24 away from tying Monique Mead (2009-12) for 2nd.

Bertolino's career 0.36 aces/set is tied for 2nd-best in the modern scoring era and 5th all-time at Georgia Tech. She will need to bring her average up to .41/set to tie Julia Bergmann for the modern scoring era record.

NO SUBSTITUTE FOR EXPERIENCE

The Yellow Jackets return 12 players from the Sweet 16 squad from last fall including the team leaders in kills (Tamara Otene – 406), hitting percentage (Liv Mogridge – .433), aces (Bianca Bertolino – 62) and blocks (DeAndra Pierce – 64).

All four Tech representatives from the 2023 ACC postseason awards are back for more in 2024:

Bertolino and Otene (1st Team All-ACC) and Heloise Soares and Larissa Mendes (All-Freshman Team).

Entering the season, the Jackets had three players with over 300 sets played under their belts: Bertolino (331), Otene (347) and Luanna Emiliano (346).

All of Emiliano's sets came while she was with UTRGV (2021-23) where she racked up the 10th most career assists by any returning DI setter (3,569) while also tallying 1,118 digs, which would put her sixth of GT's modern scoring era digs list.

Transfer DS/L Sofia Velez made her Division I debut last weekend after spending the last two seasons with Trinity Valley Junior College in the NJCAA. Over her two years at TVJC, Velez racked up 1,523 digs - the most in the junior college ranks over that time (2022 & '23). Counting last weekend, Velez has made 10+ digs in all but 1 of her 82 matches played in college.

ROAD WARRIORS

Georgia Tech went 11-4 in true road matches last season, the most wins in the Michelle Collier era and the third most in program history - including wins at No. 12 Ohio State (twice) and at No. 4-seeded Florida in the NCAA Tournament.

The 2023 team posted a .733 winning percentage on the road last season, the 5th highest of all-time. The program record for road winning percentage

was set in 2021, when the team went 10-2 (.833) on the road, making the Elite 8 in the process.

Coach Collier delivered her fifth straight winning season on the road in 2023 (2019-present), joining AVCA Hall of Famer Shelton Collier as the only two coaches in Georgia Tech history to do so.

TEAM EFFORT ON DEFENSE

Georgia Tech is the only Power 4 program to have three players with 35+ digs through three matches (Bertolino - 47 // Velez - 47 // Otene 36). Tech is one of 10 programs in all of Division I that can claim that through their first three matches as well.

Bertolino's 47 digs leads all P4 outside hitters headed into the second weekend of the season. Her 3.92 digs/set through the opening weekend is a full 0.46 digs/set better than her career-best (3.46) set back in the 2022 season. Her 1,051 career digs is the 2nd most among active outside hitters across P4, behind only Taylor Head (2020-23 at Arkansas and 2024 at Florida State).

Velez made 47 digs over her first three Division I matches, making 16 digs in each of the first two matches (vs. UCLA and New Mexico State) before finishing with 15 digs in a three-set sweep of Coastal Carolina. She has now recorded 10+ digs in all but one of her 82 career matches played after doing so in 78 of her 79 matches at Trinity Valley Junior College over the last two seasons.

After delivering the 3rd most digs of any Power 5 pin hitter last season (332) Tamara Otene has brought the same intensity to the defensive side of the ball in 2024. She made 36 digs throughout the GT Invitational, delivering 10 or more digs in all three matches.

Luanna Emiliano recorded 24 digs in the opening weekend (2.00/set). That brings her career total to 1,142 - the fifth most among active DI setters (with 1,118 coming at UTRGV).

TECH IN THE TOURNAMENT

Georgia Tech's selection to the 2023 NCAA Women's Volleyball Championship marked the 13th appearance in program history.

The White and Gold made a fourth straight tournament appearance for the first time since advancing to the Big Dance five consecutive years from 2000-04. The selection also marked the fourth consecutive berth for the Yellow Jackets under head coach Michelle Collier.

The win over No 4 seed Florida was Georgia Tech's first true road win and the first five-set win in NCAA Tournament history.

It was Head Coach Michelle Collier's 7th NCAA Tournament win, the most of any Georgia Tech head coach.

Over the last three seasons the Yellow Jackets have advanced to the second round of the NCAA tournament twice (2020, 2022) and to the Elite Eight (2021) to tie the 2003 squad for the best finish in program history.

Tech is one of 14 programs to have qualified for the 2023 NCAA Tournament after having won at least one NCAA Tournament match in each of the last three seasons.

The Yellow Jackets are 16-14 all time in the NCAA Tournament.

The Jackets were the highest AVCA ranked team not to host the first weekend of the NCAA Tournament since 2019 - No. 10 Colorado State.

GOLD JACKETS - 2023 ACC AWARDS

Georgia Tech was honored with four All-ACC selections as voted on by the league's head coaches, the conference office announced on Monday.

Junior outside hitter Bianca Bertolino and senior outside hitter Tamara Otene were awarded First Team All-ACC honors with freshman opposite Larissa Mendes and freshman setter Heloise Soares were named to the All-Freshmen Team.

This marks the fifth season in a row, since 2019, that Georgia Tech will have multiple representatives on all-conference first team, the second longest streak in the conference. It is the first time Bertolino has been named to the first team after earning Second Team (2022) and All-Freshman team (2021) honors in her career. It is the first All-ACC honor for Otene.

Mendes and Soares become the 25th and 26th Jackets to be named to the All-Freshmen team in program history. Tech owns the second most All-Freshman team selections in ACC history, just one behind Duke. This is the seventh time in program history and just the second time in the Michelle Collier era that the Jackets will have multiple representatives on the All-Freshman team – also 2018 (Brambilla and Dowd).

Bertolino was the catalyst for Georgia Tech all season, positively affecting each point in a variety of ways. She is the only Power 5 pin hitter to finish the season with 300+ kills, 250+ digs and 50+ aces all while posting an incredible .974 receiving percentage as a primary passer in serve/receive. She was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week on Oct. 23 and leads the ACC with 61 aces (.59/set). She leads all Power 5 pin-hitters in aces and is 5th overall in Division I in aces/set. She made 7 aces in Georgia Tech's four-set win over Louisville, the second most aces in a single match by a Power 5 player this season and the most in an ACC match since 2017. She becomes the 24th Yellow Jacket in program history and the 7th in the Michelle Collier era to be named to the All-ACC First or Second teams in back-to-back seasons.

One of the most versatile attackers in the country, Otene secured a 300 kill/300 dig season, registering a team-best 361 kills and 306 digs, the third most among Power 5 pin hitters. Otene was the most prolific attacker on the roster, serving as the go-to for out of system sets, while also serving as the best defensive non-DS/L in the ACC. She was named ACC Offensive Player of the Week on Sept. 25 and became the 1st Jacket in program history to achieve back-to-back 20 kill/20 dig double doubles (at UVA and vs. FSU). Otene delivered a team-best 14 double-doubles, nine of which came against AVCA Top 50 opponents. She is the first Jacket to record a 300 kill / 300 dig season since Marianna Brambilla's All-American year in 2021. The Auckland native becomes the 75th Jacket to be named All-ACC. It is her first All-ACC honor after being named 1st Team All-Missouri Valley Conference and 2021 MVC Player of the Year at Illinois State before transferring to the Flats.

Mendes announced herself as one of the most dangerous young attackers in the conference this season. She was the second freshman in the ACC to record a 20+ kill match, making 21 in Tech's five-set win over ACC Co-Champion Florida State. A two-time ACC Freshman of the Week (Sept. 4 and Sept. 11), Mendes was one of only three freshmen to win the award in consecutive weeks this season. She secured eight of her 15 10+ kill matches against AVCA Top 50 opponents and was the third offensive option on an offense that average 13.58 kills/set, the fourth highest in the conference. Mendes becomes the fifth pin-hitter in the Michelle Collier era to be named to the All-Freshman team, joining Bertolino (2021), Julia Bergmann (2019), Mikaila Dowd (2018) and Mariana Brambilla (2018).

Soares earned her way onto the court and quickly established herself as one of the most promising young setters in the nation. Playing as the second setter in a 6-2 system, Soares has provided a spark off the bench, finishing the season

with 455 assists and 106 digs. She became the first freshman setter in program history to achieve a 50+ assist match when she delivered 59 dimes in a five-set win over ACC Co-Champion Florida St. She averaged an incredible 10.78 assists/set in the 18 sets she started this season and was named ACC Freshman of the Week twice (Oct. 2 and Nov. 6). She becomes just the third Yellow Jacket setter to be named to the All-Freshman team, joining Georgia Tech Hall of Famers Kele Eveland (2000) and Andrea Nachtrieb (1993).

72 CONSECUTIVE POLLS IN THE TOP 25

Georgia Tech volleyball was ranked No. 14 in the preseason edition of the AVCA/TARAFLEX Division I Women's Volleyball Poll. It is the fifth-straight season the Yellow Jackets have received a preseason Top 25 ranking, the longest such streak in program history.

The No. 14 ranking was the fifth-highest in program history and the best since being ranked No. 9 in the 2022 preseason poll. It is the fifth time GT has received a Top 15 ranking to begin a season (also '22, '20, '04 and '03). The Jackets finished the 2023 campaign ranked No. 14 after reaching the Round of 16 in the NCAA Tournament for the second time in the past three seasons.

After the opening weekend, GT fell to No. 19, marking the 72nd consecutive week of GT volleyball in the national polls, dating back to the 2020 fall preseason. It is the longest stretch of rankings in program history.

Tech is one of five ACC programs in the Top 25 along with No. 3 Pitt, No. 4 Louisville, No. 5 Stanford and No. 15 Florida State. Miami (FL.) and SMU are also receiving votes. The Jackets were selected to finish 4th in the ACC preseason poll, voted on by the league's coaches earlier this month.

RANKED RUMBLES

Georgia Tech owns seven top-10 victories in its program's history: #3 Louisville (11/3/23), #8 Penn State (8/26/23), #10 BYU in 2022, #2 Pitt in 2021, #5 Nebraska in 2003, #8 California in the 2003 NCAA Tournament and #8 Notre Dame in 1995.

Last year's 3-1 win over #8 Penn State tied the fourth highest ranked victory in program history and marked the first ranked triumph of the season for the White and Gold. With back-to-back victories over previous No. 12 Ohio State to follow, Georgia Tech earned three consecutive top-15 wins for the first time in program history.

The Jackets added to their resume with a 3-1 win over No. 3 Louisville - marking the highest ranked home win in program history and the first time that a Georgia Tech team has defeated two Top 10 opponents in the same regular season.

The NCAA Tournament 2nd round win over No. 20 Florida marked the fifth ranked win of the season, tying a program record set back in 2003.

Tech's next ranked win would be the 34th ranked triumph in program history, including 29 in the regular season and five in the postseason.

FLYING HIGH

The Jackets owned the 23rd best overall record in the nation last year, at 24-7. The Yellow Jackets secured 13 conference victories, marking the fifth straight season Tech has won at least 13 ACC matches, the longest streak in program history.

The Jackets tied the best 20-match start in the Michelle Collier era (also 2021), after starting 17-3. It is tied for the third-best record through 20 matches in program history (20-0 in 2003 and 18-2 in 1996).

The White and Gold played in four consecutive five-set matches (Oct. 1-13) tied

for the longest streak in program history, with the Jackets winning three of those four five-sets.

Resilience was a key theme for the Jackets last year. GT has lost the opening set seven times this season, going 5-4 in those instances:

at #1 Nebraska 12/7 - 1st set, 11-25, L, 0-3
at #20 Florida 12/1 - 1st set, 22-25, W, 3-2
at Miami 11/17 - 1st set, 21-25, L, 0-3
vs. #7 Pitt 11/10 - 1st set, 13-25, L, 0-3
at BC 10/27 - 1st set, 20-25 - W, 3-2
vs. Miami 10/15 - 1st set, 23-25 - L, 0-3
vs. Florida St. 10/13 - 1st set, 21-25 - W, 3-2
at Clemson 9/20 - 1st set, 29-31 - W, 3-1
at #12 Ohio St. 9/1 - 1st set, 20-25 - W, 3-1

The Yellow Jackets were amongst the best teams in Power 5 in digs/set (14.81), kills/set (13.63) and aces/set (1.63) so last year. They finished the regular season 5th among P5 in digs/set, 14th in kills/set and 13th in aces/set.

Going beyond 2019's NIVC title, Tech has won 104 of its last 132 matches (.789 winning percentage).

The Jackets have claimed 57 of their last 66 matches in O'Keefe Gymnasium (.864 winning percentage).

TORCHIN' TAMARA

Otene has earned her first-career preseason all-ACC nod this year after leading Tech's offense in 2023. The New Zealander led the Jackets in attacks (1,067), kills (406) and double-doubles (14) last season while posting her first-career 300 kill (406) / 300 dig (332) campaign.

She became the first Yellow Jacket to ever achieve back-to-back 20/20 double-doubles after delivering 20+ kills and 20+ digs against both Virginia (Oct. 8, 2023) and Florida State (Oct. 14, 2023).

Otene is the only Jacket in program history with multiple 20/20 double-doubles in the modern scoring era.

Her next 20/20 double-double would be her third. The program record belongs to Cris Omiecinski, who delivered four over the course of four seasons (1992-95).

Otene's 406 kill effort extended Georgia Tech volleyball's streak to eight consecutive complete seasons (excluding COVID shortened season in 2020/21) with at least one 400-kill hitter. Only Georgia Tech, Stanford, Purdue and USC can claim that honor.

BERTOLINO BULLETS

Bertolino earned her third straight preseason all-conference selection this year following one of the best all-around seasons in Division I last year.

The Argentinian delivered 351 kills, 321 digs and 62 aces, the only Power 5 player to deliver 300+ kills, 300+ digs and 60+ aces.

She maintained her offensive performance while asserting herself as the best passer at her position, finishing with a .975 receiving percentage, the highest in Division I by a non-defensive specialist/libero.

Over the summer, Bertolino competed with the Argentinian National Team in a series of friendlies as well as the 2024 Challenger Cup, earning match MVP in her very first start, leading the team with 20 kills against South Korea, in May.

R-E-S-P-E-C-T

Georgia Tech is one of only 8 programs in Division I to average more than 100 percent capacity at home matches this season - selling out all home matches inside O'Keefe Gymnasium for the second season in a row. This season, they are one match shy of selling out every home match, with just a handful of tickets remaining for the Thursday, Sept. 12 match against South Alabama, a rematch of the 1st round of the 2023 NCAA Tournament.

SPICING IT UP

Georgia Tech is the most international team among Power 4 programs. 10 Yellow Jackets, 7 student-athletes and 3 coaches, are originally from countries outside of the United States.

Coaches Michelle Collier, Claudio Pinheiro and Vini Baigan along with Emiliano, Mendes and Soares all hail from Brazil. Notably, Pinheiro helped coach the Brazil women's team to Olympic gold medals in the 2008 and 2012 Olympics . He also brings years of professional coaching experience internationally to The Flats.

Bertolino and freshman Lara Martinez Casas represent Argentina, while senior outside hitter Tamara Otene is from New Zealand and junior libero Sofia Velez hails from Colombia.

With 7 of 18 rostered athletes coming from outside the US, Georgia Tech is tied with Wisconsin for the highest percentage of international athletes - 38.9%

SWARMING THE NEST

The Jackets sold out O'Keefe in back-to-back seasons after a program record 13 sellouts in 2022 and 11 sellouts a season ago. The GT Invitational is sold out for all three matches marking the 29th, 30th and 31st consecutive sellouts dating back to the 2021 season.

Tech drew a record 5,303 fans for this season's edition of Clean, Old-Fashioned Hate in McCamish Pavilion, more than quadruple O'Keefe's capacity (1,200). Tech is hoping to break that record this year when it hosts Florida on Sept. 11 at 7 pm from inside McCamish Pavilion. That match is presented by Delta.

The Jackets are one of eight programs in Division I to have averaged over 100% stadium capacity at home matches this season.

HIP HIP...COLLIER!

Coach Michelle Collier is into her 11th season leading the Jackets as the second winningest coach in program history with 199 victories.

Collier achieved her 100th career win in ACC play with a victory over NC State and her program-record breaking 101st the next match at Virginia Tech. She is now up to 111 league wins through 10 seasons.

She has won 239 matches over 12 seasons of coaching, including 40 wins while at Jacksonville (2012-13).

In her third season, she led the Jackets to a 24-8 (15-5 ACC) record, the program's first 20 win season in six years (2009).

Over the last five seasons (since 2019) Collier has brought GT to the upper echelon of the sport. Her Tech teams have a combined 111-33 record (.771) with 4 All-Americans (Mariana Brambilla, Julia Bergmann, Matti McKissock and Bianca Bertolino).

She has coached four Jackets to eight AVCA all-American honors over her career, 24 All-ACC honors and 18 all-region honors. She's also helped eight Jackets land 16 career marks in the top 10 in program history.

She is one of five female head coaches to have reached two of the last three

NCAA Regional rounds - (Louisville, Florida, Ohio State and Penn State).

She was named ACC Coach of the Year in 2019 and AVCA East Coast Region Coach of the Year in 2019 and in 2021.

She is the first coach in program history to have delivered a win percentage of at least .700 both overall and in ACC play through five consecutive seasons – 2019: 26-8, 14-4 ACC | 2020: 14-5, 13-4 ACC | 2021: 26-6, 14-4 ACC | 2022: 21-8, 13-5 ACC | 2023: 22-6, 13-5 ACC

As a student-athlete at USF, Collier ranks among the greatest collegiate volleyball players of all-time. She ranks fifth in NCAA Division I history with 2,729 career kills and holds the most career kills and digs in program history. She set three single-season marks during the 2000 season, after coming back from an injury that sidelined her in 1999, making 760 kills and 6.28 kills per set.

She has led the Jackets to postseason play for five seasons in a row and four straight NCAA Tournaments including a Regional Final (2021), a Regional Semifinal (2023), two 2nd Round appearances (2020-21 and 2022) and an NIVC Championship (2019).

She holds Georgia Tech coaching records in: ACC victories (111) NCAA Tournament matches won (seven) and consecutive NCAA Tournament appearances (four)

BRONZE FOR BERGMANN

This summer, GT alumna Julia Bergmann became the first Olympian in program history after earning a spot on the Brazilian National Team for the 2024 Paris Olympic Games.

Bergmann saw action in multiple matches over Brazil's run to the Bronze medal, including getting the match-clinching kill in her Olympic debut, helping clinch the opening round victory over Kenya.

Brazil took home the Bronze medal in Paris, making Bergmann the first Yellow Jacket to ever own an Olympic medal.

WE'RE A FAN OF FANNING

Georgia Tech volleyball head coach Michelle Collier added former All-American and current member of the Atlanta Vibe (Professional Volleyball Federation), Shelly Fanning, to the coaching staff as a player development assistant.

Fanning, who carries 10 years of playing experience with her to The Flats, will work closely with the team, assisting in practice and match planning while also serving as a mentor for the student-athletes, specifically the middle blockers.

Fanning comes to The Flats in the midst of a 10-year playing career, most recently taking part in the first season of the Professional Volleyball Federation as a member of the Atlanta Vibe. She spent her college years at Baylor, where she was a three-time AVCA All-American (2017-19), a vital member of the Bears 2019 Final Four team and the first Baylor player to achieve all-conference status four times. She graduated, twice, from Baylor with a bachelor's degree in communications and a master's degree in sports management.

After leaving college volleyball in 2019, Fanning went abroad, playing parts of four seasons in Puerto Rico and one season in Poland. Like many American players, Fanning took advantage of the growing professional opportunities at home, taking part in the Athletes Unlimited Pro League in 2023 before signing with the Atlanta Vibe for the inaugural 2024 PVF season (January-May). With the Vibe, Fanning played in all 25 matches as a starting middle blocker and finished with 53 blocks and 171 kills to help lead her team to a semifinal berth.
