STORYLINES

- Georgia Tech returns for its sixth season under head coach Nell Fortner in 2024-25, looking to improve upon last season's 17-16 overall record and 7-11 mark in league action. Tech reached postseason play last year, participating in the inaugural WBIT.
- In five years with Nell Fortner at the helm, the Yellow Jackets have reached postseason play three times (while qualifying a fourth time before Covid-19), including back-to-back appearances in the NCAA Tournament (2022 and 2021). In 2021, Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in program history. Last season, the Yellow Jackets earned a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT).
- Georgia Tech returns four starters from last year's squad guards Kara Dunn, Tonie Morgan and Inés Noguero and forward Kayla Blackshear. Morgan and Dunn led the team offensively last season, having averaged 15.6 and 15.5 points on average, respectively. Three of Tech's four returning starters all averaged double-figure scoring numbers last season. Morgan also returns as the team's leading rebounder, having secured 6.8 rebounds per game, while Blackshear was second on the team with 6.3 rpg.
- The Jackets bring back two second team all-ACC performers from last season Kara Dunn and Tonie Morgan. In addition to earning all-ACC accolades, Morgan was selected to the ACC all-tournament second team after averaging 21.5 points, 9.5 rebounds, 6.0 assists and 1.5 steals per game to help Georgia Tech reach second round action. Meanwhile, Dunn collected an ACC Player of the Week nod in December after the Jacket dropped 39 points against Georgia State.
- Tech returns a core nucleus of seven letterwinners, therefore bringing back 92% of its scoring and 87% of its rebounding from last season. In addition, the seven letterwinners accounted for 88.6 percent of the shots taken and 95.7 percent the free throws attempted.
- In addition to its scoring and rebounding returning, Georgia Tech brings back the majority of production from last season. The Yellow Jackets return solid production in blocks (89.8%), three-pointers (87.9%), steals (81.5%), minutes (80.5%) and assists (79.1%).
- Homegrown talent: Georgia Tech's 12th-ranked recruiting class that joined the roster this season features four student-athletes from the Atlanta metro region - Chazadi 'Chit-Chat' Wright (Atlanta, Ga./Wesleyan School), Dani Carnegie (Mount Vernon, N.Y./Grayson (Ga.)), Gabbie Grooms (Sharpsburg, Ga./Trinity Christian School) and Tianna Thompson (Mableton, Ga./The Galloway School). In addition to its four-member freshmen class, fifth-year transfer, Zoe Smith, hails from Brunswick, Ga., and Kara Dunn calls Dallas, Ga., home.
- Among Tech's five-member newcomer class, fifth-year transfer Zoe Smith joined the roster after playing four seasons at Georgia, A Georgia native, Smith appeared in 74 games while at Georgia, while averaging 5.8 points and 3.5 rebounds per game in Athens. She shot 46.8 percent from the field in her four-years before a season-ending injury cut her senior season short last year. She scored a career-high 21 points as a junior against Georgia Tech.

PRESEASON TUNE-UP

Georgia Tech held its final preseason tune-up against Anderson University in an exhibition game on Halloween. A total of 11 Yellow Jackets took the floor and all 11 contributed offensively in the 109-53 victory. Zoe Smith and Kara Dunn led Tech offensively, each chipping in 18 points, as five Jackets finished in double-figures. Four of Tech's five starters finished in double-figures, including Arianda Termis who tallied 12 points and a team-best seven rebounds.

Tech's 12th-ranked freshmen class saw promising minutes in exhibition play, tallying a combined 31 points, 15 rebounds, eight assists, four steals and three blocks. Tianna Thompson paced the freshmen class with 13 points, going 5-for-7 from the field, including a 2-for-3 effort from three-point range.

STRENGTH OF SCHEDULE

Georgia Tech will face a competitive schedule this year with 16 opponents on the slate having reached postseason play last season. Of those 16 postseason teams, 13 participated in the NCAA Tournament and three reached the Sweet 16. The Yellow Jackets will spend part of their Thanksgiving break in Hawai'i, opening the North Shore Showcase against Summit League defending champions, South Dakota State.

50TH ANNIVERSARY

Georgia Tech will celebrate the 50th anniversary of women's basketball on The Flats during the 2024-25 season. Tech's first varsity female sports team, women's basketball started in 1974-75 and has amassed 774 wins since. In 50 seasons, Georgia Tech has made 11 NCAA Tournament appearances, eight WNIT appearances, and seven GAIAW State Tournaments. The Yellow Jackets made their first postseason appearance in school history in 1992 and won the NWIT in Amarillo, Texas. The win also marked the first NWIT title for an ACC school.

Tech made its first NCAA Tournament appearance in 1992-93. The Jackets didn't return for 10 years, making its next trip in 2003, but then participated in every Big Dance from 2007-2012. In 2012, Tech made its first-ever run to the Sweet 16. The Jackets would return to the Sweet 16 in 2021 with Nell Fortner at the helm.

VERSATILE MORGAN

Tonie Morgan has put together quite the collegiate career on The Flats thus far. After earning ACC All-Freshman Team honors and two ACC Rookie of the Week nods in 2022-23, the Jacket continued her impressive ways as a sophomore last season. Morgan received all-ACC second team honors after leading the Jackets with 15.6 points and 6.8 rebounds per game. She added to her resume with ACC All-Tournament second team honors and a Cancun Challenge all-tournament team selection.

Morgan finished last year with eight double-doubles and posted double-figure scoring totals in 29 games. Morgan also led the Jackets in assists (170) and steals (55). Nationally, she finished the season ranked 33rd in assists (170) and 35th in assists per game (5.2).

The junior is approaching the 1,000-career points mark, currently owning 809 points through two seasons. Morgan will become the 35th player in program history to surpass the 1,000-career points mark.

GETTING IT DUNN

Kara Dunn narrowly finished outside the top spot on the team in scoring as a sophomore last season, averaging 15.5 points per game (Tonie Morgan averaged 15.6 ppg). She led the team in free throw percentage (.782), while finishing second in three-pointers made with 39 to earn her all-ACC second team honors. In ACC games only, Dunn finished 10th in scoring, dropping 16.72 points per game on average.

Freshman Tianna Thompson is no stranger to Georgia Tech, as her father. Rich, ran track and field for the White and Gold from 1988-91. An All-American and Olympic Trials finalist, Rich Thompson was inducted into the Georgia Tech Sports Hall of Fame in 2001. Thompson was tabbed outdoor all-American in the triple jump in 1989 and 1991, while collecting indoor honors in 1991, also for triple jump. He was also a multiple all-ACC honoree.

BASKETBALL HERITAGE

Continuing the theme of basketball families, freshman Gabbie Grooms shares a connection with teammate Kara Dunn as Grooms' mother also played collegiate basketball at the University of Georgia. Lady Grooms (Hardmon) played at UGA from 1989-92, played in 121 games and started 110, donning No. 23. She finished her collegiate career with 1,397 points for an 11.5 average and helped the Bulldogs to the 1991 SEC Championship.

Kara Dunn's mother, Stephanie Wheeler, also played at Georgia (1992-95) and was a member of the 1995 NCAA Final Four team.

ACC/SEC CHALLENGE

The 2024-25 season will mark the second edition of the SEC/ACC Challenge. Georgia Tech drew Mississippi State this season in a rematch of the WBIT first round game that closed last season for the Yellow Jackets.

The 2024 Challenge meeting will be the seventh in program history between the teams with the Bulldogs leading the series, 5-1.

Rusne Augustinaite has seen success in the Challenge. having recorded a career-night in Tech's first Challenge game last year against Florida. The then-freshman dropped 30 points against Florida.

HEADING TO THE NORTH SHORE

Georgia Tech will spend part of the Thanksgiving holiday in Hawai'i as it takes part in the Hawaii North Shore Showcase, Nov. 23-25. The Yellow Jackets will meet South Dakota State in its opening game on Nov. 23 before facing off against Oregon in game two on Nov. 25.

completed her four years in Athens averaging 5.8 points and 3.5 rebounds per game, while shooting 46.8 percent from the floor. She scored a career-high 21 points as a junior against Georgia Tech. Smith graduated from Georgia with a degree in human development and social sciences.

LAST SEASON RECAP

Georgia Tech capped last season with a 17-16 overall record, a four-win improvement from the season before when the Jackets went 13-17 in 2022-23. The Yellow Jackets reached the second round of the ACC Tournament last year, downing Pitt before falling to Duke in the second round.

For the third year under Nell Fortner, Tech reached postseason play, earning a bid to the inaugural Women's Basketball Invitation Tournament (WBIT). Tech dropped a first-round matchup at Mississippi State, but will meet the Bulldogs against this year in the SEC/ACC Challenge.

GOING DANCING

Under the direction of head coach Nell Fortner, Georgia Tech made back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances in 2021 and 2022, marking the first time Tech has made consecutive appearances since six-straight from 2007-12.

Tech reached the Sweet 16 for just the second time in

6th Season • Texas '82

Nell Fortner was named the sixth head coach of Georgia Tech women's basketball on April 9, 2019. One of the most successful coaches in women's basketball history, Fortner has compiled a 393-251 (.615) record as a head coach at the collegiate, professional and international levels. She has led teams to Big Ten (Purdue - 1997) and Southeastern Conference (Auburn - 2009) championships and, perhaps most notably, coached the United States national team to three international titles from 1997-2000, including the gold medal at the 2000 Summer Olympics in Sydney, Australia. Fortner is the winningest coach in the history of the USA women's basketball national team, having compiled a 101-14 (.878) record. In addition to the 2000 Olympics championship, she also led the team to the gold medal at the 1998 World Championship in Berlin, Germany and the 1998 William Jones Cup in Taipei, Taiwan. At the collegiate level, Fortner has 14 seasons of experience as a head coach - one at Purdue (1996-97), eight at Auburn (2004-12) and five at Georgia Tech (2019-pres.) - and has compiled a 250-181 (.585) overall record in the college ranks.
